## 2006 WOMEN'S OUTDOOR SEASON BESTS

**THIS WEEK** -- The Iowa men and women's track teams will compete at the Big Ten outdoor championships, Friday through Sunday, in East Lansing, MI. All events will be held at the Ralph Young Track and Field Facility. Tickets are available from the Michigan State University Athletic Ticket Office at (800) 467-8283 or www.msuspartans.com. Tickets are \$10 for adults (Ages 18-54) and \$5 for youth and seniors (Ages 0-17 and 55+) each day.

ALEXANDER, ROACH ATTEMPT TO JOIN HAWKEYE ELITE -- This weekend sophomore Kineke Alexander and junior Peaches Roach will try to become the third and fourth female student-athletes in school history to win four career Big Ten titles. Both student-athletes have several opportunities to accomplish the feat.

**Roach**, a three-time conference champion, won high jump titles at the 2004 indoor and outdoor Big Ten meets and at the 2005 indoor meet. The Kingston, Jamaica, native leads the Big Ten in the high jump, anchored the 400-meter relay that leads the conference and is ranked fifth in the 100 meters. **Roach** could also make her mark in the Iowa record books. No female track student-athlete has ever totaled more than four conference titles or won more than three in one event.

**Alexander**, is a two-time Big Ten champion, winning the 200 and 400 meters at the 2006 Big Ten indoor meet. The native of Mesopotamia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, leads the Big Ten in the 200 meters and as part of the 400-meter relay. She also ranks second in the 400 meters and as part of the 1,600-meter relay.

The other two Hawkeyes to win four Big Ten titles are **Vivien McKenzie** and **Shellene Williams**. **McKenzie** won three titles in the 100 meters and one in the 55 meters from 1983-85. **Williams** won three titles in the 400 meters and one as part of the 1,600-meter relay from 2003-04.

**BRODERSEN LOOKS TO DEFEND DISCUS TITLE** -- Hawkeye senior **Tim Brodersen** will try to defend the Big Ten discus title he won at the 2005 championships. The Vermillion, SD, native is Iowa's seventh conference discus champion in school history. **Brodersen's** season-best throw of 187-9 ranks second in the conference. Minnesota's Karl Erickson leads the Big Ten with a season-best toss of 200-6 1/4.

**2005 BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIPS REVIEW** -- The Hawkeye men's team placed eighth with 53 points at the 2005 Big Ten Outdoor Championships, while the women's team placed ninth with 52.5. Junior **Tim Brodersen**

^ - regional qualifier, \* - school record \$ - NCAA provisional qualifier won Iowa's lone individual title in the discus. Iowa had three runners-up in senior **Chris Voller** (hammer throw), sophomore **Peaches Roach** (high jump) and sophomore **Tiffany Johnson** (100-meter hurdles).

Seniors **Andy Banse** and **Aisha Hume**, **Roach** and freshman **Kineke Alexander** each recorded two top-five placings. **Banse** placed third in the shot put (60-10) and fourth in the discus (177-11), **Hume** placed fourth in the 800 meters (2:09.50) and third as part of the 1,600-meter relay (3:40.34), **Roach** placed second in the high jump (5-8 3/4) and third in the 100 meters (11.66) and **Alexander** placed fourth in the 400 meters (53.89) and third as part of the 1,600-meter relay (3:40.34). The Hawkeyes recorded 14 top-five individual finishes.

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN HISTORY -- The Iowa men's team has won two Big Ten outdoor team championships (1963, 1967) and 106 event titles since the first meet was held in 1901. Two former Hawkeyes hold a spot in the conference record books. In 1997, Bashir Yamini tied the long jump record of 26-8 1/4 set in 1935 by Ohio State's Jesse Owens. Jon Reimer holds the retired 330-yard hurdles record of 36.1, set in 1965. The Hawkeye men's team has had four student-athletes earn conference individual outdoor track honors. Pat McGhee is the lone Hawkeye to earn two awards in the same season, being Male Athlete of the Year and Athlete of the Championships in 1989. Other outdoor honorees were Anthuan Maybank (1993 Athlete of the Year), Jeremy Allen (1998 Freshman of the Year) and Tim Dwight (1999 Athlete of the Championships).

