BIG TEN OPENER STORYLINES

- Iowa won its second straight Big Ten/ACC Challenge game with a 68-54 triumph at Syracuse Tuesday; the Hawkeyes beat Pittsburgh a year ago in Iowa City in the Challenge.
- Luka Garza is the only player in the country from a Power 5 Conference to average 20 points and 10 rebounds.
- The last time Iowa won its conference opener was on Dec. 29, 2015, against top-ranked Michigan State (83-70) in Iowa City.
- Luka Garza leads the Big Ten in scoring (20.0), ranks third in double-doubles (4), overall rebounding (10.0) and offensive rebounding (3.4), and fourth in 3-point accuracy (.500). Garza, who enters Friday's game 21 points from career point No. 1,000, leads the Hawkeyes in 10 statistical categories.
- Connor McCaffery has 38 assists and only seven turnovers, tops in the Big Ten and fourth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (5.4). Over the last six games, McCaffery has 32 assists and only four turnovers.
- Friday's game features two of the country's top big men: Iowa's Luka Garza (20 ppg and 10 rpg) and Michigan's Jon Teske (13.9 ppg and 9.8 rpg).
- CJ Fredrick (quad) and Cordell Pemsil (back) did not play in Iowa's last game due to injury.
- Luka Garza and CJ Fredrick were named to last week's Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team.
- Jack Nunge suffered a season-ending torn ACL of his right knee versus Cal Poly on Nov. 24.
- Jordan Bohannon surpassed Ronnie Lester for sixth place on Iowa's career list. Bohannon is eight points from tying Jarrod Uthoff for 21st on Iowa's all-time scoring chart.
- Iowa has led the Big Ten in scoring offense two of the last six years, including last season.
- Iowa has qualified for four NCAA tournaments over the last six years (2014, 2015, 2016, 2019) and seven postseason tournaments over the last eight seasons (4 NCAA; 3 NIT).
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to 20 wins or more in five of the last seven seasons and upper division finishes in the Big Ten six of the last seven seasons. Only Michigan State (7) has more first division finishes than Iowa (6) and Wisconsin (6) since the 2013 season.
- Jordan Bohannon is the 10th player in all of Division I basketball since 1992, to post at least 79 triples and 118 assists per season in each of his first three seasons.
- Luka Garza joins Aaron White, Tyler Cook, and Jess Settles as the only Hawkeyes to total more than 800 points and 350 rebounds through their sophomore season.

THE SETTING

Iowa (6-2, 0-0) will play its fourth game away from home in nine days on Friday when the Hawkeyes travel to Ann Arbor, Michigan, to take on No. 4/5 Michigan (7-1, 0-0) in the Big Ten opener for both teams. Tipoff is set for 5:31 p.m. (CT) at the Crisler Center.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Friday's conference opener will be televised nationally on FS1. Tim Brando and Jim Jackson will call the action.

HAWKEYES WIN AT SYRACUSE TUESDAY NIGHT

Iowa led Syracuse by as many as 19 points in the second half to pull away from the Orange and register a 68-54 win Tuesday night at the Carrier Dome in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. Iowa has won its last two Challenge games, winning at home against Pittsburgh a year ago.

- After missing his first six 3-point attempts, Jordan Bohannon finished the game making five of his last eight attempts from distance and finished with 17 points.
- Luka Garza led all scorers, pouring in 23 points, while also grabbing nine boards.
- Iowa's defense allowed a season-low 54 points, limiting the Orange to 36.5 percent shooting from the field.
- Joe Wieskamp posted season bests in steals (3), rebounds (9), and assists (4), while also scoring 13 points in the winning effort.
- Iowa attempted 34 triples, tying for the seventh most in a single-game in program history. The Hawkeyes equaled a season high with 11 3-pointers, marking the second time in three games Iowa has made 11 triples in a game (Texas Tech).
- Iowa won by double digits without the services of starting guard CJ Fredrick (quad) and reserve forward Cordell Pemsl (back).
- Iowa improved to 7-12 in Big Ten/ACC Challenge games, two of the wins have come on the road: at North Carolina (60-55) in 2015 and at Syracuse (68-54) in 2019.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...

Over the next six weeks, Iowa will play games in three different time zones, seven different states, and travel 8,362 total miles.

