

THIS WEEK -- The Hawkeye men and women's track teams will send athletes who meet the qualifying standards to the 2006 NCAA Midwest Regional, Friday-Saturday in Austin, TX. All events will be held at Mike A. Myers Stadium on the University of Texas campus. Single day tickets are \$10 for adults and \$7 for youth. Tickets can be ordered from the University of Texas Athletic ticket office at 800/982-2386 or www.texasports.com.

The Midwest region will feature 39 schools from Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas and Wyoming. The top five finishers in each individual event and the top three relays from each of the four regionals will automatically advance to the NCAA Championships, to be held June 7-10 in Sacramento, CA. The other three regions are the West (40 men's teams, 42 women's teams), the Mideast (78 men's teams, 81 women's teams) and the East (110 men's teams, 112 women's teams).

WOMEN'S NCAA REGIONAL QUALIFIERS -- The Hawkeye women's team has qualified nine student-athletes in nine individual events and two relays to the Midwest Regional. Their events, qualifying marks and where they rank in the region and nation are listed below.

HAWKEYE REGIONAL FACTS -- In the four-year history of the NCAA Midwest Regional meet, the Hawkeyes have experienced success. The women's team has sent 60 qualifiers to the meet and crowned 19 all-region selections. The men's team has sent 60 qualifiers and crowned nine all-region honorees. Bill Neumann won Iowa's lone regional title in 2003, when he won the javelin.

Junior **Tiffany Johnson** and sophomore **Kineke Alexander** hold the women's school record for times qualified to the regional meet in a career. Both are seven-time qualifiers - advancing in three events in 2005 and four in 2006. Senior Tim Brodersen shares that distinction with former Hawkeye Brad **Daufeldt** for the men's squad, as both are four-time qualifiers. **Brodersen** is the only Hawkeye student-athlete to have qualified for four regional meets, competing in the discus in 2003-06. Daufeldt qualified in the discus and hammer in 2003-04.

WOMEN'S TEAM MAKES TRACKWIRE 25 -- The Hawkeye women's track team is tied for 18th in the most recent national outdoor rankings released by Trackwire. The list, compiled by Gary Verigin of www.trackwire.com, ranks schools according to a projected hypothetical score for the NCAA outdoor championships, which is generated by a power ranking of the top 12 athletes and relay squads in each NCAA event. Iowa is tied with Texas A&M for 18th in the rankings with 13 points. Texas is first with 65.

<u>HAWKEYES SET RECORDS</u> -- Hawkeye juniors Micah VanDenend, Tiffany Johnson and Peaches Roach, and sophomore Meghan Armstrong have set new school records this outdoor season.

VanDenend broke a 38-year-old 5,000-meter record at the Stanford Invitational, running a collegiate-best 13:55.96 for sixth place in the event. Iowa Head Coach **Larry Wieczorek** set the previous record of 13:56.0 in 1968.

Johnson broke her own 100-meter hurdles and triple jump records. Her collegiate-best 13.53 at the Mt. SAC Relays broke the hurdles record of 13.57 she set in 2005, and she smashed the triple jump mark of 40-9 1/2 she set in 2005 with her collegiate best 41-3 1/4 leap at the Iowa Musco Twilight VIII. **Johnson** now holds school records in the indoor and outdoor triple jump, 60-meter hurdles, 100-meter hurdles and as part of the indoor 1,600-meter relay.

Roach broke the 23-year-old school high jump record of 6-0 set in 1983 by Mary Mol with a collegiate-best 6-0 3/4 at the Mt. SAC Relays. **Roach** holds the school indoor high jump mark, which is also 6-0 3/4.

Armstrong set the school 1,500-meter record with the 4:17.41 she ran at the Big Ten Championships. The previous record of 4:19. 71 was set in 1989 by **Jeanne Kruckeberg**.

2006 BIG TEN OUTDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS REVIEW -- The Iowa men's team placed fourth and the Hawkeye women placed eighth at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships in East Lansing, MI. Despite cold and wet weather, the Hawkeye men recorded their highest team finish since they placing second in 1999. Wisconsin won the men's team title for the third straight year, while the Minnesota women's team won its first conference team title in school history.

The Iowa men were led by Big Ten champions **Tim Brodersen** and Adam **Hamilton**. **Brodersen**, a senior from Vermillion, SD, successfully defended his discus title with a winning throw of 181-2. He became the 17th Hawkeye in school history to win consecutive Big Ten titles in the same event. Brodersen also placed eighth in the hammer throw. **Hamilton**, a junior from Milford, NH, won the first title of the meet when he took the hammer throw title (208-1). He also became Iowa's fourth Big Ten hammer throw champion.

Placing in the top three for the men's team were sophomore **Shane Maier** (2nd - shot put), freshman **David Chaplin** (3rd - 100 meters), freshman **John Hickey** (3rd - shot put) and the 400-meter relay of sophomore **Max Milder**, **Chaplin**, junior **David Pierre** and freshman **Prince Riley**.

