THE SETTING

The Iowa Hawkeyes (15-12, 8-8) host the Indiana Hoosiers (13-14, 6-10) Thursday in the final home game of the regular season. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m.

SENIOR NIGHT

The Hawkeyes will honor senior JoAnn Hamlin Thursday night. Hamlin, the lone senior on this year's team, was forced to sit out the season after having a blood clot removed in her right leg.

Hamlin played in 59 games at Iowa with 19 starts. She scored 321 points in her two-year Hawkeye career. She transferred to Iowa in 2006, after playing her freshman season at Kansas State.

ON YOUR RADIO

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call Thursday's game for the Hawkeye Radio Network. The game can be heard on AM-1360 KMJM, and also on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his sixth season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her fifth year providing analysis.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,028 games, since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 625-404 (.608). That includes a 317-158 (.667) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 296-87 (.773) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Thursday is the 56th meeting between Iowa and Indiana, with the Hawkeyes leading the series, 40-15. Iowa has won three of the last five meetings. The Hawkeyes have dominated the series at home and hold a 22-3 record against the Hoosiers in Iowa City. Iowa has won the last 12 home matchups against Indiana and 22 of the last 23. Iowa lost its first two home games against Indiana before winning 10 in a row. Iowa's last loss at home to Indiana was Feb. 20, 1994.

SCOUTING INDIANA

The Indiana Hoosiers are 13-14 overall and 6-10 in Big Ten play. In its last game, Indiana was defeated at home by Minnesota, 59-50. Jori Davis led the Hoosiers with 22 points. Indiana shot just .274 (17-62) from the field and gave up 13 second chance points.

Davis leads the team with 16.9 points per game, while Jamie Braun is scoring 12.3 points per contest. Sasha Chaplin is leading the team with seven rebounds per game.

As a team, the Hoosiers are shooting .385 from the field, including .316 from three-point range and .682 from the free throw line.

IOWA VS. INDIANA NOTES

- Iowa freshman Theairra Taylor and Indiana junior Georgie Johnes are both from St. Paul, MN, and were high school teammates at St. Paul Central High School.
- Indiana Associate Head Coach Katie Abrahamson-Henderson is a native of Cedar Rapids and attended Cedar Rapids Washington High School. She was a two-year letterwinner at Iowa (1988-90) after transferring from Georgia. She was a part of two Big Ten championship teams and a Sweet 16 appearance.

LAST MEETING

Iowa knocked off Indiana, 71-67, Feb. 11 in a hard-fought game in Bloomington.

The game remained close throughout, with neither team leading by more than seven points. The Hoosiers grabbed a seven-point lead at the 5:03 mark, but an 8-0 Hawkeye run gave Iowa a one point lead with 3:47 remaining. Kelly Krei was fouled on a three-point attempt at the 2:51 mark and drained all three freebies, giving Iowa a 65-64 advantage it never relinquished.

The Hawkeyes were led by Jaime Printy, who scored 28 points and grabbed five rebounds. Kachine Alexander notched a double-double with 21 points and 16 rebounds. Kelsey Cermak added 10 points off the bench.

Indiana's Jamie Braun netted 20 points for the Hoosiers, while Hope Elam (13) and Jori Davis (12) also reached double figures.

HAWKEYES FALL AT NORTHWESTERN

Iowa's four-game winning streak was snapped Sunday at Northwestern, 72-66.

Iowa trailed by as many as 10 points with 5:10, but battled back to within two points at the 2:01 mark after a Kamille Wahlin layup. After two Amy Jaeschke free throws increased the Northwestern lead to four points, Kachine Alexander sank a layup to cut the lead again to just two points. Clutch free throws in the final 13 seconds sealed the win for the Wildcats.

The Hawkeyes were led by Wahlin, who scored 20 points and dished out six assists. Alexander collected a double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds, while Krei added 13 points.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Kachine Alexander collected her 13th double-double of the season at Northwestern Feb. 21. Alexander scored 17 points and grabbed 10 rebounds. She now has 22 career double-doubles.

