### **HEAD COACH MARLA LOOPER**



Marla Looper enters her seventh season at the helm of the University of Iowa softball program in 2017. Looper owns a 132-183-1 overall record and a 53-83 mark in Big Ten play since the 2011 season.

Under Looper's guidance in 2016, Kaitlyn Mullarkey collected a team-high nine home runs, which tied for eighth in single-season home runs in program history. Mullarkey currently ranks tied for 15th in program history with 15 career home runs.

In 2015, Looper led the Hawkeyes to their deepest Big Ten Tournament run since 2008. After earning the No. 10 seed with an 8-15 conference record (19-40 overall), the Hawkeyes overcame a three-run deficit against seventh-seeded Rutgers to win the opening round of the tournament on May 7. The Hawkeyes then upset the nationally ranked Gophers with a 2-0 victory to secure lowa's third win over a ranked opponent on the season (No. 17 UCF, No. 4 Michigan). After falling behind early in its semifinal game against third-seeded Nebraska, lowa rallied to come within three runs, but fell short of a comeback as the Huskers notched the 9-6 victory.

Looper collected her 100th career victory in the 2014 season finale. On the season, lowa posted 16 wins -- nine in conference action and three over ranked opponents (16-30-1).

In 2013, Looper's third year with the Hawkeyes, the squad amassed 30 wins (30-24), which was the most wins for the program since a 42-16 record in 2009. lowa posted six wins over ranked opponents.

During her second season with the Hawkeyes in 2012, Looper led the team to a runner-up finish in the Big Ten -- the program's highest finish since winning the league title in 2003. Iowa dropped two of its first three conference series before winning five straight to close out the season. It was the first time the team had won five straight series since the 2004 season.

lowa entered the final weekend with a conference title within reach, but it could not close the gap with Michigan despite taking 2-of-3 games at Minnesota. The Hawkeyes finished with a 27-26 overall record and a 16-8 mark in conference play in 2012. The Hawkeyes finished second in the Big Ten in pitching (2.31 ERA) and third in fielding (.967). The squad turned 26 double plays during the course of the season to rank sixth nationally in double plays per game (.49).

Looper guided the Hawkeyes to a 27-24 overall and a 9-11 Big Ten record in her first season in lowa City in 2011. The first-year head coach led the UI to a pair of six game winning streaks in her opening campaign and a tournament title at the Stetson Classic.

lowa opened Big Ten Conference play strong with an 8-3 record. Among the victories was a 4-2 triumph at No. 1 Michigan. The win, which pushed the overall mark to 26-16, was lowa's first over a No. 1 ranked opponent since the 2005 season and the first over a ranked foe since 2008.

Looper's Hawkeyes were on the verge of completing a series sweep in Ann Arbor before the Wolverines rallied from a 2-0 deficit in the bottom of the seventh inning to claim the victory.

A pair of Hawkeyes earned All-Big Ten recognition at the conclusion of the season. Liz Watkins was tabbed as a second team selection, while Katie Keim earned third team accolades.

Looper took over the reigns of the lowa program after serving as an assistant coach at the University of Texas for 11 seasons (1999-2010). Looper helped lead the Longhorns to three College World Series appearances (2003, 2005 and 2006) and nine NCAA Tournament berths.

### **Abilene Christian**

- Abilene Christian concluded the 2016 season with a 26-21 overall record and a 19-8 record in the Southland Conference.
- Senior Peyton Hedrick is the top returner for the Wildcats. She led the team with 12 home runs and a team-high 41 runs. Overall, she finished with a .331 batting average and a .669 slugging percentage.
- Abilene Christian won 13 of their final 17 games during the 2016 campaign, which included a 2-1 win over Tulsa.
- This will be the first meeting between the Hawkeyes and Abilene Christian.

### Texas A&M - Corpus Christi

- Texas A&M Corpus Christi ended the 2016 season with an 18-30 record and a 7-19 record in the Southland Conference. This season, they return four starters and seven letterwinners.
- Sophomore Candice Hadd is the top returner for the Islanders. She played and started in 47 games and amassed 34 hits, 12 runs and a .248 batting average.
- Last season, Liz Carter amassed 154 strikeouts in 142.1 innings pitched.
- The Islanders lead the series 2-0 after they topped lowa twice last season during the Texas A&M Corpus Christi Tournament.

### **Texas State**

- Texas State finished the 2016 season with a 40-22 overall record, a 15-9 Sun Belt record and a trip to the 2016 NCAA Regionals. This was first time the team made an NCAA Regional appearance since 2012.
- Taylor Webb led Texas State last season with 47 hits and a .311 batting average.
- Randi Rupp led the squad in the circle with a 30-14 record and a 1.66 ERA. Over her 51 appearances, Rupp threw 335 strikeouts.
- lowa holds a 3-1 record over Texas State. The teams last faced each other on March 19, 2014 when the Bobcats grabbed a 4-0 victory in San Marcos, Texas.

