GAME #9 STORYLINES

- Both Iowa and Indiana enter Monday's game having lost two games in a row.
- After playing its first three games of the regular season at home, Iowa is in the middle of a stretch playing six of seven away from Iowa City.
- In two games against Indiana last season, Jordan Bohannon averaged 16.5 points and eight assists. Tyler Cook averaged 11 points and six rebounds, while Cordell PemsI averaged 11 points and six rebounds.
- Isaiah Moss was named to the Cayman Islands Classic All-Tournament Team after averaging 18 points, leading the team in scoring in its first two games of the tournament.
- Iowa has yet to play a regular season game at full strength. Ahmad Wagner missed the UAB game (shoulder). Nicholas Baer played his first game last Tuesday at Virginia Tech (finger), while Connor McCaffery has missed every game (ankle and mono).
- Iowa's top seven scorers are underclassmen with sophomores Tyler Cook and Isaiah Moss leading the pack, averaging 15.3 and 13.8 points, respectively. Cook also leads the squad in rebounding (7.3). Freshman Luka Garza has a team-best 13 blocks, rookie Jack Nunge leads the team in steals (10), and sophomore Jordan Bohannon has 38 assists.
- Iowa's 40 shooting percentage from 3-point range is second-best in the Big Ten. Iowa shot 61.5 percent (8-of-13) from long distance versus UAB on Nov. 22, which is the best shooting performance of any Big Ten team this season.
- Both Ahmad Wagner and Ryan Kriener are 2-of-2 from 3-point range this season.
- Jordan Bohannon (30) and Tyler Cook (29) poured in career highs in scoring in Iowa's 95-85 triumph over UAB on Nov. 22, at the Cayman Islands Classic.
- Tyler Cook had his consecutive field goals made streak of 22 straight snap on his first attempt in Iowa's last outing against Alabama State (Nov. 12). The power forward's streak spanned four games, dating back to the second half versus Indiana at the Big Ten Tournament on March 9, 2017.
- Fran McCaffery has 392 wins in 22 seasons as a head coach; he is eight victories from reaching the 400-win milestone.
- Iowa is 69-15 when scoring 80 points or more, the last eight seasons.
- Iowa ranked first in Big Ten steals (7.4) and scoring offense (80.5), and second in assists (17.7) a year ago.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Monday's game will be televised nationally on BTN (BTN2GO). Kevin Kugler and Stephen Bardo will call the action.

IOWA EDGED BY PENN STATE IN BIG TEN OPENER

Penn State never trailed in a 77-73 win over Iowa inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Saturday in the Big Ten opener for both teams.

- All 77 of Penn State's points were scored by their starting five, with Lamar Stevens netting a team-best 22 points.
- Tyler Cook posted his first career double-double on Saturday, registering game bests in scoring (23) and rebounding (12). He also dished out a career-best four assists.
- Iowa had the scoring edge around the basket outscoring the Nittany Lions, 42-26, however Penn State drained a season-best 12 triples while limiting Iowa to just four. Penn State made 52 percent of its 3-point attempts, a season best by an Iowa opponent.
- Nicholas Baer started his first game of the season. The redshirt junior had five rebounds, two blocked shots, and scored four points.
- Iowa shot 50.9 percent from the field, marking the fifth time in eight games that the Hawkeyes have shot the basketball better than 50 percent from the field.

ALL-TIME SERIES RESULTS

Indiana holds a 101-76 advantage in the series that began with an 18-12 Hoosier win in 1909. The two teams have split the last 14 meetings, including last year's two meetings. Iowa won the only regular season meeting between the two teams, 96-90 OT, a year ago in Iowa City on Feb. 21, while Indiana bounced the Hawkeyes from the 2017 Big Ten Tournament, 95-75, in Washington, D.C. on March 9.

Indiana holds a 59-29 advantage in games played at Bloomington. Iowa and Indiana have split the last two meetings at Assembly Hall; Iowa won 77-63 in 2015, while Indiana won 85-78 in 2016.

HEAD COACH FRAN McCAFFERY

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his eighth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 22nd year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery has reached the 20-win plateau eight of the last 11 seasons, including four of the last five years.

McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 35th season as a collegiate coach in 2017, which includes 21 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery is one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament.

McCaffery, 57, holds a career mark of 392-282 (.582) and guided his teams to 11 postseason appearances (seven NCAA and four NIT). He is 141-105 (.573) at Iowa. McCaffery led Iowa to NCAA Tournament victories in two of the last three years (2015 and 2016), the first time Hawkeye teams have won tournament games in consecutive seasons since 1996-97.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have earned six postseason tournament berths (3 NCAA, 3 NIT). McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided five different Hawkeyes to all-conference honors, including four straight first team honorees. The last time Iowa had four consecutive first-team all-league honorees was 1945-48.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past five seasons at Iowa and 17 of 21 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more eight of the last 11 seasons, including four of the last five years at Iowa (2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by more than 50 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes boast a 73-17 (.811) home record the last five seasons, which includes a school-record 18 wins in 2014.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

SCOUTING INDIANA

- Indiana lost its last two games to top-ranked Duke (91-81) and at Michigan (69-55).
- The Hoosiers fell behind at Michigan, 18-4, Saturday afternoon and ultimately fell by a 14-point margin, 69-55. Juwan Morgan was the only Indiana player who scored in double figures, pouring in a game-best 24 points. Michigan made 11 triples, compared to just two for the Hoosiers.
- Monday will be the fifth time in six games the Hoosiers will have played a home contest.
- Three Hoosiers average double figures: Juwan Morgan (13.6), Robert Johnson (13.1), and De'Ron Davis (11.0).
- Indiana is 4-2 at home this season, dropping its season opener to Indiana State (90-69) and to top-ranked Duke last Wednesday night (91-81).
- Only one of Indiana's eight games have been decided by nine points or less, an 86-77 win over Howard on Nov. 12.
- Indiana ranks last in the Big Ten in scoring defense, yielding 75.1 point per game. The Hoosiers are 13th in free throw percentage (.652) and 3-pointers made per game (5.9). Individually, De-Ron Davis is first in the league in field goal percentage (.692). Robert Johnson is fifth among Big Ten players in minutes played per game (32.8).
- Archie Miller is in his first season as head coach at Indiana and seventh season overall as a collegiate head coach (143-66, .684). Miller last coached against the Hawkeyes on March 13, 2012. Miller's Dayton Flyers dropped an 84-75 decision at Iowa in the first round of the NIT.

LAST MEETING

Indiana outscored Iowa, 52-33, in the second half, bouncing the Hawkeyes from the Big Ten Tournament in the second round on March 9, at the Verizon Center in Washington, D.C.

- Iowa had its four-game winning streak snapped in the loss to Indiana. The streak began with a home win over Indiana (Feb. 21) and included two road wins over top-25 teams.
- Jordan Bohannon tied an Iowa record with six 3-point field goals in a Big Ten Tournament game (Jeff Horner vs. Minnesota, 2006). Bohannon also distributed 10 assists, which tied Iowa's Big Ten Tournament record (Horner, 2006 vs. Ohio State).
- Isaiah Moss had a career-best five steals. The five steals were the most by a Hawkeye in 34 games last season and tied an Iowa record in the Big Ten Tournament (Luke Recker, 2002 and Horner, 2006). Moss added 11 points.
- Cordell Pemsil (14 points, 11 boards) and Jordan Bohannon (24 points, 10 assists) both recorded their first career double-doubles.
- Indiana shot 60 percent (35-of-58) from the field, including 60 percent from 3-point range (12-of-20). The Hoosiers made 75 percent (6-of-8) of their 3-point attempts in the second stanza.
- Four Hoosiers scored in double figures: James Blackmon (23), De'Ron Davis (15), Thomas Bryant (11), and Devonte Green (10).

