HAWKEYES THIS WEEKEND • The Iowa Hawkeyes (15-22, 5-11) will face the Michigan State Spartans (14-21, 4-11) in a four-game series Friday-Sunday at Oldsmobile Park in Lansing, MI.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE:

Michigan State won its last game, 10-6, over Toledo Wednesday night at home. Chris Roberts ignited the Spartan offense, going 3-for-3 with two RBI and a walk. Last weekend, Michigan State was swept by in-state rival Michigan. The Wolverines out-scored the Spartans 52-16 in the four-game series.

Michigan State, who is 4-9 at home, will play the Lansing Lugnuts in an exhibition Thursday night. The Lugnuts are a minor league affiliate of the Toronto Bluejays.

The Spartans are led, offensively, by Kyle Day who is hitting .341 with five homers, 34 RBI and 21 walks. After Day, the next highest ranked Spartan in RBI is Roberts and Eric Roof with 16. Roberts has totaled nine extra base hits and is hitting .327. Roof is batting .296.

Michigan State's pitching staff has accumulated a 5.60 ERA. Chris Cullen is the starter to look out for, as he is 4-1 with a 2.85 ERA.

Iowa trails the all-time series between the two schools, 65-55-1.

LONG TIME, NO SEE:

This weekend will be the first time Iowa and Michigan State will meet since 2005. The Hawkeyes and Spartans did not play each other the last two seasons.

The two teams split a four-game series in 2005 in Iowa City. The last time Iowa visited Michigan State was 2004.

DAHM CAPTURES MILESTONE:

Head Coach **Jack Dahm** captured his 400th career victory Wednesday night with Iowa's 5-2 win at Northern Iowa. Dahm recorded 283 victories at Creighton and has won 117 at Iowa.

Dahm started in 1994 with his alma mater, Creighton University, and moved on to coach the Hawkeyes in 2003.

IOWA OFFENSE IS STREAKING:

Caleb Curry's hitting streak ended last weekend against Northwestern, it was a team-high streak of 15-games. **Justin Toole** has been swinging the bat well, having gone the last 11 games with a hit.

Curry leads the team in multi-RBI games with 12, followed by **Kurtis Muller** (10) and **Toole** (9). **Kevin Hoef** has an 18 multi-hit games to lead Iowa, while Curry and Toole have 17 multi-hit games this year.

GETTING OFF TO A GOOD START:

Last weekend, the Hawkeyes got off to a great start in every ballgame, having scored at least once in the bottom of the first inning.

DIAMOND THIEVES:

This season Iowa has out-run their opponents, going 83-for-108. Leading Iowa in steals is **Caleb Curry** (25), followed by **Justin Toole** (15) and **Kyle Riffel** with 12.

Iowa ranks first in the Big Ten and fifth nationally in thefts per game.

On Deck for the Hawkeyes

Iowa and Northern Iowa will meet for the second time in as many weeks as the two teams square-off in the fifth annual Corridor Classic.

The Panthers are 24-12 after dropping a 5-2 decision to the Hawkeyes April 23 in Waterloo. UNI, who is in first place in the MVC standings, hosts Southern Illinois in a three-game series this weekend.

As a team, UNI is hitting .317, including a .467 slugging percentage. Brandon Douglas leads the team in RBI (41), doubles (19) and slugging percentage (.627). Iowa is 66-23-1 against UNI.

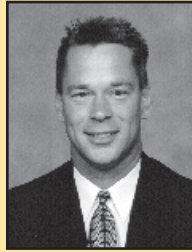

The Iowa Hawkeyes have signed eight recruits for next year. **Nick Brown**, **Sean Flanagan**, **Cory Glieden**, **Jarred Hippen**, **Mike McQuillan**, **Zach Robertson**, **Phil Schreiber** and **Chett Zeise** all signed national letters of intent.

Head Coach Jack Dahm



Jack Dahm is in his fifth season as head coach of the University of Iowa baseball team. He has compiled an 400-418-2 overall record and is 117-142 at Iowa. Dahm coached in his 800th career game on March 30th this year at Michigan.

Last season, Iowa took another step forward by recording its best record in 14 years with a 31-23 mark. The Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13. Iowa earned its second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

In Dahm's 14 years as a head coach, he has produced 23 first team all-conference performers, seven freshmen All-Americans and two All-Americans. In his four years at Iowa, Dahm has coached 19 all-Big Ten selections, including seven first teamers.