Iowa is in the middle of a stretch playing eight of 10 games away from Iowa City. The Hawkeyes will play six of seven contests against teams who finished in the Top 100 of the NCAA NET Ranking a year ago from Nov. 28 to Dec. 21 (Texas Tech, Syracuse, Michigan, Minnesota, Iowa State, and Cincinnati).

HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2023 season, is in his 10th season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 24th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau eight of the last 12 seasons, including four of the last six years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He concluded his 37th season as a collegiate coach in 2019, which includes 23 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery is one of 14 coaches to lead at least four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 59, holds a career mark of 431-311 (.580) and guided his teams to 12 postseason appearances (nine NCAA & four NIT). He is 180-134 (.573) at Iowa; the second winningest coach in program history. McCaffery led Iowa to NCAA Tournament wins in three of the last five years (2015, 2016, and 2019).

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned seven postseason tournament berths (4 NCAA, 3 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided seven different Hawkeyes to all-conference honors, including four straight first team honorees (2014-17). The last time Iowa had four consecutive first-team all-league honorees was 1945-48.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in six of the last seven seasons at Iowa and 18 of 23 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more nine of the last 13 seasons, including five of the last seven years at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2019). Iowa's 163 victories between 2013-19 are the most over an eight-year span at Iowa since 1987-94.

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 96-27 (.780) home record the last seven seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons. McCaffery's achievements earned the head coach Siena Hall of Fame recognition in 2017.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

ALL-TIME SERIES RECORDS

Michigan holds a 95-64 advantage in the series. The Hawkeyes have won six of the last 10 meetings. Iowa and Michigan split last season's two contests: Iowa won in Iowa City (74-59), while Michigan won in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals in Chicago (74-53).

The Wolverines hold a 52-24 advantage in games played in Ann Arbor. Michigan snapped a two-game losing streak in Iowa's last visit to the Crisler Center on Feb. 14, 2018 (74-59). Iowa's 72-54 victory in Ann Arbor in 2015, was Iowa's largest margin of victory at Michigan in 61 years.

LAST YEAR VERSUS MICHIGAN

- In Iowa's home win over the Wolverines last February, three Hawkeyes scored in double figures: Luka Garza (19), Joe Wieskamp (16), and Ryan Kriener (15). The Hawkeyes held the Wolverines to 32 percent shooting from the field, while the Hawkeyes shot the ball at a 45 percent clip.
- In Michigan's victory in last season's Big Ten Tournament, the Wolverines held Iowa to a season-low 6.3 percent (1-of-16) from 3-point range. Tyler Cook and Luka Garza combined for 28 points to lead Iowa, while five Wolverines netted double figures.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN

- Michigan won its first seven games of the season and made the largest jump in the 70-year history of the AP Poll checking in at No. 4 this week after being unranked the first four weeks of the season.
- The Wolverines won their first seven games of the season by an average of 16.4 points, including victories over Iowa State, North Carolina, and Gonzaga to become 2019 Battle 4 Atlantis Champions.
- Michigan lost its first game of the season Tuesday night at top-ranked Louisville (58-43). The Wolverines were held to 26 percent from the field (15-of-58), including just 16 percent of its 3-point attempts (3-of-19). Center Jon Teske led the Wolverines, totaling 18 points and 10 rebounds.
- Michigan ranks first in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (.397, second in 3-pointers made (9.4), third in field goal accuracy (.496), and fourth in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.291).
- Four starters average double figures in scoring: Isaiah Livers (15.3); Jon Teske (13.9); Zavier Simpson (11.9); and Eli Brooks (11.5). Simpson also ranks second in the nation in assists per game (8.9).
- Two Wolverines have made 15 or more 3-pointers: Isaiah Livers (22) and Eli Brooks (16). Michigan ranks 24th in the country in 3-point accuracy (75-of-189, .397).
- All but three of Michigan's outcomes have been decided by 10 points or more.
- Former Michigan All-American Juwan Howard is in his first season as a collegiate head coach. Howard returns to Ann Arbor after spending the last six years with the Miami Heat. While an assistant for the last five years (2014-19), Howard helped the Heat win three division titles and one Eastern Conference championship. Howard spent his first year as an assistant coach/player development coach (2013-14) as well as serving as the team's defensive coordinator. Prior to beginning his coaching career, Howard played 19 years in the NBA, including winning back-to-back NBA championships with Miami in 2012 and 2013. Howard was a three-year letterman from 1991-94 and helped lead the Wolverines to back-to-back Final Four appearances in 1992 and 1993.