Alexander had double-doubles in each of Iowa's first three games, before missing the next seven games with a stress fracture. She now has double-doubles in six of Iowa's last seven games.

Despite missing seven games, Alexander still ranks third in the Big Ten in double-doubles, behind Ohio State's Jantel Lavendar (17) and Illinois' Jenna Smith (15), who are both post players.

PRINTY NEARS SCORING RECORD

Jaime Printy needs only six more points to become the all-time freshmen scoring leader at Iowa. She is currently in third place with 411 points, and trails Megan Skouby (414) and Lisa Becker (416).

JOHNSON. TEAM SET BLOCKS RECORD

Freshman Morgan Johnson broke both the school and Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for blocks in a single game with eight against Minnesota Feb. 18. The previous school and arena record was seven blocks. Johnson had tied the record twice this season.

Johnson first blocked seven shots at Northern Iowa Nov. 22. She repeated the accomplishment Jan. 14 against Penn State in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

In addition, Iowa broke the school record for team blocks in a single game with 13. The previous record was 12 (at Drake, Dec. 20, 2009).

ON A STREAK

Since Jan. 21, Iowa has won seven of its last nine games. Iowa has moved from last place in the Big Ten to a tie for fifth place. The Hawkeyes are just one game out of third place. Iowa has also moved up 19 spots in the NCAA RPI (74 to 55) since Jan. 21.

KASHIN' IN FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE

Kachine Alexander set two school records and a Big Ten Feb. 14 vs. Illinois.

Alexander's 17 made free throws and 20 free throw attempts were both school records. In addition, the two marks are Carver-Hawkeye records for an Iowa player.

Alexander's 17 made free throws are also the most by a single player in a Big Ten game. The 20 attempts are the third-most by a Big Ten player in conference history.

Alexander has scored 112 of her total 317 points from the free throw line, and is averaging 7.2 trips to the charity stripe per game.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 10th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 26th season as a college head coach. She is a two-time Big Ten and WBCA Regional Coach of the Year, most recently earning honors a year ago in 2007-08.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 540-263 (.672), including a 184-121 (.603) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose. Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to six post-season tournaments (4 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and six upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

PRINTY SETS FRESHMEN THREE-POINTERS RECORD

Jaime Printy became Iowa's all-time leader for three-pointers made by a freshman Feb. 4 at Ohio State. Printy's four treys against the Buckeyes gave her 50 for the season, which is one better than the previous record of 49, held by Lindsey Meder (1998-99). She currently has 66 made treys.

WAHLIN SETS SOPHOMORE TREY MARK

Kamille Wahlin broke Wendy Ausdemore's record for three-pointers made by a sophomore Feb. 18 vs. Minnesota. Wahlin finished with five made three-pointers, which gave her 67 on the year. She currently has 69 treys. Ausdemore's record was 62 made three-pointers.

CLIMBING THE RECORDS LADDER

- Jaime Printy already broke the freshmen record for three-pointers made in a single season at Iowa with 66.
- Printy's 411 points rank third among Hawkeye freshmen. She only needs six more points to become the all-time freshmen scoring leader at Iowa. She trails Megan Skouby (414) and Lisa Becker (416).
- Printy's 83 assists ranks fourth in Iowa history for a freshman. She trails Kamille Wahlin for second place (87).
- Kamille Wahlin has already set the new sophomore three-pointer record. She broke Wendy Ausdemore's previous record of 62. Wahlin currently has 69.
- Morgan Johnson's 66 blocks are the second-most for an Iowa freshman. Tangela Smith (73) is in first place. Smith's 73 blocks also rank first all-time in Iowa history.
- Johnson's 185 rebounds are third among freshman. She trails Cindy Haugejorde (237) for third place.

