THIS WEEK -- The Iowa men's tennis team will travel to Champaign, IL, to compete in the Big Ten Tournament. The Hawkeyes (10-11, 2-8 in the Big Ten), seeded ninth, will face eighth-seeded Michigan State in the first round Thursday at 10 a.m. The winner of the match will face top-seed Illinois, who is ranked fourth in the nation. Competition will take place at the Atkins Tennis Center. Admission is \$5 for adults and \$3 for students.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE -- Michigan State enters the tournament with a 12-12 overall record, going 4-6 in Big Ten competition. Iowa dropped a 6-1 decision to the Spartans April 1 in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes hold a 29-22 lead in the series.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION -- Host Illinois is the top seed and defending Big Ten team champion. The Fighting Illini have won the last nine regular season conference titles, and eight of the last nine conference tournament championships. Second-seed Ohio State won the Big Ten tournament title in 2001, and is ranked 24th in the nation. In the event of inclement weather, starting times are subject to change. Once a team reaches four points, the remaining matches are abandoned. All times are Central.

LAST WEEK -- Iowa split in its final duals of the season, defeating Purdue (4-3) and losing to fourth-ranked Illinois (7-0). Picking up singles wins for Iowa were junior Chaitu Malempati, junior Brett Taylor and freshmen J.P. Ritchie and Bart van Monsjou. Ritchie and van Monsjou also picked up a doubles win against the Boilermakers.

QUOTING HOUGHTON -- "We made a lot of improvement this year, and there is no reason why we can't continue that success in the Big Ten Tournament. Without question, all the Big Ten teams will be tough competition. I think this is as strong as I've seen the conference - top to bottom."

Steve Houghton, the dean of Big Ten coaches, is in his 24th year as head coach of the Hawkeyes. He has compiled a career record of 271-271 (.500).

Houghton had a successful playing career at Iowa, lettering three years and winning the No. 5 singles championship at the Big Ten meet. His career Big Ten singles record was 21-6, and his career winning percentage of .727 (40-15) is the second best in Iowa history.

His best season came in 1984 when Iowa won a school record 21 matches and two Hawkeyes earned all-Big Ten honors. The doubles team of Claes Ramel and Martin Aguirre qualified for nationals in 1989 and Houghton was named NCAA Region IV Coach of the Year. He has coached two Davis Cup players at Iowa. Bryan Crowley won the Rolex Region IV championship in 1995 and was ranked first in regional singles action, before falling to career-hampering injuries.

In 2001, Houghton coached Tyler Cleveland to yet another remarkable season. Cleveland went 19-3 overall and recorded the best record in the Big Ten's No. 1 position at 8-2. Cleveland etched his name in the Big Ten record books as he became the first men's player to receive back-to-back Big Ten Player of the Year honors. He was also honored with the Region IV ITA Farnsworth Senior Player of the Year. Cleveland is considered one of the greatest players in Iowa tennis history.

In 2002, Houghton led the Hawkeyes to a 12-10 record overall and a 4-6 Big Ten record. Iowa was ranked as high as 57th and recorded key wins over Northwestern, Penn State and Nebraska. The Hawkeyes also came close to knocking off No. 15 Ohio State, losing 4-3 after Pete Rose was forced to retire in the game deciding match.

Houghton's players are not only students of the game, but they are also students in the classroom. Thirty-two of Houghton's player have earned 66 academic all-Big Ten awards since the honor began in 1987.

The Hawkeye coach was a member of the 1971 Iowa tennis team that recorded a 3.53 team GPA, the highest of any NCAA team in any sport that year. That team also qualified for the NCAA meet after a third place Big Ten finish. A member of the Iowa Tennis Hall of Fame, Houghton completed his sixth year as a member of the Region IV Ranking Committee. He is also involved with the Iowa City Tennis Association and has worked with the Iowa sports school's tennis program since its inception. He has also served on both the NCAA ranking and selection committees.

An Iowa City native, Houghton was a nationally ranked junior player at City High School. He earned his bachelor's (1971) and master's (1973) degrees from the University of Iowa.

Houghton was born Jan. 9, 1949. Steve and his wife, Leora, have four children: Cari, Jeff, Jon and Scott.

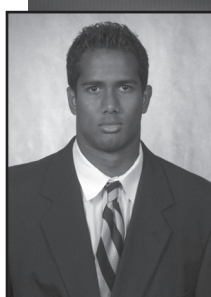
