ON THE MAT

The third-ranked University of Iowa (4-0) wrestling team hosts top-ranked Penn State on Saturday on Mediacom Mat inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena (14,742). The dual begins at 8 p.m. (CT).

Tickets are \$15 for adults and \$8 for youth 18-years old and younger. UI students and youth five-years old and younger are admitted free, but everyone entering the arena must have a ticket.

THE SERIES

Iowa leads the all-time series 26-7-2. The Hawkeyes has won five of the last six meetings, including the most recent dual, 22-16, on Feb. 1, 2013, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

The Hawkeyes are 13-3 all-time at home against Penn State. The Nittany Lions haven't won in Iowa City since defeating Iowa, 21-12, on Feb. 3, 2006.

BRANDS VS. SANDERSON

Iowa head coach Tom Brands owns a 6-1 all-time record against Penn State head coach Cael Sanderson.

Brands and Sanderson met three times from 2006-08, when Sanderson was head coach at Iowa State. Brands won all three meetings.

The coaches have met four times since Sanderson was named head coach at Penn State prior to 2009. Brands won in 2010, 2011 and 2013. Sanderson earned his only win of the series in 2012 (22-12 at State College).

A NONCONFERENCE AFFAIR

Saturday's meeting marks the first time since 1998 the teams will meet in a nonconference dual. Iowa won the last meeting, 23-9, on Jan. 17, 1998, in the NWCA National Duals.

Penn State joined the Big Ten prior to the 1992-93 season. Iowa owns a 10-3-1 advantage in the nonconference series.

24-Ho! Ho! Ho!

The Hawkeyes are 24-0 in December duals since Tom Brands was named head coach prior to the 2006-07 season.

Four Hawkeyes in the probable lineup are undefeated in their career in the month of December. Freshmen Cory Clark (2-0) and Thomas Gilman (1-0) are both undefeated in their young careers, while senior Derek St. John is 14-0 and junior Bobby Telford is 9-0.

THROW OUT THE RANKINGS

Penn State enters the dual ranked No. 1 for the third time in the last four years. Iowa has knocked off the Nittany Lions the last two times they have entered the dual as the nation's top-ranked team.

No. 8 Iowa knocked off No. 1 Penn State, 22-13, on Jan. 30, 2011, and again last season as the nation's No. 3 team, 22-16, in Iowa City.

The lower ranked team has come away with the win in each of the last three meetings.

No. 3 Penn State topped No. 2 Iowa, 22-12, at State College, Pa., on Jan. 22, 2012.

HOME WINNING STREAK

The Hawkeyes have won 13 consecutive duals at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has won 51 of its last 52 duals at home, including a 38-dual home winning streak from 2008-12.

Iowa hasn't lost a nonconference home dual to a team not named Oklahoma State since Dec. 5, 2004 (Iowa State, 19-16).

Iowa is 209-19 (.916) all-time inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

HOME MAT ADVANTAGE

Six Hawkeyes in the probable lineup have a combined 85-0 record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. They include Cory Clark (4-0), Tony Ramos (28-0), Josh Dziewa (5-0), Derek St. John (27-0), Mike Evans (20-0), and Sammy Brooks (1-0).

CLARK AMONG UNBEATENS

Redshirt freshman Cory Clark is one of six Hawkeyes in the probable lineup with an undefeated record.

Clark is 9-0 overall with a team-best six falls. He is 5-0 in duals and 4-0 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Five of his six pins have come in the opening period.

GILMAN SHINES IN DUAL DEBUT

Redshirt freshman Thomas Gilman earned a 12-3 major decision against Edinboro's 17th-ranked Kory Mines in his dual debut Dec. 5.

Gilman improved to 7-1 overall. He has two pins, a technical fall and a major decision among his seven wins. His only loss this season was to teammate Cory Clark in the finals of the Luther Open.

Gilman owned a 23-5 record competing unattached last season. He has three career tournament titles to his credit, including a first-place finish at the 2013 Joe Parisi Open on Nov. 23.

RAMOS CLOSES IN ON MILESTONE

All-American Tony Ramos is four wins shy of becoming the 38th wrestler in program history to reach 100 career wins.

