**IOWA MEN'S GOLF**

**HAWKEYES IN 20<sup>TH</sup> AFTER FIRST DAY OF XAVIER PROVIDENT INVITATIONAL**

**Mason, OH --** The Iowa men's golf team is in 20<sup>th</sup> place after the first day of the Xavier Provident Invitational. The Hawkeyes shot a 36-hole total of 593. Leading the way is Indiana after firing a round of 560.

Leading the way for the Hawkeyes tied for 19<sup>th</sup> place is **Erik Feldick**. Feldick fired a round of 142. **Bennett Hammerberg** carded a score of 146 which placed him tied for 47<sup>th</sup>. **Brian DeBuhr** shot a round of 153, which was good enough to place him tied for 90<sup>th</sup>. **Todd Larson** and **Robby Storm** came in with scores of 154 and 155 respectively to place them tied for 98<sup>th</sup> and 102<sup>nd</sup>.

Individually leading the way is Indiana's Jeff Overton. Overton fired a 36-hole total of 130. Three strokes behind in second is Marquette's Michael Bielawski.