HAWKEYES SHOOTING THE BALL WITH ACCURACY

Other than games against Louisiana (.367) and Virginia Tech (.333), the Hawkeyes have shot the basketball well. The Hawkeyes have shot 50 percent or better in five of their eight games, including shooting a white-hot 60 percent against UAB on Nov. 22. The Hawkeyes shot 59.6 percent against Chicago State, 54.3 percent versus Grambling State, 50.9 percent in a loss to South Dakota State and 50.9 percent in Saturday's setback to Penn State. Iowa is shooting 48.2 percent from the field.

GARZA SHINES IN EARLY SEASON GAMES

Freshman Luka Garza ranks second on the team in rebounding (7.0), first in blocked shots (1.6), second in free throw attempts (35), and fourth in scoring (8.5).

Garza became just the second Hawkeye in the last 20 years to register 16 points and five rebounds in their debut (Aaron White in 2011).

Garza followed up that performance against Chicago State (16 points, 5 rebounds) with a double-double against Alabama State. The native of Washington, D.C. had 11 points and a game-best 13 rebounds. Garza is the fifth Hawkeye to post a double-double in either his first or second game over the last 20 years, joining Dean Oliver, Reggie Evans, Devon Archie, and Aaron White. Garza's efforts in those first two wins garnered the forward Big Ten Freshman of the Week accolades.



MOSS ELEVATING HIS GAME

Last year as a redshirt freshman playing alongside honorable mention All-American Peter Jok, Isaiah Moss averaged 6.5 points per game. Through eight games his sophomore campaign, the native of Chicago is averaging 13.8 points per contest, a +7.3 points per game improvement.

Moss has netted double figures in seven of eight games this season. He is shooting 45 percent from the field and has missed only one free throw in 18 attempts.

COOKIN' WITH TYLER

Tyler Cook is having a solid start to his sophomore campaign. Cook ranks first in scoring (15.3) and rebounding (7.3). Cook has made a team-best 58 percent of his field goal attempts (minimum 50 attempts). The native of St. Louis has grabbed six or more rebounds in all eight games, including a career-best 12 in Iowa's last game against Penn State on Saturday. He had the best game of his collegiate career against UAB on Nov. 22 (29 points on 8-of-11 shooting from the field and 13-of-16 from the free throw line).

Cook ranks 10th in league scoring (15.3) and 11th in rebounding (7.3). He has one double-double this season (Penn State).

Not only has Cook done a good job getting to the free throw line, but making his foul shots. Cook ranks 23rd nationally in free throw attempts (60) and 37th in free throw makes (44).

BACK IN ACTION

Sophomore forward Cordell Pemsil had successful sports hernia surgery in May. Pemsil did not participate in the Prime Time League nor Iowa's exhibition games overseas.

Pemsil is averaging 5.8 points and 5.9 rebounds after eight contests this season. The native of Dubuque, Iowa, netted a game-high 15 points in Iowa's win over Alabama State on Nov. 12. He had a personal-best 14 rebounds and a career-best six assists at Virginia Tech. The 14 boards against the Hokies are the third most by a Big Ten player this season. Pemsil reached double figures for the second time this season in Iowa's last outing against Penn State on Saturday.

Pemsil started 14 of 34 games a year ago, averaging 8.9 points and five rebounds per contest. The forward shot a single-season school record 61.7 percent (116-of-188) from the field his during freshman campaign.

BOHANNON NAMED CANDIDATE FOR BOB COUSY AWARD

Iowa sophomore Jordan Bohannon has been named to the 20-player watch list for the 2018 Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor recognizes the top point guards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee comprised of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.

Bohannon joins Minnesota's Nate Mason and Bryant McIntosh of Northwestern as the only Big Ten student-athletes on the national list.

The native of Marion, Iowa, has had a great start to the 2017-18 campaign, dishing out 38 assists, and averaging 13.4 points. He is shooting 49 percent (24-of-49) from 3-point range and 87.5 percent (21-of-24) from the free throw line. His is averaging three 3-pointers made per game, which ties for first in the league.