### **Texas Tech**

- The Red Raiders held a 23-32 overall record and a 6-12 record in the Big 12 last season.
- Kiani Ramsey led the team with 56 hits and a .348 batting average through 53 games played.
- Mattison Maisel and Dominique Alcocer return for Texas Tech in the circle. Maisel had a 5.07 ERA and a 7-12 record, while Alcocer collected a 6.75 ERA and an 8-13 record.
- The Red Raiders hold a 2-1 series lead over the Hawkeyes. The teams last squared off in 2001 when they split a pair of games. Texas Tech secured a 9-1, five inning win on March 15, but lowa rebounded for a 1-0, eight inning win on March 18.

### In the Rankings - B1G

Two Big Ten Teams are ranked in both the ESPN.com/USA Softball preseason ranking and the USA Today/NFCA Coaches poll, both released on Jan. 31. Michigan leads the conference at No. 6 in both polls, while Minnesota lands at No. 14 in ESPN.com/USA Softball poll and No. 16 in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches poll.

### **A Challenging Schedule**

lowa will take on 12 opponents who reached the 2016 NCAA Regionals, three of which also reached the 2016 Super Regionals. Texas State, Florida, Fresno State, Washington, Arizona State, Cal, Missouri, Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Western Illinois and Northwestern all reached Regionals, while Florida, Washington and Missouri each advanced to the Super Regionals.

### **Attendance Record**

  the team with a .418 on-base percentage. The Park Ridge, Illinois, native had a team-high 13 stolen
  bases on 15 attempts. Defensively, she started every game at first base and led the team with 321
  putouts and chipped in 25 assists.
- After a solid freshman season, sophomore Mallory Killian is poised to help the Hawkeyes during the 2017 season. Kilian split time between third base and designated player last year and amassed 24 hits and 12 runs in 93 at-bats. She also chipped in four doubles and four home runs for a .430 slugging percentage. Defensively, Kilian tallied 15 putouts and 24 assists.
- Angela Schmiederer split time between catcher and outfielder as a sophomore. She amassed 29 hits and 15 runs in 114 at-bats. She also chipped in eight doubles and three home runs for a .404 slugging percentage.

### **New Faces**

- lowa added eight freshmen to its squad for the 2017 season.
- Devin Cantu played three seasons at Cedar Hill High School and was a three-time first team all-district selection. As a junior, Cantu was named Offensive Player of the Year.
- Havyn Monteer played at Boonville R-1 High School in Missouri and holds school records for most at bats (323), runs (144), hits (154), singles (103), and stolen bases (97) in a career.
- Taylor MaKowsky played at Klein Oak High School in Klein, Texas, and was a three-time all-district selection, which included first team honors as a senior.
- Lea Thompson played for Scecina Memorial High School in Indianapolis, Indiana. She was a three-time all-conference selection and earned the team's Offensive Player of the Year award as a sophomore and junior.
- Taylor Libby competed at West High School in Iowa City. She hit .440 as a junior with 16 doubles and four home runs and currently holds the school record for doubles (16) and RBIs (45) in a single season.
- Allison Doocy played at Ankeny High School where she set the lowa State Tournament strikeout record in 2015 with 33 strikeouts in three state tournament games. She holds the school record for strikeouts in a single season (233).
- McKenzie Schneider played at Carroll Senior High School where she batted .397, scored 110 runs, drove

in 103 runs and posted a .460 on-base percentage. She hit .435, blasted seven home runs, notched 40 RBIs, and scored a team-high 50 runs as a senior.

### **Back in Black (and Gold)**

- Megan Blank enters her first season as a volunteer assistant coach. She joins
  the Hawkeyes after two seasons with the Chicago Bandits of the National Pro
  Fastpitch Association and one season as a volunteer assistant at Northwestern.
  Blank, who recently signed for her third season with the Bandits, was one of
  the most decorated softball players in lowa's history.
- Blank, a four-time All-Big Ten first team selection, had a standout career with the Hawkeyes. Blank played and started at shortstop in every game of her collegiate career. She broke or tied five school records and finished in the top 10 in 12 statistical records.

### **Other Staff Additions**

- Daniel Gratz has joined the University of lowa softball staff as the director of operations.
- Gratz joins the Hawkeyes after spending three seasons as head coach at Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School. He also worked as assistant coach this past season for John Wood Community College.
- His accomplishments at Kennedy led Gratz to be named 2016 Conference Coach of the Year (Missouri Valley Conference) and 2016 District Coach of the Year (Iowa 5A — East District).