Ramos has a career record of 96-13, including a perfect 27-0 mark inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Ramos owns a 57-2 all-time record in duals, including a 34-1 nonconference mark.

Ranked No. 3 at 133 pounds, Ramos has recorded a team-best six falls this season. He entered the season with 24 career pins, and has since raised his career total to 30. He recorded two falls as a redshirt freshman, eight falls as a sophomore, and 14 falls last season as a junior. Ramos needs 44 career falls to tie Chuck Yagla for 10th all-time in career pins.

Brent Metcalf, who scored 47 pins from 2008-10, was the last Hawkeye to crack the top 10 list. Prior to Metcalf, the list had not changed since Terry Brands (48), Tom Brands (46), and Mark Reiland (45) ended their careers in 1992.

DZIEWA HAPPY AT HOME

Junior Josh Dziejwa is one of six Hawkeyes in the probable lineup with an undefeated record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Dziejwa is 5-0 at home with three pins and two major decisions. He is 7-1 all-time in duals, including a 1-0 mark as a redshirt freshman (149 pounds), and a 1-0 in record last season as a sophomore. Both wins were major decisions.

Dziejwa is 10-1 in his first year as a full-time starter. He four pins and a team-best three major decisions.

KELLY PINS HIS FOURTH

Junior Michael Kelly recorded his fourth fall of the season when he flattened Buffalo's Ryan Todora in 4:03 on Dec. 12.

The four pins matches Kelly's career total heading into this year. He earned two falls as a freshman and two as a sophomore.

Kelly opened the season with a career-best eight-match winning streak. His only loss this season is a 4-2 setback to Iowa State's Luke Goettl. He is 9-1 overall with six bonus-point victories.

ST. JOHN OFF TO HOT START

Senior Derek St. John, who is 27-0 all-time at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, has started 11-0 for the third straight season. He was 11-0 as a sophomore and 22-0 as a junior before suffering his first loss.

St. John has won a team-high 18 straight matches. Among his 10 wins this year, he has five pins, one technical fall and one major decision. He is 6-0 in duals, scoring a team-best 31 points. St. John has a 52-4 all-time dual record.

He enters 2013-14 as a three-time All-American and a chance to become the 18th four-time All-American in school history.

St. John finished fourth as a freshman and runner-up as a sophomore before winning the NCAA title in 2013. He put together five-straight wins to climb to the top of the 157-pound bracket and become the 52nd national champion in program history. His title is the 80th individual NCAA wrestling championship in school history.

Mark Perry was the last Hawkeye four-time All-American. He is also the last Iowa wrestler to win back-to-back NCAA championships. Perry won titles in 2007 and 2008.

MOORE IMPROVES TO 4-0

Junior Nick Moore improved to 5-0 with a 13-4 major decision against Buffalo's Wally Maziarz. The major decision was his first of the young season.

Moore opened the season with a pair of first period falls at the Iowa City Duals, and improved to 3-0 with a 3-1 decision over Iowa State's third-ranked Mike Moreno.

He is currently ranked No. 4 in the national rankings.

Moore was 18-10 overall last season at 165, placing fourth at the Big Ten Championships and earning his first NCAA berth.

11-FOR-11 ON BONUS POINTS

Junior Mike Evans, who is 20-0 all-time inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena, has scored bonus points in each of his 11 matches, including a team-best five technical falls, four pins, and two major decisions.

The four pins surpass his season total from a year ago, when he recorded two falls.

Evans is riding a career-long 11 match winning streak. He opened each of the last two seasons with 9-0 records before suffering his first defeat. He won his first 10 matches while

competing unattached as a freshman.

Evans opened the season in the Iowa starting lineup for the third straight year, but for the first time at 174 pounds. He recorded a 26-8 record at 165 as a freshman, and was 2-0 at 165 his sophomore season before bumping up a weight class. He was 21-7 at 174 in 2013, earning a Big Ten runner-up finish and his first All-America honor.

LOFTHOUSE STREAK HITS 11

Senior Ethen Lofthouse has won a career-best 11-straight matches. He has won his first 10 bouts of 2013-14, and ended last season with a win at the NCAA tournament. His previous career long winning streak was six, which he has done on two other occasions -- first in 2011-12, and then again at the beginning of the 2012-13 season.

