THIS WEEK -- The Hawkeye men's and women's track teams will compete at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships, May 14-16 in West Lafayette, IN. All events will be held at Rankin Track and Field on the Purdue University campus. All-session tickets are \$15 for adults and \$9 for seniors, students and youth. Single-session tickets are \$8 for adults and \$5 for seniors, students and youth. Tickets are available at www.purduesports.com or at the athletic ticket office at 800/497-7678.

2003 BIG TEN OUTDOOR REVIEW -- The Iowa women's team won three events en route to a sixth place finish at the 2003 Big Ten Outdoor Championships in Minneapolis, MN. It was the highest placing for a Hawkeye women's track and field team since 1994, when the team tied for fourth. Iowa's 70 points was the most scored by a Hawkeye women's team since the 1992 conference outdoor meet when it scored 75. It was also only the second time in school history, and the first time at the conference outdoor meet, than an Iowa squad won three events at the same Big Ten meet. Their three titles ended a five-year absence from the winner's stand as Iowa's last Big Ten outdoor champion was **Wynsome Cole** in the 400-meter hurdles in 1998.

Winning events for the Hawkeyes and earning first team all-Big Ten honors were junior **Shellene Williams** in the 400 meters, junior **Aisha James** in the long jump and the 1,600-meter relay of senior **Nicole Charles**, sophomore **Aisha Hume**, senior **Sarah Steffen** and **Williams**. **James** became Iowa's first Big Ten long jump champion with her winning leap of 21-4. The 1,600-meter relay also won Iowa's first conference title in that event, shattering a 14-year-old school record with a winning time of 3:39.95. **Williams** became the third student-athlete in program history to win two Big Ten titles at the same meet with her first-place finish in the 400 meters (53.58). Former Hawkeyes **Elaine Jones** (1984) and **Ellen Grant** (1997) also accomplished that feat.

Sophomore **Alana Redfern** and junior **Jessie Strand** each earned second team all-Big Ten honors with their runner-up finishes in the javelin and pole vault, respectively. **Redfern**, who at one time led the nation in the javelin with her collegiate-best and school record-setting throw of 181-5, placed second with a throw of 166-1. **Strand** broke the school pole vault record of 12-6 that she'd set earlier that month with her second-place mark of 12-10.

The men's team placed ninth with 27 points at the conference outdoor meet. Junior **Bill Neumann** led the Hawkeyes by winning his second straight Big Ten javelin title with a throw of 238-2. He is the fourth javelin thrower in school history to win two Big Ten titles in that event, and the first back-to-

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN HISTORY -- The Iowa men's team has won two Big Ten outdoor team championships (1963 and 1967) and 105 event titles since the first meet was held in 1901. Three former Hawkeyes hold a spot in the conference record books. In 1997, Bashir Yamini tied the long jump record of 26-8 1/4 set in 1935 by Ohio State's Jesse Owens, and in 2000 Arno van der Westhuizen set the conference hammer throw record of 218-5. Jon Reimer holds the retired 330-yard hurdles record of 36.1, set in 1965. The Hawkeye men's team has had four student-athletes earn conference individual outdoor track honors. Current Iowa assistant coach Pat McGhee is the lone Hawkeye to earn two awards in the same season, being named Athlete of the Year and Athlete of the Championships in 1989. Other outdoor honorees were Anthuan Maybank (1993 Athlete of the Year), Jeremy Allen (1998 Freshman of the Year) and Tim Dwight (1999 Athlete of the Championships).

The Iowa women's squad has yet to win a Big Ten outdoor team title, but has crowned 25 event champions in 16 individual running events, four field events and two relays since the first meet was held in 1982. Former Hawkeye **Erica Broomfield** is the lone Iowa individual conference honoree, earning Big Ten Outdoor Freshman of the Year accolades in 1998.

LAST WEEK -- The University of Iowa men's and women's track and field teams won a combined total of six events at the annual Iowa Musco Twilight VI Saturday. The Hawkeyes also set two meet records and one Francis X. Cretzmeyer track record at the meet. In all, five meet records and three track records fell on the day, while 50 student-athletes recorded regional qualifying marks.