The Iowa women's squad has yet to win a Big Ten outdoor team title, but has crowned 27 event champions in 17 individual running events, five field events and two relays since the first meet was held in 1982. The two Hawkeyes to have earned Big Ten Outdoor Freshman of the Year honors are **Erica Broomfield** (1998) and **Peaches Roach** (2004).

**WOMEN'S TEAM MAKES TRACKWIRE 25** -- The Hawkeye women's track team is 21st in the most recent national outdoor rankings released by Trackwire. The list, compiled by Gary Verigin of www.trackwire.com, ranks schools according to a projected hypothetical score for the NCAA outdoor championships, which is generated by a power ranking of the top 12 athletes and relay squads in each NCAA event. Iowa is ranked 21st with 10 points after opening the outdoor season ranked 20th. Texas is first with 61.

HAWKEYES SET RECORDS -- Hawkeye juniors Micah VanDenend, Tiffany Johnson and Peaches Roach have set new school records this outdoor season. VanDenend broke a 38-year-old 5,000-meter record at the Stanford Invitational, running a collegiate-best 13:55.96 for sixth place in the event. Iowa Head Coach Larry Wieczorek set the previous record of 13:56.0 in 1968. Johnson broke her own 100-meter hurdles and triple jump records. Her collegiate-best 13.53 at the Mt. SAC Relays broke the hurdles record of 13.57 she set in 2005, and she smashed the triple jump record of 40-9 1/2 she set in 2005 with her collegiate best 41-3 1/4 leap at the Iowa Musco Twilight VIII. Johnson now holds school records in the indoor and outdoor triple jump, 60-meter hurdles, 100-meter hurdles and as part of the indoor 1,600-meter relay. Roach broke the 23-year-old school high jump record of 6-0 set in 1983 by Mary Mol with the collegiate-best 6-0 3/4 at the Mt. SAC Relays. Roach holds the school indoor high jump mark, which is also 6-0 3/4.

**LAST WEEK** -- Iowa crowned two champion at the Drake Relays in Des Moines, IA. Sophomore **Kineke Alexander** won the women's special 400 meters (52.01), while junior **Tiffany Johnson** won the women's University 100-meter hurdles (13.58). Junior **Meghan Armstrong** placed third and qualified for the NCAA regional in the women's special 1,500 meters (4:26.01). For the men's team, sophomore **Shane Maier** placed second in the shot put (59-11 1/4), junior **Adam Hamilton** placed third in the hammer throw (213-6) and sophomore **Matty Gorman** placed third in the long jump (24-8 1/2) and fifth in the triple jump (48-0).

**NEXT COMPETITION** -- The Hawkeyes will send athletes who meet the qualifying standards to the 2006 NCAA Midwest Regional, May 26-27 in Austin, TX. All events will be held at Mike A. Myers Stadium on the University of Texas campus. Single day tickets are \$10 for adults and \$7 for youth. Tickets can be ordered from the University of Texas Athletic ticket office at 800/982-2386 or www.texasports.com.

The Midwest region will feature 39 schools from Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas and Wyoming. The top five finishers in each individual event and the top three relays from each of the four regionals will automatically advance to the NCAA Championships, to be held June 7-10 in Sacramento, CA. The other three regions are the West (40 men's teams, 42 women's teams), the Mideast (78 men's teams, 81 women's teams) and the East (110 men's teams, 112 women's teams).

## **University of Iowa Women's Head Coach**



## James Grant Head Coach 10th Season

James Grant is in his 10th season at the helm of the Iowa women's track and field program. Grant was the former assistant coach at Iowa for 11 years (1986-96).

