QUICK HITS

- lowa made its ninth consecutive postseason appearance (8 NCAA, 1 WNIT), earning an at-large bid to the WNIT last season.
- The Hawkeyes have made a postseason tournament appearance in 15 of head coach Lisa Bluder's 16 seasons at the helm of the program, receiving 12 NCAA Tournament and three WNIT (2003, 2005, 2016) opportunities.
- Bluder is one of 14 Division I head coaches to win 675 or more in her career. She has been a head coach for 32 seasons, including 16 at lowa.
- lowa returns four of its five starters from last season in senior Ally Disterhoft, junior Chase Coley, and sophomores Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson.
- Iowa's freshmen class of Bre Cera (2016 Journal Sentinel Player of the Year), Kathleen Doyle (Illinois Miss Basketball), Makenzie Meyer (Iowa Miss Basketball), Amanda Ollinger, (Gazette Female Athlete of the Year) and Alexis Sevellian (Finalist for Michigan Miss Basketball) was ranked No. 7 nationally by Blue Star -- the highest ranked recruiting class for head coach Lisa Bluder and her staff.
- Senior Ally Disterhoft was named Preseason All-Big Ten by the coaches and media, the Big Ten Conference announced Oct. 24. She led the Hawkeyes in scoring last season, averaging 17.1 points per game. The guard/forward netted double figures in every game last season and became the highest scoring junior in program history with 565 points.
- Disterhoft ranks seventh on lowa's all-time career scoring list with 1,718 career points. Former Hawkeye Cindy Haugejorde holds the scoring record with 2,059 points.
- Disterhoft earned Academic All-America of the Year and first team Academic All-America accolades last season. She owned the highest GPA (4.03) of any Academic All-American last season and was the only junior to be named to the first team.
- Bluder owns a 331-192 (.633) overall record and a 160-106 conference mark at lowa. In her 32 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 687-334 (.673).

SCOUTING KENT STATE

- Kent State enters Tuesday's contest with a 6-4 overall record. The Golden Flashes have won four straight games with wins over Florida Golf Coast, Fort Wayne, Wright State, and Youngstown State.
- Senior guard Larissa Lurken leads the team in scoring (23.0) and rebounding (6.5). Junior forward Jordan Korinek is also averaging double figures in scoring (12.0).
- The Golden Flashes rank eighth in free throw attempts (258) and free throws made (186). As a team, Kent State is shooting .721 from the free throw line.
- Lurken leads the nation in free throw attempts (105) and free throws made (84). She also ranks fifth in points per game (23.0) and eighth in total points (230).
- The Hawkeyes and Golden Flashes have each played Robert Morris. The Hawkeyes defeated the Colonials, 81-60, on Dec. 9 in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. Kent State fell to Robert Morris, 65-68, in overtime on Nov. 19 in Kent, Ohio.
- The Golden Flashes are coached by first-year head coach Todd Starkey. Starkey spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana.

THE SERIES

- lowa leads the all-time series, 2-0.
- The team's last met in Iowa City, Iowa, in 2001. The Hawkeyes defeated the Golden Flashes, 76-65, in the Hawkeye Challenge at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

DAVIS NAMED MADNESS B1G PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Sophomore Tania Davis was named the Madness Big Ten Women's Basketball Player of the Week, College Sports Madness announced Dec.12.
- Davis averaged a team-high 18.5 points, shot .526 from the field (10-of-19), .600 from 3-point range (6-for-10) and a perfect 1.000 (11-for-11) from the free throw line to lead lowa to a pair of wins over lowa State and Robert Morris.
- The Flint, Michigan, native registered career highs in points (23), 3-pointers made (5) and field goals made (7) to guide the Hawkeyes past in-state rival lowa State (88-76) on Wednesday.
- Two days later, Davis netted 14 points and was a perfect 7-for-7 from the charity stripe to help the Hawkeyes to an 81-60 win over Robert Morris.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

- Sophomore Megan Gustafson registered the 16th double-double of her career against lowa State. It was her seventh double-double of the season.
- Gustafson is one of eight NCAA student-athletes to record seven or more doubledoubles this season.
- Gustafson has led lowa in boards in every game this season.
- The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native ranks fourth in the nation in double-doubles (7), fifth in rebounds (126), sixth in field goals made (86), ninth in field goal percentage (.672), and 23rd in rebounds per game (10.5).