Minnesota won both the men's and women's team titles, scoring 153.5 and 171.5 points, respectively. The Iowa men's and women's teams both placed third, scoring 106 and 115 points, respectively.

Senior **Shellene Williams** won the 200 meters, setting a meet record of 23.50. She also broke the 21-year-old school record of 23.59 set by Davera Taylor in 1984. Senior **Sarah Arens** also won the 3,000-meter steeplechase with a track and meet record of 10:38.53. The women's 1,600-meter relay of junior **Aishe Hume**, freshmen **Lindsey McCalla** and **Tiffany Johnson** and **Williams** won their race in 3:45.02 in their first time out this season. Other Iowa winners were senior **Michelle Lahann** in the 1,500 meters (4:24.18), senior **Brad Daufeldt** in the ham-

Unattached competitor and Iowa City native Joey Woody ran fastest time in the United States to date this year, setting a meet and track record in the 400-meter hurdles with his winning time of 48.94.

MEN'S HEAD COACH LARRY WIECZOREK



Larry Wieczorek

Head Coach Eighth Year at Iowa University of Iowa, 1969

Larry Wieczorek is in his eighth season as head men's track and field coach at the University of Iowa. He served as an assistant track and field coach for the Hawkeyes for 12 years (1985-96).

A six-time Big Ten champion (including two in cross country) and four-time all-American at Iowa, Wieczorek once held conference marks in the one, two, three, four and five-mile runs. A member of Iowa's last Big Ten track championship team in 1967, he still owns Iowa records in the outdoor 5,000-meters and the indoor two miles, as well as third-fastest mark in the cross country 8,000 meters. He was honored for his collegiate accomplishments by being inducted into the University of Iowa's National Varsity Club Athletics Hall of Fame in 1998.

Wieczorek has coaching experience in all events. Returning to his alma mater as a field event coach at Iowa in 1985, he developed a strong squad that included two-time Big Ten long jump champion Quinn Early, Iowa's first-ever outdoor Big Ten shot put champion Chris Gambol, who still has the second-best mark in that event in outdoor school history, and Gary Kostrubala, who was the first discus thrower in the Big Ten's to throw over 200 feet when he set Iowa's current school record of 202-4. Kostrubala was also an NCAA indoor qualifier in the shot put (60-10 3/4) with the second-best mark in that event in indoor school history.

Since he was named head men's track and field coach in 1997, his plan to build a strong sprint program around a national power 1,600-meter relay, and strong throws program is being realized. In his seven years at the helm, Wieczorek has coached NCAA Champion long jumper Bashir Yamini, 23 all-Americans, 60 national qualifiers and 33 Big Ten Champions. Iowa's 1,600-

meter relay won the 1999 Big Ten outdoor title and has earned all-America honors twice during Wieczorek's tenure. The Hawkeyes recorded their highest conference indoor placing (fourth place) in 1997, and their highest team finish at the Big Ten Outdoor Championships (second) in 33 years at the 1999 Big Ten outdoor meet.

When Wieczorek joined the Iowa staff, several of his athletes were also members of the nationally-ranked Iowa football team. He has continued to foster a strong relationship with the Iowa football staff, which has resulted in outstanding contributions from several multi-sport athletes. Current NFL standout Tim Dwight was a two-time first team all-America wide receiver and return specialist for the Hawkeye football team from 1994-97. He was named Male Athlete of the 1999 Big Ten Outdoor meet after he won the 100 meters, ran the lead leg on the winning 400-meter relay and the second leg on the winning 1,600-meter relay, and placed second in the 200 meters. In 2001, fullback Jeremy Allen became Iowa's only five-time all-American in the throws. He was a four-time Big Ten Champion and the only thrower in conference history to earn Big Ten Freshman of the Year honors at both the indoor and outdoor conference meets.

