HAWKEYES FALL TO GOPHERS IN OT

lowa suffered a heartbreaking 1-0 loss to Minnesota last Sunday at the lowa Soccer Complex. The Hawkeyes managed to outshoot Minnesota 13-7 and gained seven corners in the match, but couldn't find the back of the net in 91 minutes of play.

Minnesota netted the game-winner in the first minute of overtime off a corner. The ball was sent to the back post where Renee de St. Aubin headed the ball across the box. Sara Clancy was there to fire the ball into the back of the net for the win.

The Hawkeyes had a few chances off set pieces in the first half, including a free kick by sophomore **Kelly Warner**. After one of Minnesota's 23 fouls, Warner took a free kick from 20 yards out. The ball curved toward the upper corner of the goal, but the Gopher goalkeeper made a jumping stop to deny the goal.

Ohio State defeated Iowa, 2-0 last Friday at the Iowa Soccer Complex. The Hawkeyes couldn't catch a break as three solid scoring chances didn't front for the Hawkeyes. equal goals.

Hyink and junior Kelsie Full saw shots miss just wide in the second half. Hyink also had a shot off a corner that was cleared by the Ohio State defense before it could roll into the back of the net.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN

The Michigan Wolverines are 5-5-4 overall and 1-2-2 in Big Ten play.

Judy Coffman and Melissa Dobbyn lead the Wolverine offense with 10 points. Coffman has four goals and two assists while Dobbyn has three goals and four assists

Megan Tuura has started 11 games in goal for Michigan. leads the Big Ten with a 0.44 goalsagainst average and has 33 saves.

The Wolverines are coached by Debbie Rademacher. Iowa has never defeated Michigan (0-10-0 all time).

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE

The Michigan State Spartans are 5-7-1 overall and 1-4-0 in Big Ten play.

Lauren Hill leads the Spartan offense with 16 points (seven goals, two assists). Lauren Sinacola has four goals while Mauren Pawlak and Kristi Timar each have four assists.

Nicole Galas has played the entire season in net and has a 1.36 goals-against average with 53 saves.

Sophomore Stephanie Hyink and junior Kelsie Full are proving to be a pretty good combination up

SEASON OF IMPROVEMENT

The Hawkeyes have made quite a few improvements during the 2006 season.

- Five wins are the most since 2002 season.
- Four shutouts are the most since 2002 season.
- Two-consecutive shutouts are the most since 2002 season.
- Four-match unbeaten streak in 2006 is second-longest in school history.
- The Hawkeyes collected their first win over a BCS school out of the Big Ten since 2003 (1-0 win vs. South Carolina).
- First win over Iowa State since 2002.
