Brian Bedo and former Air Force coach Ardie McNelly will call the action.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,077 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 658-419 (.611). That includes a 329-165 (.666) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 313-90 (.777) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

SCOUTING BRADLEY

The Bradley Braves are 7-3 and have won their last three contests. Two of the last three wins have come on the road (Butler and Central Michigan).

The Braves defeated Central Michigan, 66-60, on Dec. 6. Catie O'Leary led Bradley with 15 points off the bench. Katie Yohn had 13 points and eight rebounds and MacKenzie Westcott had 12 points and six boards.

Leah Kassing leads Bradley with 13.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per game. Yohn is next with 12.2 points per contest. Westcott is the team's second leading rebounder at 7.2 boards per game.

As a team, Bradley is averaging 65.9 points per game and shooting .415 (236-569) from the field, including .329 (52-158) from three-point distance.

IOWA VS. BRADLEY NOTES

- Iowa leads the all-time series, 5-0. The Hawkeyes won a 91-53 decision last year in Iowa City.
- Three players on Bradley's roster are from Iowa: freshman Shrona Butts (Des Moines/East), sophomore Alyson Spinass-Valainis (Davenport/Assumption) and senior Mackenzie Westcott (Williamsburg/Williamsburg).
- Two players on Iowa's roster are from Illinois: freshman Melissa Dixon (Johnsburg/Johnsburg) and senior Megan Considine (Byron/Byron).

LAST MEETING

Iowa defeated Bradley, 91-53, last season in its home opener.

Four Hawkeyes hit double figures, led by Jaime Printy with 21 points. Kamille Wahlin added 17 points, five assists and three steals while Kachine Alexander had a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds. Kelly Krei and Hannah Draxten each had 12 points.

The Hawkeyes converted 25 Bradley turnovers into 35 points and netted 16 second chance points off 13 offensive rebounds.

OPPONENTS IN THE RANKINGS

Five Iowa opponents are ranked in the AP or ESPN/USA Today polls: Texas A&M (10/10), Ohio State (12/14), Penn State (16/17), Purdue (22/22) and Nebraska (25/RV).

In addition, Northwestern and Michigan are receiving votes.

HAWKEYES RUN PAST WESTERN ILLINOIS

Iowa used balanced scoring and a solid shooting performance to take down Western Illinois, 98-45. Four Hawkeyes scored in double figures and 10 of Iowa's 11 players recorded at least two points. The Hawkeyes shot .494 (38-77) from the field, including .423 (11-26) from three-point distance.

Jaime Printy led all scorers with 25 points in just 19 minutes of play. Melissa Dixon added 15 points off the bench, Kamille Wahlin netted 14 points and Morgan Johnson scored 10 points in only eight minutes of play.

WINNING BIG

Iowa's 53-point winning margin over Western Illinois (Dec. 9) was the fourth-largest in school history. It was also the largest margin of victory for a Hawkeye team since an 89-34 win (55 points) over Boise State in 1996.

EVEN MORE BENCH POINTS

The Hawkeyes scored 37 points off the bench against Western Illinois (Dec. 9), which were the most for an Iowa team since scoring 49 against Northern Illinois in 2007.

Earlier this season, Iowa netted 26 bench points, which were tied for the most since 2008.

HITTING 90

Iowa's 98 points vs. Western Illinois (Dec. 9) are the most for an Iowa team since scoring 99 points, also against Western Illinois, in 2000.

The Hawkeyes have now scored 90 or more points in 49 games.

DIXON HAS STRONG WEEK OFF THE BENCH

Freshman Melissa Dixon averaged 13 points and four rebounds in Iowa's two games at Iowa State (Dec. 7) and vs. Western Illinois (Dec. 9).

Dixon scored 11 points (4-7 FGs) and grabbed four rebounds in Iowa's game at Iowa State. She followed with 15 points and four rebounds against Western Illinois.

Dixon played a total of 39 minutes and did not commit a turnover.

STARTING TO HEAT UP FROM DISTANCE

Iowa is the only team in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 15 three-point shooters in the league (by shooting percentage).

