'DON JAMES---Washington

We got some breaks. We won by a combination of good defense and breaks. They tried some things early but couldn't sustain a drive. Anytime you can shut out the Big Ten champion it has to be your best overall performance. Iowa has got a good reputation. They beat UCLA, Nebraska and Michigan on their way here. We beat two bowl teams in the last two weeks to get here too. We made team accomplishments in a down year. Eleven guys played pretty well. I can't make any distinctions of any one guy. We've been recruiting well so we have good athletes. When we lose a player, we have a young guy to come in and take over..

Jacque Robinson had a great game. Early in the season he had injury and fumble problems. He had finger surgery and was lost five to six weeks early. Actually, I just went up and introduced myself today.

Going into the USC game, he was on the scout team playing Marcus Allen. I got the coaches together and told them we had the best running back on the fourth team. He played Marcus Allen for two days and Jacque Robinson the rest of the year.

We got better after the UCLA game. I said after the loss that we would not make it to the Rose Bowl. My wife Carol said we would. We coaches decided to think along those same objectives.

I'm on the Coaches selection committee (for national rankings). I wouldn't say we're one of the top five teams, but I'd be glad to see us in the top ten.

HAYDEN FRY---Iowa

You just witnessed an old fashioned end-kicking. Washington really put it to us in every area of the game...including coaching. They were impressive on offensive and devastating on defense. That was the worst game we played but the Huskies were the reason why...this wasn't one of our better games, but I give Washington credit for that. We didn't execute.

Anyone who participates in any contest is disappointed in a loss. We did some great things getting here. We thought we'd win today. You can't blame it on distractions or the extra curriculums. The Huskies did the same things. This was a beautiful trip with great hospitality. You must be burned before you learn. We got burned today. We played a very poor ball game. We didn't do things correctly.

We thought we did everything to get prepared. I don't know why we lost. Washington did the same things they've done all year. We just didn't look like the Hawkeyes today and Washington did it to us.

Jacque Robinson: Who's he? He made us look like a poor tackling team. Ron Hallstrom had a great game for us doing the trap blocking.

Our fans are great. When it's been 23 years since your last bowl game they can't be disappointed. We sell out every game at home and this is our first winning season for almost 20 years. They love their Hawks no matter what. They're loyal to the end.
