THE COURSE -- Competition will be played at Cabarrus Country Club. The 7,116-yard course is a par 72.

PREVIOUS COMPETITION -- In 2005, Charlotte won the 49er Collegiate Classic with a score of 884. Charlotte's Ray Sheedy carded a 212 to take first place. Iowa did not compete in the event in 2005.

LAST TIME OUT -- The Hawkeyes tied for third at the Big Four Championships in Cedar Rapids. Iowa State won the event, carding a 568. Drake followed with a 571 and Iowa tied with Northern Iowa at 574. Junior Dan Holterhaus compiled a score of 138 in 36 holes to finish second. Senior Jon Feldick carded a 146 and tied for 10th.
