### HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS



Two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his fourth season as head wrestling coach at Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time all-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 73-6 overall and 21-3 Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and an 90-26 career mark.

In his third season with the Hawkeyes, Brands led Iowa to its second straight NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning five all-Americans and two Big Ten champions. The 2009 national title was the school's 22nd, and it was only the second time in school history Iowa won the NCAA title without an individual champion. Brands earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after guiding Iowa to the school's 33rd conference team title. The Hawkeyes ended the 2008-09 season with a 24-0 record, going undefeated for the first time since 1999-2000. The Hawkeyes, who ended the season on a 38-dual match winning streak that dates back to the 2007-08 campaign, clinched the 2009 Big Ten regular season title with a perfect 8-0 mark in conference competition and won the 2008 Midlands team title.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time all-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

### THIS WEEK

The top-ranked Iowa wrestling team (14-0) will open the 2010 Big Ten dual season on the road with matches at Michigan (4-7) and Purdue (10-4). The Hawkeyes will wrestle Michigan Friday at 6 p.m. (CT) at Cliff Keen Arena in Ann Arbor. Then they will face Purdue Sunday at Noon (CT) at Lowell High School Gymnasium in Lowell, IN.

### IOWA WINNING STREAKS

The Hawkeyes have won their last 52 dual matches, which is a school record. The current streak started with a win over Cornell (32-3) on Jan. 12, 2008, which was the first match after Iowa lost to Oklahoma State (19-14) on Jan. 5.

lowa has also won its last 21 duals at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. That streak, which ranks fourth in school history, started with a 27-13 win over Penn State on Jan. 20, 2008, which was also the first home match after the Jan. 5 loss to the Cowboys.

The Hawkeyes have won 36 consecutive duals on the road, which is also a school record. That streak started with a 20-13 win at Iowa State on Dec. 9, 2007.

### MICHIGAN WOLVERINES

Michigan is 4-7 with wins over Pennsylvania (19-12), Newberry (22-13), Bucknell (21-15) and Clarion (29-15), and losses to Lehigh (9-21), Bloomsburg (17-18), American (19-20), Kent State (9-28 and 7-29) and Virginia (10-23 and 13-19).

Wolverine Head Coach Joe McFarland is 136-56-5 in 11 seasons at Michigan and 166-90-5 in 14 years as a collegiate head coach. He is assisted by Michigan alums Kirk Trost (1986) and Mike Kulczycki (2003).

Michigan is led by junior Anthony Biondo (197) and sophomores Zac Stevens (133) and Justin Zeerip (174). Biondo is ranked ninth in the nation by *AWN* and Intermat, and 11th by *W.I.N.* with a 24-2 record. Stevens has an 18-9 record, while Zeerip is 22-12.

Purdue is 10-4 with wins over Northern Iowa (24-9), Northwestern (33-7), Missouri (19-15), Mount St. Joseph (30-12), Indianapolis (32-10), Southern Illinois (52-0), Lakeland (41-6), UNC Greensboro (30-9), Kent State (26-17) and Ashland (43-12), and losses to Stanford (16-19), Rider (10-25), Old Dominion (14-17) and Maryland (10-22). Friday, February 13, 2009, was pretty lucky for the top-ranked Iowa wrestling team. The squad blanked #25 Purdue, 38-0, at Carver-Hawkeye Arena to remain undefeated at 21-0 (5-0 Big Ten). Iowa had won its last 35 matches, and despite adverse weather conditions, 5,709 fans turned out for the dual. It was the first time Iowa shut out an opponent since beating Binghamton (48-0) on Nov. 29, 2008, at the Journeymen Duals in Troy, NY.

Iowa dominated the dual, scoring 36 takedowns while holding Purdue to two. Iowa senior **Charlie Falck** opened the dual at 125 with a 14-4 major decision over Purdue's Matt Fields. Junior **Daniel Dennis** (133) and senior **Alex Tsirtsis** (141) followed with match-ending technical falls to build a 13-0 lead for Iowa. Dennis, who was named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week February 10 for his wins at Michigan State and Penn State. Tsirtsis picked up his 90th career victory and his 20th win in Carver-Hawkeye with a 17-1 victory over Matt Hemry in 5:00.

### MARION NAMED BIG TEN WRESTLER OF THE WEEK

Hawkeye 141-pounder **Montell Marion** has been named Big Ten Wrestler of the Week. It is the first time the sophomore from Des Moines, IA has earned the honor. Marion's earned the award as a result of his upset victory in top-ranked Iowa's win over fourth-ranked Oklahoma State last Saturday in Iowa City.

It's also the third-straight week a Hawkeye wrestler has earned the conference honor. This marks the first time, since the Big Ten Conference started awarding the weekly honor during the 2001-02 season, that wrestlers from the same team have earned the honor in three consecutive weeks. Hawkeye seniors **Brent Metcalf** (149-Jan. 5) and **Jay Borschel** (174-Jan. 12) were honored earlier this month.

