The Hawkeyes travel to blustery Ann Arbor, MI, this weekend to take on the Michigan Wolverines and kick off the Big Ten season.

Iowa's Big Ten opener at Michigan today has been postponed due to an overnight snowfall. Weather permitting, the four-game series against the Wolverines will now consist of noon (CDT) doubleheaders Saturday and Sunday (March 29-30) at the Wilpon Baseball and Softball Complex, home to Ray Fisher Stadium. The first game each day will be a nine-inning contest, followed by a seven-inning game.

HAWKEYES THIS WEEK • The Hawkeyes will travel to Ann Arbor, MI, to take on the No. 25 Michigan Wolverines and kickoff the Big Ten season. Iowa trails the all-time series against Michigan, 92-40. Under Coach Jack Dahm, Iowa is 5-12 against the Wolverines.

HAWKEYES ON THE AIR • Starting with Iowa's first home game on March 25, tune into AM-800 KXIC. Voice of the Hawkeyes Brent Balbinot will call the play-by-play, with former Hawkeyes Troy Wulf and Kurt Vitense supplying color commentary.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN:

The No. 25 Wolverines are 10-6 and 2-0 at home so far.

There most notable win was against currently No. 22 Coastal Carolina 4-1. They have lost to No. 1 Arizona State twice and tied the New York Mets in an exhibition game.

Michigan is led by offensive threat Nate Recknagel, who is hitting a solid .383 to lead the Wolverines. He leads the Big Ten in slugging percentage (.767), is seventh in runs scored (17), eighth in on-base percentage (.466) and leads the league in home runs (7), runs batted in (22) and total bases (46).

As a team, the Wolverines are hitting .299. The Michigan pitching staff has a collective 5.36 ERA and are led by Chris Fetter, who has started four games and is 3-0. Travis Smith and Zach Putnam are also pitchers to lookout for.

In the series between the two schools, Iowa trails, 92-40.

WESTERN ILLINOIS SUMMARY:

The Hawkeyes won their home opener Tuesday night over Western Illinois, 7-4, at Duane Banks Field. In the win, the Hawkeyes took advantage of four Leatherneck errors and strung together seven hits.

In the Iowa win, **Kevin Hoef** was 1-for-4 with two RBIs and scoring two Iowa runs. **Kyle Riffel** extended his hitting streak to eight games tonight, going 1-for-3 with three RBIs and **Wes Freie** continued to swing the bat well going 2-for-4. **Kurtis Muller** utilized the bunt in the Iowa win, laying down two sac bunts.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS SUMMARY:

Northern Illinois led start-to-finish en route to a 5-4 victory over the Iowa Wednesday at Duane Banks Field.

Leading the Hawkeyes were **Justin Toole**, **Kyle Riffel** and **Kody McManis**. Toole went 2-for-5, driving in three RBI. Today marked Toole's team-leading seventh multi-RBI game. Riffel went 2-for-4 with

an RBI, extending his hitting streak to nine games. It also marked the fifth game this season the senior recorded two hits or more in a game. McManis posted his first multi-hit game of the season, going 2-for-3 and scored a run.

BIG TEN OPENER: COMPARISONS:

Iowa's team batting average is slightly higher than Michigan's .303 to .299.

The Hawkeyes have 28 hit-by-pitches, compared to Michigan's mere 12.

Iowa is more patient in the box, drawing 73 walks to Michigan's 68.

The Black and Gold have a higher team on-base percentage, .407 to the Wolverines' .381.

Both teams are close in hits, Michigan has the edge with 169, to Iowa's 165.

The Black and Gold have a slight lead over the Wolverines in doubles, 33-32.

The Hawkeyes have fielded more double plays this season, 11-9.

The two team's pitching staffs have similar earned run averages, the Wolverines have the advantage, 5.36 to 5.69.

However, Iowa pitchers manage the bases well, having picked off eight runners, to Michigan's five.

HAWKEYES SWING THE BAT:

The Hawkeyes are hitting .303 as a team on the year. The Black and Gold are led by **Caleb Curry**, who is hitting .452, and sophomore **Justin Toole**, who has hit .364 on the year.

IOWA OFFENSE IS STREAKING:

After two home games, **Kyle Riffel** is currently on a nine game hitting streak, going 3-for-7 on the week with four RBIs.

On top of that, **Caleb Curry** leads the team with nine multi-hit games, followed by **Justin Toole** who has eight. Toole leads the team with multi-RBI games with seven, after picking up one at Duane Banks Field this past week.

