ON THE MAT

The third-ranked University of Iowa (4-0) wrestling team hosts Buffalo on Thursday on Mediacom Mat inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,077). The dual begins at 7 p.m. (CT).

Tickets are \$12 for adults and \$8 for youth 18-years old and younger. UI Students and youth five-years old and younger are admitted free.

THE SERIES

Iowa leads the all-time series 1-0. The Hawkeyes won the only meeting between the schools, 39-3, in Buffalo last season.

HOME WINNING STREAK

The Hawkeyes have won 12 consecutive duals at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Iowa has won 50 of its last 51 duals at home, including a 38-dual home winning streak from 2008-12.

Iowa hasn't lost a nonconference home dual to a team not named Oklahoma State since Dec. 5, 2004 (Iowa State, 19-16).

Iowa is 2008-19 (.916) all-time inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

HOME MAT ADVANTAGE

Five Hawkeyes in the probable lineup have a combined 79-0 record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. They include Cory Clark (3-0), Tony Ramos (27-0), Josh Dziewa (4-0), Derek St. John (26-0) and Mike Evans (19-0). They are a combined 79-0 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

23-Ho! Ho! Ho!

The Hawkeyes are 23-0 in December duals since Tom Brands was named head coach prior to the 2006-07 season.

Four Hawkeyes in the probable lineup are undefeated in their career in the month of December. Freshmen Cory Clark and Thomas Gilman are both 1-0. Senior Derek St. John is 13-0 and junior Bobby Telford is 8-0.

CLARK AMONG UNBEATENS

Redshirt freshman Cory Clark is one of six Hawkeyes in the probable lineup with an undefeated record.

Clark is 8-0 overall with a team-best six falls. He is 4-0 in duals and 3-0 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Five of his six pins have come in the opening period.

GILMAN SHINES IN DUAL DEBUT

Redshirt freshman Thomas Gilman earned a 12-3 major decision against Edinboro's 17thranked Kory Mines in his dual debut Dec. 5.

Gilman improved to 7-1 overall. He has two pins, a technical fall and a major decision among his seven wins. His only loss this season was to teammate Cory Clark in the finals of the Luther Open.

Gilman owned a 23-5 record competing unattached last season. He has three career tournament titles to his credit, including a first-place finish at the 2013 Joe Parisi Open on Nov. 23.

RAMOS CLOSES IN ON MILESTONES

All-American Tony Ramos is five wins shy of becoming the 38th wrestler in program history to reach 100 career wins.

Ramos has a career record of 95-13. including a perfect 27-0 mark inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Ramos owns a 56-2 all-time record in duals, including a 33-1 nonconference mark.

Ranked No. 3 at 133 pounds, Ramos has recorded a team-best six falls this season. He entered the season with 24 career pins, and has since raised his career total to 30. He recorded two falls as a redshirt freshman, eight falls as a sophomore, and 14 falls last season as a junior. Ramos needs 44 career falls to tie Chuck Yagla for 10th all-time in career pins.

Brent Metcalf, who scored 47 pins from 2008-10, was the last Hawkeye to crack the top 10 list. Prior to Metcalf, the list had not changed since Terry Brands (48), Tom Brands (46), and Mark Reiland (45) ended their careers in 1992.

DZIEWA HAPPY AT HOME

Junior Josh Dziewa is one of seven Hawkeyes to enter Thursday's dual with an undefeated record inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Dziewa is 4-0 at home with three pins and a major decision. He is 6-1 all-time in duals, including a 1-0 mark as a redshirt freshman (149 pounds), and a 1-0 in record last season as a sophomore. Both wins were major decisions.

ST. JOHN OFF TO HOT START

Senior Derek St. John has started 10-0 for the third straight season. He was 11-0 as a sophomore and 22-0 as a junior before suffering his first loss.

St. John has won a team-high 17 straight matches. Among his 10 wins this year, he has four pins, one technical fall and one major decision. He is 5-0 in duals, scoring a team-best 25 points. St. John has a 51-4 all-time dual record.

He enters 2013-14 as a three-time All-American and a chance to become the 18th four-time All-American in school history.

St. John finished fourth as a freshman and runner-up as a sophomore before winning the NCAA title in 2013. He put together five-straight wins to climb to the top of the 157-pound bracket and become the 52nd national champion in program history. His title is the 80th individual NCAA wrestling championship in school history.

Mark Perry was the last Hawkeye fourtime All-American. He is also the last Iowa wrestler to win back-to-back NCAA championships. Perry won titles in 2007 and 2008.