The women's team was led by juniors **Tiffany Johnson** and **Peaches Roach** and sophomore **Meghan Armstrong**. **Johnson** placed second in the 100-meter hurdles (13.62), third in the triple jump (40-5) and ran on the 400 and 1,600-meter relays that placed fourth and seventh, respectively. **Roach** placed second in the high jump (58-3/4), fourth in the 200 meters (24.28) and anchored the fourth-place 400-meter relay. **Armstrong** placed second in the 1,500 meters (4:17.41), setting a school record that beat her previous collegiate-best by almost nine seconds.

Sophomore **Kineke Alexander** was withheld from competition during the final day so as not to aggravate a nagging injury in the cold and wet conditions. In the prelims, she posted the second-fastest time in the 200 meters, the fourth fastest clocking in the 400 meters, and ran on the 400 and 1,600-meter relays. The 400-meter relay had the top qualifying time. Had she been able to compete on Sunday, Iowa's team finish could have been as high as fifth.

2005 NCAA MIDWEST REGIONAL REVIEW -- The men and women's teams placed 17th at the 2005 NCAA Midwest Regional in Norman, 0K. The women's team scored 17 team points, while the men scored 15, and both automatically qualified two competitors to the NCAA Championships. Senior **Ken Kemeny** and junior **Tim Brodersen** automatically qualified in the shot put and discus, respectively. Sophomore **Peaches Roach** and freshman **Kineke Alexander** placed second in the high jump and 400 meters, respectively, to earn automatic bids in those events.

University of Iowa Women's Head Coach



James Grant Head Coach 10th Season

James Grant is in his 10th season at the helm of the Iowa women's track and field program. Grant was the former assistant coach at Iowa for 11 years (1986-96).

Grant has coached eight all-Americans, 21 Big Ten champions and 60 NCAA Midwest Regional qualifier during his tenure as head

coach. Iowa placed third at the 2004 Big Ten Indoor Championships in Iowa City and sixth at the 2003 conference outdoor meet - the team's highest placings under Grant. The third-place indoor finish tied the team's highest conference finish in school history.

During the 2006 indoor season, sophomore Kineke Alexander became Grant's first NCAA Champion, and the third in school history, when she won the 400 meters at the national meet. Junior Peaches Roach and Meghan Armstrong also earned all-America honors. Alexander won the 200 and 400 meters at the Big Ten Championships, setting the 400-meter meet record.

In 2005, Roach and Alexander became Grant's first indoor all-Americans. Roach defended her Big Ten indoor high jump title to become the second Hawkeye to win two consecutive Big Ten titles in the same event in school history.

In 2004, Shellene Williams became the second student-athlete in program history to win four Big Ten titles, winning three titles in the 400 meters and one as part of the 1,600-meter relay. Roach gave Iowa its first Big Ten high jump titles, winning that event at the indoor and outdoor conference meets to earn outdoor Freshman of the Year honors.

In 2003, the 1,600-meter relay of Aisha Hume, Nicole Charles, Sarah Steffen and Williams shattered the 15-year-old school record of 3:41.23 with the blistering 3:36.26 they ran at the NCAA Midwest Regional. The quartet also won Iowa's first Big Ten title in that event. Aisha James wowed the Drake Relays crowd when she set school, meet, stadium and Trinidad and Tobago records in the long jump with a then-world leading mark of 22-3 (6.78 m). James became the first Big Ten long jump champion in school history and the first Hawkeye field event champion since 1993 with her victory at the conference meet. Alana Redfern qualified for the NCAA Championships for the second straight year when she broke her own school javelin record by almost 20 feet and set the Canadian National record in that event. James and Redfern became Iowa's first Drake Relays champions in the long jump and javelin, respectively.

While improving in the league standings in considered a priority, Iowa's track and field team also concerns itself with performance in the classroom. During Grant's tenure, 44 Hawkeyes have earned 76 academic all-Big Ten honors.

As Iowa's assistant coach from 1986-96, Grant coached several Hawkeyes to success. In 1995, Yolanda Hobbs was an all-American in the 55 and 200 meters after winning the 55-meter Big Ten title. In 1994, Iowa's 400 meter-relay of Tina Floyd, Hobbs, Marlene Poole and Tanja Reid won Iowa's first Big Ten title in that event, earned all-America honors and set meet and school records. Karen Layne won the 1990 600-meter Big Ten title, while Senta Hawkins won the Big Ten 400 meters in 1988. In 1989, Iowa's 1,600-meter relay placed second at the Big Ten Indoor and Outdoor Championships.

A former Jamaican track standout, Grant coached at the high school level in Jamaica for 11 years prior to joining the Hawkeye program. From 1982-86, Grant coached men's and women's track at G.C. Foster College of Physical Education and Sport. There he led the men's team to two national titles and two second-place finishes, and the women's team to three national titles.

