



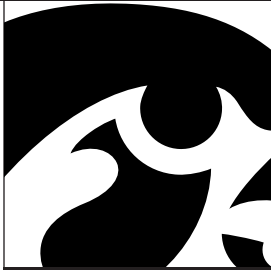

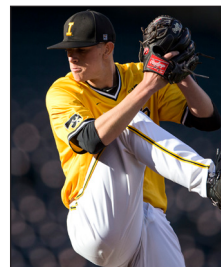

WOLVERINES

LEADING OFF

- The Hawkeyes have won six straight home Big Ten Conference series dating back to the start of the 2015 season. Iowa is 27-5 at Duane Banks Field since the start of the 2015 season.
- This weekend's series against Michigan begins a season-long nine game home stand.
- Iowa has won 10 of its last 13 Big Ten series dating back to last season. The Hawkeyes have split four league series this season.
- The Hawkeyes will be playing their third ranked opponent of the season this weekend at Banks Field. Iowa is 0-6 with series losses at Dallas Baptist and at Missouri State.
- Senior Nick Roscetti has been named to the Brooks Wallace Shortstop of the Year Award Watch List. He is one of three Big Ten players and 54 players nationally to be up for the honor.
- Junior Mason McCoy became the first Hawkeye since 2007 to hit for the cycle; he finished 5-for-7 with six RBIs in a 22-2 rout of Air Force on April 13. The five hits tied an Iowa single-game school record and he is the first Big Ten player to accomplish the feat since 2013.
- Iowa has posted 10 come-from-behind victories in 2016. The Hawkeyes have two walk-off wins -- their seventh and eighth since the start of 2015 -- downing Bradley, 7-6, on March 22 and Illinois, 4-3, in 10 innings April 9.
- Iowa is second in the Big Ten and 18th nationally in team fielding percentage -- a staple of Rick Heller-coached teams -- at .977.

UI head coach Rick Heller is in his third season leading the Hawkeye baseball program.

Heller, an Eldon, Iowa, native, has been head coach at four institutions -- Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99) -- leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

Heller is the winningest coach in his first two seasons in Iowa history, posting a 71-41 record, and he is one of two UI head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament. In 28 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 761-606-4.

The Hawkeyes had a breakthrough season in Heller's second season in Iowa City, going 41-18 with the 41 victories being the second-most all-time and just the fourth 40-win season in program history. Iowa earned the school's first NCAA Regional berth since 1990, where it went 2-2 at the Springfield Regional for the program's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972.

The Hawkeyes rolled to a 15-5 start and won its first 11 series of the season, including a school-record eight consecutive Big Ten series wins dating back to the 2014 season. Iowa swept No. 19 Indiana to open Big Ten play to catapult the Hawkeyes into the national rankings for the first time in 25 years. Iowa climbed to as high as No. 13 before finishing the year 20th by Collegiate Baseball, 25th by Baseball America, and 28th by the NCBWA -- the program's first appearance in the final rankings in school history.

Heller guided Iowa to a Big Ten runner-up (three games ahead of the third place finisher) finish in a year where the league was at its all-time best with a record five NCAA Regional participants. Iowa went 19-5 in conference play for a .792 winning percentage -- the best winning percentage by a second place team since the Big Ten returned to single division play in 1988.

In NCAA Regional play, Heller led the Hawkeyes to a pair of wins over Oregon in Springfield, Missouri, and lost two games to No. 8 national seed Missouri State by a combined three runs. Senior reliever Nick Hibbing was tabbed as the Springfield Regional's Most Outstanding Player and was named to the all-tournament team.

Under Heller's watch, Iowa had a pair of players earn three All-America distinctions, had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections, and a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award.

THIS WEEK

The University of Iowa baseball team opens a season-long nine game home stand by welcoming No. 18/21 Michigan to Duane Banks Field for a three-game weekend series from April 22-24. Friday's series opener is set to begin at 6:05 p.m. (CT), Saturday will start at 3:05 p.m., and Sunday's finale at 11 a.m.

GAME COVERAGE

- All three games of the weekend series will be audio and video streamed live on Hawkeye All-Access with Brent Balbinot and Steve Duncan on the call.
- Live statistics will be available at www.hawkeye-sports.com and fans can follow the action via Twitter/UIBaseball.

SERIES PROMOTIONS

- On Friday, fans can play baseball bingo and there will be postgame fireworks at Banks Field.
- Kids can run the bases following Saturday's game, and on Sunday, the first 200 fans will receive free ice cream sundaes.