Grant has coached eight all-Americans and 21 Big Ten champions during his tenure as head coach. Iowa placed third at the

2004 Big Ten Indoor Championships in Iowa City and sixth at the 2003 conference outdoor meet - the team's highest placings under Grant. The third-place indoor finish tied the team's highest conference finish in school history.

During the 2006 indoor season, sophomore Kineke Alexander became Grant's first NCAA Champion, and the third in school history, when she won the 400 meters at the national meet. Junior Peaches Roach and Meghan Armstrong also earned all-America honors. Alexander won the 200 and 400 meters at the Big Ten Championships, setting the 400-meter meet record.

In 2005, Roach and Alexander became Grant's first indoor all-Americans. Roach defended her Big Ten indoor high jump title to become the second Hawkeye to win two consecutive Big Ten titles in the same event in school history.

In 2004, Shellene Williams became the second student-athlete in program history to win four Big Ten titles, winning three titles in the 400 meters and one as part of the 1,600-meter relay. Roach gave Iowa its first Big Ten high jump titles, winning that event at the indoor and outdoor conference meets to earn outdoor Freshman of the Year honors.

In 2003, the 1,600-meter relay of Aisha Hume, Nicole Charles, Sarah Steffen and Williams shattered the 15-year-old school record of 3:41.23 with the blistering 3:36.26 they ran at the NCAA Midwest Regional. The quartet also won Iowa's first Big Ten title in that event. Aisha James wowed the Drake Relays crowd when she set school, meet, stadium and Trinidad and Tobago records in the long jump with a then-world leading mark of 22-3 (6.78 m). James became the first Big Ten long jump champion in school history and the first Hawkeye field event champion since 1993 with her victory at the conference meet. Alana Redfern qualified for the NCAA Championships for the second straight year when she broke her own school javelin record by almost 20 feet and set the Canadian National record in that event. James and Redfern became Iowa's first Drake Relays champions in the long jump and javelin, respectively.

While improving in the league standings in considered a priority, Iowa's track and field team also concerns itself with performance in the classroom. During Grant's tenure, 44 Hawkeyes have earned 76 academic all-Big Ten honors.

As Iowa's assistant coach from 1986-96, Grant coached several Hawkeyes to success. In 1995, Yolanda Hobbs was an all-American in the 55 and 200 meters after winning the 55-meter Big Ten title. In 1994, Iowa's 400 meter-relay of Tina Floyd, Hobbs, Marlene Poole and Tanja Reid won Iowa's first Big Ten title in that event, earned all-America honors and set meet and school records. Karen Layne won the 1990 600-meter Big Ten title, while Senta Hawkins won the Big Ten 400 meters in 1988. In 1989, Iowa's 1,600-meter relay placed second at the Big Ten Indoor and Outdoor Championships.

A former Jamaican track standout, Grant coached at the high school level in Jamaica for 11 years prior to joining the Hawkeye program. From 1982-86, Grant coached men's and women's track at G.C. Foster College of Physical Education and Sport. There he led the men's team to two national titles and two second-place finishes, and the women's team to three national titles.

A graduate of Eastern Michigan University, Grant captained the 1970 and 1971 Huron track teams, earning all-America honors while specializing in the 400 meters, 400-meter hurdles, and the mile relay. He was the Jamaican 400-meter hurdle national record holder, with a time that was ranked in the top-20 in the world. Grant also represented Jamaica at the Pan American Games and the Commonwealth Games for six years. In 1991, he was inducted into the Eastern Michigan Hall of Fame.

He was the 1965 and 1966 Jamaican national champion in both the 200 and 400-meters as a high school athlete at Jamaica's Kingston College.

Grant received his bachelor's degree in sociology and history from Eastern Michigan, and his master's degree in physical education from the German College of Physical Education in Leipzig, Germany.