Bohannon, one of five players named to the All-Big Ten Freshman Team, led the Hawkeyes in assists (175) and 3-pointers made (89), and was third in scoring (10.9 ppg). He was one of only two freshmen in the country over the last 25 seasons to register 175+ assists and 85+ 3-pointers. His 89 triples shattered Iowa's single-season freshman record, besting Matt Gatens' previous mark of 52 set in 2009. Bohannon's 175 assists are the most by an Iowa freshman and rank eighth-best by any Hawkeye player in a single season. He finished the season by posting a school-record three straight double-doubles in points and assists (Indiana, South Dakota, and TCU). Bohannon helped lead Iowa to a win at nationally-ranked Maryland, draining eight 3-pointers (8-of-10) -- the most by a Hawkeye rookie and one shy of Chris Kingsbury's school record.

CONNOR McCaffery TO PLAY FRESHMAN SEASON

Freshman guard Connor McCaffery announced his decision earlier this month to play his freshman season on the basketball court. McCaffery will join the baseball team upon conclusion of the basketball season. A decision as to whether or not McCaffery will red-shirt baseball this spring will be determined at that time.

However, the guard's start to his freshman year has been off to a slow start. After playing in Iowa's two exhibition games, McCaffery missed Iowa's first eight regular season games. McCaffery sat out the first two games due to a sprained ankle, while he missed Iowa's last six outings due to illness (mono).

HAWKEYES GO UNDEFEATED IN EUROPE

Iowa finished its European Tour with a perfect record in August notching wins in Germany, Switzerland, and Italy.

Four Hawkeyes averaged in double figures in the four games. Freshman Luka Garza averaged a double-double (22.5 points, 10.3 rebounds), sophomore Isaiah Moss averaged 12.5 points, Cook averaged 12.3 points, while Ryan Kriener averaged 11.3 points. As a team, the Hawkeyes shot 48.6 percent from the field, out-rebounded their opponents by 18, and had a +5.8 turnover margin.

Iowa played its first game in Germany, the home of Hawkeye senior Dom Uhl. The native of Frankfurt, Germany, had seven points, seven rebounds, three assists, two steals, and a block in his homecoming.

Garza led the team in scoring in all four games.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,748 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,616-1,132 (.588). Iowa's 1,616 wins are 39th most among Division I programs. That includes a 1,033-361 (.741) record in home games, a 579-768 (.430) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 762-766 (.499) mark in Big Ten games and a 438-135 (.764) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

TRIPLE PLAY

Jordan Bohannon finished his rookie season with a flurry, posting a school-record three straight double-doubles in points and assists.

Bohannon tallied 24 points and 10 assists against Indiana at the Big Ten Tournament on March 9. The native of Marion, Iowa, then registered 19 points and 11 assists against South Dakota on March 15 in the first round of the NIT. Bohannon bested that performance again on March 19, posting personal bests in scoring (25) and assists (13). The 13 helpers are the most by a Hawkeye in a postseason game.

HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- Iowa scored 90 points or more nine times in 2016-17. The Hawkeyes netted 90-plus points in three of their four victories.
- Iowa is one of only three teams to have posted a Big Ten record of .500 or better each of the last five seasons (Michigan State and Wisconsin).
- Iowa has won 48 of its last 52 nonconference home games, dating back to 2012.
- Iowa is 69-15 when scoring 80 points or more, the last eight seasons. The Hawkeyes are 66-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last eight years.
- Fran McCaffery and his coaching staff are the first in program history to win 18 games or more in six straight seasons. McCaffery's 137 victories rank second behind Tom Davis (152) for most in the first seven seasons as Iowa's head coach.
- Fran McCaffery has guided Iowa to upper division finishes in the Big Ten in each of the last five seasons. McCaffery has accumulated 17 first division finishes in 21 years as a head coach.

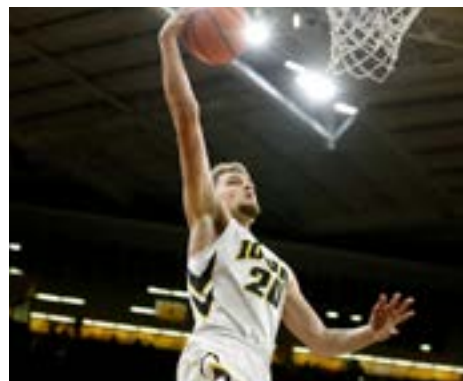