Before coming to Iowa City, Dahm spent 18 years as a member of the Creighton Bluejays baseball program. He left the Bluejays as the winningest coach in school history, having compiled 283 wins against 276 losses in 10 seasons as a head coach.

Twenty-seven of Dahm's players have been selected in the MLB Draft, while four have gone on to play in the major leagues. In the past three years, nine Hawkeyes have inked contracts with professional teams, including three last spring.

In the classroom, Iowa is in the 90th-percentile in the NCAA's Academic Progress Report, placing them in the top 30 baseball programs, academically. During his Iowa tenure, Dahm has seen 33 players named academic all-Big Ten, including a team-record ten players in 2006. That is the best four-year total in the history of the program.

The 41-year old Dahm and his wife, Lynn, have been married 14 years. The couple has three children - sons Casey and Tyler and daughter Lyndsey.

BY THE NUMBERS IN THE BIG TEN:

Caleb Curry has taken the Big Ten by storm, when compared with the league's players he ranks in the top ten in: batting average (.409), on base percentage (.473), slugging percentage (.561), hits (56), runs batted in (41), hit-by-pitches (8) and stolen bases (25).

Other Hawkeyes who rank well in the conference include: **Justin Toole** is in the top ten in runs batted in (34), hits (56) and runs scored (38). **Kevin Hoef** leads the league in hit-by-pitches (15), is fourth in runs scored (38), is fourth in triples (3) and fifth in total plate appearances (169). **Kyle Riffel** leads the league in sac bunts (9), and is ninth in the league in hit-by-pitches (6) and **Kurtis Muller** is sixth in the league in sac bunts (6). **Andrew Porter** is first in appearances (23) and sixth in saves (4) and **Kyle Heim** is tied for second (20) in appearances.

IOWA DOWNS IN-STATE RIVAL:

The Hawkeyes defeated in-state rival Northern Iowa (UNI) Wednesday night in front of 1,012 fans at Riverfront Stadium, 5-2. The win was Iowa Head Coach Jack Dahm's 400th of his career and snapped a three-game losing streak for the Hawkeyes. The two runs Iowa allowed UNI tonight matched a season low for the Panthers.

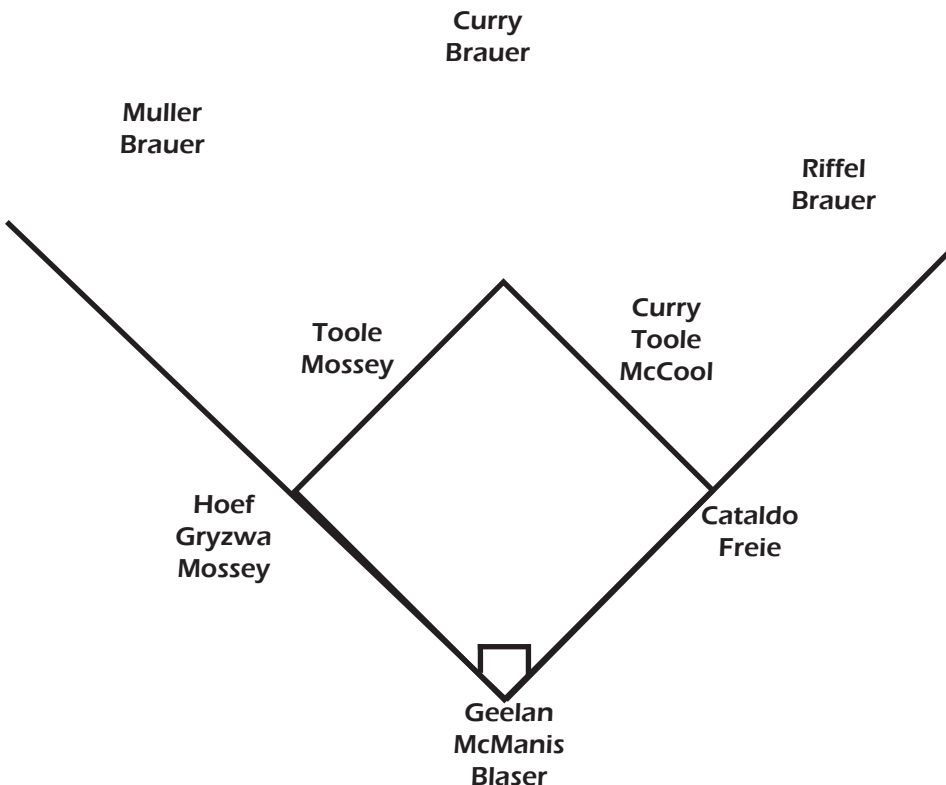
In the win, five Hawkeyes recorded multi-hit games and four recorded an RBI. **Kurtis Muller** led the Hawkeyes going 2-for-5 and driving in two runs. **Caleb Curry** went 2-for-4 with a double, run and RBI. **Wes Freie** moved to the clean-up spot and went 2-for-4 with an RBI, a double and a walk. **Justin Toole** was 2-for-5 with a run, while **Justin Brauer** went 2-for-4 with a run.

