Admission is \$3.

**HAWKEYES LATE RALLY FALLS SHORT** -- Iowa scored three runs in the top of the ninth inning to cut the deficit to 9-8, but Northern Iowa pitcher Spencer Black settled down to retire the next three Hawkeye batters to end the contest.

In the ninth, pinch hitter Gabe Haugland got things rolling with a double down the right field line and Andy Cox followed with a bloop single into shallow left field to put two runners on base for pinch hitter Mike Best. Best tatted the first pitch he saw deep over the left field fence.

The Hawkeyes scored all eight of their runs on home runs. Kris Welker con-

nected on a three-run shot in the sixth, Yoho hit a two-run shot in the eighth and Best in the ninth.

The Panthers used a consistent offense to jump out to a 6-0 lead. Northern Iowa scored two runs in four separate innings and added a run in the eighth. They pounded out 13 hits off four Iowa pitchers.

**LOOKING FOR A WINNING STREAK --** The Iowa baseball team has 12 wins this season, however, the squad has only won back-to-back contests once this season (Illinois State and Michigan), but sandwiched in between those wins was an exhibition loss to the Iowa Cubs.

The Hawkeyes won the series opener in three-of-four Big Ten series this season, but they dropped the second game of the series in all three cases.

**TWO-IN-A-ROW --** Starter Nathan Johnson pitched his second consecutive complete game in the 6-3 victory over Penn State last Friday. Johnson allowed nine hits and three runs (two earned), while striking out five Nittany Lion batters. On April 16, Johnson struck out a career-high 14 Indiana batters, while allowing two runs on eight hits.

Johnson is leading the Hawkeyes in virtually every pitching category. The senior from Oskaloosa, IA, has a 4-2 record with a 3.68 ERA in ten starts. He has a 54-14 K/BB ratio in 63 2/3 innings of work, while holding opposing hitters to a .291 average.

In conference games, Johnson is 2-0 in four starts with a 1.83 ERA, which is third in the league. He is fourth in the Big Ten with 32 K's in 34 1/3 innings, while only walking eight batters. He is holding conference batters to .233 average.

**Jack Dahm** enters his first season as Iowa's head baseball coach and has a 283-276 career record. Prior to coming to Iowa, Dahm spent 10 years as the Head Coach at Creighton University, where he is the school's all-time winningest coach. Dahm also played for four years for the Bluejays under current Chicago Cubs General Manager Jim Hendry.

Assistant Coach **Nick Zumsande** is in his first season as Iowa's pitching coach after collecting 14 years of coaching experience throughout the Midwest. Prior to joining the Hawkeyes, Zumsande served as the pitching coach for Indiana State. Before joining the Sycamores, Zumsande coached for one year at Iowa State University where he helped lead the team to their first Big 12 Tournament appearance in school history.

Assistant Coach **Ryan Brownlee** is in his first season as Iowa's hitting/fielding instructor and recruiting coordinator. Prior to coming to Iowa, Brownlee was the hitting/fielding coach at James Madison University, where he led the Dukes to school records in fielding percentage. Before going to JMU, Brownlee served as an assistant at his alma mater, Evansville.

Volunteer Assistant Coach **Spencer Allen** is in his first season with the Hawkeyes. Allen will coach first base during game days and is responsible for outfield instruction. Allen earned his B.A. in 2001 from Iowa State, where he was a three-year starter at second base.

**YOHU TIES HAWKEYE RECORD --** Junior Nate Yoho went 4-for-5 with three runs and two RBIs in the 6-3 triumph over Penn State on April 16.

Among the four hits were three doubles to tie an Iowa record that hasn't been matched since 1999. Former Hawkeyes Toby Humes and Brad Carlson accomplished the feat during the 1999 season.

On the season, Yoho is batting .284 with two home runs and a team-leading 11 doubles and 28 RBIs. He has started every game this season in rightfield for Iowa and leads the team with 13 multi-hit games and nine multi-RBI contests.

**GUNNIN' EM DOWN --** Junior Kris Welker has caught 31 games for the Hawkeyes behind the plate this season. Over this span, Welker has thrown out 21-32 (.604) of the base runners attempting to steal on him.

At the plate, Welker is batting a staggering .516 (16-31) over the past nine games. He has two home runs, one double and 11 RBIs in that span.

On the season, Welker has a .291 average and is second on the team with 20 RBIs. He is also leading the Big Ten with 13 HBP.

**MR. EXTRA BASE HIT** -- Senior Jim Reid has seven extra base hits (3 triples, 4 doubles) since being inserted into the starting line-up on April 17 against Indiana.

Reid is leading the team with a .326 average and a .581 slugging percentage. He also has tallied six RBIs on the season.

**THROWN INTO ACTION** -- The Hawkeyes boast a .333 (10-30) average this season in pinch hitting situations with Jim Reid leading the way with a .667 mark. Iowa got two pinch hits in the ninth inning on Wednesday against UNI. Gabe Haugland doubled and Mike Best hit a three-run home run.

**LEFTY VS. RIGHTY** -- The Hawkeyes are batting .264 this season against left-handed pitching and .256 against righthanders.

Kris Welker (.429), Mike Best (.353), L.J. Mims (.316) are leading the team against the southpaws, while Jim Reid (.341) is tops against righthanders.

**ON THE BASE PATHS** -- The Hawkeyes have swipped 48-75 (.640) bases this season. Jeff Gremley is 10-of-14 to lead the team, while Nate Yoho and Jesse Brownell are tied for second with seven stolen bases apiece.

**A LOOK AT THE WILDCATS** -- Iowa holds a 118-84-2 advantage over Northwestern. Last season, the Wildcats won three-of-four over Iowa in Evanston.

Northwestern enters the contest with a 17-19-1 overall record and a 6-10 conference mark. On Tuesday, the Wildcats thwarted Wisconsin-Milwaukee 15-4 at home. Last weekend, Northwestern dropped three-of-four home games against Minnesota.

The Wildcats are batting just under .300 as they enter