MOORE IMPROVES TO 4-0

Junior Nick Moore defeated Edinboro's Zach Towers, 11-4, to improve to 4-0.

Moore's victories this season include a 3-1 decision over third-ranked Mike Moreno, and a pair of first period falls at the Iowa City Duals.

He is currently ranked No. 4 in the national rankings.

Moore was 18-10 overall last season at 165, placing fourth at the Big Ten Championships and earning his first NCAA berth.

10-FOR-10 ON BONUS POINTS

Junior Mike Evans has scored bonus points in each of his 10 matches. He owns a team-high four technical falls, and has recorded four pins and two major decisions this season.

The four pins surpass his season total from a year ago, when he recorded two falls.

Evans is riding a career-long 10 match winning streak. He opened each of the last two seasons with 9-0 records before suffering his first defeat. He won his first 10 and his last 10 matches while competing unattached as a freshman.

Evans opened the season in the lowa starting lineup for the third straight year, but for

the first time at 174 pounds. He recorded a 26-8 record at 165 as a freshman, and was 2-0 at 165 his sophomore season before bumping up a weight class. He was 21-7 at 174 in 2013, earning a Big Ten runner-up finish and his first All-America honor.

LOFTHOUSE STREAK HITS 9

Senior Ethen Lofthouse has won a career-best nine-straight matches. His previous career long winning streak was six, which he has done on two other occasions -- first in 2011-12, and then again at the beginning of the 2012-13 season.

Lofthouse is 9-0 this season and ranked No. 1 at 184 pounds by Amateur Wrestling News.

He has five pins this season, one more than he had all of last year.

BROOKS EARNS DECISIVE WIN

Redshirt freshman Sammy Brooks recorded an 11-0 major decision to help lowa prevail at Edinboro, 22-19. The win was the first dual victory of Brooks' career.

He is now 1-1 in career duals, both at 197 pounds.

He bumped up a weight class to make his Hawkeye dual debut at Iowa State on Dec. 1, but fell to third ranked Kyven Gadson, 3-2.

He is 7-2 overall competing at 184 pounds, and 1-1 at 197.

BURAK AWAITS DEBUT

Sophomore Nathan Burak, an NCAA qualifier at 197 pounds last season, could make his season debut against Buffalo.

Burak earned his second career dual victory at Buffalo last season, scoring a 12-4 major decision against Angelo Malvestuto.

TELFORD RISES THROUGH FALLS

Junior Bobby Telford pinned all five opponents at the Luther Open on Nov. 16. It was Telford's first appearance since leaving the 2013 NCAA Championships with a knee injury.

He navigated the 285-pound bracket at the Luther Open in a combined time of 7:32. He pinned his first four opponents in the opening minute before winning the championship finals with a second period fall (4:42).

Telford's five falls match his season total from a year ago. He now has 19 career pins.

NCAA EXPERIENCE

The Hawkeyes return seven wrestlers with NCAA Championship experience. Senior Derek St. John (157) is the defending national champion at 157 pounds and a three-time All-American. Seniors Ethen Lofthouse (184) and Tony Ramos (133) are three-time NCAA qualifiers and two-time All-Americans. Juniors Mike Evans (174) and Bobby Telford (285) are two-time NCAA qualifiers. Telford earned All-America honors in 2012, while Evans earned All-America honors in 2013. Junior Nick Moore (165) and sophomore Nathan Burak (197) both qualified for their first NCAA Championships in 2013.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING HISTORY

lowa's overall dual meet record is 931-222-31 (.799) in 104 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 23 national titles and 34 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 52 NCAA Champions have won a total of 80 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 16 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 105 Big Ten champions have won a total of 190 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time, and 28 two-time lowa winners. Iowa's 148 All-Americans have earned All-America status 301 times, including 17 four-time, 32 three-time and 38 two-time honorees.

LAST MEETING (Dec. 17, 2012 -- Buffalo, N.Y.)

lowa won nine of 10 bouts and scored bonus points in eights contests to improve to 10-0.

Mike Evans scored a takedown 35 seconds into the match and totaled six nearfall points by the end of the frame to cruise to a 14-1 major decision at 174. Ethen Lofthouse recorded five takedowns and 2:37 of riding time to earn a 12-4 win at 184.

Bobby Telford (285) needed just 1:36 to earn his fourth pin of the season, and Tony Ramos (133) closed the dual with a fall in 4:22.

Michael Kelly and Derek St. John both dominated their respective third periods to earn major decisions at 149 and 157. Kelly fell behind 4-0 in the first but rallied to tie the score 8-8 entering the second. He opened the second frame with an escape and added two points for stalling before finishing the match with a five-point move to win 21-13.

