Game #8 Quick Hits

- Iowa has won nine of its last 10 home games, dating back to Feb. 1.
- The Hawkeyes will not leave the state of Iowa until Jan. 6 when they travel to Ann Arbor, Mich., to face nationally-ranked Michigan.
- Iowa's first seven games have been decided by eight points or more.
- Roy Devyn Marble has scored in double figures in all seven games this season.
- Aaron White leads the team in rebounding (7.0), and free throws made (43) and attempted (57), and is second in scoring (13.7).
- The Hawkeyes have attempted 20 or more free throws in six of their seven games, including attempting 39 (made 31) against Wichita State.
- This marks the second time in three years under Fran McCaffery that the Hawkeye head coach has started two freshmen in the season opener (Basabe and McCabe in 2010).
- Iowa is 10-2 when scoring 80 points or more, the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes are 18-0 when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points, the last two years.
- Iowa's average starting lineup height is 6-foot-6. The Hawkeye starting lineup consists of two freshmen, one sophomore, and two juniors.

THE SETTING

Iowa (5-2) returns home to host Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (1-4) on Saturday. Tip-off is set for 12:05 p.m. on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,400).

Tickets for Saturday's contest cost \$14 for adults, and \$5 for UI students and youth. The ticket is also good for the women's game against UNI, which will start at approximately 2:30 p.m. after the men's game.

Free trading cards will be distributed to the first 1,000 fans on Saturday. Also, Saturday is Camper Reunion Day. Campers earn free admission, while guests can purchase \$5 tickets.

ON THE AIR

Radio: All Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

Television: Saturday's game will not be televised, but fans can access the game online on hawkeyesports.com via the BTN Digital Network. Hawkeye All-Access subscribers can watch live video streams of UI events on the BTN Digital Network at no extra charge. Fans can also access the game via video.BTN.com.

HAWKEYES DROP ACC/BIG CHALLENGE GAME AT VIRGINIA TECH

- Iowa lost 95-79 at Virginia Tech on Tuesday in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge.
- The Hawkeyes trailed by 17 early in the second half, but a 16-2 Hawkeye run got the visitors within one possession (57-54) with 12 minutes remaining. The Hokies outscored Iowa 38-25 the final 12 minutes to record the victory.
- Aaron White tallied 21 points and 10 rebounds to post his second double-double of the season and sixth of his career.
- Roy Devyn Marble had a solid outing, scoring 14 of his 18 points in the second half. He also finished with seven rebounds and a game-high seven assists. The seven helpers are one shy of a personal best.
- The Hokies outscored the Hawkeyes 27-13 at the foul line. Virginia Tech attempted 30 free throws compared to 18 for Iowa.
- Eight Hawkeyes scored four points or more, while four netted nine or more.
- Virginia Tech is the first team Iowa has faced this season that shot better than 42 percent from the field. The Hokies made 52.5 percent (32-of-61) of their attempts.

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery is in his third season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 17th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 30th season as a collegiate coach in 2012, which includes 16 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 53, holds a career mark of 285-216 (.569) and guided his teams to seven postseason appearances (five NCAA, two NIT). He is 34-39 (.466) at Iowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- The Hawkeyes have played 10 players or more in each of the first seven games.
- Aaron White is attacking the rim averaging a team-best 8.1 free-throw attempts per game. He is averaging 6.1 free-throw makes per outing.
- The Hawkeyes have attempted 20 or more free throws in six of their seven games. Iowa has attempted 23 free throws twice (Central Michigan and Howard) and 25 twice (Gardner-Webb and UTPA).
- Iowa has made (129) more free throws than its opponents have attempted (130), which is a staple of Fran McCaffery-coached teams.
- Roy Devyn Marble scored 15 of his season-high 22 points in the first half against Howard. It marked the third time in his career the junior reached the 20-point plateau.
- Aaron White netted 21 points at Virginia Tech, marking the third time in his career the sophomore reached the 20-point plateau.
- Iowa has exactly 96 assists and 96 turnovers through seven games.
- Iowa blocked 10 shots vs. UT-Pan American in its season opener, the most by an Iowa team since Nov. 14, 2005 (Md.-Eastern Shore).

ALL-TIME SERIES

Saturday will be the first meeting between Texas A&M-Corpus Christi and Iowa. The Islanders are a member of the Southland Conference. The Hawkeyes are 4-1 all-time against current members of the Southland.

