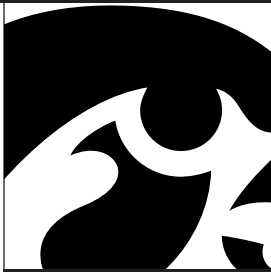

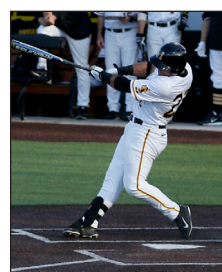

### LEADING OFF

- Iowa scored 28 runs in just six innings in a 28-0 victory over Northwestern College on March 8 in the 2016 home opener. The 28 runs were the second-most in a game in school history and the most in the Big Ten this season.
- Sophomore Austin Guzzo scored five runs against the Red Raiders, tying a school record. He is one of three players to score five runs and the first since John Mahoney in 1978.
- The Hawkeyes are fifth in the Big Ten Conference with a 3.38 team ERA and third with a .970 fielding percentage through the first 10 games.
- Iowa's defense has committed just one error in its last four games after committing 10 errors during the first two weekends.
- Senior Nick Roscetti is riding a seven-game hitting streak, while senior Joel Booker and Tyler Peyton have reached base safely in eight straight contests.
- Junior C.J. Eldred is 1-0 with a 0.64 ERA in two starts. He has allowed two runs (one earned) in 14 innings, has nine strikeouts to two walks, and is limiting hitters to a .128 average.
- Iowa returns 20 letterwinners, four positional starters, 2/3 of its starting rotation, and 10 total pitchers in 2016. Among the returnees is All-Big Ten selections Tyler Peyton, Calvin Mathews, and Nick Roscetti.

UI head coach Rick Heller is in his third season leading the Hawkeye baseball program.

Heller, an Eldon, Iowa, native, has been head coach at four institutions -- Iowa (2014-present), Indiana State (2009-13), Northern Iowa (1999-2009), and Upper Iowa (1987-99) -- leading all four schools to NCAA postseason play. He is one of nine coaches all-time and one of five active coaches to lead three different Division I programs to NCAA Regional play.

Heller is the winningest coach in his first two seasons in Iowa history, posting a 71-41 record, and he is one of two UI head coaches to lead the program to the NCAA Tournament. In 28 seasons as a head coach, Heller owns a career record of 761-606-4.

The Hawkeyes had a breakthrough season in Heller's second season in Iowa City, going 41-18 with the 41 victories being the second-most all-time and just the fourth 40-win season in program history. Iowa earned the school's first NCAA Regional berth since 1990, where it went 2-2 at the Springfield Regional for the program's first NCAA Tournament win since 1972.

The Hawkeyes rolled to a 15-5 start and won its first 11 series of the season, including a school-record eight consecutive Big Ten series wins dating back to the 2014 season. Iowa swept No. 19 Indiana to open Big Ten play to catapult the Hawkeyes into the national rankings for the first time in 25 years. Iowa climbed to as high as No. 13 before finishing the year 20th by Collegiate Baseball, 25th by Baseball America, and 28th by the NCBWA -- the program's first appearance in the final rankings in school history.

Heller guided Iowa to a Big Ten runner-up (three games ahead of the third place finisher) finish in a year where the league was at its all-time best with a record five NCAA Regional participants. Iowa went 19-5 in conference play for a .792 winning percentage -- the best winning percentage by a second place team since the Big Ten returned to single division play in 1988.

In NCAA Regional play, Heller led the Hawkeyes to a pair of wins over Oregon in Springfield, Missouri, and lost two games to No. 8 national seed Missouri State by a combined three runs. Senior reliever Nick Hibbing was tabbed as the Springfield Regional's Most Outstanding Player and was named to the all-tournament team.

Under Heller's watch, Iowa had a pair of players earn three All-America distinctions, had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections, and a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award.

