### ILLINI, CRAIG VIRGIN TAKE ILLINOIS INTERCOLLEGIATE TITLES IN BIG TEN WARM-UP

NORMAL, Ill.--Craig Virgin and the University of Illinois took the individual and team titles Saturday in the Illinois Intercollegiate Cross Country Meet on the Illinois State University golf course in Normal.

Virgin set an automatic record of 23:49, since the five-mile course was being run for the first time. He was followed closely by teammate Mike Durkin, who took second in 24:04.

In the team standings, the Illini scored 53 points, just edging Eastern Illinois with 55. Southern Illinois-Carbondale was third at 99, Western Illinois fourth with 126 and Illinois State fifth with 134 in the 11-team meet.

After taking the top two individual places, the Illini placed Mike Bridges in 13th (24:55); Rich Brooks in 18th (25:08), Dave Brooks in 19th (25:12); Mike Meier in 25th (25:20), and Bill Allen in 35th (25:44).

"Coach Blackman's teams have been winning games with field goals, so we won our meet with a safety of sorts," Illini coach Gary Wieneke said. "Eastern was really fired up, since their coach Pat O'Brien is retiring after this year and they wanted to give him a send-off.

"Everything in a two-point meet is deciding, but the one biggest thing was the kick by Rich and Dave Brooks. Both of them passed Eastern's fifth man, along with some other runners, in the last half mile. That real strong finish pushed their scoring back just enough to make the difference."

Other than that important spot, Wieneke pointed to Durkin's performance as a key factor.

"Durk stayed right with him through four miles," Wieneke said. "They went through the mile marks with the same times--4:40, 9:27, 14:32--until the fourth when Craig had a 19:19 and Mike was at 19:21. Virgin finally pulled away from him then."

With the Big Ten Championships coming up next Saturday at Illinois, the Illini may not have been as emotionally high as some of the other squads. But all in all, Wieneke was pleased with their performance.

"It was rainy and cold, so the conditions weren't too good," he said. "But the split between our first man and seventh was only 1:55 and between our last five men was only 49 seconds. So that's pretty good grouping."

The Illini, 5-1-1 in the dual season and with a championship in their first tournament, now host the Big Ten Championships Saturday. The meet will begin at 10:30 a.m. at the university golf course in Savoy, next to Willard Airport.

"We've arranged with the C-U Mass Transit District to have a special bus line out to the meet and back from campus," Wieneke said. "We should be right in the middle of a good fight for both the team and individual title, so we expect a good crowd out there. It would certainly be a big help for our squad."

FRANK LAUTERBUR:

"It was by far our worst effort of the year. We just didn't deserve to win the way we played.
