#### **BUCKNELL UNIVERSITY BISON**

Head Coach Dan Wirnsberger is 34-31-2 in five years at Bucknell, and 60-53-2 in seven years as a collegiate head coach. He is assisted by Dave Hoffman and Donny Ooton. Hawkeye Head Coach **Tom Brands** coached Hoffman and Ooton at Virginia Tech.

Bucknell is led by returning all-American Andy Rendos (165), and five other NCAA qualifiers in seniors David Marble (133), and Shane Riccio (174), juniors Kevin LeValley (149) and David Thompson (184), and sophomore Derek Reber (125).

## **HEAD COACH TOM BRANDS**



Two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Tom Brands, is in his fourth season as head wrestling coach at Iowa. A 1996 Olympic gold medalist and member of wrestling's Hall of Fame, Brands is only the eighth wrestling coach at Iowa. The former Hawkeye wrestler was a four-time all-American and three-time national champion (1989-92) at Iowa. He has a 64-6 overall and 26-3 Big Ten coaching record at Iowa, and a 81-26 career mark.

In his third season with the Hawkeyes, Brands led Iowa to its second straight NCAA and Big Ten team titles, crowning five all-Americans and two Big Ten champions. The 2009 national title was the school's 22nd, and it was only the second time in school history Iowa won the NCAA title without an individual champion. Brands earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors after guiding Iowa to the school's 33rd conference team title. The Hawkeyes ended the 2008-09 season with a 24-0 record, going undefeated for the first time since 1999-2000. The Hawkeyes, who ended the season on a 38-dual match winning streak that dates back to the 2007-08 campaign, clinched the 2009 Big Ten regular season title with a perfect 8-0 mark in conference competition and won the 2008 Midlands team title.

Brands served as head coach at Virginia Tech University for two seasons (2005-06), recording a 17-20 dual mark. Prior to taking the helm at Virginia Tech, Brands was an assistant coach at lowa for 12 seasons (1993-2004). He helped the Hawkeyes to a 177-27 dual record, seven NCAA and eight Big Ten titles, while crowning 23 NCAA champions, 73 all-Americans and 36 Big Ten champions. He was named the National Wrestling Coaches Association Assistant Coach of the Year in 2000.

As a competitor, Brands won the 1996 Olympic freestyle gold medal at 136.5 pounds in Atlanta, GA. He also won a gold medal at the 1993 World Freestyle Championships in Toronto, two World Cup gold medals (1994, 1995) and was the 1995 Pan American Games champion. He won four U.S. National titles (1993-96) and made four straight U.S. World or Olympic teams (1993-96). Along with his twin brother, Terry, Tom was named 1993 USA Wrestling Athlete of the Year, the 1993 John Smith Outstanding Freestyle Wrestler and 1993 Amateur Wrestling News Man of the Year. He was inducted into wrestling's Hall of Fame in 2001.

Brands was a four-time all-American at Iowa (1989-92). During his Hawkeye career, he won three NCAA titles and was named Outstanding Wrestler of the 1992 NCAA Championships. Also a three time Big Ten champion, Brands won 95 percent of his matches at Iowa. His career mark of 158-7-2, included an undefeated season in 1991 (45-0).

Rugters is 3-1 with wins over Sacred Heart twice (43-0 and 42-6) and Northern Iowa (25-10) and a loss to Penn State (17-18). Head Coach Scott Goodale is 34-16 in three years at Rutgers. He is assisted by Lehigh alums John Leonardis and Cory Cooperman.

The Scarlet Knights return NCAA qualifiers Dominick Russo (Hwt.) and Scott Winston (157) from the 2008-09 team that went 20-8 overall and 8-1 in the ElWA. Senior Lamar Brown (197), junior Bill Ashnault and redshirt freshman Joe Langel have also made individual appearances in national rankings this season.

#### **THE SERIES**

Iowa leads the series with Bucknell, 1-0, winning the only meeting (40-3) last season in Iowa City. This will be the first meeting with Rutgers.

### LAST MEETING - HAWKEYES POUND BUCKNELL, 40-3

Hawkeye Head Coach Tom Brands collected his 70th career victory Jan. 30 as his top-ranked lowa wrestlers defeated Bucknell, 40-3, in front of 5,525 fans in Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The top-ranked Hawkeyes improved to 18-0 on the season with the win, while Bucknell fell to 8-8.

The Hawkeyes jumped out to a 23-0 lead with wins at the first six weights. Hawkeye senior **Charlie Falck** opened the dual at 125 with a 9-3 decision over Derek Reber. Iowa junior **Daniel Dennis** followed a 14-4 major decision over David Marble. Hawkeye senior **Alex Tsirtsis** showed no ill effects after having a wisdom tooth removed earlier in the week, sticking Adam Healey in 1:22 at 141. Iowa junior 149-pounder **Brent Metcalf** posted his 55th straight win with a 4:20 pin over Kevin LeValley. Hawkeye sophomore **Matt Ballweg** posted an 8-0 win over Tyler Riccio at 157. Iowa junior **Ryan Morningstar** posted his a 2-1 win over Andy Rendos at 165.

Bucknell won its only match of the dual at 174. Iowa sophomore **Colby Covington** was wrestling for injured Hawkeye starter **Jay Borschel**. Covington lost a 7-2 decision to Bucknell's Shane Riccio. Hawkeye junior **Phillip Keddy** won a 14-0 major decision over David Thompson at 184. Iowa junior **Chad Beatty** scored 13 takedowns to post a 26-11 technical fall in 6:20 over Rob Waltko at 197. Iowa junior **Dan Erekson** closed out the dual by accepting a forfeit at heavyweight.