McCAFFERY'S JOIN LIST OF BROTHERS ON SAME TEAM

Redshirt sophomore Connor McCaffery and freshman Patrick McCaffery are one of 16 brothers nationally who are playing on the same Division I team this season. The McCaffery's at Iowa join brothers playing at Oklahoma State, Ohio, Northwestern State, Vermont, Pepperdine, Eastern Washington, Mount St. Mary's, Navy, Maryland, Coppin State, Boston College, Robert Morris, Ohio State, SIUE, and The Citadel.

Iowa is one of 13 father/coach and son/player duos in Division I in 2019-20 (Cal Poly, Central Connecticut State, Davidson, Detroit Mercy, Illinois, Oregon State, Portland, Syracuse, Texas Southern, UT Martin, Utah, and Wright State). Of the 13 schools, the McCaffery's are the only program with a father/coach and two sons on the roster.



NUNGE SUFFERS TORN ACL

University of Iowa men's basketball sophomore Jack Nunge suffered a season-ending torn anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) of his right knee in Sunday's home game versus Cal Poly. The injury occurred late in the first half as Nunge was driving to the basket.

"All of us feel for Jack," said McCaffery. "This is an unfortunate setback for a young man who spent countless hours in the gym and weight room last year preparing for this season. Jack has the full support of his teammates and coaches during his recovery."

Nunge (6-foot-11, 245 pounds) started Iowa's first five games, averaging six points, 4.6 rebounds, and 1.8 assists. The native of Newburgh, Indiana, redshirted last season.

GARZA PRODUCING BOTH INSIDE AND OUT

Luka Garza has been Iowa's bell cow the first eight games of the season. The junior is producing both inside and out, ranking second on the squad in 3-point percentage (.500, 9-of-18) and is third in field goal efficiency (.568, 63-of-111). He is the only player from a Power 5 conference to average 20 points and 10 rebounds.

Garza leads the team in 10 statistical categories: scoring (20.0), rebounding (10.0), double-doubles (4), offensive rebounding (3.4), defensive rebounding (6.6), blocked shots (1.5), field goals made (63) and attempted (111), free throws made (25) and attempted (41).

Garza leads the Big Ten in scoring (20.0 ppg), and is third in double-doubles (4) and rebounding (10.0 rpg). The native of Washington, D.C., has registered four double-doubles, including back-to-back efforts against Oral Roberts and North Florida. Garza made 12 of his final 13 field goal attempts in the win over the Ospreys.

Garza has grabbed a season-high 12 rebounds in three games this season (SIUE, North Florida, and Texas Tech). He has controlled eight rebounds or more in all eight contests in 2019-20.

Garza registered a career-high 30 points and 10 rebounds against Oral Roberts, becoming the first Hawkeye since Peter Jok in 2016 to total at least 30 points and 10 rebounds in a game. Jok amassed 33 points and 10 boards versus Omaha.

2 HAWKEYES NAMED TO PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

Junior Luka Garza and sophomore Joe Wieskamp have been named to preseason watch lists.

Garza is one of 20 players named to the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Watch List. The honor recognizes the top center in college basketball. Garza was an honorable mention All-Big Ten honoree after ranking second on the team in scoring (13.1) and fourth in rebounding (4.5) a season ago. Garza enters Friday's game at Michigan with 979 career points, 21 shy of the 1,000-point milestone.

Wieskamp is one of 20 players named to the Jerry West Award Watch List. The honor recognizes the top shooting guard in men's college basketball. Wieskamp was named to the All-Big Ten Freshman Team last season after ranking second in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (.424, 59-of-139) and ranking third on the team in scoring (11.1) and steals (32), and second in rebounding (4.9). Wieskamp ranks third on the team in scoring (11.1) and is second in rebounding (5.4).

Both lists will be narrowed down to 10 in mid-February and then five finalists will be selected in March that will be presented to Abdul-Jabbar and West and the selection committees.

GET TO KNOW THE NAME -- CJ FREDRICK

Redshirt freshman CJ Fredrick has made an impact on this team, just seven games into his collegiate career. Fredrick was named to the Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team last weekend after averaging 13 points, 3.5 assists, and 3.0 rebounds. The native of Cincinnati, Ohio, did not play in Iowa's last outing at Syracuse due to a sore quad in his left leg. It is hopeful he will return for Friday's game at Michigan.

