- Recorded career highs in points (29) and free throws made (8) and attempted (8), matched a career high in steals (3) and also collected five rebounds in loss to Illinois
- Collected 13 points, four rebounds and matched a career high with three blocks in home victory over Penn State
- Grabbed a team-high seven rebounds and scored five points in loss at #15 Purdue
- Shared a team-high of 24 points, bolstered by 6-8 shooting from behind the arc and 6-6 from the foul line, and collected five rebounds and three assists in home win over Wisconsin

2006-07 HIGHLIGHTS

- Posted a career high in scoring in consecutive games (Wisconsin and Illinois)
- Ranks 18th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage and 94th in 3-pointers made
- Named to the WBCA Classic and Hawkeye Challenge All-Tournament teams
- Named to the Academic All-District second team (3.83 GPA)
- Broke the Iowa sophomore single-season 3-pointers made record (62), previously held by Lindsey Meder (60)
- Averaged 19.6 points and 4.4 rebounds the last five games of the regular season
- Made two 3-pointers or more 19 times this year, including in 12-of-16 Big Ten contests; made at least one triple in 16 consecutive contests
- Netted double figures in 21-29 contests
- Posted team highs in blocks eight times, scoring eight times, assists and rebounds four times and steals three times
- Tied the Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for most 3-pointers made (5) by an Iowa player vs. Quinnipiac
- Bested her five triples by draining six on eight attempts in the regular season finale vs. Wisconsin to break the Carver-Hawkeye Arena record by an Iowa player
- Tallied 15 points, grabbed six rebounds and collected three assists in season-opening win vs. Missouri State
- Scored 12 points and collected six rebounds and four assists in victory over Kansas
- Netted 19 points and collected eight rebounds and a game-high five assists in win over Indiana State
- Scored 23 points (8-12 FG, 2-2 FT), bolstered by 5-7 shooting from 3-point range and also collected five rebounds and five assists in triumph over Quinnipiac
- Registered 10 points, eight rebounds and a career-high three blocks in victory over Florida International

- Only Big Ten player ranked in top ten in scoring and top five in assists
- First Iowa freshman or sophomore to amass over 350 points and 100 assists in a single-season
- Ranks 28th in the nation in free throw percentage
- Named to the WBCA Classic All-Tournament team
- Has made 32 of her last 50 (.640) 3-point field goal attempts
- Has made at least one 3-pointer in 14 of the last 15 contests
- Ranks third in assists in a single-season (121) by an Iowa sophomore