Lofthouse is 10-0 this season and ranked No. 2 at 184 pounds.

Among his 10 wins, he has one major decision and five pins, one more than he had all of last year.

BROOKS IMPROVES AT 197

Redshirt freshman Sammy Brooks has recorded a pair of major decisions in his last two outings. A natural 184-pounder, Brooks has bumped up to 197 to wrestle in the absence of Nathan Burak. He has posted a 2-1 record at 197, and owns a 9-3 record overall.

He bumped up a weight class to make his Hawkeye dual debut at Iowa State on Dec. 1, but fell to third-ranked Kyven Gadson, 3-2.

He then recorded an 11-0 major decision to help Iowa prevail at Edinboro, 22-19. The win was the first dual victory of Brooks' career. In his most recent outing, Brooks earned a 13-5 major decision against Buffalo. The outing marking his first career appearance inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

BURAK AWAITS DEBUT

Sophomore Nathan Burak, an NCAA qualifier at 197 pounds last season, could make his season debut against Penn State.

Burak placed fourth at the Big Ten Tournament and advanced to the NCAA round of 12 as a true freshman last season. He has been sidelined since the start of the year with an undisclosed injury.

TELFORD RISES THROUGH FALLS

Junior Bobby Telford opened the season pinning all five opponents at the Luther Open on Nov. 16. It was Telford's first appearance since leaving the 2013 NCAA Championships with a knee injury.

He navigated the 285-pound bracket at the Luther Open in a combined time of 7:32. He pinned his first four opponents in the opening minute before winning the championship finals with a second period fall (4:42). Telford's five falls match his season total from a year ago. He now has 19 career pins.

Telford, who owns a 15-3 career mark inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena, made his 2013-14 dual debut against Buffalo. He scored five takedowns and five nearfall points, totaling 5:28 of riding time, to defeat James Benjamin, 16-3.

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes have seven wrestlers with NCAA Championship experience in the lineup. Senior Derek St. John (157) is the defending national champion at 157 pounds and a three-time All-American. Seniors Ethen Lofthouse (184) and Tony Ramos (133) are three-time NCAA qualifiers and two-time All-Americans. Juniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are two-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012, while Evans earned All-America honors in 2013. Junior Nick Moore (165) and sophomore Nathan Burak (197) both qualified for their first NCAA Championships in 2013.

100-WIN CLUB

LAST MEETING (Feb. 1, 2013 -- Iowa City, Iowa)

Iowa won 6-of-10 matches to defeat top-ranked Penn State, 22-16, in front of a sold-out crowd at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

The win gave the third-ranked Hawkeyes sole possession of first place in the Big Ten and snapped Penn State's streak of 20 consecutive dual victories.

The Hawkeyes won all five matches they were favored and scored an upset at 174 pounds. Sixth-ranked Mike Evans' 4-3 win over No. 4 Matt Brown swung the team score in Iowa's favor and prevented the Hawkeyes from splitting 10 matches and looking at what would have been another tiebreaker scenario.

Iowa's lightweights continued business as usual. Top-ranked Matt McDonough (125) used an escape in the first tiebreak to edge No. 2 Nico Megaludis, 2-1, in a rematch of last year's NCAA finals. Tony Ramos (133) created a bit of breathing room with a second-period pin against Jordan Conway, and Mark Ballweg (141) extended the Iowa lead to 13-0 with a major decision over Bryan Pearsall.

Penn State got on the board when No. 8 Andrew Alton put an 18-8 major decision on Brody Grothus at 149, but top-ranked Derek St. John (157) pushed Iowa's advantage back to 13 points when he scored a takedown with 32 seconds on the clock to defeat No. 5 Dylan Alton, 4-3, and send Iowa into intermission with a 16-4 lead.

Penn State closed the gap again when No. 2 David Taylor earned an 18-2 technical fall against No. 13 Nick Moore, pulling the Nittany Lions within 16-9. Evans' victory helped Iowa reclaim a 19-9 lead, but Penn State set up a decisive heavyweight bout when top-ranked Ed Ruth (184) majored Grant Gambrell, 21-10, and third-ranked Quentin Wright (197) defeated No. 19 Nathan Burak, 8-3.

