The University of Iowa women's basketball team will play its second-straight road game Monday night, as the Hawkeyes head to Des Moines to take on Drake. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m. at the Knapp Center.

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call Monday's game for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on AM-800 KXIC or on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his seventh season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her sixth providing analysis.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,045 games, since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 639-407 (.611). That includes a 318-158 (.668) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 302-87 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 301-87 (.776) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

SCOUTING DRAKE

The Drake Bulldogs are 5-4 overall, including a 2-3 record this season at the Knapp Center. In their last game, the Bulldogs dropped a tough, one-point game at home to Tennessee Tech (56-55) Dec. 11. Kristin Turk led the team with 18 points, eight rebounds, five assists, three steals and two blocks. Rachael Hackbarth added 12 points.

For the season, Turk leads Drake with 19.6 points per game. She has made 23 of Drake's 53 three-pointers on the season. Hackbarth is next at 11.9 points and a team-best 6.6 boards.

Drake is shooting .412 (205-497) from the field, including .368 (53-144) from three-point distance.

IOWA VS. DRAKE NOTES

- Drake leads the all-time series, 24-18. Iowa has won the last eight games in the series, including the last four at the Knapp Center.
- Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder coached 10 successful seasons (1990-2000) at Drake before joining the Hawkeyes.
- Iowa Associate Head Coach Jan Jensen and Assistant Coach Jenni Fitzgerald both played and coached at Drake. Jensen is one of only two Drake women's basketball players to have her uniform retired. Both Jensen and Fitzgerald received the Drake Double D Award, which is the highest honor Drake bestows on its student-athletes.
- Drake and Iowa share two common non-conference opponents this season in Central Michigan and Iowa State. Drake was defeated in Ames by Iowa State (64-46) and knocked off Central Michigan (90-70) in Flagstaff, AZ at the Northern Arizona Thanksgiving Classic. Iowa defeated both Central Michigan (90-79) and Iowa State (62-40) in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- Drake has three players from the state of Iowa, while the Hawkeyes have five. Both teams have four players from Minnesota.
- The last three meetings in the series have all been on Dec. 20.

LAST MEETING

Iowa torched the nets in the second half to defeat in-state rival Drake, 71-63, inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena Dec. 20, 2009.

The Hawkeyes scored 48 points in the second half, shooting .576 (19-33) from the field, including a blistering .625 (5-8) from distance.

The Bulldogs used an 11-3 run to close the first half and took a 30-25 lead into the locker room. Iowa used a 10-3 surge to take a 62-55 lead. Iowa's defense held Drake in check for the rest of the game.

The Hawkeyes committed only five fouls in the game and did not send Drake to the charity stripe.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 16 in the AP and No. 15 in the ESPN/USA Today top 25.

Four Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and ESPN/USA Today polls: North Carolina (10/11), Ohio State (11/10), Michigan State (14/17) and Iowa State (21/20).

Kansas State and Northwestern are receiving votes.

LATE RUN LIFTS IOWA OVER SOUTH DAKOTA STATE

Iowa used a 13-3 run in the final 6:03 to close out South Dakota State, 65-54, Saturday in Brookings.

Leading by only one point at 50-49, Kamille Wahlin made a layup at the 6:03 mark to spark the final run. Two more made baskets by Wahlin followed by a deep three from Jaime Printy gave Iowa a 59-51 advantage. Printy made a layup for a 61-51 lead. Iowa's final four points came at the charity stripe.

Three Hawkeyes scored double figures, led by Morgan Johnson with 26 along with seven rebounds. Wahlin finished with 12 points and Printy added 11.

BLUDER CLOSING IN ON MILESTONE

Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder is just one win away from becoming only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 199 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

PRINTY ON A ROLL FROM THE LINE

After missing her first free throw attempt of the season in Iowa's season-opener, Jaime Printy has made 31-straight free throws.

The school record for consecutive free throws made is 33, set by Lindsey Meder during the 2000-01 season.

JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson has scored double figures in Iowa's last four games, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

HAWKEYES DOMINATING THE PAINT

Iowa is racking up the points in the lane through 11 games.

The Hawkeyes have scored 20 or more paint points in all but one game (Bradley, 16) this season and have netted 30 or more points six times. Iowa has outscored its opponents, 320-281 in the paint so far and the Hawkeyes are averaging 29.1 points in the paint per game.

Iowa has recorded more paint points than its opponents in eight games this season.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 555-266 (.676), including a 199-124 (.616) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

PRINTY LENDS A HELPING HAND

Jaime Printy recorded a career-high nine assists in Iowa's 22-point victory over Iowa State Dec. 9.

Printy leads the team with 52 assists and has led the team in helpers in six of Iowa's 11 games.

KREI DRAINING FROM DISTANCE

Kelly Krei tied a career-high for three-pointers made against Iowa State Dec. 9, draining five long distance shots. The Iowa City native finished with 15 points (5-8 3Pt FGs).