HAVE A DAY, TANIA

- A career day by sophomore Tania Davis led the Hawkeyes past in-state foe lowa State on Wednesday, Dec. 7.
- Davis registered career highs in points (23), 3-pointers made (5), and field goals made (7).
- The Flint, Michigan, native was 7-of-11 from the field and 5-of-6 from 3-point range in 30 minutes of action.
- On the season, Davis is shooting .404 (19-of-47) from long distance -- the second highest percentage on the team (Disterhoft, .513).

DYNAMIC DUC

- Senior Ally Disterhoft and sophomore Megan Gustafson have each scored in double figures in every game this season.
- Both Disterhoft and Gustafson have netted 20 or more points four times this year.
 They both accomplished the feat in games against Oral Roberts, James Madison, and Drake.
- Together, the pair averages 34.2 points per game.

DISTERHOFT FROM DOWNTOWN

- After starting the season 1-for-9 from 3-point range, senior Ally Disterhoft has netted 19 of her last 30 (.633) shots from downtown.
- Disterhoft leads the team, shooting .513 (20-of-39) from 3-point range this season.

FAST FACTS

- The Hawkeyes are 8-0 when leading at the half.
- lowa is 8-0 when scoring 70 points or more.
- The Hawkeyes rank 11th nationally in total attendance (31,469).
- lowa shot .688 (11-for-16) from three point range against UNI on Dec. 4, marking the second-highest 3-point field goal percentage in a single game this season (Tennessee, .857, vs. Navy).

MOVIN' ON UP

- Senior Ally Disterhoft now ranks sixth on lowa's all-time career scoring list.
- Disterhoft has 1,756 career points and is 303 points from tying lowa's all-time scoring record of 2,059 set by Cindy Haugejorde (1976-80).
- Disterhoft also ranks 10th all-time in 3-point field goals (136), 13th in career blocks (59), and 14th in rebounds (668).

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir), the all-time winningest coach in program history, completed her 16th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 32nd season as a college head coach in 2015-16.

Under her direction, the Hawkeyes have advanced to 15 postseason appearances (12 NCAA and three WNIT) in 16 seasons, including NCAA Tournament berths in eight of the last nine seasons.

Bluder, the 2015 Carol Eckman Award winner, has posted a 331-192 (.633) record at lowa and her career record stands



Bluder, 1-of-14 active Division I coaches with 675 or more wins, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010) and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year (2001 and 2008). She has guided lowa to a winning record in 15 of her 16 years at lowa, including 11 upper-division finishes in the challenging Big Ten Conference. Bluder, who ranks third among Big Ten coaches all-time in league victories (160), has led lowa to nine 20-win seasons in her 16 years, including seven of the last nine years.

Bluder has coached numerous players to different awards in her 16 years in lowa City. She has mentored 19 players to 47 All-Big Ten honors, including 12 first team picks, 16 second, 11 third and eight honorable mention selections. She has also had two Big Ten Freshman of the Year award winners, two Big Ten Sixth Player of the Year recipients, eight members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and three players named to the Big Ten All-Defensive team, with Kachine Alexander earning the honor twice.

Five players during Bluder's tenure have earned a total of seven Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-region team accolades and six players have earned a total of 11 honorable mention All-America honors. Bluder coached her first consensus All-American in Samantha Logic, who earned the honor after being named a WBCA Division I Coaches All-American, USBWA All-American, ESPN Second Team All-American, and Third Team Associated Press All-American.

With Bluder on the lowa sidelines, student-athletes have been named Academic All-Big Ten 75 times, including a program-best eight honorees in 2011 and 2012. The 75 honorees is the highest total mentored by any of the Big Ten coaches. Bluder has also mentored three Academic All-Americans in Ally Disterhoft (2015, 2016), Logic (2015), and Lindsey Meder (2001, 2002). Disterhoft was also named Academic All-America of the Year in 2015.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five postseason appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

- Kathleen Doyle registered her first career start against No. 9 UCLA in the Cancun Challenge on Nov. 24. She has remained in the starting lineup since.
- Since getting the starting nod, Doyle is averaging 8.7 points, 3.0 assists, and 2.0 steals per game.
- Doyle set career highs in points (17) and field goals made (6) against lowa State on Dec. 7.
- The LaGrange Park, Illinois, native ranks seventh in the conference in steals (24) and is tied for eighth in steals per game (2.0).