HAWKEYES LEADING IN STAT CATEGORIES

- As a team, the Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in three-pointers made per game (7.74) and rank second in three-point percentage (.370). In Big Ten games only, Iowa leads the conference in three-pointers made per game (7.56). Nationally, Iowa ranks 12th in three-pointers made per game and 23rd in three-point percentage.
- Iowa's team free throw percentage of .752 is third in the Big Ten, and 20th nationally.
- Iowa's scoring offense of 69.4 points per game ranks second in the Big Ten and 61st nationally. The Hawkeyes are also second in league games only (68.2 points per game).
- Individually, freshman Jaime Printy ranks second in the Big Ten in free throw percentage (.867) and three-pointers made per game (2.44). In addition, she leads the league with 2.56 treys per game in conference games.
- Kamille Wahlin leads the Big Ten in three-pointers made per game (2.65) and ranks 31st nationally.
- Kachine Alexander is third in the Big Ten in double-doubles, and ranks 20th nationally. In league games only, Alexander is third in rebounding (10.6), defensive rebounds (7.67) and offensive rebounds (2.93).
- In Big Ten games only, freshman Morgan Johnson ranks first with a .486 field goal percentage. She is also third in blocked shots per game (2.56), and 18th in the country.

LEADING THE ROOKIES

Jaime Printy and Morgan Johnson are making their cases to be included on the Big Ten all-Freshmen team this season.

Printy leads all Big Ten freshmen in scoring (15.2) and free throw percentage (.867), while Johnson is first in rebounding (6.9) and blocked shots (2.44).

ONE, TWO FROM THREE

Kamille Wahlin and Jaime Printy are proving to be a potent one-two punch from behind the three-point arc.

The duo ranks first and second in the Big Ten in three pointers made per game. Wahlin leads the league with 2.65 per game, while Printy is second at 2.44.

UNDERCLASSMEN CONTRIBUTING

Iowa's freshmen and sophomore class are putting up big numbers for the Hawkeyes this season.

Hawkeye underclassmen are responsible for 81 percent of the teams' points and minutes played.

In additions, Iowa's freshmen class in contributing the fourth-highest percentage of minutes played (47.5) and the sixth-highest percentage of points (47.7) in the entire country.

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF FREE THROWS

Iowa, under Head Coach Lisa Bluder, is proving to be one of the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

The Hawkeyes have ranked in the top 20 in the nation four of the past five seasons. Iowa finished the 2005-06 season ranked 10th (.760), 2006-07 ranked fifth (.788) and also ranked fifth (.792) last season.

The 2009-10 campaign is no different. Iowa currently ranks 20th in free throw percentage across the NCAA (.752). The Hawkeyes are led at the charity stripe by Kamille Wahlin (.900) and Jaime Printy (.867).

HITTING 70 POINTS

If the Hawkeyes score 70 or more points, chances are they will walk away with a win.

Thirteen of Iowa's 15 wins have come when the team scores 70 or more points. The Hawkeyes are 11-1 when scoring between 70-79 points, and 2-1 when reaching 80 points.

ATTACKING THE GLASS

Iowa dominated the glass at Indiana Feb. 11, out-rebounding the Hoosiers by 24 (53-29).

Feb. 11 was the first time since March 20, 2003 that Iowa held a rebounding margin of that size. Iowa out-rebounded St. Louis in the first round of the WNIT by 30 (57-27).

Iowa's 53 rebounds Thursday night were also the most team rebounds since Dec. 30, 2003, when the Hawkeyes grabbed 55 against Missouri.

PRINTY LEADS CHARGE AT INDIANA

Freshman Jaime Printy sparked Iowa in the second half at Indiana Feb. 11, scoring 20 of her 28 points in the final 20 minutes. Printy scored 14-straight points for the Hawkeyes between the 10:41 and 4:05 mark in the second half.

With Iowa leading by just one point with 20 seconds left, Printy nailed a runner in the paint as the shot clock expired to put the Hawkeyes up three points.