Krei made five three-pointers against Penn State in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament last season.

SILENCING THE CYCLONES

Iowa's defense was stout against No. 15 Iowa State Dec. 9, holding the Cyclones to just 40 points.

The scoring output by Iowa State was the lowest for an Iowa opponent since the 2007-08 season. Iowa held Michigan to 37 points in the Big Ten Tournament (March 7, 2008).

AT THE CHARITY STRIPE

Iowa currently leads the Big Ten and ranks eighth in the NCAA with a .780 free throw percentage. Jaime Printy leads the league and ranks second in the NCAA at .969 (31-32).

Kachine Alexander has attempted 76 free throws, Morgan Johnson has 38, Printy has 32 and Kelly Krei has 29.

DRAINING FREEBIES WHEN IT COUNTS

The Hawkeyes are putting games out of reach from the free throw line late in the game.

The Hawkeyes are shooting .860 (37-43) from the charity stripe in the final five minutes of games this season. That includes a .800 percentage (16-20) in the final two minutes and a .870 mark (20-23) in the final minute.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Iowa is one of only two teams (Penn State) to have five players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the league. All five Hawkeye starters average double figures.

Northwestern has four ranked while Ohio State and Wisconsin have three. The other six Big Ten schools have either one or two players among the top 30 scorers.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in all 11 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan and Kansas State.

HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa's rebounding numbers through its first 10 games are impressive. The Hawkeyes rank second the Big Ten in total rebounding (43.5 per game) and offensive rebounding (14.3).

Kachine Alexander and Morgan Johnson are tied for the league lead in offensive rebounds per game (3.5). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the most for any Big Ten player this season.

LEADING THE LEAGUE

Three Hawkeyes are leading the Big Ten in different statistical categories.

- Kachine Alexander and Morgan Johnson are tied for the league lead in offensive rebounds (3.5 per game).
- Jaime Printy has the best free throw percentage (.969) in the Big Ten.

BOMBS AWAY FOR A SCHOOL RECORD

The Hawkeyes set a school record with 37 three-point attempts against North Carolina Dec. 2. Iowa was just one three-pointer away from tying the school record for long distance shots made (12).

Kamille Wahlin attempted 11 treys while Jaime Printy had nine.

ALEXANDER CRACKS TOP 10 IN CAREER REBOUNDING

Kachine Alexander's 10 rebounds against North Carolina Dec. 2 increased her career total to 695, moving her into 10th place on Iowa's career rebounding list. Alexander moved past Lisa Becker, who collected 691 rebounds from 1893-87.

Alexander currently has 715 rebounds.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (27), 10th in career rebounding (715), 13th in career assists (263) and 27th in career scoring (940). She needs 11 more rebounds to move past Franthea Price for ninth place on the rebounding list and 17 assists to move past Laurie Aaron and Necole Tunsil for 12th on the assists list. She needs nine more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
- Morgan Johnson ranks fifth in career blocks (106) and needs eight more to move past Jennie Lillis into fourth place.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks sixth in career three-pointers made (129) and needs 10 more to move past Kristi Faulkner into fifth place.
- Jaime Printy ranks 11th in career three-pointers made (103) and needs six more to move past Jenna Armstrong and into the top 10 of the list.

ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

HAWKEYES LAND ON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAMS

Senior Kachine Alexander was named MVP of both the Islander Tip-Off Tournament and the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge. Kamille Wahlin was named to the all-tournament team at both the Islander Tip-Off Tournament and the Caribbean Challenge. Morgan Johnson earned a spot on the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge all-tournament team.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.

ALEXANDER ON WATCH LISTS

Senior Kachine Alexander has been named to the watch lists for the Wade Trophy, the Wooden Award and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

Alexander is also one of 30 Division I women's basketball players nationally to be selected as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible, the candidates must show excellence in four categories: community, classroom, character and competition.

KASH IN THE BANK (LAST SEASON)

- As a 5-9 guard, junior Kachine Alexander ranked second in the Big Ten and 23rd nationally with 10.4 rebounds per game last season.
- Alexander claimed the Big Ten rebounding title, averaging 11.1 boards per game in league games.
- Alexander was the top rebounding guard in the country under 5-10, and was one of only two guards in the entire country to average a double-double (16 points, 10.4 rebounds per game). She was also one of only three Big Ten players to average a double-double, with the other two being post players.
- Alexander had 15 double-doubles last season, which was one shy of the Iowa single season record.
- Alexander scored double figures in 22 of 27 games played, including eight 20-plus point performances. She had 10 or more rebounds in 17 of those games, with an impressive 10 games with 12 or more boards.
- Alexander averaged more rebounds than nine of the 10 players selected to the Division I State Farm Coaches' all-America Team. She averaged the same amount of rebounds (10.4) as Nebraska's Kelsey Griffin last year.
- Alexander had more double-doubles than seven all-Americans, despite playing between 12 and 14 fewer games than most of the honorees last year.