**THIS WEEK**

The University of Iowa baseball team heads to Emerson, Georgia, for four games at the Spring Swing at LakePointe. The Hawkeyes will face Omaha at 2:30 p.m. (CT) Friday, Seton Hall at 3:30 p.m. Saturday, Savannah State at noon Sunday, and Point University at 1:30 p.m. Monday. All four games will be played at Perfect Game Park South at LakePointe.

**NOTABLES**

- Sophomore Austin Guzzo is hitting .833 with five RBIs and six runs scored over his last two games. He has five hits in six at-bats and has a 1.000 slugging and .900 on-base percentage.
- Senior Joel Booker is leading the team with a .359 average with 14 hits in 39 at-bats. The North Carolina native has five doubles; he had 10 extra base hits all of his junior season.
- Booker is also pacing the team with four steals (in four attempts) this season. The outfielder was 9-for-14 in stolen base attempts last season.
- Sophomore Cole McDonald picked up his first career win against Northwestern College, tossing two shutout innings. Shane Ritter, Sam Lizzarraga, and Jared Mandel combined for the seven-inning shutout.

**OMAHA NOTABLES**

- The Mavs have lost three of their last four games to see their record drop to 7-7 overall. UNO split a midweek series at Air Force (W, 12-3, L, 10-18) following a series loss at Grand Canyon last weekend.
- Omaha is hitting .305 as a team and averaging 5.9 runs per game. The team has 32 extra base hits, including seven home runs.
- Seven players are hitting over .300, including Cole Gruber, who paces the team with a .397 average. He has 23 hits, 15 runs, and is 11-of-13 on the base paths. Clayton Taylor is hitting .354 with four home runs, 13 runs,

and 22 RBIs.

- The Mavs have struggled on the mound, posting a 6.27 team ERA, allowing 101 runs on 163 hits in 122 innings. The team has 81 strikeouts to 46 walks and opponents are hitting .324.
- Senior RHP Tyler Fox will likely start Friday. He is 2-1 with a 2.04 ERA in three starts, allowing 11 runs (four earned) on 18 hits over 17 2/3 innings. Fox has 13 strikeouts to three walks.

**SETON HALL NOTABLES**

- The Pirates have won four of their last five games to even their record at 6-6 overall. Seton Hall beat Indiana twice (7-2, 6-4 (10) last weekend and lost 9-3 to Ohio State at the Snowbird Classic.
- Seton Hall is hitting .266 as a team and is averaging 4.2 runs per game. Five Pirate players are hitting above .300 with Mikael-Ali Moques leading the team with a .375 average with eight runs, five doubles, and eight RBIs.
- The Pirates, who have a 4.63 team ERA, will start freshman LHP Cullen Dana, who is 1-0 with a 2.45 ERA in two starts. He has allowed three runs on four hits in 11 innings and has 11 strikeouts to four walks.

**SAVANNAH STATE NOTABLES**

- The Tigers are 4-10 overall.
- Savannah State is hitting .247 as a team and average 4.4 runs per game. The Tigers have two players hitting above .300 in Mendez Elder (.365) and Jonathan Moore (.324). Elder has a team-best seven doubles, 11 runs, and 10 RBIs.
- The Tigers, who have a 6.66 team ERA, have allowed 148 hits over 119 innings and have 81 walks to 72 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting .306 against the staff.
- RHP Greg Holman will start against Iowa. He is 0-1 with a 5.28 ERA, allowing five runs on seven hits over eight innings in three starts.

**POINT NOTABLES**

- The Skyhawks, an NAIA team in West Point, Georgia, are 7-12 overall, losers of three of their last four contests.
- Point is hitting .249 as a team and is averaging 4.7 runs per game. Nathan Greene leads the team with a .356 average with 14 runs and seven RBIs. Christian Cabral has a team-



best 12 RBIs and two home runs.

- The Skyhawks have a 4.11 team ERA, allowing 145 hits and 103 runs (65 earned) over 142 1/3 innings.