Marion, who is now ranked seventh in the nation by Intermat, scored Iowa's biggest upset in Saturday night's 19-16 victory over the Cowboys. Marion, who was ranked #11 by Intermat at match time, blanked fifth-ranked sophomore Jamal Parks, 4-0. After a scoreless first period, Marion scored an escape and takedown and added a riding time point for the victory. Marion accumulated 3:16 of riding time during the match, improving to 12-2 in collegiate matches and 4-1 in dual competition this season.

### HAWKEYES EDGE OKLAHOMA STATE, 19-16

The top-ranked Hawkeyes fought off a strong performance by #4 Oklahoma State, scoring a 19-16 win Jan. 16 at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. A crowd of 10,967 was on hand to see the Hawkeyes pick up their 52nd straight dual win, and beat the Cowboys for the first time in Carver-Hawkeye since December 4, 2000. Both teams won five bouts, but Iowa's bonus-point wins at 125, 149 and 174 were the difference in the final team score. Iowa remains undefeated at 14-0, while handing Oklahoma State (8-1-1) their first loss.

lowa jumped out to a 4-0 lead on redshirt freshman **Matt McDonough**'s 13-4 major decision over ninth-ranked Oklahoma State senior Chris Notte at 125. Mc-Donough, who is ranked fourth in the nation at 20-0, scored three third-period takedowns and accumulated over four minutes of riding time.

Oklahoma State answered at 133 with #6 Jordan Oliver's 3-2 upset of #4 **Daniel Dennis**. The Hawkeye senior led 1-0 going into the final period. Oliver, who is a redshirt freshman, escaped to tie the score at 1-1. Dennis took a 2-1 lead with less than a minute remaining when Oliver was given his second stalling warning of the bout. But Oliver scored a takedown off a scramble as time expired to record the win, and hand Dennis (8-1) his first loss of the season. It was the first match back for Dennis, who has been out injured since Iowa's dual with Iowa State on Dec. 6.

Hawkeye sophomore **Montell Marion** had a tough task against fifth-ranked sophomore Jamal Parks at 141, but blanked Parks, 4-0, to record an upset of his own. After a scoreless first period, Marion scored an escape and takedown in the second period to take a 3-0 lead. Parks chose the down position to start the third period, but could not escape. The unranked Hawkeye sophomore accumulated 3:16 of riding time, improving to 12-2 on the season.

Iowa picked up critical team points at 149 when top-ranked Hawkeye senior **Brent Metcalf** scored a 21-5 technical fall over Cowboy junior Quinten Fuentes in 5:15. Metcalf, who improved to 20-0 on the season, scored three takedowns and a three-point nearfall in each of the first two periods. He ended the match with an escape and takedown early in the third period.

Oklahoma State closed the gap to 12-10 with wins at the next two weights. At 157, Cowboy junior Neil Erisman recorded a 16-7 major decision over Hawkeye junior **Aaron Janssen**. Janssen scored a second-period takedown to pull within two (5-3), but Erisman rolled off nine straight points to score Oklahoma State's only team bonus points of the night. Cowboy redshirt freshman Alex Meade then pulled an upset at 165 with a 5-3 win over Iowa senior **Ryan Morningstar**. Meade, who is ranked between 10th and 13th in the nation, scored takedowns in the first and third periods, while holding third-ranked Morningstar to three escapes in the match.

Hawkeye seniors **Jay Borschel** (174) and **Phillip Keddy** (184) stepped up to put Iowa in position for the team win. Borschel, who is ranked first or second in the nation, recorded his 80th career victory with a 9-1 major decision over Oklahoma State sophomore Mike Benefiel. Borschel, who is undefeated at 19-0 this season, scored a takedown in each period and accumulated 4:37 of riding time to hand Benefiel, who is ranked between seventh and 14th in the country, his second loss of the season. Keddy followed with a tough 3-2 win over Oklahoma State junior Clayton Foster at 184, collecting his 90th career win.

Leading 19-10 with two bouts left, Iowa's hopes for its 52nd straight win rested on reserves **Luke Lofthouse** (197) and **Blake Rasing** (Hwt.). Lofthouse fought hard against seventh-ranked sophomore Alan Gelogaev, but lost the bout 3-2. Oklahoma State needed a pin from top-ranked heavyweight Jared Rosholt

to tie the dual, but Rasing had other plans. Down 5-0 in the third period, Rasing escaped and scored two takedowns of his own to pull within one (6-5), but ran out of time and lost 7-5.

The Hawkeyes also sent five unattached competitors to the annual Brand Open in Omaha, NE, Saturday. Freshman **Ethen Lofthouse** won the 174-pound title, while junior **Tyler Clark** placed second at 133 and freshman **Dylan Carew** placed third at 149.