Head Coach Jack Dahm



Jack Dahm is in his fifth season as head coach of the University of Iowa baseball team. He has compiled an overall record of 392-405-2 and is 109-129 at Iowa.

Last season, Iowa took another step forward by recording its best record in 14 years with a 31-23 mark. The Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13. Iowa earned its second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

In Dahm's 14 years as a head coach, he has produced 23 first team all-conference performers, seven freshmen All-Americans and two All-Americans. In his four years at Iowa, Dahm has coached 19 all-Big Ten selections, including seven first teamers.

Before coming to Iowa City, Dahm spent 18 years as a member of the Creighton Bluejay baseball program. He left the Bluejays as the winningest coach in school history, having compiled 283 wins against 276 losses in 10 seasons as a head coach.

Twenty-seven of Dahm's players have been selected in the MLB Draft, while four have gone on to play in the major leagues. In the past three years, nine Hawkeyes have inked contracts with professional teams, including three this past spring.

In the classroom, Iowa is in the 90th-percentile in the NCAA's Academic Progress Report, placing them in the top 30 baseball programs, academically. During his Iowa tenure, Dahm has seen 33 players named academic all-Big Ten, including a team-record ten players in 2006. That is the best four-year total in the history of the program.

The 41-year old Dahm and his wife, Lynn, have been married 14 years. The couple has three children - sons Casey and Tyler and daughter Lyndsey.

SOLID BULLPEN OUTING:

In the Hawkeyes' two game home-stand, eight pitchers were used in the Black and Gold bullpen. Together they pitched 13 innings only allowing four runs on 13 hits and striking out four.

An astounding 13 Iowa pitchers have seen action so far this year, throwing 137 and two-thirds innings.

CURRY RECEIVES HONOR:

Senior **Caleb Curry** received *CollegeBaseballHub.com's* Heartland Hitter of the Week honor for his performance against Rutgers.

Curry went 8-for-13 with seven RBI, two walks and three runs scored in the series.

BY THE NUMBERS IN THE BIG TEN:

Caleb Curry has taken the Big Ten by storm, when compared with the league's players he ranks in the top five in: batting average (.452), slugging percentage (.532), on base percentage (.514), hits (28), runs batted in (21) and stolen bases (12).

Other Hawkeyes who rank well in the conference include: **Justin Toole** is tied for first in runs batted in (22), **Kevin Hoef** leads the league in hit-by-pitches (8), is fourth in runs scored (19) and is tied for fifth in walks (10). **Kyle Riffel** is second in the league in hit-by-pitches (5) and **Matt Mossey** is tied for fifth in doubles (6). **Kurtis Muller** leads the league in sac bunts (5). **Andrew Porter** is tied for first in appearances (10), while **Zach Kenyon** and **Nick Erdman** are tied for first in pick-offs (2). **Brock Alberts** is tied for seventh in the league in strikeouts (21).