Penn State entered the heavyweight match with an advantage in the tiebreak criteria, but Iowa walked to the mat with a 19-16 lead and the 285-pound favorite. Sixth-ranked Bobby Telford took the drama out of the match early when he took No. 17 Jon Gingrich to the mat at the 1:56 mark of the opening period. Telford put a 1:56 ride on Gingrich to end the first, and saddled the Nittany Lion the length of the second, earning a stall point along the way. He added an escape, a reversal, a takedown and a point for riding time to win the match, 9-2, and send 15,077 home with a 22-16 Hawkeye victory.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

Iowa's overall dual meet record is 932-222-31 (.799) in 104 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 52 NCAA Champions have won a total of 80 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 105 Big Ten champions have won a total of 190 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 28 two-time Iowa winners. Iowa's 148 All-Americans have earned All-America status 301 times, including 17 four-time, 32 three-time and 38 two-time honorees.

ALL-AMERICAN STREAK

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 42 seasons. Iowa has totaled 255 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes return five All-Americans to this year's squad. Tony Ramos (2nd-133), Derek St. John (1st-157), Mike Evans (6th-174) and Ethen Lofthouse (5th-184) join 2012 All-American Bobby Telford (5th-285) in the 2013-14 lineup.

40 YEARS OF DOMINANCE

Since 1974, only seven schools have captured the NCAA Championship. During that 40-year span, the Hawkeyes have won 23 team titles, including nine straight from 1978-86. The other schools include Oklahoma State (7), Minnesota (3), Penn State (3), Iowa State (2), Arizona State (1) and Oklahoma (1).

ATTENDANCE LEADERS AT IT AGAIN

In seven home dates last season, Iowa averaged 8,764 fans per dual. It marked the fifth straight year Iowa averaged over 8,000 fans, and the seventh straight season the Hawkeyes led the nation in attendance. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,955, set when Iowa defeated Iowa State (20-15) on Dec. 6, 2008.

The seventh-largest dual crowd in NCAA history saw Iowa defeat top-ranked Penn State on Friday, Feb. 1, 2013. The Hawkeyes drew a sellout crowd of 15,077, the sixth-largest wrestling crowd in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history.

That all-time single dual record stood until Dec. 8, 2013, when 15,996 watched Pitt wrestle Penn State at the Bryce Jordan Center.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

The Hawkeyes have won 13-straight duals inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena (14,742). Iowa finished the 2012-13 home schedule with a 9-0 record at home. The perfect record marked Iowa's 20th undefeated season at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Fieldhouse in 1983. Iowa has a 209-19 (.915) all-time record in the arena. The Hawkeyes have also won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

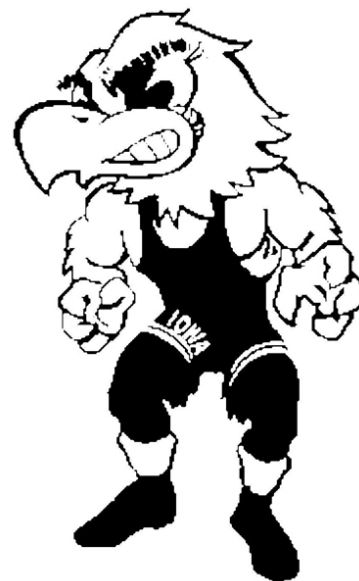

Tom Brands Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 137-13-1 (.911) overall and 51-5 (.911) Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 154-32-1 (.820) career mark.

In seven seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning eight NCAA champions, 10 Big Ten champions and 38 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 53 academic all-Big Ten honorees, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 62 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last seven years, sending the entire 10-man

lineup in 2009-10. Iowa has also won five of the last six Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, Iowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

Iowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when it hosted Iowa State Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The previous record of 15,646 was set Feb. 1, 2002, when Minnesota hosted Iowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis. The Hawkeyes won the Iowa State dual, 20-15. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' six seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive seasons.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginia Tech crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
