Post game comments by Michigan Coach "Bo" Schembechler:

"I'd call this a rather typical first game. Saw some things you like and some things you don't like."

"Basically, I think our offensive line did a good job. Especially in the second half."

"Aslo we played this game without our top defensive tackle and a linebacker. We've had several injuries that have hurt us."

"We felt Iowa would be vulnerable outside. We probed a little inside and then went to the pitch outside and it worked real well for us."

Anyone for Iowa impress you? "Yes. Earl Douthitt was really good. I was very impressed with him. Without him, Iowa would have....."

"Reason for the fumbles was first game jitters. I think it's very tough to play an important conference game the first game of the season. No non-conference game, no exhibition game, no thing. I think it's a shame to open a season like this."

"We thought Caldwell would be that quick and know Skogman is a good steady quarterback. We didn't really have any idea which whe would start. I was sort of surprised it was Skogman."

"We felt we could go outside with the option football play. I hate to tell you this because you probably aren't going to believe me, but we really are a much better passing team INNIXIONIZEWXEMMENT than you saw today."

Post game comments by Iowa Coach Frank Lauterbur

"They really went at us and did just we were afraid they'd do. When you let Michigan control the ball the way they did today, there's no way you can come out ahead. They played (Michigan) a very fine ball game.

"There play in the second half was excellent. I'll have to look at the films, but we might have been a little slower in the second half.

"I thought we did move the ball fairly well, but all the fumbles we had took care of any gains we made. I did see some sparks out there that still make me believe we'll be a good ball club.

"I decided to start Skogman just this morning. Both he and Caldwell are about

"Michigan did a great job on the counter-option, that's what killed us. Franklin did just a great job as far as execution is concerned. I think our trouble on the play was that we were just overreading it.

"I thought Kyle threw very well today and gave us some offensive thrust. We've just got to eliminate the fumbles to be an effective team. Our protection on the passer was pretty good. And I thought Rollins and Schultz caught the ball very well.

"I put in Caldwell just for a change of pace, hoping we could go down for a quick score and get back in the game.

"I've got to look at the films to make a real good evaluation, but it's obvious we've got a ways to go.