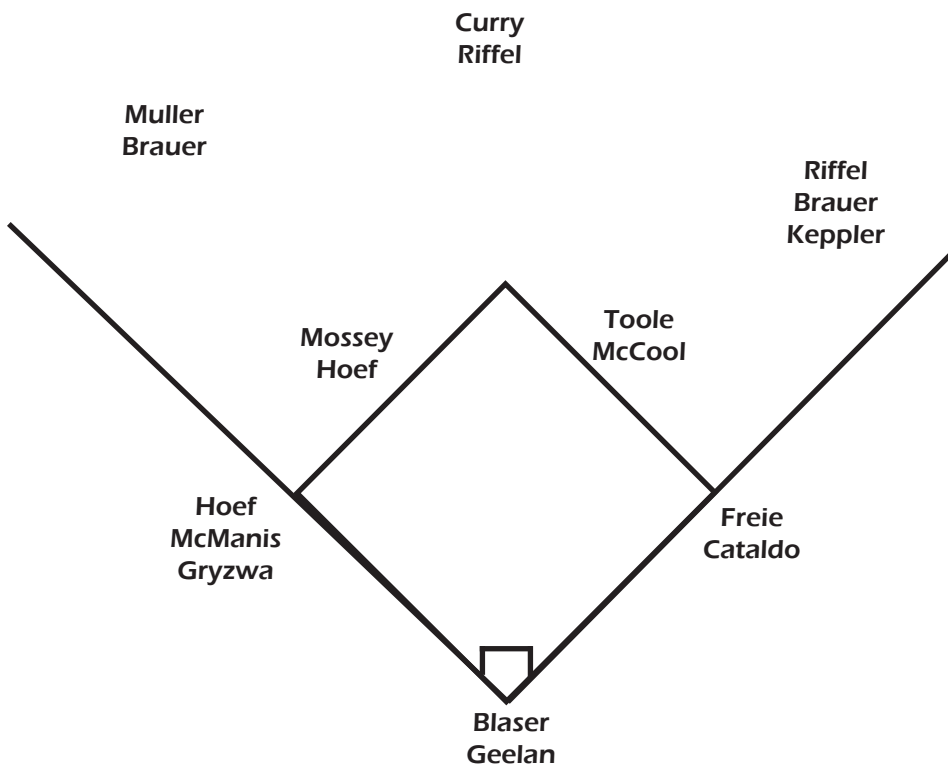

Freie had a stellar weekend helping lead Iowa to a 2-1 record, including a 6-3 upset win over fifth-ranked Vanderbilt, at the Music City Classic in Nashville, TN. The first baseman, who was named tournament MVP, was 9-for-12 with a double, home run, two RBI and two walks. The junior led the Black and Gold against No. 5 Vanderbilt, going a perfect 4-for-4 with an RBI.

Alberts had a great season debut in Iowa's come-from-behind win over Xavier Feb. 29. The senior right hander threw five and one-third innings in relief for the win. He allowed no runs, scattered five hits with no walks and struck out a career-high 10 of the 21 batters he faced.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH:

Iowa will play one of its toughest schedules in 2008 as it will face nine teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season. The Hawkeyes will welcome NCAA Tournament teams Minnesota, Nebraska and Ohio State to Iowa City and will take on Albany, Creighton, Michigan, Rutgers, Stetson and Vanderbilt on the road. Iowa will face three teams in conference action that advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

LAST SEASON:

Iowa posted a 31-23 record in 2007, the Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13, and earned their second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

During the season, Iowa defeated five teams (Nebraska, Fresno State, Ohio State, Minnesota and Michigan) that reached the NCAA Tournament. The Hawkeyes also posted a 12-game winning streak, which is the second-longest in school history. Included in the streak was a school-record 10-game Big Ten winning streak.

BIG TEN NETWORK SCHEDULE:

Some Hawkeye games will be televised on the Big Ten Network for the first time this season. The following games have been picked by the network:

THE ASSISTANT COACHES:

Head Coach **Jack Dahm** is assisted by coach **Ryan Brownlee** and coach **Nick Zumsande**, along with volunteer coach **Kris Welker** and Director of Baseball **Matt Haddy**.

Ryan Brownlee enters his fifth season as Iowa's hitting, infield instructor and recruiting coordinator.

As hitting coach, Brownlee saw the team's batting average vault 55 points from 2005 to 2007 (.269 to .324). Additionally, the team also scored more runs (273 to 401) had more RBIs (249 to 345) and walks (152 to 245) during that time span. **Nick Zumsande** enters his fifth year as the Iowa pitching coach.

Under Zumsande's guidance, the Hawkeye pitching has had a pitcher named first team all-Big Ten three of the last four years, and a pitcher named all-conference in each of his four years.

Kris Welker is in his second year as the team's volunteer assistant. Welker works with the Iowa catchers and outfielders, prepares scouting reports and coaches first base.

As a senior, Welker earned third team all-Big Ten honors, helping Iowa to a third-place finish in the Big Ten and a trip to the conference tournament. He led the team with a .354 batting average, 46 RBIs and 16 doubles. Welker also received the Bob Oldis, Jr MVP Award

Matt Haddy is in his third season as the Director of Baseball Operations for the University of Iowa.

He assists the coaching staff with the day-to-day operations and administrative areas of the program. Haddy also serves as the travel coordinator and director of Hawkeye Baseball Camps.

Hawkeyes honored were: **Justin Toole** at second, **Kevin Hoef** at shortstop, **Kyle Riffel** in the outfield, **Caleb Curry** in the outfield and **Wes Freie** as utility and MVP.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES:

When you look around the diamond this season, your eyes don't deceive you. There are several familiar faces in the lineup playing different positions. Junior **Kevin Hoef** moved from third base to shortstop, while senior **Caleb Curry** moved to center field from left field.

HAWKEYES HIT THE CLASSROOM:

In October, the Iowa baseball team was awarded the 2007 NCAA Public Recognition Award for being in the 90% percentile of Academic Progress Report (APR) for baseball.

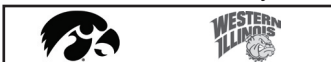

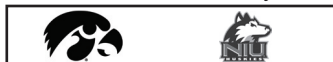
