THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa track and field team travels to the 28th-annual Meyo Invitational in South Bend, Indiana, to compete Friday and Saturday. Friday's competition begins with field events at 3 p.m. (CT) followed by running events at 3:30 p.m. inside the Loftus Sports Center on the campus of the University of Notre Dame. Action resumes Saturday with running events at 8:45 a.m. and field events at 9:30 a.m.

A BIG WEEKEND AHEAD

The invitational hosts one of the largest fields in recent history with nearly 1,000 entries from 49 schools and several track clubs from across the country. The annual event averages between 700 and 800 participants, including All-Americans and Olympians.

MALLETT PUNCHES TICKET TO NCAA

Junior All-American Aaron Mallett ran two of the fastest times of his collegiate career in the men's 60-meter hurdles at the Razorback Invitational on Jan. 30. He leads the Big Ten in the event and ties for fourth nationally after posting 7.71 -- 0.01 hundredths shy of the school record (7.70) -- in the prelims. He took the event title in 7.72 over Oregon's Devon Allen (7.74) in the finals to remain undefeated this season.

2016 INDOOR SEASON LEADERS

GUSTER RESUMES HER POST

Junior Elexis Guster leads the Big Ten in the women's 400 meters for the second consecutive week. She first climbed to the top of the conference following a winning performance in 54.21 at the Big 4 Duals on Jan. 23. The defending 400-meter champion widened her margin over Minnesota's Titania Markland (53.91) when she posted 53.52 at the Razorback Invitational on Jan. 30. That time ranks 11th nationally.

THOMAS, MEYERS REACH BENCHMARK

Sophomore Jahisha Thomas and junior Avery Meyers each reached a new milestone in their respective events at the Razorback Invitational from Jan. 29-30.

In her first long jump appearance of the season, Thomas climbed one spot to second on Iowa's all-time list for her indoor collegiate-best leap of 19-9 1/2 (6.03m). That is the first time the London native has jumped over six meters in the event during an indoor season.

In the field for Iowa, Meyers threw over 59 feet in the men's shot put for the first time in his collegiate career. His mark, 59-0 1/4 (17.99m), moved him to eighth all-time.