St. John scored one takedown in the first and two in the second before totaling 11 points in the third. He recorded four takedowns in the final frame and used three nearfall points at the end of the match to secure a 21-7 major decision.

Freshman Nathan Burak fought back from an early deficit to earn a major decision at 197, and sophomore Matt Gurule, filling in for top-ranked Matt McDonough at 125, earned a 15-10 shootout against returning NCAA qualifier Max Soria.

2013-14 SCHEDULE

Nine of Iowa's 17 dual opponents are ranked in the top 25 of the NWCA/ *USA Today/AWN* Division I Coaches Poll.

They include Penn State (1), Minnesota (2), Oklahoma State (5), Nebraska (9), Northwestern (16), Purdue (21), and Michigan (19). Iowa defeated No. 15 Iowa State, 23-9, on Dec. 1, and No. 15 Edinboro, 22-19, on Dec. 5. Iowa's schedule includes one regular season tournament, 17 duals, eight home dates and two postseason events -- Big Ten Championships (Mar. 8-9), and NCAA Championships (Mar. 20-22).

3 HAWKEYES EARN TITLES AT JIM FOX OPEN

Phillip Laux (125), Brandon Sorensen (157) and Walt Gillmor (165) all earned tournament titles at the Jim Fox Open.

Laux improved to 13-0 this year after recording two decisions, one fall and one major decision to win the 125-pound title.

Gillmor improved to 8-0 this year, recording two falls and a decision to win the 165-pound bracket.

Sorensen won the first tournament title of his career with three-straight decisions at 157 pounds.

Broc Berge (197) won a pair of decisions in the quarter and semifinals before falling, 3-1, in the finals of the 197-pound bracket. Jeremy Fahler earned a runner-up finish at 184 pounds.

Ethan Owens (141), Connor Ryan (149), Logan Thomsen (157), and Terrance Jean-Jacques (285) all placed third.

GILMAN GETS GOLD AT JOE PARISI OPEN

Thomas Gilman defeated Oklahoma State's Edward Klimara, 5-2, to win the 125-pound Gold Division title at the Joe Parisi Open on Saturday.

Gilman, a redshirt freshman, earned a spot in the finals by defeating another Cowboy, Austin Miller, 7-5, in the quarterfinals, and topping Missouri's Barlow McGhee, 3-1, in the semifinals. The tournament championship is Gilman's first this season and the third of his career.

Redshirt freshman Sammy Brooks earned a pair of falls and an overtime victory before dropping a 2-1 decision in the 184-pound finals.

Redshirt freshman Topher Carton and sophomore Brody Grothus rebounded from a pair of quarterfinal defeats to win the consolation bracket of their respective weights. Carton recorded a pair of falls and a 5-1 mark to place third at 141 pounds. Grothus recorded three pins and a 6-1 mark to place third at 149.

Redshirt freshman Phillip Laux won the 125-pound title in the Black Division (freshmen/sophomores). Laux went 5-0 with three pins to improve to 9-0 this year.

48 FALLS AT LUTHER OPEN

Twenty-six Hawkeyes combined for 48 falls at the season-opening Luther Open on Nov. 16.

Bobby Telford led all Hawkeyes, pinning each of his five opponents en route to the 285-pound title.

lowa swept 10 weight classes in the Elite Division and earned a pair of titles in the Freshman Division.

Iowa Elite champions included Cory Clark (125), Tony Ramos (133), Josh Dziewa (141), Michael Kelly (149), Derek St. John (157), Walt Gillmor (165), Mike Evans (174), Ethen Lofthouse (184), Kris Klapprodt (197) and Telford.

Phillip Laux (125) and Broc Berge (197) both won titles in the Freshman Division.

ALL-AMERICAN STREAK

The Hawkeyes have crowned at least one All-American every year since 1972, a span of 42 seasons. Iowa has totaled 255 All-America honors during that stretch. The Hawkeyes return five All-Americans to this year's squad. Tony Ramos (2nd-133), Derek St. John (1st-157), Mike Evans (6th-174) and Ethen Lofthouse (5th-184) join 2012 All-American Bobby Telford (5th-285) in the 2013-14 lineup.

40 YEARS OF DOMINANCE

Since 1974, only seven schools have captured the NCAA Championship. During that 40-year span, the Hawkeyes have won 23 team titles, including nine straight from 1978-86. The other schools include Oklahoma State (7), Minnesota (3), Penn State (3), Iowa State (2), Arizona State (1) and Oklahoma (1).