Fredrick is second on the team in scoring (11.1) and ranks first in the Big Ten in 3-point accuracy (.565, 13-of-23), is second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.6), 13th in field goal percentage (.587, 27-of-46), 14th in 3-pointers made per game (1.9), and 14th in assists (3.3).

Fredrick led Iowa in scoring in three games (DePaul, Cal Poly, and San Diego State).

GETTING TO THE FREE THROW LINE

Iowa has earned 186 free throw attempts through eight games. Iowa's 23.25 average ranks 36th in the country. The Hawkeyes have made more free throws (135) than their opponents (111) have attempted (+24). Jordan Bohannon, who has led the Big Ten in free throw accuracy each of the last two seasons, leads the conference again so far this year, making all 12 attempts. Connor McCaffery ranks fifth (.895), while Joe Toussaint is 14th (.793).

BOHANNON JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

Jordan Bohannon is 12 assists from becoming the sixth Hawkeye to amass 1,000 points and 500 assists. Bohannon, Iowa's all-time leader in 3-pointers made, Hawkeye senior enters Friday's Big Ten opener at Michigan with 280 3-pointers; Ohio State's Jon Diebler (2008-11) is the Big Ten all-time leader in triples made (374).

WIESKAMP NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN

Sophomore shooting guard Joe Wieskamp is one of 10 men's basketball players selected to the 2019-20 Preseason All-Big Ten team as selected by a media voting panel.

Wieskamp was named to the five-player All-Big Ten Freshman Team a season ago, leading the team and finishing second in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (.424, 59-of-139). He ranked third on the team in scoring (11.1) and steals (32), and second in rebounding (4.9). The Muscatine, Iowa, native joins Ayo Dosunmu of Illinois and Maryland's Jalen Smith as the only underclassmen recognized on the 10-player team. Wieskamp is the third Hawkeye in the last five seasons to be named Preseason All-Big Ten (Peter Jok, 2016; Jarrod Uthoff, 2015).

GARZA JOINS ELITE COMPANY

Luka Garza has put up numbers that few Hawkeyes have done through their sophomore season. Garza joins Aaron White, Jess Settles, and Tyler Cook as the only Hawkeyes to total more than 800 points and 350 rebounds through their sophomore year.

Garza's sophomore campaign started with surgery in early September to remove a benign cyst in his abdomen. The native of Washington, D.C., recovered in time to start the season opener and have another stellar season for the Hawkeyes. Garza was an honorable mention all-conference honoree and was voted the MVP of the 2K Empire Classic in New York City.

Garza achieved single season bests in points per game (13.1), field goals made per game (4.9), and free throw percentage (.804). He ranked second on the squad in scoring (13.1) and fourth in rebounding (4.5).

BOHANNON RECOVERS FROM HIP SURGERY

Senior guard Jordan Bohannon has been recovering from hip surgery in May. Bohannon entered the 2019-20 season with 96 consecutive starts, which tied for the eighth-longest active streak in the country. The streak was snapped in Iowa's opener versus SIUE, playing 19 minutes off the bench.

Bohannon (6-foot-1, 185 pounds) suffered the injury early his junior season and managed the injury until the end of the season.

A third-team All-Big Ten performer last season, Bohannon was credited with a team-best 118 assists, becoming just the seventh Hawkeye to register three 100-assist seasons. The native of Marion, Iowa, is one of 10 Division I basketball players since 1992, to total at least 79 3-pointers and 118 assists in each of his first three seasons. As a junior, Bohannon ranked third on the team in scoring (11.6 ppg) and led the Big Ten in free throw accuracy during league play. Bohannon is Iowa's all-time leader in 3-point field goals made (275). Last season, Bohannon netted 85 points over the final two minutes of regulation and two minutes of overtime to rank among the nation's best.

Bohannon became the seventh Hawkeye to register three 100-assist seasons (Dean Oliver, Jeff Horner, B.J. Armstrong, Andre Woolridge, Mike Gesell, Devyn Marble).

FRESHMAN GAINING CONFIDENCE

Freshman Joe Toussaint is gaining confidence with each game played. The native of New York ranks fifth on the team in scoring (7.4), is third in assists (2.25), and is 23-of-29 (.793) from the foul line.

Against North Florida, Toussaint shined, scoring seven of his 10 points and dishing out three of his four assists in highlight fashion over the final 20 minutes. The native of Bronx, New York, equaled a personal best with 13 points, including sinking all nine free throw attempts, against San Diego State in Las Vegas on Nov. 29.

