HAWKEYES AND REDBIRDS MEET AGAIN -- The Iowa baseball team will play at Illinois State on Wednesday night at Redbird Field in Normal, IL, beginning at 6 p.m.

JOIN COACH DAHM AT FLANNIGAN'S ONE LAST TIME -- Every Monday night from 6-7 p.m. during the Iowa baseball season Iowa Head Coach Jack Dahm will join KXIC's Brent Balbinot for a call-in show at Flannigan's Bar & Grill for "Hawk Talk with Jack Dahm".

IOWA SPLITS WITH PURDUE -- The Hawkeyes won the first and third games of the four game series with the Boilermakers last weekend at Duane Banks Field.

In the opener, the Hawkeye bats scored runs in six of their eight at-bats and received another solid outing by Nathan Johnson to come away with a 9-2 victory. Johnson pitched his fifth complete game of the Big Ten season, while allowing two runs on seven hits and striking out seven.

On Saturday, Iowa dropped a ten inning affair in the opener. The Hawkeyes jumped out to a two-run lead before Purdue evened the score with home run in the fourth.

The Boilermakers pushed three runs on across the plate in the tenth inning and Iowa scored one run in the bottom of the inning making the final score 6-4.

seven run lead through four innings and won the game 8-3. In the third frame, senior Jim Reid hit a grand slam deep over the left centerfield fence to give the Hawkeyes the spark.

Austin Seward picked up the first win of his career after pitching 5 1/3 innings of four hit ball. Seward had a no-hitter through four innings.

In the series finale, the Boilermakers roughed up Iowa starter Andrew Hansen and got a quality outing by their starter Chris Toneguzzi in the 11-7 win. Hansen lasted only 3 2/3 innings, while allowing six runs on eight hits. Toneguzzi held the Hawkeyes to only one run on four hits to lead his team to the split.

The Hawkeyes scored six runs in the final two innings as they had eight of their 11 hits. Jim Reid led the Hawkeyes at the plate as he went 4-for-5 with four singles and two runs scored.

DAHM GETS 300TH CAREER WIN -- Iowa Head Coach Jack Dahm picked up his 300th career victory in the 8-3 win over Purdue on Saturday at Duane Banks Field. In 11 seasons as a head coach, Dahm has now compiled a 300-309 overall record between Creighton and Iowa.

FAMILY REUNION -- Iowa assistant coach Ryan Brownlee will look to go 2-for-2 against his family this season after Iowa defeated Illinois State earlier this season. Ryan's father, Jim and brother Tim are coaches for the Redbirds. Jim serves as the Illinois State head coach, while Tim serves as an assistant.



Jack Dahm enters his first season as Iowa's head baseball coach and has a 283-276 career record. Prior to coming to Iowa, Dahm spent 10 years as the Head Coach at Creighton University, where he is the school's all-time winningest coach. Dahm also played for four years for the Bluejays under current Chicago Cubs General Manager Jim Hendry.

Assistant Coach **Nick Zumsande** is in his first season as Iowa's pitching coach after collecting 14 years of coaching experience throughout the Midwest. Prior to joining the Hawkeyes, Zumsande served as the pitching coach for Indiana State. Before joining the Sycamores, Zumsande coached for one year at Iowa State University where he helped lead the team to their first Big 12 Tournament appearance in school history.

Assistant Coach **Ryan Brownlee** is in his first season as Iowa's hitting/fielding instructor and recruiting coordinator. Prior to coming to Iowa, Brownlee was the hitting/fielding coach at James Madison University, where he led the Dukes to school records in fielding percentage. Before going to JMU, Brownlee served as an assistant at his alma mater, Evansville.

Volunteer Assistant Coach **Spencer Allen** is in his first season with the Hawkeyes. Allen will coach first base during game days and is responsible for outfield instruction. Allen earned his B.A. in 2001 from Iowa State, where he was a three-year starter at second base.

THE DIFFERENCE MAKERS -- The Hawkeyes are 3-11 in one-run games this season. Iowa lost the first three games of the series against Minnesota all by one run. In addition, the Hawkeyes are 1-4 in extra inning affairs.

THE ONE MAN ROTATION -- Senior Nathan Johnson is leading the Big Ten with a 1.64 ERA in seven starts. The righthander has a 4-1 record and has an incredible 47/9 K/BB ratio in conference play.

Johnson hasn't been relieved for in a game since April 9 against Michigan, a span of five complete games. Of a possible 63 innings in league starts, he has been on the hill for 60 1/3 innings.

On the year, Johnson has a 6-3 record with a 3.01 ERA. He has 69 strikeouts in 89 2/3 innings of work, the most innings in the conference.

"THE GRAND SALAMI" -- Senior Jim Reid belted a pitch deep over the left centerfield fence in the second game of Saturday's doubleheader. The home run was the second of his career and the first grand slam by a Hawkeye this season.

REID TIES RECORD -- Jim Reid tied an Iowa record for the second time in as many weeks with a four-hit effort against Purdue on Sunday. Reid went 4-for-5 in the game with four singles to tie the mark. Last weekend, Luis Andrulonis tied the record for the first time this season with four singles in the series finale at Minnesota.

Reid is tied for the team lead with a .306 batting average and has eight doubles, three triples and 15 RBIs.

LYTLE'S AVERAGE CONTINUES TO CLIMB -- Entering the month of May, Andy Lytle was batting .270. Thus far this month, the junior has caught fire as he is leading the team with a .378 (17-45) mark to be considered Iowa's "Mr. May".

For the season, Lytle is tied for the team lead with a .306 average, while serving as the Iowa lead-off hitter since April 17.

DOUBLE ME UP -- Junior Nate Yoho is leading the team with 55 hits this season including 14 doubles and two home runs. He is tied for third on the team with a .301 average and is leading the team with 35 RBIs. Yoho has a team-best 18 multiple hit games and 11 multi-RBI games.

Yoho is the only Hawkeye to start every game this season, starting all 50 games in right field.

GREMLEY'S STREAK ENDS AT 11 GAMES -- Junior Jeff Gremley had a season long 11-game hitting streak halted Sunday against Purdue. The streak was the longest of the season for an Iowa player, with the previous best being a nine game streak by Jesse Brownell.

A FOLLOW-UP ON THE REDBIRDS -- Illinois State enters the contest with a 19-31 record after splitting the four-game series with Indiana State last week-end.

On April 6, Iowa used a ninth inning rally to come from behind and beat the Redbirds, 11-10. Jeff Gremley hit a triple off the wall and scored the game-winning run on an error to give the Hawkeyes the victory.

Centerfielder Nate Whitney is leading the team with a .340 batting average and has a team-high 14 doubles. Left fielder Jeremy Pickrel has a team high 10 home runs, but he has struck out 68 times in 142 at-bats.

Freshman RHPs Kitt Kopach or Luke Baughman will get the ball for the Redbirds. Kopach is 0-0 with a 9.53 ERA in five appearances, while Baughman is 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA in two appearances (1 start).

The Redbirds are led second-year Head Coach Jim Brownlee.
