HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS



The 2008 NWCA, W.I.N. Magazine and Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his third season as head wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at the University of Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time all-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 49-6 overall and 13-3

Big Ten record at Iowa, and a 66-26 career mark.

In his second season at Iowa, Brands guided the squad to NCAA and Big Ten titles, as well the Big Ten regular season title with an undefeated 8-0 league mark. It was Iowa's 21st NCAA team title - the first since 2000 - and the Hawkeyes' 32nd Big Ten championship - the first since 2004. Iowa also won the 2007 Midlands title and the Division I trophy at the NWCA/Cliff Keen National Duals in January. The Hawkeyes posted a 21-1 dual mark, ending the season on a 14-match winning streak. Senior Mark Perry and junior Brent Metcalf each won NCAA titles, and Iowa crowned a total of seven all-Americans, which was the most for Iowa since 2001.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001. Brands was a four-time all-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

OKLAHOMA STATE COWBOYS

Oklahoma State is 11-3 with wins over Old Dominion (30-9), Virginia (33-7), Appalachian State (41-3), American (33-9), Northern Colorado (41-3), Cal Poly (37-6), Minnesota (23-13), UC Davis (29-7), Clarion (44-0), Navy (34-3) and Edinboro (24-12), and losses to Lehigh (13-18), Oklahoma (15-18) and Central Michigan (14-17).

Head Coach John Smith is 278-38-4 in 18 years at Oklahoma State. Smith, who is the all-time winningest coach in school history, was a two-time NCAA champion (1987-88) for the Cowboys and a two-time Olympic gold medalist (1988, 1992). He is assisted by Eric Guerrero and Tyrone Lewis, who wrestled for Smith at Oklahoma State.

The Cowboys are led by seniors Jared Rosholt (Hwt.), Clayton Foster (197) and Brandon Mason (165). Rosholt is ranked #1 in the nation and boasts a 23-0 record. Foster is ranked between seventh and 11th in the country and has a 20-1 record. Mason, a native of Shenandoah, IA, is ranked between ninth and 12th with a 21-3 mark.

THE SERIES

Oklahoma State leads the series, 25-16-1, and holds a 12-5-1 advantage in Stillwater. The Cowboys hold a 419-32-5 overall record at Gallagher-Iba Arena. Oklahoma State has won the last nine meetings between the two schools. Iowa's last win in the series was a 20-14 victory in Iowa City in 2000, and its last win in Stillwater was 26-9 in 1996.

Iowa Head Coach **Tom Brands** is 0-3 against Oklahoma State, while Cowboy Head Coach John Smith is 14-5 against Iowa.

LAST MEETING - OKLAHOMA STATE 19, IOWA 14

Oklahoma State handed top-ranked Iowa its only loss of the 2007-08 season when it beat the Hawkeyes 19-14 in Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Feb. 5. A crowd of 14,332 attended the dual. It was the seventh-largest crowd for a dual meet in NCAA wrestling history and the fifth-largest in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

lowa won four of the 10 weights, including two by major decision. Junior **Charlie Falc**k opened the dual at 125 with a narrow 7-5 decision over Ben Ashmore. Falck fought off his back early in the third period and scored a reversal with one minute left to pick up the win. Sophomores **Brent Metcalf** (149) and **Phillip Keddy** (184) both scored major decisions, while senior **Matt Fields** closed out the dual with a 4-3 win over Jared Rosholt at heavyweight.

Oklahoma State won five of the six matches its was favored in, and added an upset to their six-win tally. Top-ranked Coleman Scott held off a late charge by second-ranked sophomore **Joe Slaton** at 133 to win 8-6 and hand Slaton his first loss of

HAWKEYES WIN SECOND STRAIGHT NATIONAL DUALS TITLE

The top-ranked Hawkeyes won their fifth Cliff Keen/NWCA National Duals tournament title Sunday, beating Cornell 23-13 in the championship finals at the UNI-Dome in Cedar Falls. The Hawkeyes beat Wyoming (38-3), Minnesota (27-7) and Nebraska (22-11) en route to the finals

It is the first time the Hawkeyes - who won the team title in 2008 - won back-to-back National Duals titles since 1995 and 1996. The Hawkeyes improved to 14-0 on the season, and have won their last 28 matches. Cornell fell to 4-1. ESPNU will air a taped-delay broadcast of the championship finals on Jan. 15 at 3 p.m. (CT).

Hawkeye senior **Alex Tsirtsis** (141) and juniors **Brent Metcalf** (149), **Phillip Keddy** (184) and **Dan Erekson** (Hwt.) all went 4-0 during the two-day tournament. Metcalf won all four of his matches with team bonus-point victories - one pin, two technical falls and one major decision. He is 19-0 this season and on a 51-match winning streak.

lowa's overall dual meet record is 842-215-30 (.788) in 97 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 21 national titles and 32 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 49 NCAA champions have won a total of 76 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 14 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 101 Big Ten champions have won a total of 182 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-

time and 24 two-time lowa winners. Iowa's 135 all-Americans have earned all-America status 273 times, including 17 four-time, 27 three-time and 33 two-time honorees.

HAWKEYES LOOK TO EXTEND WINNING STREAKS

lowa has won its last 28 duals, and its last 24 duals away from lowa City. The school record for overall consecutive dual wins is 42 (1994-97), and for consecutive away dual wins is 31 (1994-97). The 24 straight away duals rank second best in school history. Hawkeye junior **Brent Metcalf** (149) also has a winning streak of his own, winning his last 51 bouts.

HAWKEYES SET ATTENDANCE RECORD

Iowa set the national collegiate dual meet attendance record of 15,955 when it hosted #2 Iowa State Dec. 6 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The previous record of 15,646 was set Feb. 1, 2002, when Minnesota hosted Iowa at the Target Center in Minneapolis. The Hawkeyes won the Iowa State dual, 20-15.

HAWKEYE WRESTLING TICKET INFORMATION

Tickets for Iowa's five remaining home duals are on sale at the UI Athletic Ticket Office at 800-464-2957, 319-335-9327 or **www.hawkeyesports.com**.

Against Wisconsin, Illinois, Bucknell and Purdue, tickets purchased in advance are \$10 for adults and \$5 for youth. Tickets purchased at the meet are \$12 for adults, \$6 for youth. University of Iowa students and children ages five and under will be admitted free.

Against Minnesota, tickets purchased in advance are \$13 for adults, \$7 for youth and \$2 for children ages five and under. Tickets purchased at the meet are \$15 for adults, \$8 for youth and \$2 for children ages five and under. Due to the possibility of a sellout crowd, the first 1,000 general admission University of lowa students will be admitted free of charge after they log-in to their student account at **www.hawkeyesports.com** to reserve a seat and download a free paper ticket. After that allotment is sold out, students may purchase reserved seats at the youth price.