RYAN KRIENER TAKES THE NEXT STEP

Ryan Kriener registered single-season bests in nearly every statistical category as a junior last year. His scoring (5.7) and rebounding (3.0) averages improved, along with his shooting percentages. Kriener tallied double figures seven times in 2018-19.

The native of Spirit Lake, Iowa, is off to a good start in 2019-20 ranking second off the bench in scoring (6.1) and fourth overall in rebounding (4.3). He is second on the team in field goal accuracy, making 17 of his 29 attempts (.586) and is 14-of-20 (.700) from the charity stripe.

3 HAWKEYES RETURN AFTER REDSHIRT YEAR

Forwards Jack Nunge and Cordell Pems, along with guard CJ Fredrick are on this season's roster after redshirting a year ago.

Nunge saw action in all 33 games as a freshman, ranking second on the team in blocked shots (25), fourth in steals (21), and fifth in scoring (5.7). However, Nunge will miss the remainder of the 2019-20 season after suffering a torn ACL in his right knee in Iowa's fifth contest of the season. Pems played in two nonconference games before undergoing a procedure to remove hardware near his knee last December. He has played in 68 career games, averaging 7.2 points and 4.7 rebounds per game.

Fredrick was the 2018 Kentucky Gatorade Player of the Year his senior year at Covington Catholic High School.

Joining the three redshirts on the roster this season will be newcomers: Bakari Evelyn, Joe Toussaint, Patrick McCaffery, and Aidan Vanderloo. Evelyn is a graduate transfer from Valparaiso, while Toussaint, McCaffery and Vanderloo (walk-on) are true freshmen.

2019-20 SCHEDULE NOTES

- Iowa will play 14 games against teams who finished in the Top 50 of the NCAA NET Rankings last season. Furthermore, the Hawkeyes will play six of seven games against teams who finished in the Top 100 of the NCAA NET Ranking a year ago from Nov. 28 to Dec. 21 (Texas Tech, Syracuse, Michigan, Minnesota, Iowa State, Cincinnati).
- Iowa will play games in three different time zones and ten states, including games in Las Vegas, Chicago, Indianapolis, Philadelphia, and New York.
- From Nov. 28-Jan. 4, the Hawkeyes will travel 8,362 total miles (Las Vegas, Syracuse, Ann Arbor, Ames, Chicago, Philadelphia).
- Iowa's first five games of the season will be played at home at Carver-Hawkeye Arena, from Friday, Nov. 8 to Sunday, Nov. 24. The last time Iowa opened with five straight home games was the 2013-14 season.
- Iowa will visit the Palestra in Philadelphia on Jan. 4, for a Big Ten game against Penn State. It will mark the Hawkeyes' first visit to the historic building since 1961. Fran McCaffery played inside the Palestra for three years while a guard at Penn (1980-82).
- Iowa will open Big Ten play versus Michigan in Ann Arbor on Dec. 6. The last time the Hawkeyes opened league play against the Wolverines in Ann Arbor was the 1968-69 season.
- Iowa will play three straight Big Ten home games for the first time since 2003. The Hawkeyes will host Michigan on Jan. 17; Rutgers on Jan. 22; Wisconsin on Jan. 27.
- Iowa's Big Ten home opener will be against Minnesota on Dec. 9. The last time the Hawkeyes hosted the Golden Gophers in their first league home game was the 1995-96 season.
- The Hawkeyes will play Cincinnati for the second straight season on Dec. 21 (Chicago), after beating the Bearcats in the first round of the NCAA Tournament last March in Columbus. Four of the previous nine meetings against Cincinnati have come on a neutral floor.
- Iowa will host nine weekend home games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena, including five Big Ten games on Friday, Saturday or Sunday.

PATRICK McCAFFERY GRANTED #22

Patrick McCaffery has been granted uniform No. 22 to wear by All-American Bill Seaberg (1954-56) in honor of his friend Austin "Flash" Schroeder, who passed away in 2015.

McCaffery started wearing No. 22 when his father was the coach at Siena and it was the number of his favorite Siena player, Ryan Rossiter. McCaffery has worn that number for each team he has played for at every level. It also was the number that Schroeder wore in baseball.