**SERIES RECORD**

- Iowa leads the all-time series over Nebraska-Omaha, 7-4. The Hawkeyes last faced the Mavericks in 2014, winning 7-1 in Port Charlotte.
- The Hawkeyes are 0-1 all-time against Seton Hall, dropping a 2-0 decision during the 2011 season in St. Petersburg, Florida.
- Iowa has never faced Savannah State or Point University.

**BREAKING DOWN 28-0**

Iowa opened its 2016 home schedule with a 28-0 blasting of Northwestern College on March 8 at Banks Field. The 28 runs are the second-most in a single game in school history.

- All nine starters and 11 players tallied an RBI in the game. Iowa had 24 RBIs among the 28 runs.
- Nine different players tallied a hit, eight posted multi-hit games, and 13 different players scored at least one run. Iowa drew 11 walks in the contest.

**IN THE B1G**

- Iowa is second in the Big Ten with 64 runs scored and has the fifth-best on-base percentage (.375) and fifth-most RBIs (57). The Hawkeyes lead the conference in walks (52).
- Senior Nick Roscetti is tied for third in runs scored (11) and Booker is tied for sixth with four steals.

**SOPHOMORE C.J. ELDRÉD...**

- has been Iowa's most consistent pitcher, going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA in three appearances (two starts). Eldred ranks sixth in the Big Ten in ERA and second in opposing batting average (.129).
- recorded a quality start at Southern Illinois, throwing nine innings of two-hit, one run ball. He had a no-hitter through 7 2/3 innings, but wasn't involved in the decision.
- picked up his first career win against Dartmouth, allowing one run on four hits over five innings, fanning five.
- sat out the 2015 season after transferring from Indiana University, where he redshirted

in 2014.

- is the son of former Hawkeye first round MLB Draft pick and Major Leaguer Cal Eldred.

**SENIOR TYLER PEYTON...**

- logged a quality start at Dallas Baptist, going 6 1/3 innings, scattering two hits, and striking out six. Both runs were unearned, as he took the loss.
- is expected to take the ball in game two this weekend against Seton Hall.
- did not pitch at Southern Illinois due to forearm tightness.
- is 12-7 in his Iowa career with a 3.89 ERA in 32 starts. Peyton has 15 quality starts and has pitched into the seventh inning 14 times in his career.
- has logged 180 1/3 innings in two-plus seasons, where he has 126 strikeouts to 59 walks.
- earned third-team All-America honors by D1Baseball.com and the USBWA as a junior.
- has the best change-up in the Big Ten Conference according to Baseball America.

**SENIOR CALVIN MATHEWS...**

- is 10-12 with a 3.09 ERA in 42 appearances (38 starts). He has logged 198 1/3 innings, allowing 179 hits, striking out 138 strikeouts to 60 walks.

**TEAM CAPTAINS**

Seniors Jimmy Frankos, Calvin Mathews, Tyler Radtke, and Nick Roscetti are the team captains for the 2016 season. Radtke is in his second season as team captain.

**PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS**

- The Hawkeyes have been selected to finish fourth in the Big Ten Conference in a vote of the league's 13 head coaches. Michigan was tabbed as the league favorite, followed by Maryland and Indiana.
- Iowa was also picked to finish second in the conference by Collegiate Baseball and fourth by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.
- D1Baseball.com and College Sports Madness have Iowa playing in its second straight NCAA Regional in 2016.

**RETURNEES BY THE NUMBERS**

- Iowa returns 51.5 percent of its RBIs (135 of 262), 46.4 percent of its runs (136 of 293), 45.1 percent of its hits (243 of 539) and 42.9

percent of its doubles (36 of 84). The Hawkeyes also have six (of 14) home runs returning to the lineup.

- On the pitching front, Iowa returns weekend starters Tyler Peyton (7-4, 3.03 ERA) and Calvin Mathews (5-3, 2.45 ERA) and 11-of-19 saves from 2015. The Hawkeyes have 61 percent of their wins (25 of 41), 69 percent of their innings pitched (371 of 537.1), and 66.2 percent of the strikeouts (247 of 373) back.

