**THIS WEEK** -- University of Iowa sophomore **Dragos Agache** will compete in the 100 and 200 breaststroke at the NCAA Championships. The Championships are being hosted by Georgia Tech University. All events will take place in the Georgia Tech Aquatic Center. Tickets can be purchased through the Georgia Tech ticket office ([www.ramblinwreck.com](http://www.ramblinwreck.com)). All-session passes for adults are \$65 and students are \$50.

**LAST COMPETITION** -- Agache last competed at the Big Ten Championships on February 23-25. Agache earned NCAA 'B' times in the 100 and 200 breaststroke. His time of 53.94 in the 100 breast set a new school record, topping the previous record of 54.80 set in 1998, by Marco Minonne.

**HIGH STANDARDS** -- Agache competed in 17 individual events this season and recorded seven individual victories. He was runner-up three times and never finished out of the top four. Agache set a collegiate best in the 100 breast at the Big Ten Championships, and led the team in the 200 breast. His time in the 100 breast (53.94) ranks first on Iowa's all-time top performers list and his time in the 200 breast (1:59.67) ranks third.

**HEAD COACH MARC LONG** -- Marc Long is in his second season as head coach for the University of Iowa women and first for the men. He served two seasons as the Iowa women's assistant coach (2003-04) before taking over. He also served as a Hawkeye men's assistant from 1998-2001.
