### HAWKEYES CAPTURE SHARE OF ISU TOURNAMENT TITLE

The Hawkeyes finished 2-1 at the Iowa State Challenge last weekend in Ames, Iowa. The Hawkeyes opened the tournament Friday with a 3-2 win over Syracuse. Trailing 2-0 Friday night at Iowa State, the Hawkeyes rallied to push the match to five sets. The visitors led the fifth set (4-2) before ultimately falling, 3-2, to the 18th-ranked Cyclones. Iowa defeated Eastern Washington in straight-sets Saturday to conclude action. Iowa, Syracuse and host Iowa State all finished with 2-1 records after the Orange defeated the Cyclones in the final match of the Iowa State Challenge on Saturday night, 3-2.

Juniors Rachael Bedell and Nikki Dailey, and sophomore Alex Lovell, were named to the Golden Grizzly Invitational All-Tournament Team. Last weekend, Dailey and Lovell were named to the Iowa State Challenge All-Tournament Team. Dailey turned in three double-doubles and Lovell led the Hawkeyes with 43 kills during the three-match tournament.

## IN GOOD COMPANY

Bethany Yeager became the 14th Hawkeye in program history to surpass 1,000 career digs in Iowa's season-opening sweep of Chicago State. The junior registered a match-high 21 digs in the win. She ranks first in the Big Ten with 201 digs and ranks second in digs per set (5.00). The Brenham, Texas, native ranks 46th nationally in digs per set. Yeager ranks eighth at Iowa in career digs (1,199). Fellow junior Nikki Dailey ranks seventh in career assists (1,867) and stands at eighth in league assists (9.74/set). As a team, the Hawkeyes rank 81st nationally in kills per set.

## DOUBLE THE FUN

Three Hawkeyes have registered a double-double in 2012. Junior Nikki Dailey leads the way with six double-doubles. Sophomore Alex Lovell has turned in five and junior Rachael Bedell has notched four. Dailey recorded double-doubles during all three Iowa State Challenge matches, and has tallied four-straight overall. Lovell registered 17 kills and 10 digs in Iowa's sweep of Eastern Washington last Saturday.

## ROAD WARRIORS

After playing its first four matches at home on Mediacom Court in Carver-Hawkeye Arena at the Hawkeye Challenge (Aug. 24-25), Iowa is in the middle of a stretch of 11-straight matches away from Iowa City. The Hawkeyes went 2-1 last weekend in the Iowa State Challenge after finishing 2-1 in the Oakland Tournament (Aug. 31-Sept. 1). Iowa continues action on the road and concludes nonconference action this weekend in Milwaukee, Wis., at the Marquette Tournament. The Hawkeyes open conference action Sept. 21 at Ohio State and Sept. 22 at Penn State before returning to Iowa City on Sept. 28 to face Michigan in their Big Ten home opener. Iowa is 4-0 in neutral site matches and 0-2 in true road matches.

## BIG TEN GOES BIG IN POLLS

The Big Ten is represented by seven teams in the AVCA top 25 poll, including two of the top four nationally-ranked squads. The seven teams marks the most of any conference. Defending league champion Nebraska is No. 1 overall, followed by Penn State at No. 4. Minnesota ranks 10th and Purdue sits at No. 14. Other top 25 residents include Ohio State (No. 21), Michigan (No. 22) and Illinois (No. 23), the 2011 national runner-up. Michigan State and Northwestern are receiving votes.

## YOU FROM AROUND HERE?

Two Hawkeyes, junior Nikki Dailey and sophomore Emily Yanny, hail from the state of Wisconsin. Dailey is from Franklin and Yanny is a native of New Berlin. Both locations are approximately 15 miles from this weekend's matches in Milwaukee.



## Head Coach Sharon Dingman



Sharon Dingman was named the eighth coach in the history of the University of Iowa volleyball program on March 21, 2008. In four seasons at the helm of the volleyball program, she has imposed a winning attitude and established a volleyball culture that has Iowa fans excited about the immediate future.

In 2011, the Hawkeyes used their second of consecutive nationally recognized recruiting classes to continue building a program that will in time ascend up the Big Ten Standings. Four Hawkeye freshmen combined to start 59 matches, and those four freshmen combined with four sophomores to total 62-percent of Iowa's starting lineup. The Hawkeyes' youth flourished in the non-conference season, racing to a 10-3 record and a pair of tournament championships.

In 2010, Iowa's four freshmen combined for 67 starts. The Hawkeyes started their freshman quartet four times, more than any other Big Ten school. Iowa kicked off the season with consecutive tournament championships and made program history by starting the season 3-0 for the second consecutive year. Iowa knocked off No. 16 Michigan in Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Nov. 12 to mark the third time in as many seasons Dingman and the Hawkeyes defeated a top 25 opponent.

In 2009, Dingman helped Iowa match the best start in program history by guiding the Hawkeyes to a 6-0 start. Iowa eventually became the first team in school history to start the season 7-0 on the road. The Hawkeyes captured five conference wins in 2009, raising Dingman's two-year Big Ten win total to 11, the highest two-year stretch for an Iowa volleyball team since 2000-01.