#### HAVEN'T WE MET?

Hawkeye senior **Brent Metcalf** is the only lowa wrestler to face a Bucknell wrestler outside of last season's dual. He pinned junior Kevin LeValley in 6:01 in the first round of the 2009 NCAA Championships. There have been no previous meetings between lowa and Rutgers wrestlers.

#### **HAWKEYES GO 5-0 AT IOWA CITY DUALS**

Iowa opened the 2009-10 dual meet season Nov. 20, going 5-0 at the Iowa City Duals. A crowd of 5,468 fans attended the event at Carver-Hawkeye Arena. The Hawkeyes posted a 49-1 record on the day beating Coe College (39-3), Cornell College (57-0), Iowa Lakes Community College (52-0), University of North Carolina Pembroke (47-0) and Southern Illinois Edwardsville (51-0).

The five victories extended Iowa's dual match winning streak to 43, which breaks the school record of 42 (1994-97). The Hawkeyes recorded 25 pins, nine technical falls, seven major decisions and eight decisions on the day. Iowa also tallied 139 takedowns, while giving up none.

Hawkeye seniors **Brent Metcalf** (149) and **Jay Borschel** (174) led lowa, pinning all five of their lowa City Duals opponents. Borschel pinned each of his foes in the first period, including one in 13 seconds which is the fastest on the team this season. His combined pin time total was 8:28, while Metcalf's was 16:14. Seniors **Daniel Dennis** (133) and **Dan LeClere** (141), and redshirt freshman **Matt McDonough** (125) each scored team bonus points in all five of their victories. Senior **Phillip Keddy** (184) scored two pins, two technical falls and a decision; senior **Ryan Morningstar** (165) recorded two pins, one technical fall, one major decision and one decision; while senior **Chad Beatty** (197) scored one pin, one technical falls, one major decision and two decisions on the day. Sophomore **Jordan Johnson** (Hwt.) recorded three pins and two decisions, while junior **Jake Kerr** (157) scored two pins and two decisions.

#### **DENNIS WINS AT NWCA ALL-STAR CLASSIC**

Hawkeye senior **Daniel Dennis** scored two takedowns in the third period to beat Maryland's Steve Bell, 9-8, in the 133-pound match at the 44th annual NWCA All-Star Classic Nov. 22 in Fullteron, CA. A standing room only crowd of 4,000 filled Cal State Fullerton's Titan Gymnasium for the event.

#### **BALLWEG, MARION WIN TITLES AT KAUFMAN-BRAND OPEN**

University of Iowa junior **Matt Ballweg** (157) and sophomore **Montell Marion** (141) each won titles at the 2009 Ryan Kaufman-Glen Brand Open Nov. 21 in Omaha, NE. A total of 18 Hawkeye wrestlers competed at the tournament and 14 finished in the top five of their respective weight classes. The Kaufman-Brand Open, which is annually hosted by the University of Nebraska-Omaha, is one of the largest single-day collegiate events in the nation.

**Matt Ballweg** won the 157-pound title in the elite division, scoring a 7-2 win over lowa State's Andrew Sorenson in the finals. Ballweg scored a pin, two major decisions and two decisions on the day. His closest match was a 3-2 quarterfinal win over Hawkeye freshman **Derek St. John**, who placed third.

Marion, who was competing unattached, won the 141-pound title in the elite division. He won all four bouts by decision, including a 7-2 win over Nebraska-Omaha's Mario Morgan in the finals.

The Hawkeyes had a total of six finalists in the elite division, with junior **Tyler Clark** (133) and sophomores **J.J. Krutsinger** (125), **Vinnie Wagner** (184) and **Blake Rasing** (Hwt.) all placing second at their respective weights.

lowa had the most placewinners at 133 pounds as redshirt freshmen **Nate Moore** and **Mark Ballweg** placed third and fourth, respectively, in the elite division. Moore scored a 3-2 victory over Ballweg in the third-place match. Freshman **Nick Trizzino** (133) also placed fourth in the amateur division. Placing fourth for lowa in the elite division were junior **Luke Lofthouse** (197) and freshman **Ethen Lofthouse** (174). Redshirt freshman **Grant Gambrall** placed fifth at 184 in the elite division, while freshman **Joe DuCharme** placed fifth at 165 in the amateur bracket.

#### **HAWKEYES LOOK TO EXTEND STREAKS**

lowa set a new school record for consecutive victories (43) with its five wins at the lowa City duals last week. The previous record of 42 spanned the 1994-97 seasons. The Hawkeyes have also won their last 29 duals away from lowa City, which ranks second in school history. The school record for consecutive road wins is 31 (1994-97).

#### **IOWA WRESTLING HISTORY**

lowa's overall dual meet record is 859-215-30 (.792) in 100 seasons. The Hawkeyes have won 22 national titles and 33 Big Ten titles. Iowa's 49 NCAA champions have won a total of 57 NCAA individual titles, crowning six three-time and 14 two-time champions. The Hawkeyes' 101 Big Ten champions have won a total of 184 conference titles. There have been seven four-time, 18 three-time and 26 two-time lowa winners. Iowa's 138 all-Americans have earned all-America status 278 times, including 17 four-time, 27 three-time and 35 two-time honorees.