IN THE POLLS

- Two Big Ten teams are included in the week seven (Dec. 19) Associated Press Top 25. They include: No. 4 Maryland and No. 12 Ohio State. Northwestern is receiving 24 votes in the poll.

GUSTAFSON NAMED B1G PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Center/forward Megan Gustafson was named Big Ten Player of the Week, the conference office announced Nov.
 14. It is the second weekly honor of Gustafson's career.
- The Port Wing, Wisconsin, native posted back-to-back double-doubles to lead lowa to wins overall Oral Roberts and Hampton on Nov. 11 and 13. The sophomore tied a career high in points (25) and recorded 12 rebounds, an assist and a block in 26 minutes of action against Oral Roberts on Nov. 11. Two days later, Gustafson netted 14 points and pulled down 11 boards to lead the Hawkeyes past Hampton. She also went a combined 7-for-8 from the free throw line.
- Gustafson earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors on Feb. 22, 2016. She is the first Hawkeye to win Big Ten Player of the Week since Samantha Logic won the award on March 2, 2015.



DISTERHOFT EARNS PRESEASON HONOR

Senior Ally Disterhoft was named Preseason All-Big Ten by the coaches and media, the Big Ten Conference announced Oct. 24. The lowa City, lowa, native was a second team All-Big Ten selection in 2015 and 2016 and an honorable mention All-Big Ten honoree in 2014. She was also named to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team and Big Ten All-Tournament team in 2014.

HAWKEYES CONTINUE POSTSEASON STREAK

- lowa made its ninth straight postseason appearance (8 NCAA, 1 WNIT) with an atlarge bid to the WNIT in 2016.
- Iowa was one of six Big Ten Conference teams (Minnesota, Michigan, Nebraska, Northwestern, Rutgers) and one of three teams from Iowa (Drake, UNI) to be included in the WNIT field of 64.

RETURNING EXPERIENCE

- lowa returns four of its five starters from last season in senior Ally Disterhoft, junior Chase Coley, and sophomores Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson.
- Senior Ally Disterhoft garnered second team All-Big Ten accolades by coaches and media for the second consecutive season and received lowa's Sportsmanship Award. The preseason All-Big Ten pick by coaches and media scored in double figures in every game last season and in 78 of her 84 consecutive starts.
- Tania Davis and Megan Gustafson were named to the 2016 Big Ten All-Freshman Team.
- Davis was one of two Big Ten freshmen to lead her team in assists per game (3.4) and average at least one steal per game (1.2) last season. She has dished out 111 assists in 33 games played, the second-highest total recorded by a freshman at lowa (Samantha Logic; 136).
- Gustafson was the only freshman and one of three players in the conference overall to lead her team in field goal percentage (.554), rebounds (225), and blocks (58) last season.
- Chase Coley averaged 11.1 points per game last season the second highest mark on the team. The junior compiled 365 points, 194 rebounds, 53 assists, 37 blocks, and 24 steals in her sophomore campaign to receive lowa's Most Improved Award.

- lowa's freshmen class consists of Bre Cera (2016 Journal Sentinel Player of the Year), Kathleen Doyle (Illinois Miss Basketball), Makenzie Meyer (Iowa Miss Basketball), Amanda Ollinger (2016 Gazette Female Athlete of the Year), and Alexis Sevellian (finalist for Michigan Miss Basketball).
- Cera has started all seven games this season, while Meyer has started five and Doyle has started the last two.

THE BLUDER FILE

- Head coach Lisa Bluder begins her 17th season at the helm of the lowa women's basketball program this season. She owns a 331-192 (.633) overall record and a 160-106 Big Ten record at lowa. In her 32 seasons as a head coach, Bluder is 687-334 (.673).
- Bluder is one of 14 active Division I coaches to collect 675 or more career wins.
- The head Hawkeye is second in career Big Ten wins (160) and in total wins among Big Ten coaches. She trails only C. Vivian Stringer who has compiled 189 Big Ten wins and 971 career wins.
- Bluder ranks third all-time among all Big Ten coaches with 160 conference victories.
