#### THIS WEEK:

The University of Iowa men's tennis team will travel to two nationally-ranked foes, No. 29 Arizona and No. 15 Minnesota. The Hawkeyes take on the Wildcats on Monday, March 18, at 2 p.m. (PT) at the LaNelle Robson Tennis Center. Iowa will conclude its trip on Friday, March 22, against the Golden Gophers at 6 p.m. (CT) at the Baseline Tennis Center.

#### LAST WEEK:

- The Hawkeyes swept in-state rival Drake, 4-3, and Nebraska, 5-2, in their Big Ten opener. lowa's win at Nebraska was their first road victory of the year.
- After a successful weekend, lowa has checked in at No. 47 in the latest ITA Rankings.

#### ARIZONA BREAKDOWN:

- The 29th-ranked Wildcats are coached by Clancy Shields, who is in his third season. Shields guided Arizona to 16 victories and the Pac-12 Quarterfinals a year ago.
- Arizona is 11-3 overall, dropping its last two matches on the road against Pac-12 foes, Cal, (L, 4-2) and Stanford (L, 4-0).
- lowa's 4-1 victory over Arizona last season in Iowa City, Iowa, was its first win over the Wildcats in 14 matches.

### MINNESOTA BREAKDOWN:

- Geoff Young is in his 13th season as Minnesota's head coach. Young coached the Golden Gophers to a Sweet 16 appearance a year ago.
- The 15th-ranked Golden Gophers are 12-1 overall, riding a 10-match win streak that began on Jan. 27.
- Senior Josip Krstanovic is ranked No. 43 in singles and is joined by classmate Justyn Levin in doubles at No. 79 playing the No. 1 spot.
- The Hawkeyes were edged, 4-3, by the Golden Gophers last year in lowa City. Minnesota owns a 59-36-3 advantage in the series history.

## **HAWKEYE NOTABLES:**

- Kareem Allaf won 11 matches during competition, including seven in a row to capture the ITA Central Regional championship. He became the third Hawkeye to accomplish the feat in school history.
- Oliver Okonkwo has amassed 18 doubles wins as a freshman, 12th most in a single season in program history.
- Will Davies has won 11 of his last 13 singles matches on courts four and five.
- With one more singles win, Allaf will crack the Top-15 in program history for the Hawkeyes.
- lowa is 10-0 when winning the doubles point this year.
