



## RUNNING BACK SHONN GREENE

University of Iowa

5-11, 235 pounds, Junior, Sicklerville, NJ

-  The first student-athlete from a FBS school to rush for over 100 yards the first seven games of the 2008 season.
-  Greene is the first Iowa player to ever rush for over 100 yards the first seven games of a season.
-  Shonn has netted 937 yards on 152 attempts (6.2 avg), which is the second-highest total by an Iowa running back, in the first seven games of a season, since 1997 (Tavian Banks, 1,125 yds).
-  He ranks second in the Big Ten and sixth nationally in rushing yards per game (133.9).
-  Ranks first in rushing yards per Big Ten game (143.7).
-  Ranks 35th in the country in all-purpose yards (136.7).
-  Greene rushed nine times for 101 yards and a score in the first quarter vs. FIU (Sept. 6). It marked the first time an Iowa running back totaled over 100 yards rushing in a quarter since Fred Russell (108 yards) in 2002.