KASH GETS NO. 500

Kachine Alexander became the 19th player in Iowa history to reach the 500-career rebound plateau at Iowa Feb. 7 against Michigan State.

Alexander enters Sunday's game at Northwestern with 543 rebounds.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE

In Iowa's win against Purdue Jan. 31, both Morgan Johnson (16 points, 11 rebounds) and Kachine Alexander (16 points, 10 rebounds) recorded double-doubles.

The last time Iowa had two players record double-doubles, in the same game, was Feb. 19, 2005 in Iowa's 78-59 win at Michigan. Johanna Solverson finished with 18 points and 10 assists, while Jamie Cavey ended with 19 points and 14 rebounds.

The last time Iowa had two players record double-doubles with points and rebounds was Dec. 10, 2004 in Iowa's 91-82 win at Creighton. Krista VandeVenter had 19 points and 14 rebounds, while Jamie Cavey had 20 points and 10 rebounds.

HALEWAY TO 100

Iowa scored 50 points in the first half against Minnesota Feb. 18. The last time Iowa scored 50 or more points in a first half was Nov. 29, 2003 at Florida International. Iowa led 53-34 at half, and won 93-86.

OH, SO CLOSE

Eight of Iowa's 12 losses have been by six points or less, with three of those being by three points. Iowa has also lost two overtime games by a combined seven points.

- The Hawkeyes had a three-point attempt at the buzzer against West Virginia fall short, that would have sent the game to overtime.
- Against Boston College (Dec. 2), Iowa missed a three-pointer with seven seconds left that would have tied the game.
- Against Michigan (Dec. 6), Iowa missed the front-end of a one-and-one from the free throw line with both 27 and 11 seconds left, each time trailing by only one point.
- Iowa's two overtime losses came at Penn State (Dec. 28, four point loss) and at Minnesota (Jan. 3, three point loss). In each of those games, the Hawkeyes had the potential game winning shot in regulation bounce off the iron as time expired.
- Iowa led by nine points with 9:48 remaining against Penn State (Jan. 14), but an 11-0 Lady Lion run gave them a 51-49 advantage with 7:13 left. Penn State took the lead for good with 5:36 left, as Iowa could only come within four points with 44 seconds left.



- The Hawkeyes had a 72-71 lead with 4:58 at then-No. 8 ranked Ohio State, but couldn't hold on to the win, losing by four points.
- Iowa dropped a six-point decision at Northwestern. The Hawkeyes trailed by only two with 13 seconds remaining, but clutch free throw shooting by Northwestern dealt Iowa the loss.
- In addition, Iowa led No. 19 Kansas by three points (54-51) with 6:41 remaining in the game, but the Jayhawks closed the contest with a 15-1 run.

WAHLIN SHOOTS HER WAY INTO RECORD BOOKS

Sophomore Kamille Wahlin went 7-15 from three-point range against Penn State Dec. 28, which set one school record, and tied another.

Wahlin's 15 three-point attempts set a school record for long distance shots attempted in a single game. Her seven made treys also tied Lindsey Meder's school record, set against Wisconsin Dec. 31, 2000.

THREE HAWKEYES OUT FOR SEASON

Senior JoAnn Hamlin, sophomore Hannah Draxten and freshman Theairra Taylor will all miss the season with injuries.

Hamlin has missed the entire season after having a blood clot removed in her right leg. Taylor suffered a torn ACL in Iowa's win over South Dakota State. Draxten has played four games this season, despite suffering from a herniated disc. It was announced after Iowa's loss at Penn State that Draxten will be forced to miss the rest of the season due to the back injury.

ALEXANDER NAMED BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Kachine Alexander was named Ten Player of the Week for the second time this season Feb. 15.

The Minneapolis, MN, native averaged 22.5 points and 11 rebounds in wins at Indiana and at home against Illinois. She shot .579 from the field and .875 from the free throw line. She scored 21 points and grabbed 16 rebounds at Indiana, and followed with 24 points, six rebounds and six assists against Illinois.

