Web Conference • Iowa Head Coach Cindy Fredrick will be hosting a weekly "Web Conference" every week this season. She will address a variety of topics, from the state of the team to that week's opponents.

Third Place in Des Moines • The Hawkeyes finished in third place at the Hampton Inn State of Iowa College Volleyball Challenge last weekend. Iowa defeated Drake, 3-1, but fell to Iowa State, 3-0 and No. 21 LSU, 3-2.

Taming the Bulldogs • lowa opened the tournament with a 3-1 win over host-school Drake.

The Bulldogs took an early 1-0 lead after winning game one, 30-27. The Hawkeyes tied the match with a 30-26 win in game two, led by freshman **Megan Eskew** and sophomore **Megan Schipper**, who scored Iowa's first nine points in the game. Iowa finished on a 5-1 run to win the game.

The Hawkeyes gained an 18-17 lead in game three and never trailed after, winning 30-25 to take a 2-1 lead in the match.

Game four stayed within two points until Iowa went on a 13-6 run to take an 18-11 lead. Iowa went on another 9-4 run to take a commanding 28-22 lead, but a 6-0 spurt by Drake tied the game at 28. The Hawkeyes had two match points, but Drake fought back and eventually took a 31-30 lead. Iowa responded with two **Aimee Huffman** kills and took advantage of a Drake error to end the match.

Hawkeyes Fall to Cyclones • lowa dropped a 3-0 decision to intra-state rival lowa State in its first match Saturday.

The Hawkeyes struggled offensively, hitting just .147 as a team and were outblocked, 15-3.5.

lowa State won game one, 30-25. The Cyclones took a 12-11 lead and never trailed after gaining the advantage.

lowa led game two, 9-8, but a 9-1 Cyclone run gave them a 17-10 lead and once again never trailed, taking game two by a 30-22 margin.

The Hawkeyes couldn't fight back against the Cyclones, dropping game three, 30-23. Iowa tied the match at 1-1, but trailed the entire game after the Cyclones took a slim 2-1 lead.

So Close to the Upset • The Hawkeyes nearly upset No. 21 LSU Saturday night, but lost in five games.

Game one saw 10 ties and eight lead changes en route to an Iowa win. The Hawkeyes closed game one on an 8-1 run.

LSU took games two and three, but the Hawkeyes battled back to crush the Tigers, 30-19 in game four. The game was tied at 8-8 before lowa went on a 14-6 run. The Hawkeyes kept between an eight and nine-point lead before closing the game on a 4-1 run.

lowa stormed out to an early 3-0 lead in the fifth game, but the Tigers battled back to tie the game at 4-4. Both teams traded points until LSU took a slim 8-7 lead as the team's switched sides.

The game knotted up at 8-8 before LSU took a 10-8 and eventually gained a 12-9 advantage. Three-straight Hawkeye points tied the match at 12-12. LSU had two match points, but Iowa fought back to earn a match point of their own. The Tigers eventually scored three points to gain a 19-17 win.



Head Coach Cindy Fredrick



Cindy Fredrick is in her fourth season as head coach of the lowa volleyball team.

The Hawkeyes have improved in every facet of the game since Fredrick arrived in 2004. In the first year of the Fredrick Era, the Hawkeyes began laying the foundation of a successful program. The team not only improved both their overall and Big Ten Conference record, but became more competitive in every aspect in the game. The coaching staff

worked hard to instill a new winning attitude in the team, which helped the Hawkeyes to an 8-3 start.

The Hawkeyes continued to make strides in 2005 recording more wins (14), Big Ten wins (4), kills (1,709), assists (1,527), service aces (161) and blocks (252) than Fredrick's first year. There were plenty of highlights on the year, including an 11-4 start and the team's first win over in-state rival Northern Iowa in 16 years.

Individually, Fredrick guided Catherine Smale to a spot on the Big Ten all-Freshman team in 2005 – the first Hawkeye to earn that honor. The coaching staff also made great strides in recruiting, pulling in the 30th-ranked class in the nation according to prepvolleyball.com.