## Larry Wieczorek Head Coach 10th Season

Larry Wieczorek is in his 10th season as head men's track and field coach at the University of Iowa. He recently completed his 19th season as head men's cross country coach for the Hawkeyes. He served as an assistant track and field coach for 12 years before taking the helm in 1997.

A six-time Big Ten champion (including two in cross country) and four-time all-American at Iowa, Wieczorek once held conference marks in the one, two, three, four and five-mile runs. A member of Iowa's last Big Ten track championship team in 1967, he still owns Iowa record in the indoor two miles, as well as third-fastest mark in the cross country 8,000 meters. Hawkeye junior Micah VanDenend broke Wieczorek's 38-year-old 5,000-meter school record earlier this month. Wieczorek was honored for his collegiate accomplishments by being inducted into the University of Iowa's National Varsity Club Athletics Hall of Fame in 1998.

Wieczorek returned to his alma mater as a field event coach in 1985 before taking the helm of the cross country program in 1987. He has since shifted his track responsibilities to the distance corps.

Under Wieczorek, the cross country team has placed sixth or higher nine times at the NCAA Regional Championships, has posted 27 all-region selections and qualified for the NCAA Championships four times. In 2002, Wieczorek was named Midwest Region Coach of the Year honors by the United States Cross Country Association after the Hawkeyes won the NCAA Regional for the first time in school history. In 2004, the Hawkeyes recorded their highest placings under Wieczorek at the Big Ten (3rd) and NCAA Championships (13th).

Since he was named head men's track and field coach in 1997, Wieczorek has coached NCAA Champion long jumper Bashir Yamini, 23 all-Americans, 82 national qualifiers, 52 NCAA Midwest Regional qualifiers and 37 Big Ten Champions. Iowa's 1,600-meter relay won the 1999 Big Ten outdoor title and has earned all-America honors twice during Wieczorek's tenure. The Hawkeyes recorded their highest conference indoor placing (fourth) in 1997, and their highest team finish at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships (second) in 33 years at the 1999 Big Ten outdoor meet.

In 2006, sophomore Matty Gorman won the Big Ten indoor long jump title. He and junior Micah VanDenend (3,000 meters), senior Dan Haut (5,000 meters), sophomore Shane Maier (shot put) and junior Adam Hamilton (hammer throw) acheived

NCAA provisional qualifying marks in their respective events. VanDenend set the school 3,000-meter record, while sophomore Ryan Niver set the school heptathlon mark. During the outdoor season, the team has qualified nine student-athletes for the NCAA Midwest Regional Championships.

Another of Wieczorek's goals as head coach was to create an annual outdoor home event for the Hawkeyes that would be entertaining for the community and feature outstanding competition for participating student-athletes. Now in it's eighth year of existence, the annual Iowa Musco Twilight Meet is just that. Named for Musco Lighting of Oskaloosa, IA, who supplies mobile lighting equipment, the co-ed meet which featured 12 teams in 2006, starts in the late afternoon and extends into the night. In its first four years, the meet had produced 43 NCAA provisional qualifiers. Since the creation of the regional qualifying system in 2003, 187 competitors have reached qualifying standards at the twilight meet.

While improving in the league standings is a priority, the Hawkeyes also concern themselves with performance in the classroom. Under Wieczorek, former cross country runners Kevin Herd, Chad Schwitters and Stetson Steele earned academic all-America honors. Iowa has had an academic all-Big Ten selection each year during his tenure, totaling 57 honorees in cross country and 101 in track and field.

Wieczorek came to Iowa after 11 seasons as head track coach at Proviso (IL) West High School. He also served as an assistant at Proviso West for three years. His prep teams were consistent placers on the state level and several of his athletes won state titles. He served on the Illinois track advisory board and founded the prestigious Proviso Indoor Track Classic. Wieczorek was inducted into the Illinois High School Track and Cross Country Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000.

Wieczorek was born on September 11, 1946, in Chicago, IL. He received his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1969 and his M.S. degree in physical education from Northern Illinois University in 1973. His wife's name is Jackie.