Cancer touched both of their lives. McCaffery had surgery on March 19, 2014, to remove a tumor on his thyroid. On that same day, while on a family spring break trip to Mexico, Austin discovered a large lump in his groin. Two days after Patrick's surgery, doctors informed his family that the tumor was malignant. A second surgery was scheduled in April. That month, Schroeder started chemotherapy for T-Cell lymphoma. Schroeder was 15 when he passed away on April 28, 2015.

Seaberg's No. 22 hasn't appeared for 63 seasons and 1,845 games. McCaffery wrote Seaberg a letter, explaining what No. 22 means to him. Seaberg agreed to let McCaffery wear it, with the stipulation that it return to retired status after McCaffery's playing career ends at Iowa.

McCaffery played in Iowa's first two games, however has missed the last six contests.

Garza is the seventh Hawkeye to score 30 or more points in a single game in the McCaffery era.
- Iowa won 21 games in the 2018-19 regular season, matching the highest total in 13 seasons (2015 and 2016).
- Iowa posted five victories over nationally-ranked opponents in 2018-19, equaling Iowa's highest total in the Fran McCaffery era and the most since 2006 (8).

- Riley Till and Michael Baer earned Dean's List recognition for their academic achievements in the Fall of 2018.

- Iowa is 90-21 when scoring 80 points or more, the last 10 seasons. The Hawkeyes are 74-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last 10 years.
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to upper division finishes in the Big Ten in six of the last seven seasons. McCaffery has accumulated 18 first division finishes in 23 years as a head coach.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,816 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,655-1,159 (.588). Iowa's 1,655 wins are 36th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,057-371 (.740) record in home games, a 592-787 (.429) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 776-788 (.496) mark in Big Ten games and a 462-145 (.761) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

LUTE OLSON ENSHRINED IN HALL OF FAME

Former Iowa head men's basketball coach Lute Olson was enshrined in the College Basketball Hall of Fame in Kansas City on Nov. 24. Olson coached Iowa for nine seasons (1974-83), taking the Hawkeyes to five straight NCAA Tournaments, including the 1980 Final Four. He left as the Hawkeyes' winningest coach -- his 165 wins now rank third most in school history. Olson was instrumental in the vision and construction of Carver-Hawkeye Arena, which opened on Jan. 5, 1983. Olson went on to coach at the University of Arizona for 25 years (1983-2008).

FRAN McCAFFERY SIGNS FIRST GRAD TRANSFER

Fran McCaffery enters his 10th season as head coach of the Hawkeyes and signed his first graduate transfer this past July. Bakari Evelyn, a native of Detroit, played the previous two seasons at Valparaiso (2017-18) and his freshman year at Nebraska (2016).

Last season at Valparaiso, Evelyn tied for first on the team in 3-pointers made (48), ranked second in assists (68) and fifth in scoring (8.4 ppg). He led the team in steals and assists in six games, and scoring three times.

As a sophomore, Evelyn was a Missouri Valley Conference All-Newcomer Team selection and was named co-MVP of the Savannah Invitational. He was the only Crusader to start all 32 games, ranking second on the team in scoring (12.6 ppg) and first in assists (93).

Evelyn saw limited action in 18 games as a freshman at Nebraska.

COACHING EXPERIENCE

McCAFFERY RECORDS WIN NO. 20

Last season, Fran McCaffery and the Iowa Hawkeyes reached the 20-win plateau for the fifth time in seven seasons. McCaffery joins Lute Olson (6) and Tom Davis (10) as the only Iowa head coaches to win 20 or more games in at least five seasons. Both Olson and Davis had 20 or more victories over a span of six of seven seasons.

McCaffery has taken Iowa to the NCAA Tournament four times. Among Iowa's head basketball coaches, McCaffery ranks third in tournament appearances behind Davis (9) and Olson (5). Davis is Iowa's all-time winningest coach, while McCaffery moved past Olson into second place earlier this season.

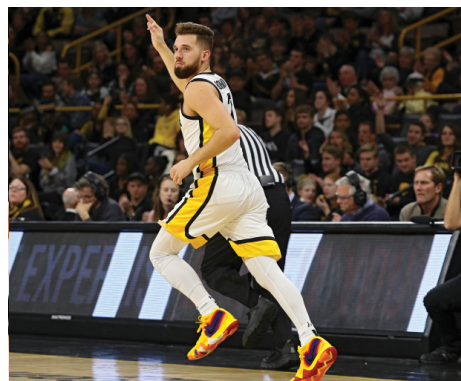
