HAWKEYES SWEEP NORTH DAKOTA STATE

Iowa defeated North Dakota State, 4-0 and 6-1 in a doubleheader last Sunday. The Hawkeyes collected 16 total hits against the Bison.

In game one, Iowa plated three runs in the first inning for an early lead. Freshman Erin Riemersma hit an RBI single to the center field fence followed by a two-RBI double to the right field fence by senior Kylie Murray. The Hawkeyes added another run in the sixth off an RBI single by junior **Emily Gerlick**.

Senior Ali Arnold threw her sixth complete game and fourth shutout of the season. She allowed only one hit and struck out six.

In game two, North Dakota State took a 1-0 lead in the top of the third, but Iowa responded in the fourth with an RBI double by sophomore **Emily Nichols**. The Hawkeyes used a five-run fifth inning to take the lead, capped by a three-run home run by Riemersma.

Freshman **Brittany Weil** improved her record to 17-8 with the win, throwing a complete game, while striking out three.