Kelly Krei and Melissa Dixon are tied for third in the conference at .444. Jaime Printy ranks 13th at .351 and Kamille Wahlin ranks 14th at .349.

Penn State and Nebraska are the only other schools to have more than one player in the top 15 (both have two players ranked).

JOHNSON FROM THE FIELD

Junior Morgan Johnson has attempted at least 10 shots in five of Iowa's 10 games this season. In four of those games, Johnson has shot .500 or better.

Johnson was 5-10 (.500) vs. Harvard, 9-13 (.692) at Northern Iowa, 6-11 (.545) at Kansas State and 5-10 (.500) at Iowa State.

The only game Johnson failed to shoot .500 with 10 or more shots was vs. Virginia Tech (8-21, .381).

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 12th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 28th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 48, has a career record of 573-278 (.673), including a 217-136 (.615) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to 10 post-season tournaments (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and eight upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS

The Hawkeyes have cashed in from the free throw line so far this season. Iowa is 153-191 from the charity stripe and their .801 free throw percentage ranks second in the Big Ten and sixth-best in the NCAA.

Individually, Jaime Printy's .897 free throw percentage is second-best in the Big Ten and 29th-nationally.

REACHING DOUBLE FIGURES

Iowa's game vs. Western Illinois (Dec. 9) marked the fifth time this season that at least three players have scored 10 or more points.

The Hawkeyes had four players in double figures against Northern Iowa, Kansas State and Western Illinois. Three players reached double digits against Harvard and Albany.

NO DOUBLE FIGURES. NO PROBLEM

Iowa had just one player (Morgan Johnson) score double figures in a win over Virginia Tech (Nov. 30).

The last time an Iowa team won a game with just one player in double figures was Dec. 2, 2007 vs. Detroit when Kristi Smith netted 10 points.

Since the game vs. Detroit in 2007, Iowa teams have only had one player score 10 or more points just seven times. The Hawkeyes lost all seven of those contests.

CONSISTENT STARTS

Three Hawkeyes have recorded consistent starts in certain statistical categories through seven games this season.

- Junior Jaime Printy has scored at least 15 points in all but three games, including four 20 point performances.
- Freshman Samantha Logic has grabbed at least five rebounds and dished out at least four assists in six of Iowa's 10 games.
- Junior Morgan Johnson has recorded three blocks in four of Iowa's first 10 contests.

PRINTY STREAK SNAPPED

Junior Jaime Printy had converted 30-straight free throws, dating back to Iowa's game vs. UNLV (Nov. 13), before a miss from the charity stripe against Texas A&M (Nov. 26).

Printy went 8-8 against UNLV (Nov. 13), 9-9 against Albany (Nov. 16), 4-4 vs. Northern Iowa (Nov. 19) and 8-8 vs. St. John's (Nov. 25). She made her first attempt against Texas A&M, before missing the first of two free throws in the second half.

Printy's latest streak is the second time she has made at least 30-straight free throws. She made 32-straight free throws last year, one shy of Iowa's record for consecutive free throws (33 by Lindsey Meder).

LOGIC COLLECTS DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Freshman Samantha Logic scored 10 points and grabbed 11 rebounds at Northern Iowa (Nov. 19) for her first career double-double.

Logic's double-double was the first for an Iowa freshman since the 2009-10 season. Morgan Johnson had 16 points and 11 rebounds vs. Purdue (Jan. 31, 2010).

KREI HITTING THE GLASS

Kelly Krei recorded her third career double-double vs. Albany (Nov. 16) with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

Krei's first double-double came at home vs. Indiana as a sophomore (14 points and 13 rebounds). Her second was in the season opener vs. Southern in the Islander Tip-Off Classic, hosted by Texas A&M Corpus Christi, as a junior (20 points and 10 rebounds).