Steve Turnbull threw four solid innings, striking out three and allowed no earned runs and no walks in earning his second win of the season. Turnbull made his first start since March 18 at Stetson.

SUCCESSFUL WITH RUNNERS :

Several Hawkeyes have taken advantage of base runners this season.

Caleb Curry is hitting .506 (40-79) with runners on to lead the Black and Gold. **Justin Toole** is hitting .773 (12-17) when runners are on third and less than two outs, while **Kurtis Muller** is 44-for-76 (.579) in advancing runners. **Kevin Hoef** is hitting .500 (5-10) with the bases loaded.

UTILIZING THE SAC BUNT:

The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in sacrifice bunts this season in the conference (36). Leading the Black and Gold is **Kyle Riffel** with nine, followed by **Kurtis Muller** with six, and **Justin Toole** with four.

WEARING PITCHES:

Iowa has no problem taking one for the team. The Hawkeyes have 56 hit-by-pitches on the year which is more than any other team in the Big Ten and enough to rank them 43rd in the country in the category.

To lead the Black and Gold is **Kevin Hoef** with 15, followed by **Caleb Curry** (8) and **Kurtis Muller** (7).

FRESHMAN STEPS UP:

Kurtis Muller has had a stellar season as Iowa's only everyday freshman starter, hitting a solid .290. He has 32 RBI, nine stolen bases, five doubles, one triple and two homers on the year. On top of that, he leads the league in sac flies (5) and ranks second in team sac hits (6).

This past weekend, Muller was red-hot, going 7-for-13 with seven RBI. On Wednesday, Muller went 2-for-5 with two RBI and a run.

McMANIS TAKES ON CATCHER:

Because **Tyson Blaser** and **Ben Geelan** are not 100 percent with injuries -- utility infielder **Kody McManis** has started a major of the games behind the dish.

McManis has improved behind the plate and also from the batters box,

as well. On the season, McManis is hitting .306 with a double and five RBI. Coming into the season, McManis had a career .186 batting average.

Geelan returned to action last Sunday after missing three and a half weeks with an ankle injury. The senior played in two games this week, going 2-for-5 with a run and RBI in his return.

BRANDS TO THROW OUT FIRST PITCH AT CORRIDOR CLASSIC :

Iowa Head Wrestling Coach Tom Brands will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at the fifth annual Corridor Classic presented by Cedar Rapids Toyota-Scion Wednesday at Veterans Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids. The Corridor Classic pits the Iowa Hawkeyes against the Northern Iowa Panthers in baseball.

Brands, who was named the National and Big Ten Coach of the Year, led the Hawkeyes to their 21st national championship last month. In addition, the Big Ten and NCAA Championship trophies will be on display on the concourse at the event.

HAWKEYES GO YARD:

The Hawkeyes added another three home runs to their Big Ten total vs. Northwestern last weekend. Iowa hit three long balls in the four-game series. The Hawkeye total has now swelled to 14.

Against Northwestern, **Kevin Hoef** hit his third career homer, **Caleb Curry** hit a shot for his second one this week and **Wes Freie** hit a bomb to give him his third this season.

Eleven of Iowa's 14 homers this season have been in Big Ten play (five at Indiana and three vs. Purdue and Northwestern).

THE ASSISTANT COACHES:

Head Coach **Jack Dahm** is assisted by coach **Ryan Brownlee** and coach **Nick Zumsande**, along with volunteer coach **Kris Welker** and Director of Baseball **Matt Haddy**.

Ryan Brownlee enters his fifth season as Iowa's hitting, infield instructor and recruiting coordinator.

As hitting coach, Brownlee saw the team's batting average vault 55 points from 2005 to 2007 (.269 to .324). Additionally, the team also scored more runs (273 to 401) had more RBIs (249 to 345) and walks (152 to 245) during that time span. **Nick Zumsande** enters his fifth year as the Iowa pitching coach.