Iowa set season attendance records in each of Dingman's first two seasons as head coach, including averaging a school-record 1,632 fans in 2009, the 23rd highest total in the country. Since 2008, the Hawkeyes have experienced nine of the school's top 10 all-time attendance figures, and 17 of the top 20. On November 11, 2009, the Hawkeyes eclipsed the 3,000 mark for the first time in program history when 3,102 fans saw Iowa host top-ranked Penn State. Four of Iowa's top 10 all-time attendance figures came in 2011, as fans continued to pack Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena in year four of the Dingman era.

Dingman led the Hawkeyes to their most successful campaign in recent memory in her first season at the helm. Iowa's 14 wins in 2008 were tied for the most since 2000, and its six conference victories are the most since 2000. Dingman guided the Hawkeyes to a ninth place finish in the competitive Big Ten Conference, which was the highest finish for a Hawkeye squad since 2000.

Dingman and the Hawkeyes set or snapped many streaks in a successful first season. Iowa won seven-straight matches, tying the fourth-longest winning streak in school history. The Hawkeyes also swept every opponent during the winning streak and won 15-straight sets. That was the longest set-winning streak since 1990. Iowa opened the conference season with wins over No. 18 Wisconsin and Northwestern, marking only the fifth time in school history that a Hawkeye team started 2-0 in Big Ten play. The Hawkeyes also had a winning record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena for the first time since 1998.

The Hawkeyes also snapped conference losing streaks in Dingman's first season. Iowa defeated Ohio State for the first time in 39 tries, dating back to 1988. That win also broke an 18-match losing skid on the road in Big Ten play. Iowa's upset win over No. 18 Wisconsin snapped a 26-match losing streak against the Badgers, which went back to 1994.

Dingman set a personal milestone at Northwestern on Nov. 14 when she recorded her 350th career win in Iowa's five-set victory. Her career record stands at 388-296 in 22 seasons as a head coach.

### WELCOME

The Hawkeyes have six newcomers on this year's roster. They include sophomore transfers Alessandra Dietz (Loyola-Marymount, 6-1, MB) and Katie Kelley (Maryland, 5-5, DS), and true freshmen Julianne Blomberg (5-11, DS/OH), Kathleen Dailey (5-11, DS/OH), Erin Radke (6-1, RS) and Anne Yanda (5-11, S). Five newcomers -- Dietz, Kelley, Yanda, Radke, Blomberg -- have seen action in 2012.

### HAWKEYE IRONWOMEN

Juniors Bethany Yeager and Nikki Dailey have started every match since the start of the 2011 season. Dailey has not missed a set since last season, while Yeager, an Academic All-Big Ten honoree, has only missed one set in her first three seasons at Iowa (270-of-271).

### RETURNING LEADERS PACING THE HAWKEYES

In 2011, sophomore Alex Lovell led the team in kills and became Iowa's first freshman since 2005 to surpass 300 kills in a single season, recording 312. Junior Nikki Dailey led the team a year ago in assists (1,152) and service aces (33). Junior Bethany Yeager led Iowa in digs (527) for the second time in as many years. All three are leading the same respective categories this season. Lovell is pacing the Hawkeyes with 138 kills. Dailey has registered 409 assists and Yeager leads Iowa with 210 digs.

### GIANT SLAYERS

The Hawkeyes have defeated a ranked team in three of Dingman's four seasons. Iowa will have plenty of opportunities to continue that trend, as seven of its remaining 2012 opponents appear in this week's AVCA top 25 poll. Iowa's top 25 victories since 2008 include: vs. No. 18 Wisconsin (3-0, 2008); vs. No. 18 Michigan State (3-0, 2009); vs. No. 16 Michigan (3-1, 2010). The Hawkeyes are 0-1 against ranked foes this season, falling at No. 18 Iowa State on Sept. 7, 3-2.

### TEAM CAPTAINS

Senior Allison Straumann and juniors Bethany Yeager and Nikki Dailey have been voted team captains for the 2012 season. Straumann, Iowa's lone senior, has appeared in 48 career matches. Yeager and Dailey have started every match since the beginning of last season.

### HAWKEYE SCHEDULE

The Hawkeyes hosted the Hawkeye Challenge and make three weekend road trips before beginning their 20-match Big Ten schedule. The entire 33-match schedule includes 18 contests against teams that appeared in the 2011 NCAA Tournament. Iowa will play a home-away series with every Big Ten team except Illinois and Northwestern for the second-straight season. The Hawkeyes face the Illini once (at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, Nov. 24) and the Wildcats once (at Northwestern, Oct. 21).

**Sharon Dingman** is in her fifth season as the head Hawkeye. She is joined by assistants **Jason Allen** and **Ben Boldt**.

Allen is in his fifth season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Allen was also promoted to the team's recruiting coordinator following the 2008 season. Allen previously served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Sam Houston State University prior to serving as the 16U head coach for the Texas Tornados club program in 2007.

Boldt is in his fourth season as an assistant coach at Iowa. Before joining the Hawkeyes, Boldt spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Alabama. Prior to joining Alabama, Boldt served as a staff assistant for five seasons at the University of Nebraska. In his final season, the Cornhuskers finished 33-1 en route to the NCAA Championship.

**Angie Boldt** is in her fifth season as the Director of Volleyball Operations. She came to Iowa City in 2008 after serving as the Director of Volleyball Operations at Alabama for two seasons.

**Adam Rollman** is in his first season as a volunteer assistant coach. Rollman previously served as a student assistant at Nebraska Wesleyan in 2011 and a student manager for Nebraska in the spring of 2012.