- The Islanders have two players who have made five 3-pointers or more: Will Nelson (8) and Joy Williamson (6).
- Texas A&M-Corpus Christi has been outrebounded by an average of 2.2 per game.
- The Islanders average 64.4 points per game and have allowed 70.2.
- Texas A&M-Corpus Christi lost its last game at Toledo on Wednesday (80-68). Toledo outscored the Islanders 35-24 at the free throw line. Toledo attempted 46 foul shots en route to victory. Johnathan Jordan poured in a team-high 22 points in defeat.

IOWA POSTS LARGEST COMEBACK IN SCHOOL HISTORY

Iowa trailed Gardner-Webb by 23 points (38-15) with 13 seconds left in the first half on Nov. 17 in Iowa City. Sophomore Josh Oglesby drained three free throws after being fouled on a 3-point attempt with one second remaining in the half to cut the deficit to 20 (38-18) at halftime. The Hawkeyes rallied in the second half and ultimately won by nine points (65-56), which is a 32-point swing. The comeback is believed to be the largest in school history.

The last team in the country to overcome a 20+ halftime deficit was Harvard, which trailed Brown by 22 points (53-31) and won 85-78 on Feb. 12, 2011.

The last Big Ten team to overcome a 20+ halftime deficit was Illinois, which trailed at Clemson by 20 points (47-27) and won 76-74 on Dec. 2, 2009.

HAWKEYE DEFENSE IMPROVING

Last year, Iowa allowed opponents 72.5 points per contest. Through seven games in 2012, Iowa is yielding 61.9 points. Iowa held Howard to 36 points on Nov. 15, which were the fewest points a Hawkeye team allowed since a 61-36 win over Bryant on Dec. 5, 2008.

Junior Melsahn Basabe and senior Eric May have been Iowa's leaders off the bench.

Basabe is averaging 7.1 points and 4.3 rebounds. He also has rejected a team-best 14 shots, blocking four shots in two games (Central Michigan and Western Kentucky).

May is averaging 5.9 points and four rebounds. His scoring numbers have been aided by his ability to attack the basket and get to the free throw line in the early stages of the season. Iowa split its two games at the Cancun Challenge. The Hawkeyes beat Western Kentucky 63-55 in the semifinals, but fell to Wichita State 75-63 in the championship. Aaron White and Roy Devyn Marble were named to the all-tournament team.

The Hawkeyes had three players score 21 points each in the two games (10.5 avg.): Eric May, Mike Gesell and Marble.

White tied the Cancun Challenge record for most free throws made in the four tournament games with 28. White tied Ryan Thompson of Rider (2009). Iowa won preliminary round games against Howard and Gardner-Webb in Iowa City.

Peter Jok Signs With Hawkeyes

University of Iowa Men's Basketball Coach Fran McCaffery announced today that Peter Jok has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa.

"We are thrilled that Peter Jok is going to become part of the Hawkeye family," said McCaffery. "He has a complete skillset that will be a great asset to our team. He's an excellent athlete who can play four different positions, and is a terrific 3-point shooter. Peter is exactly what we are looking for in this class."

Jok is a 6-foot-6, 200-pound guard born in Sudan, who played his first two years as a prep at Des Moines Roosevelt, and his last two at West Des Moines Valley. Last season at Valley, Jok earned second team all-conference honors after averaging 10.2 points. He hit 86 percent of his free throws, grabbed 4.3 rebounds and made 37 percent of his 3-point attempts. Jok's high school coach at Valley is Jeff Horner, Iowa's all-time assist leader.

As a sophomore at Roosevelt, Jok averaged 18.5 points and seven rebounds and was a second team all-state and first team all-conference honoree. He was also one of 30 high school freshmen invited to the Nike Top 100 Camp in St. Louis in 2010, and participated in the 2012 NBA Players Association Top 100 Camp.

Jok played AAU basketball on the All-Iowa Attack.

Jok will join Jarrod Uthoff, who transferred to Iowa from the University of Wisconsin this year, on the 2013-14 active Iowa roster.

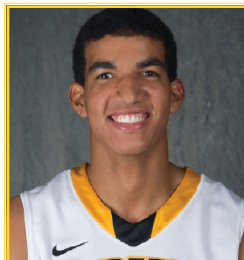
