## <u>IOWA BASEBALL</u> HAWKEYES TAKE GAME ONE AGAINST INDIANA, 3-2

**BLOOMINGTON, IN** - The University of Iowa baseball team defeated the Indiana University Hoosiers, 3-2, Friday afternoon in Bloomington, IN. Iowa ups its record to 19-25 (8-13 in the Big Ten), while Indiana falls to 17-26 (7-14).

The Hoosiers jumped out to an early 1-0 lead in the bottom on an RBI single from Jay Brant. Iowa starter **Luke O'Loughlin** settled in after that, keeping Indiana off the board until the seventh. The senior righthander scattered seven hits over six 2/3 innings.

Iowa tied the game at 1-1 in the top of the fourth when hot-hitting **Brian Burmester** brought **Travis Sweet** home with an infield single.

Indiana came back with a run in the seventh on an RBI single from Keith Haas, but the Hawkeyes came right back in the top of the eighth, tying things up when **Kevin Hoef** scored on a costly Hoosier error.

Iowa took the lead in the top of the ninth when **Ben Geelan** delivered a bases-loaded sacrifice fly.

All-Big Ten closer **Tim Gudex** sent the Hoosiers packing with a 1-2-3 ninth inning, picking up his seventh save of the year.

**Kevin Sunderman** picked up the win in relief, sitting down all four batters he faced before giving way to Gudex.

Iowa and Indiana will return to the field tomorrow with a doubleheader beginning at noon (CDT).