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

- Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks fourth in career three-pointers made (182), tied for 10th in career assists (339) and 21st in career scoring (1,157). She needs four more three-pointers to move past Kristi Smith into third place, 15 more assists to move past Jollette Law for eighth place and 23 more points to past Crystal Smith for 19th place.
 - Morgan Johnson ranks second in career blocks (177) and needs 59 more to move past Tangela Smith for first place.
 - Jaime Printy ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (172) and 18th in career scoring (1,199). She needs 11 more three-pointers to move past Wahlin for fourth place and 32 more points to move past Crystal Smith for 18th place.
 - Kelly Krei ranks eighth in career three-pointers made (132) and needs seven more to move past Kristi Faulkner into seventh place.

NESBITT SIDELINED WITH KNEE SURGERY

Junior Trisha Nesbitt will be sidelined after having minor knee surgery Nov. 15. She is expected to miss 3-6 weeks of action.

HAWKEYES ON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAMS

Junior Jaime Printy was named to both the Hawkeye Challenge and Junkanoo Jam all-tournament teams. Senior Kamille Wahlin was chosen for the Hawkeye Challenge all-tournament team and freshman Samantha Logic was picked for the Junkanoo Jam all-tournament team.

Printy led Iowa in scoring vs. both Harvard (24 points) and UNLV (25 points) in the Hawkeye Challenge. She added six rebounds and four assists vs. Harvard, along with five rebounds and four assists vs. UNLV.

Printy was also named CollegeSportsMadness.com's Big Ten Player of the Week.

Wahlin netted nine points against Harvard and scored 15 vs. UNLV. She also had two rebounds and three assists against the Rebels.

Logic averaged 14.5 points and six rebounds while shooting .500 (12-24) from the field against two tough opponents in the Junkanoo Jam.

Logic started the week with 13 points, three rebounds and three steals in Iowa's win over St. John's. Logic was 5-9 from the field in 22 minutes of action.

Against the No. 4 ranked and defending NCAA champion Texas A&M Aggies, Logic was one rebound shy of a double-double. She scored 16 points, grabbed nine rebounds and added three assists.

Printy started the Junkanoo Jam with a team-best 17 points (8-8 FTs), five rebounds, three assists and three steals against St. John's.

Printy added 14 points, three rebounds and three steals against Texas A&M.

HAWKEYES PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The Iowa women's basketball team was picked to finish third by both the league coaches and media. Penn State was chosen as the favorite in both polls.

Junior Jaime Printy was a preseason all-Big Ten selection by both the league media and coaches.

PRINTY NAMED TO WATCH LISTS

Junior Jaime Printy has been named to the "Wade Watch," Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy Watch Lists. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy list has 51 players.

The three awards are considered the most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

PRINTY NOTES FROM LAST SEASON

- Became the youngest player in school history to earn All-America honors, taking home Associated Press honorable mention accolades as a sophomore. She is the only returning All-American in the Big Ten this season.
- Became the first player in school history to reach the 1,000 career point milestone as a sophomore.
- Earned second team All-Big Ten honors by the coaches and was a third team pick by the media.
- One of eight Hawkeyes named Academic All-Big Ten.
- Named Big Ten Player of the Week once.
- Started all 31 games and led the Hawkeyes with 16.8 points per game.
- Tied school record for free throw percentage in a single game (10-10, 1.000 vs. Indiana), three-pointers attempted in a single game (15 vs. Michigan) and three-pointers made in an NCAA Tournament game (5 vs. Gonzaga).

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last season marked the eighth time in 11 seasons under head coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last four seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the 10th time in 11 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's tie for third place in the Big Ten is also the eighth time, under Bluder, the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its sixth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last four seasons.

NEW HAWKEYES RANK HIGH

Iowa's freshmen class was tabbed as the 11th best recruiting class of 2011 by ESPNHoop-Gurlz.com. The class includes five players, one at each position.

Included in the class is guard Samantha Logic, who is the third McDonald's High School All-American to commit to the University of Iowa under Head Coach Lisa Bluder.

TWO PLAYERS OUT FOR THE SEASON

Senior Megan Considine and sophomore Jade Rogers will both miss the entire 2011-12 season.

Considine suffered a torn Achilles tendon during preseason workouts. Rogers had surgery to repair an injured knee.