IOWA TIDBITS

- The Hawkeyes will use their fifth different weekend starting rotation of the season against Michigan. Iowa used the same starting rotation throughout the entire 2015 season.
- Iowa has won 10 of its last 13 Big Ten Conference series dating back to the start of the 2015 season.
- Three players -- Joel Booker, Nick Roscetti, and Mason McCoy -- have started every game this season.
- Iowa has 21 home runs in 34 games -- the sixth-most in the Big Ten -- this season with nine different players hitting at least one home run. Senior Joel Booker has a team-high four home runs, while four Hawkeyes have three apiece.
- Senior Joel Booker is 11-of-12 on the base paths this season. The outfielder has been successful in seven straight attempts; he hasn't been caught stealing since March 12 against Seton Hall.
- The Hawkeyes have a +52 run differential this season. Iowa is 13-1 when scoring at least six runs and 0-11 when scoring 0-2 runs.
- Iowa is 3-8 against left-handed starting pitching... the Hawkeyes will face three southpaws against the Wolverines.
- Iowa is 12-1 when leading after six innings, 13-1 after seven, and 14-0 after eight innings. The Hawkeyes are 4-14 when trailing after six, 3-14 after seven, and 1-16 after eight.

MICHIGAN NOTABLES

- The Wolverines enter the weekend ranked 18th nationally by Baseball America and 21st in the NCBWA poll.
- Michigan brings a five-game winning streak to Iowa City that has boosted its record to 26-9 overall and 6-2 in the Big Ten. The Wolverines swept a three-game series against Nebraska last weekend in Ann Arbor and defeated Toledo, 2-1, Wednesday night.
- The Wolverines are third in the Big Ten with a .304 average and the team scores 6.3 runs per game. Three Michigan players are in the top 10 in the confer-

ence in average with Cody Bruder leading the way with a .386 average, while Jake Bivens (.374, ninth) and Harrison Wenson (.359, 10th).

- Michigan has a 3.20 team ERA to rank third in the league, averages 8.5 strikeouts per game, and has a league-leading six shutouts. Opponents are hitting .211 against the Wolverines' pitching staff.
- The Wolverines will send a trio of lefties to the mound this weekend. Junior Brett Adcock (4-3, 2.53 ERA) will start the series opener, sophomore Oliver Jaskie (5-2, 2.86) will be on the hill Saturday, and senior Evan Hill (5-1, 2.45 ERA) will start the finale.

LAST SEASON VS. MICHIGAN

- Iowa faced (and fared well against) all three Michigan starting pitchers during the 2015 series in Ann Arbor. The Hawkeyes scored two runs off seven hits in handing Brett Adcock a 2-0 loss in the series finale. Iowa scored four runs on six hits against reliever Oliver Jaskie in the series opener, and plated four runs on five hits in 3 1/3 innings against starter Evan Hill in game two.
- Iowa's Ryan Erickson went 5 2/3 innings against the Wolverines last season to earn the victory in the series opener, allowing two runs on five hits. Calvin Mathews limited Michigan to three hits in six shutout innings in a 2-0 win in the series finale.

SERIES RECORD

- The Wolverines lead the all-time series over Iowa, 111-50 -- a series dating back to 1895.
- Iowa won 2-of-3 games last season in Ann Arbor -- its first series victory over the Wolverines since 2010. Michigan downed the Hawkeyes, 8-5, in a winner's bracket game at the 2015 Big Ten Tournament in Minneapolis.
- This is Michigan's first trip to Iowa City since the 2012 season.

THE REAL MCCOY

Junior Mason McCoy hit Iowa's first cycle since 2007 when he finished 5-for-7 with three runs and six RBIs in a 22-2 victory over Air Force on April 13. The third baseman had a bunt single in the first, an RBI triple in the second, an RBI double in the fourth, and a two-run home run in the sixth. He added a two-run double in the seventh to tie the program record for hits in a game.

- Jason White was the last Hawkeye to hit for the cycle on April 22, 2007, against Illinois. That was 3,276 days and 479 games ago.
- McCoy is the second documented player to hit for the cycle in program history and the first by a Big Ten player since 2013 (Justin Parr, Illinois).
- McCoy became the 16th player to tally a five-hit game and the first since Eric Toole in 2013 at Purdue.

BANKS MAGIC

Iowa is 27-5 at home since the start of the 2015 season. The Hawkeyes went 17-3 last season for the most home victories since 1996. Iowa has six walk-off victories at Duane Banks Field since the start of 2015.