A graduate of Eastern Michigan University, Grant captained the 1970 and 1971 Huron track teams, earning all-America honors while specializing in the 400 meters, 400-meter hurdles, and the mile relay. He was the Jamaican 400-meter hurdle national record holder, with a time that was ranked in the top-20 in the world. Grant also represented Jamaica at the Pan American Games and the Commonwealth Games for six years. In 1991, he was inducted into the Eastern Michigan Hall of Fame.

He was the 1965 and 1966 Jamaican national champion in both the 200 and 400-meters as a high school athlete at Jamaica's Kingston College.

Grant received his bachelor's degree in sociology and history from Eastern Michigan, and his master's degree in physical education from the German College of Physical Education in Leipzig, Germany.

University of Iowa Men's Head Coach



Larry Wieczorek Head Coach 10th Season

Larry Wieczorek is in his 10th season as head men's track and field coach at Iowa. He recently completed his 19th season as head men's cross country coach for the Hawkeyes. He served as an assistant track coach for 12 years before taking the helm in 1997.

A six-time Big Ten champion (including two in cross country) and four-time all-American at Iowa, Wieczorek once held conference marks in the one, two, three, four and five-mile runs. A member of Iowa's last Big Ten track championship team in 1967, he still owns Iowa record in the indoor two miles, as well as third-fastest mark in the cross country 8,000 meters. Hawkeye junior Micah VanDenend broke Wieczorek's 38-year-old 5,000-meter school record earlier this month. Wieczorek was honored for his collegiate accomplishments by being inducted into the University of Iowa's National Varsity Club Athletics Hall of Fame in 1998.

Wieczorek returned to his alma mater as a field event coach in 1985 before taking the helm of the cross country program in 1987. He has since shifted his track responsibilities to the distance corps.

Under Wieczorek, the cross country team has placed sixth or higher nine times at the NCAA Regional Championships, has posted 27 all-region selections and qualified for the NCAA Championships four times. In 2002, Wieczorek was named Midwest Region Coach of the Year honors by the United States Cross Country Association after the Hawkeyes won the NCAA Regional for the first time in school history. In 2004, the Hawkeyes recorded their highest placings under Wieczorek at the Big Ten (3rd) and NCAA Championships (13th).

Since he was named head men's track and field coach in 1997, Wieczorek has coached NCAA Champion long jumper Bashir Yamini, 23 all-Americans, 82 national qualifiers, 60 NCAA Midwest Regional qualifiers and 39 Big Ten Champions. Iowa's 1,600-meter relay won the 1999 Big Ten outdoor title and earned all-America honors twice during Wieczorek's tenure. The Hawkeyes recorded their highest conference indoor placing (fourth) in 1997, and their highest team finish at the Big Ten outdoor meet (second) in 33 years in 1999.

In 2006, sophomore Matty Gorman won the Big Ten indoor long jump title. Five Hawkeyes acheived NCAA provisional qualifying marks. Junior Micah VanDenend set the school 3,000-meter record, while sophomore Ryan Niver set the school heptathlon mark. During the outdoor season, Iowa recorded its highest Big Ten placing since 1999 with its fourth-place finish at the

conference meet. Senior Tim Brodersen sucessfully defended his Big Ten discus title, becoming the 17th Hawkeye in school history to win back-to-back conference titles in the same event. Hamilton was Iowa's other conference champion, taking home the hammer throw title. VanDenend also broke Wieczorek's 38-year-old 5,000-meter record of 13:56.0, running a 13:55.96 early in the season.

Another of Wieczorek's goals as head coach was to create an annual outdoor home event for the Hawkeyes that would be entertaining for the community and feature outstanding competition for participating student-athletes. Now in it's eighth year of existence, the annual Iowa Musco Twilight Meet is just that. Named for Musco Lighting of Oskaloosa, IA, who supplies mobile lighting equipment, the co-ed meet which featured 12 teams in 2006, starts in the late afternoon and extends into the night. In its first four years, the meet had produced 43 NCAA provisional qualifiers. Since the creation of the regional qualifying system in 2003, 187 competitors have reached qualifying standards at the twilight meet.

While improving in the league standings is a priority, the Hawkeyes also concern themselves with performance in the classroom. Under Wieczorek, former cross country runners Kevin Herd, Chad Schwitters and Stetson Steele earned academic all-America honors. Iowa has had an academic all-Big Ten selection each year during his tenure, totaling 57 honorees in cross country and 101 in track and field.

Wieczorek came to Iowa after 11 seasons as head track coach at Proviso (IL) West High School. He also served as an assistant at Proviso West for three years. His prep teams were consistent placers on the state level and several of his athletes won state titles. He served on the Illinois track advisory board and founded the prestigious Proviso Indoor Track Classic. Wieczorek was inducted into the Illinois High School Track and Cross Country Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000.

Wieczorek was born on September 11, 1946, in Chicago, IL. He received his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1969 and his M.S. degree in physical education from Northern Illinois University in 1973. His wife's name is Jackie.






