Post game comments by Nebraska Coach Tom Osborne:

"We are pleased that we were able to win this game. We didn't play well offensively, but we did a good job on defense, except for a few breakdowns."

"I think they (Iowa) have some good players. I think Hayden Fry has done a good ~~job~~ job and frankly, I think Iowa probably did a better job of coaching for this game than we did."

"Iowa just flat played us even, even without those fumbles. We just have to get better. We've got to get a lot better."

"Quinn (Nebraska quarterback, Jeff Quinn) played hurt in practice this past week and then his bad ankle was beginning to hamper him more early in that second half, so we went with Hager (reserve ~~QB~~ Tim Hager). And I think he did a fine job for us. Yes, Hipp (halfback I.M. Hipp) had a pulled muscle and we were forced to go with Johnson (Craig Johnson). We were ~~hoping~~ hoping to red shirt him this year, but we had to go with him and I think he also did a fine job for us."

"I really am not sure what happened on some of those completions for Iowa. They were ~~being~~ hitting on some hooks and those are not really our linebackers' responsibilities."

"I certainly hope those five fumbles are unusual for us. Sure Iowa was hitting hard and that might have caused some. But mostly it was just poor ball handling."

"I think possibly a big difference in the game today was that our players have won quite a few ball games and even when we were down 21-7, they still had confidence. It might have been just the opposite for the Iowa players."

"I think Iowa is just a real good team. No, they aren't going to win the Big Ten probably, but they are going to beat some teams. They are a team that's going to be in every game and win some too. But they are going to have to win soon. Coming close is alright for a while but it's just not winning."

Post game comments by Iowa Coach Hayden Fry:

"The defense played with great courage. There's no question about it. We played one of the greatest offensive machines in the country."

"We only had one bad kick today. Reggie Roby, for a freshman, did a whale of a job."

"The two interceptions and the face mask penalty in the fourth quarter kept their drive going."

"Pete Gales was outstanding. It's ironic that on the two interceptions he threw to number two receivers when the number one receivers were wide open."

"Brad Reid usually doesn't drop the ball (as he did on the fumble in the fourth quarter). If he had caught it, we think we could have been in position for Roby to kick a field goal."

"There's no question that we have improved with each game. The third quarter was very pleasant. I don't think we let up at all during the fourth quarter. It was a tough ball game for our people. I think Nebraska thinks they've been in a ball game, too. They have one of the top defenses in the nation, especially for a second string quarterback to do so well against it. For the first time today, we played our kind of defense. We're