HOME COOKIN'

The Hawkeyes are hitting .305 in 12 home games and average 9.3 runs per contest. Five regulars and nine total players are hitting over .300 with senior Daniel Aaron Moriel posting a team-best .379 average with 13 RBIs. Iowa's pitching staff has a 3.11 ERA over 107 innings at home with 103 strikeouts to 39 walks.

ROSCETTI NAMED TO BROOKS WALLACE WATCH LIST

Senior Nick Roscetti has been named to the Brooks Wallace Shortstop of the Year Award Watch List. He is one of three players from the Big Ten and 54 players nationally named to the initial list. The Illinois native is hitting .329 with 28 runs and 24 RBIs in 2016.

CHANGING UP THE ROTATION

Iowa will use its fifth different rotation of the season this weekend against Michigan. After C.J. Eldred takes the hill Friday, redshirt junior Ryan Erickson will make his second career start -- first Big Ten start -- on Saturday, and senior Calvin Mathews will return to the rotation after a two week layoff for the series finale.

Erickson made his first career start March 5 at Southern Illinois. He went 2 1/3 innings, allowing three runs on six hits in a no-decision.

20-PLUS RUNS

Iowa scored 22 runs on 16 hits in its 22-2 victory over Air Force on April 12 to complete the two-game series sweep. It was the team's second 20+ run game this season as the Hawkeyes scored 28 runs -- the second-most in program history -- in a 28-0, seven-inning win over Northwestern College on March 8. It is the first time since 1996 Iowa has had two 20-run games in a season.

6 X 2

Iowa had two players finish with six RBIs in its 22-2 rout of Air Force on April 13. Junior Mason McCoy finished 5-for-7 with three runs and six RBIs, while senior Daniel Aaron Moriel was 3-for-5 with four runs and six RBIs. Moriel had career-highs in runs and RBIs, and tied a career-best in hits. McCoy had career-best numbers across the board.

• It was Iowa's first six RBI game since 2010 -- Mike McQuillan (vs. Illinois State, 2/20/10). The school record for RBIs in a game is 10 by Brian Wujcik.

JOINING HISTORY

• Freshman Mitchell Boe tied a school record, drawing four walks in against Air Force on April 13.
 • Sophomore Austin Guzzo scored five runs against Northwestern College on March 8 to tie a school record. He is one of three players to score five runs in a game and the first since John Mahoney in 1978.

COMPLETE GAME C.J.

Redshirt sophomore C.J. Eldred threw back-to-back complete games in starts against Maryland and Minnesota. He is second in the Big Ten in the complete games and ranks 27th nationally.

Eldred is the first Hawkeye since Jared Hippen in

2011 to pitch back-to-back complete games. Hippen did it in consecutive road games at Ohio State and Purdue.

TOP 15 BOOKER

Joel Booker ranks in the top 15 in the Big Ten in six different offensive categories. He is tied for seventh in total bases (74), tied for ninth in steals (11) and doubles (10), 11th in runs (31), 10th in hits (48), and 15th in slugging percentage (.517).

GALLAGHER RETURNS TO 'PEN

After making back-to-back Big Ten starts, sophomore Nick Gallagher is returning to the bullpen. The Iowa City, Iowa, native has a team-high four wins, going 4-2 with a 3.41 ERA this season. As a reliever, the right-hander is 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA in six appearances.

BALLS & STRIKES

• Freshman Cole McDonald earned his third win in Iowa's 22-2 win over Air Force on April 13. He scattered two hits in four innings and fanned a career-high five batters.
 • Freshman Shane Ritter notched his first career win against Air Force on April 12. He allowed four runs on six hits in four innings -- zero over final three frames. He had a career-high six strikeouts.
 • Iowa's pitching staff emerged in the Big Ten series-opening victory over Maryland. The Hawkeyes limited the Terrapins to six runs over 27 innings, posting a weekend series-best 2.00 ERA and striking out 23 to seven walks. Maryland hit .221 in the three-game series.

BOOKER'S BREAKOUT

In his first season as Iowa's leadoff hitter, senior Joel Booker is the catalyst at the top of the Hawkeye lineup.

• The outfielder is hitting a team-best .336 with 48 hits, 31 runs scored, and 21 RBIs. He has 10 doubles, two triples, and four home runs -- surpassing his extra base hit output from his entire junior season.
 • Booker is second on the team with 14 multi-hit games, including five three-hit and two four-hit contests.
 • He had a career-best 14-game hitting streak and reached safely in 18 consecutive games earlier this season. He has hit safely in 26-of-34 games and reached safely in all but four contests.
 • Booker has posted single-game career-bests in hits, RBIs, and runs this season. He drove in all four runs and hit his fourth home run -- a three-run shot -- in Iowa's 4-3 series-clinching victory over Illinois.