ATTENDANCE LEADERS AT IT AGAIN

In seven home dates last season, lowa averaged 8,764 fans per dual. It marked the fifth straight year lowa averaged over 8,000 fans, and the seventh straight season the Hawkeyes led the nation in attendance. The dual wrestling attendance record for Carver-Hawkeye Arena is 15,955, set when lowa defeated lowa State (20-15) on Dec. 6, 2008.

The seventh-largest dual crowd in NCAA history saw Iowa defeat top-ranked Penn State on Friday, Feb. 1, 2013. The Hawkeyes drew a sellout crowd of 15,077, the sixth-largest wrestling crowd in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history.

That all-time single dual record stood until Dec. 8, 2013, when 15,996 watched Pitt wrestle Penn State at the Bryce Jordan Center.

CARVER-HAWKEYE ARENA

The Hawkeyes have won 12-straight duals inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,077). Iowa finished the 2012-13 home schedule with a 9-0 record at home. The perfect record marked lowa's 20th undefeated season at Carver-Hawkeye Arena since moving from the UI Fieldhouse in 1983. Iowa has a 208-19 (.915) all-time record in the arena. The Hawkeyes have also won five tournament titles on their home mat, including the 1983 and 1994 Big Ten Championships, and the 1986, 1991 and 1995 NCAA Championships.

TICKET INFORMATION

Single-meet tickets are available for purchase on hawkeyesports.com. Admission to Buffalo (12/12), Michigan State (1/4), Indiana (1/12) and Michigan (2/9) is \$12 for adults and \$8 for youth. Single-meet tickets to Penn State (12/21), Oklahoma State (1/10) and Minnesota (1/25) are \$15 for adults and \$8 for youth. Kids five-years old and younger are admitted free to all wrestling events, but everyone entering the arena must have a ticket.

HAWKEYES EARN 2012-13 B1G DUAL TITLE

lowa captured its fifth Big Ten regular season title in the last six years when it defeated Nebraska, 31-7, on Feb. 10 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The perfect conference record marked the fifth time in six seasons the Hawkeyes finished the Big Ten regular season with an undefeated mark.



Tom Brands Head Coach (University of Iowa, 1992)

Three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his eighth season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time All-American and threetime national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 136-13-1 (.909) overall and 51-5 (.911) Big Ten coaching record at lowa, and a 153-32-1 (.820) career mark.

In seven seasons as Iowa's head coach, Brands has led the Hawkeyes to three NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning eight NCAA champions, 10 Big Ten champions and 38 All-Americans. Iowa has honored 53 academic all-Big Ten honorees, including a school-record 12 in 2011-12. The Hawkeyes have qualified 62 wrestlers for the NCAA Championships in the last seven years, sending the entire 10-man

lineup in 2009-10. Iowa has also won five of the last six Big Ten regular season titles.

During Brands' tenure, lowa set school records for longest dual unbeaten (84) and winning streaks (69), longest dual road unbeaten (51) and winning streaks (44), most Carver-Hawkeye Arena victories (11) and most dual shutouts (8).

lowa also made another entry in the record books, setting the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when it hosted Iowa State Dec. 6, 2008, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The previous record of 15,646 was set Feb. 1, 2002, when Minnesota hosted Iowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis. The Hawkeyes won the Iowa State dual, 20-15. Iowa has led the nation in attendance in each of Brands' six seasons, setting an NCAA all-time attendance average of 9,014 in 2011-12.

Brands was named 2008 NWCA Coach of the Year after leading the Hawkeyes to their first NCAA team title since 2000 and their first Big Ten team title since 2004. He was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 2008, 2009 and 2010, becoming the first coach in conference history to earn the honor in three consecutive

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. In his first season with the Hokies, Brands led the team to the 2005 regular season Atlantic Coast Conference title, set a school record for dual meet wins (16) and had a school-record five wrestlers gualify for the NCAA Championships. During his tenure, Virginià Téch crowned five ACC champions and had two All-Americans. Senior heavyweight Mike Faust was named 2006 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 All-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

In 2004, he was one of three coaches for the U.S. Olympic freestyle wrestling team, participating in Athens. Brands also served as assistant coach for the 2002 and 2003 U.S. Freestyle World Teams, earning Freestyle Coach of the Year honors from USA Wrestling both years. He was also a member of the U.S. coaching staff at the 2001 World Championships, and has coached a number of other U.S. teams in international competition.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001

Brands was a four-time All-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three-time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at lowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

The Sheldon, Iowa, native was born April 9, 1968. He earned his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1992. He and his wife, Jeni, have three children, Madigan, Kinsee and Tommy.
