THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa men's tennis team will have two home matches in three days, facing Arkansas on Friday at 2 p.m. (CT) and DePaul on Sunday at 1 p.m. (CT). Both matches will be inside the Hawkeye Tennis and Recreation Complex as Iowa is making its home debut.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

Arkansas started the season with three straight victories, while No. 66 DePaul has lost two straight matches since starting 4-0. Arkansas has one ranked singles player in No. 109 Manfred Jeske. lowa fell to both the Razorbacks and the Blue Demons on the road last season.

LAST TIME OUT

The Hawkeyes went 1-2 at the Tribe Kickoff Tournament, defeating George Washington 4-2 to conclude the tournament. lowa took three-of-five singles matches against the Colonials and swept doubles. lowa's first match of the tournament resulted in a 4-3 loss to William & Mary. lowa split matches with the Tribe, each winning four a piece. lowa then fell by the same score to Dartmouth, winning two doubles matches and two singles matches.

DIERCKX ON A ROLL

Sophomore Jonas Dierckx opened the season perfect at the Tribe Kickoff Tournament, going 3-0 in singles and 2-0 in doubles. Dierckx picked up a marquee victory against Dartmouth's nationally-ranked Cameron Ghorbani (6-1, 2-6, 6-4). All three of Dierckx's singles wins came in three sets. Diercks went 2-0 with freshman Matt Hagan at the No. 3 doubles position. Dierckx has won seven of his last eight singles matches and six straight doubles matches dating back to the fall season.

DOUBLES DOMINATION

The Hawkeyes have claimed the doubles point in all three matches this season. Junior Garret Dunn and sophomore Michael Swank went 2-0 in No. 1 doubles to lead lowa. Swank was making his dual varsity debut. Dierckx and Hagan also went 2-0 in the No. 3 position. In No. 2 doubles, seniors Tom Mroziewicz and Will Vasos provided lowa with one victory. lowa is 5-1 on the season in doubles.

HEAD COACH STEVE HOUGHTON

Steve Houghton, the dean of Big Ten tennis coaches, is in his 31st year as head coach of the Hawkeyes. He has compiled a career record of 332-343 (.493), recording the most wins of any coach in lowa men's tennis history. Houghton recorded his 300th win at Indiana State Feb. 6, 2009. He became the winningest coach in lowa tennis history in 1992 and is a member of the lowa Tennis Hall of Fame. While playing at lowa, Houghton had a career winning percentage of .727 (40-15), second best in lowa history.