**MR. EVERYTHING RETURNS**

Senior Tyler Peyton returns as Iowa's Most Valuable Player as a two-way player. The Grimes, Iowa, native is the team's Friday night starter, where he went 7-4 with a 3.03 ERA as a junior, logging 95 innings. Peyton also is the team's top hitter, batting .337 with 31 runs and 31 RBIs in the three spot in the order last season. He was a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award in 2015 and earned third-team All-America honors from D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA.

- Peyton bypassed the 2015 Major League Baseball Draft to return to Iowa City. He turned down seventh round talk and returned after being selected in the 33rd round by the Cincinnati Reds.

**MCCOY'S BREAKOUT SUMMER**

Junior college transfer Mason McCoy, a two-time All-American at Illinois Central College, had a breakout summer in the Northwoods League, breaking league single-season records in hits (112), runs (80), and total bases (168). The Washington, Illinois, native was the Northwoods League MVP, La Crosse Loggers MVP, an NWL All-Star, and a Postseason All-Star.

- Iowa won with its pitching and defense in 2015 and it's the equation UI head coach Rick Heller is counting on again this season. The Hawkeye pitching staff shattered the school record with a 2.95 ERA over 59 games. The previous record was 3.63 in 1971.

- The team finished 10th in the nation in hits allowed per nine innings (7.69) and 16th in ERA last season.

- Iowa was 11th nationally (and second in the Big Ten) in fielding percentage with a .978 clip. Iowa committed 50 errors in 59 games and turned 51 double plays.

**HOME COOKIN'**

The Hawkeyes went 17-3 at Duane Banks Field in 2015 -- the most home victories since 1996. The success stems, in part, to the game day atmosphere, where nearly 18,000 fans supported the team throughout the season. The Hawkeyes averaged nearly 1,000 fans per home contest and had two crowds of 2,400-plus during Big Ten Conference play.

**#HELLERBALL**

- UI head coach Rick Heller is one of nine coaches all-time (one of four active) to lead three different NCAA Division I teams to regional play.

- The Hawkeyes finished the 2015 season ranked No. 20 by Collegiate Baseball, 25th by Baseball America, and 28th by the NCBWA. It was the program's first end of season rankings in school history.

- Iowa finished as the runner-up in Big Ten play, winning 19 games during the regular season -- the most for the program since 1990.

- The Hawkeyes won 41 games -- the second-most in a single season in school history. It was Iowa's

fourth 40-win season in program history.

- Heller is the winningest coach in his first two seasons in program history, winning 71 games. Iowa has posted back-to-back 30 win seasons for the first time since 1989 and 1990.
- Iowa had a school-record six All-Big Ten selections in 2015. The Hawkeyes have had 11 All-Big Ten honorees in two seasons under Heller.
- Iowa has posted winning streaks of nine games (in 2015) and seven games (in 2014) -- the longest streaks for the program since 2012.

**ROSTER BREAKDOWN**

- Of Iowa's 37-man roster, 20 are upperclassmen. The Hawkeyes' roster features 11 freshman, seven sophomores, seven juniors, and 12 seniors.
- Iowa has 19 native Iowans on the 2016 roster -- the most of any state. Thirteen hail from Illinois.
- The Hawkeyes roster includes players ranging from California to North Carolina to Canada.
- Iowa boasts three sets of high school teammates on the 2016 roster: Calvin Mathews and Josh Martsching -- Davis County High School in Bloomfield, Iowa; Tyler Peyton and Cole Baker -- Dallas Center-Grimes High School in Grimes, Iowa; Zach Daniels and Sam Lizarraga -- Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Tyler Peyton and Luke Vandermaten were also teammates at Iowa Central Community College in 2014.
- The Hawkeyes have 20 letterwinners, four positional starters, 2/3 of their starting rotation, and 10 total pitchers returning in 2016.