Alexander first received the award Nov. 16, after earning MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge. She tied a Hawkeye Challenge tournament record by grabbing 18 rebounds (nine offensive, nine defensive), along with netting 19 points in Iowa's season-opening win over Santa Clara. Both her 19 points and 18 rebounds were game highs.

Alexander followed on Sunday with a 21 point, 12 rebound (nine offensive, three defensive) performance in the championship game against Illinois State. Alexander was clutch down the stretch at the free-throw line, making 13-16 attempts from the charity stripe.

PRINTY EARNS FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

Jaime Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the fourth time this season, Feb. 15.

Printy averaged 22.5 points along with 4.5 rebounds in Iowa's wins at Indiana and over Illinois. She scored a career-high 28 points at Indiana, and netted 17 points vs. Illinois.

Printy led the Hawkeyes to back-to-back conference wins, as Iowa defeated Illinois in Champaign, and knocked off Northwestern in Iowa City. The Marion, IA, native averaged 22.5 points on the week, and shot a blistering .522 (12-23) from the field, including .400 (4-10) from three-point range and .850 (17-20) from the charity stripe. Printy led Iowa with 22 points at Illinois, including 8-8 from the free throw line, which set career highs in both makes and attempts. She also added four rebounds, four assists and two steals. Against Northwestern, Printy led the Hawkeyes with 23 points on 6-10 shooting, and played 38 minutes in the win.

Hawkeyes Ink Talented Recruit

Jade Rogers has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa next fall.

"We are eager to have Jade Rogers join our team," Bluder said. "Jade is a tremendous kid that loves the game, and has grown up as a Hawkeye fan. Jade will be a versatile player that can play a number of positions. She can post up or she can shoot the long ball. She is also a good rebounder. Jade has had a great career at Cedar Rapids Kennedy, and is looking forward to continuing her career as a Hawkeye."

Rogers, a 5-11 forward, is from nearby Hiawatha, IA, and attends Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School. She led the state in scoring (22.3) and rebounding (13.4) as a sophomore, and was named the Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year. She also earned first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference honors.

Rogers suffered an ACL injury during the summer of the 2008, but returned to the court and helped lead Kennedy to the semifinal round of the state tournament. Rogers played in 17 games as a junior and averaged 17.9 points and 10.6 rebounds. She was named first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference, along with being named to the state tournament all-tournament team.

As a freshman, Rogers earned second team all-state honors, along with first team all-district, all-metro and all-conference recognition.

Rogers currently has 1,089 points (18.5 per game average), which is fourth on the all-time scoring list at Kennedy. She also holds school records for single-game rebounds (20), single-season rebounds per game (12.6) and is on pace to become Kennedy's career rebounding leader. Rogers is also a three-time team captain.

Rogers has also lettered in volleyball. She helped lead the Kennedy volleyball team to a state tournament appearance this year.

Printy first earned the award Nov. 30, after a stellar performance against William & Mary, and an impressive two-game stretch at the Nugget Classic in Reno, NV. Her second accolade came Jan. 4, after the Hawkeyes defeated Wisconsin and dropped a tough overtime game at Minnesota. Her third honor came Jan. 25 after wins over Illinois and Northwestern.

JOHNSON EARNS FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

Morgan Johnson was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week (Feb. 1) for her efforts in Iowa's win against Purdue.

Johnson led Iowa against the Boilermakers with her third career double-double. The Platte City, MO, native netted 16 points and 11 rebounds, and finished 7-8 from the field. She made her first seven shots of the game before missing her final attempt at the 2:10 mark in the second half. Johnson added two blocks in 24 minutes of action.

HAWKEYES RACKING UP THE HONORS

Freshman Jaime Printy has now been named Big Ten Freshman of the Week a conference-leading four times this season. As a team, the Hawkeyes have collected seven weekly honors this season, second only to Ohio State's eight awards.