The Hawkeyes broke two school attendance records during the 2006 season. Iowa averaged 1,008 fans, which broke the singleseason average attendance record. Fredrick and her Hawkeyes also drew 1,690 fans to the Iowa State match, which shattered the singlematch attendance school record. Fredrick and the Hawkeyes won 11 of their first 12 matches, including nine in a row.

Turning mediocre volleyball programs into winning programs has been a big part of Fredrick's past, most recently as head coach at Washington State University. During her 15 year tenure at Washington State, Fredrick earned more wins than any coach of a women's sport with a 278-192 record and in seven seasons she had 20 or more wins. In 1995, after guiding her squad to a national ranking of fifth, the highest rank of any men's or women's team in school history, she was named Pac-10 and AVCA District VIII Coach of the Year. Fredrick also led the Cougars to ten NCAA tournament appearances, including two Elite Eight finishes and one Sweet 16 berth. In 1992 her squad was the NIVC Champions. In the 2002 NCAA tournament, the Cougars posted a 3-0 victory over Northern Iowa to advance to the Elight Eight.

Prior to coaching at Washington State, Fredrick coached at Weber State (Ogden, UT). When Fredrick first took over the Wildcat program in 1985, she led her team to a sixth place finish in the Mountain West Conference. By the time she left after the 1988 season, her team had finished first in the Big Sky Conference, earned an NCAA tournament birth and Fredrick was named Big Sky Coach of the Year. Fredrick also guided Mt. Vernon, IA, native Kim Benesh to Big Sky Player of the Year honors. She left Weber State with a benchmark 86-60 record in four seasons.

Fredrick's volleyball ties to the state of Iowa run deeper than just the University of Iowa. Fredrick began her coaching career as the head coach at Davenport Central High School from 1974-82. In 1981, she led her squad to a 33-0 season record and a state championship. From 1983-1985 she was head coach of the USVA Junior Development team in eastern Iowa that won four state Midwest championships. In the summer of 1985, Fredrick was named head coach for the United States Volleyball Association team for the state of Iowa that competed throughout Canada. **Scouting Texas Arlington** • The Texas Arlington Mavericks are 5-5 overall.

The Maverick attack is led by Teena Sobczak, who has 118 kills. Torie Dacus also has triple-digit kills with 102. Both Sobczak and Dacus also have triple-digit digs with 114 and 122, respectively.

Texas Arlington's primary setter is Emily Nedderman with 372 assists.

The Mavericks are coached by Diane Seymour. Iowa leads the all-time series, 2-1.

Scouting Ball State • The Ball State Cardinals are 1-7 overall. Elaina Kakatolis leads the Ball State offense with 92 kills while Julie Breivogel has 86 kills.

Angie Parrell has a team-best 216 assists, while Alyssa Rio has 199 digs.

The Cardinals are coached by Dave Boos. Iowa trails the all-time series, 1-0.

Scouting College of Charleston • The College of Charleston Cougars are 4-3 overall.

Whitney Russell has a team-high 84 kills and Emily Sawin is second with 74 kills.

Lindsey Kane leads the team with 202 assists.

The Cougars are coached by Jason Kepner. Iowa leads the all-time series, 1-0.

Hiza Named to All-Tournament Team • Junior **Emily Hiza** was named to the Hampton Inn State of Iowa College Volleyball Challenge all-tournament team. Hiza recorded 60 digs (5.0 digs per game) and had three service aces.

Schipper and Emerging • Sophomore Megan Schipper has been impressive in the first three weeks of the season. The Aplington, IA, native leads the team in kills (104) and kills per game (3.25). She is also tied for the lead in service aces (14) and service aces per game (0.44) and is second on the team in digs (70).

Kremer and Hiza in Big Ten Stats • Juniors Laura **Kremer** and **Emily Hiza** both rank in the top 10 in different Big Ten statistical categories.

Kremer has a total of 46 blocks (two solo, 44 assists) which is fifth-best in the conference. Hiza's 132 digs is good enough for seventh place in the conference.

Iowa Ranks High in Attendance • Iowa's average home attendance of 1,252 fans is the 16th-highest average attendance in the nation.

In addition, Iowa's opening night crowd of 1,584 against BYU is the 42nd largest single-game crowd thus far in 2007.
