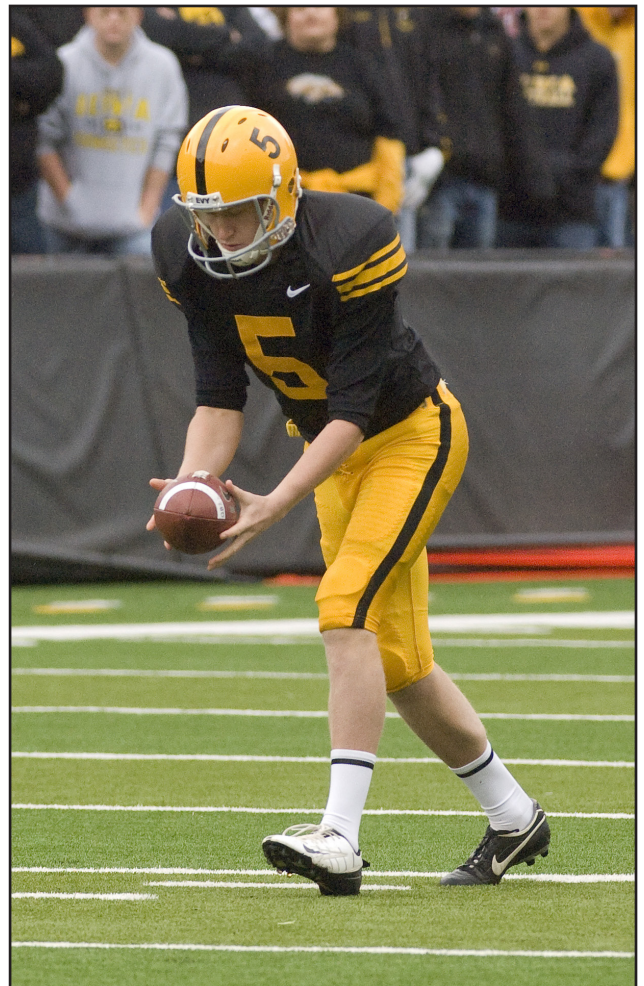

Hawk-Item - - Ranks fifth in career interceptions with 13... holds Iowa career record and ranks fourth all-time in the Big Ten Conference with 392 interception return yards... 86-yard touchdown return vs. Indiana in 2009 ranks as fifth longest interception return in school history... tied Iowa single-game record with three pass interceptions in 35-3 win at Iowa State in 2009. . . set Iowa bowl records for longest interception return (48 yards) and interception return yards in a game (74) in 2009 Outback Bowl win over South Carolina, along with tying Iowa bowl record with two interceptions... tied for 54th in career tackles with 211... one of four juniors named to 2010 Leadership Group... one of four sophomores named to 2009 Leadership Group.

Quarterback - 6-4, 230, Senior - Mentor, OH - Lake Catholic High School

Pronounced STAN-zee

Hawk-Item -- Ranks second in the Big Ten and ranks 11th nationally in passing efficiency (160.5)... has posted 25-9 record as starting quarterback, ranking second among Iowa quarterbacks in career victories... has thrown at least one touchdown pass in last 21 games he has played to establish school record and is on pace to set school record for passing efficiency... ranks third in career touchdown passes (56), passing yards (7,177) and total offense (7,164)... ranks fourth in career completions (531) and attempts (886)... only quarterback to start three games against Penn State Coach Joe Paterno and win all three... one of seven seniors named to 2010 Leadership Group... one of four juniors named to 2009 Leadership Group.