While improving in the league standings is considered a priority, the Hawkeyes also concern themselves with performance in the classroom. Under Wieczorek, Iowa has had an academic all-Big Ten selection each year during his tenure, totaling 40 in track and field.

Wieczorek came to Iowa after 11 seasons as head track coach at Proviso (IL) West High School. He also served as an assistant for three years. His prep teams were consistent placers on the state level and several of his athletes won state titles. He served on the Illinois track advisory board and founded the prestigious Proviso Indoor Track Classic. Wieczorek was inducted into the Illinois High School Track and Cross Country Coaches Hall of Fame in 2000.

Wieczorek was born on September 11, 1946, in Chicago, IL. He received his B.S. degree in physical education from Iowa in 1969 and his M.S. degree in physical education from Northern Illinois University in 1973. His wife's name is Jackie.

WOMEN'S HEAD COACH JAMES GRANT



James Grant

Head Coach Eighth Year at Iowa Eastern Michigan University, 1971

James Grant is in his eighth season at the helm of the Iowa women's track and field program. He served as an assistant coach at Iowa for 12 years (1985-96).

Grant and the Hawkeyes have had two consecutive recordbreaking seasons, headlined by their third-place finish at the 2004 Big Ten Indoor Championships and a sixth-place finish at the 2003 Big Ten Outdoor Championships. Both were Iowa's highest placings during Grant's tenure, and the third-place infoor finish tied the team's highest conference finish in school history.

Grant also had immense success in his first two seasons at the Hawkeye helm. Wynsome Cole earned all-America status in the 400-meter hurdles in 1997, and won a Big Ten title in that event in 1998. Ellen Grant won 400-meter titles at the 1997 conference indoor and outdoor meets. The 400-meter relay of Tara Underwood, Cole, Grant and Kaydene Wynter also won a Big Ten outdoor title. Erica Broomfield won the 200-meter title, and was runner-up in the 55 meters to earn Big Ten Indoor Freshmen of the Year accolades in 1998.

While improving in the league standings in considered a priority, Iowa's track and field team also concerns itself with performance in the classroom. During Grant's tenure, 31 Hawkeyes have earned 54 academic all-Big Ten honors. This includes a team record 11 honorees in 2001.

As Iowa's assistant coach, Grant coached several Hawkeyes to success. In 1995, Yolanda Hobbs earned all-America status in the 55 and 200 meters after winning the 55-meter Big Ten title.

In 1994, Iowa's 400 meter-relay of Tina Floyd, Hobbs, Marlene Poole and Tanja Reid became the first in school history to ever win a Big Ten title in that event, setting a school and meet record. The team set records four times that season and earned all-America honors at the NCAA Championships. Karen Layne won the 1990 600-meter Big Ten title, while Senta Hawkins won the Big Ten 400 meters in 1988. In 1989, the 1,600-meter relay placed second at the conference indoor and outdoor meets.

A former Jamaican track standout, Grant coached at the high school level in Jamaica for 11 years prior to joining the Hawkeye program in 1986. From 1982-85, Grant coached the men's and women's track teams at G.C. Foster College of Physical Education and Sport. There he led the men's team to two national championships and three second-place finishes, and the women's team to three national titles. During that time he coached world outdoor champion quarter-miler Bert Cameron, and world indoor champion quarter-miler Devon Morris.

A graduate of Eastern Michigan University, Grant captained the 1970 and 1971 Huron track teams, earning all-America honors while specializing in the 400 meters, 400-meter hurdles, and the mile relay. During this time, he held the Jamaican 400-meter hurdle national record with a time that was ranked in the top-20 in the world. Grant also represented Jamaica at the Pan American Games and the Commonwealth Games for six years. In 1991, he was inducted into the Eastern Michigan Hall of Fame.

He was the 1965 and 1966 Jamaican national champion in both the 200 and 400-meters as a high school athlete at Jamaica's Kingston College.

Grant received his bachelor's degree in sociology and history from Eastern Michigan, and his master's degree in physical education from the German College of Physical Education in Leipzig, Germany.