THINGS ARE "ROSEY"

• Senior Nick Roscetti has a team-best 16 multi-hit games and seven multi-RBI contests. He had a career-best 15-game hitting streak from Feb. 26-March 22.
 • The shortstop has seven games with two or more RBIs, including a four-RBI performance, tying a career-high, in Iowa's 7-6 walk-off victory over Bradley on March 22. Roscetti had the game-winning RBI

 • Earned his first victory of the season at Minnesota on April 3, allowing one run on five hits over five innings.
 • logged a quality start at Dallas Baptist, going 6 1/3 innings, scattering two hits, and striking out six. Both runs were unearned, as he took the loss.
 • had his best outing since the series opener in game two against Maryland. He pitched five innings, allowing one run on three hits and struck out seven, but wasn't involved in the decision.
 • is 13-10 in his Iowa career with a 4.43 ERA in 38 starts. Peyton has 15 quality starts and has pitched into the seventh inning 14 times in his career.

- Freshman Zach Daniels got out of a bases-loaded jam in the top of the ninth inning to record his first career save April 10 against Illinois. Daniels is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA in eight appearances, allowing three runs on eight hits over nine innings.

BIG TEN HONORS

- Zach Daniels earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors on March 14 after hitting .571 with five RBIs and three runs scored in two Iowa victories. He had four RBIs in a 28-0 win over Northwestern College and went 3-for-4 with two runs and an RBI in a win over Savannah State.
- Robert Neustrom was honored as the Big Ten Freshman of the Week on March 28 after hitting .500 in helping Iowa to a 3-1 record last week. Neustrom had hits in three of four games, including two multi-hit contests, and posted a .667 slugging and .462 on-base percentage.
- It is the first time Iowa has had two different players earn the freshman honoree in the same season.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Seniors Jimmy Frankos, Calvin Mathews, Tyler Radtke, and Nick Roscetti are the team captains for the 2016 season. Radtke is in his second season as team captain.

MR. EVERYTHING RETURNS

Senior Tyler Peyton returns as Iowa's Most Valuable Player as a two-way player. The Grimes, Iowa, native is the team's Friday night starter, where he went 7-4 with a 3.03 ERA as a junior, logging 95 innings. Peyton also is the team's top hitter, batting .337 with 31 runs and 31 RBIs in the three spot in the order last season. He was a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award in 2015 and earned third-team All-America honors from D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA.

- Peyton bypassed the 2015 Major League Baseball Draft to return to Iowa City. He turned down seventh round talk and returned after being selected in the 33rd round by the Cincinnati Reds.

MCCOY'S BREAKOUT SUMMER

Junior college transfer Mason McCoy, a two-time All-American at Illinois Central College, had a breakout summer

in the Northwoods League, breaking league single-season records in hits (112), runs (80), and total bases (168). The Washington, Illinois, native was the Northwoods League MVP, La Crosse Loggers MVP, an NWL All-Star, and a Postseason All-Star.

#HELLERBALL

- UI head coach Rick Heller is one of nine coaches all-time (one of four active) to lead three different NCAA Division I teams to regional play.
- The Hawkeyes finished the 2015 season ranked No. 20 by Collegiate Baseball, 25th by Baseball America, and 28th by the NCBWA. It was the program's first end of season rankings in school history.
- Iowa finished as the runner-up in Big Ten play, winning 19 games during the regular season -- the most for the program since 1990.
- The Hawkeyes won 41 games -- the second-most in a single season in school history. It was Iowa's fourth 40-win season in program history.
- Heller is the winningest coach in his first two seasons in program history, winning 71 games. Iowa has posted back-to-back 30 win seasons for the first time since 1989 and 1990.
- Iowa had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections in 2015. The Hawkeyes have had 11 All-Big Ten honorees in two seasons under Heller.
- Iowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015) and seven games (in 2014) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- Of Iowa's 37-man roster, 20 are upperclassmen. The Hawkeyes' roster features 11 freshman, seven sophomores, seven juniors, and 12 seniors.
- Iowa has 19 native Iowans on the 2016 roster -- the most of any state. Thirteen hail from Illinois.
- The Hawkeyes have 20 letterwinners, four positional starters, 2/3 of their starting rotation, and 10 total pitchers returning in 2016.