Under Zumsande's guidance, the Hawkeye pitching has had a pitcher named first team all-Big Ten three of the last four years, and a pitcher named all-conference in each of his four years.

Kris Welker is in his second year as the team's volunteer assistant. Welker works with the Iowa catchers and outfielders, prepares scouting reports and coaches first base.

As a senior, Welker earned third team all-Big Ten honors, helping Iowa to a third-place finish in the Big Ten and a trip to the conference tournament. He led the team with a .354 batting average, 46 RBIs and 16 doubles. Welker also received the Bob Oldis, Jr MVP Award

Matt Haddy is in his third season as the Director of Baseball Operations for the University of Iowa.

He assists the coaching staff with the day-to-day operations and administrative areas of the program. Haddy also serves as the travel coordinator and director of Hawkeye Baseball Camps.

CURRY RECEIVES HONOR:

Senior **Caleb Curry** received *CollegeBaseballHub.com's* Heartland Hitter of the Week honor for his performance against Rutgers.

Curry went 8-for-13 with seven RBI, two walks and three runs scored in the series.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES:

When you look around the diamond this season, your eyes don't deceive you. There are several familiar faces in the lineup playing different positions. Senior **Caleb Curry** moved to center field from left field and also has taken on shortstop and second base. Junior **Justin Toole** also will move from second to shortstop on occasion.

SCHEDULE STRENGTH:

Iowa will play one of its toughest schedules in 2008 as it will face nine teams that advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season. The Hawkeyes will welcome NCAA Tournament teams Minnesota, Nebraska and Ohio State to Iowa City and will take on Albany, Creighton, Michigan, Rutgers, Stetson and Vanderbilt on the road. Iowa will face three teams in conference action that advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

LAST SEASON:

Iowa posted a 31-23 record in 2007, the Hawkeyes placed fourth in the Big Ten Conference at 17-13, and earned their second trip to the conference tournament in the last three years -- this after going just once the previous 15 years.

During the season, Iowa defeated five teams (Nebraska, Fresno State, Ohio State, Minnesota and Michigan) that reached the NCAA Tournament. The Hawkeyes also posted a 12-game winning streak, which is the second-longest in school history. Included in the streak was a school-record 10-game Big Ten winning streak.

HAWKEYES HIT THE CLASSROOM:

In October, the Iowa baseball team was awarded the 2007 NCAA Public Recognition Award for being in the 90% percentile of Academic Progress Report (APR) for baseball.

Wes Freie was named Big Ten Player of the Week on March 4. In addition, **Brock Alberts** earned co-Pitcher of the Week accolades, sharing the honor with Phil Isaksson.

Freie had a stellar weekend helping lead Iowa to a 2-1 record, including a 6-3 upset win over fifth-ranked Vanderbilt, at the Music City Classic in Nashville, TN. The first baseman, who was named tournament MVP, was 9-for-12 with a double, home run, two RBI and two walks. The junior led the Black and Gold against No. 5 Vanderbilt, going a perfect 4-for-4 with an RBI.

Alberts had a great season debut in Iowa's come-from-behind win over Xavier Feb. 29. The senior right hander threw five and one-third innings in relief for the win. He allowed no runs, scattered five hits with no walks and struck out a career-high 10 of the 21 batters he faced.

2008 MUSIC CITY CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:

After going 2-1 at the tournament and upsetting Vanderbilt, the Hawkeyes received six of the 12 spots on the all-tournament team, including the MVP.

Hawkeyes honored were: **Justin Toole** at second, **Kevin Hoef** at shortstop, **Kyle Riffel** in the outfield, **Caleb Curry** in the outfield and **Wes Freie** as utility and MVP.

BIG TEN NETWORK SCHEDULE:

Three Hawkeye games will be televised on the Big Ten Network (HD) this season. Iowa's doubleheader at Indiana last Saturday was broadcast on the network. Only one game remains to be televised.

O'ROURKE OUT:

Senior pitcher **Casey O'Rourke** has ended his collegiate career for medical reasons following his bout with testicular cancer in 2006. He will remain on the squad as a student assistant.

O'Rourke had 11 appearances and seven starts last season. He pitched 32.2 innings and had an 8.54 ERA. The native of Williamsburg, IA, was named to the academic all-conference team last year.
