THE SETTING

The No. 8 seed Iowa Hawkeyes (19-13) will face the No. 9 seed Rutgers Scarlet Knights (19-14) Saturday in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Tip-off is slated for 7:16 p.m. (CT) on the campus of Stanford University.

ON YOUR TELEVISION

Iowa's NCAA Tournament first round game will be televised by ESPN2 in a whip-around format with home market protection. If ESPN2 does not cover Iowa's game in your market, it can be seen for free on espn360.com.

Terry Gannon and Mary Murphy will call the action.

ON YOUR RADIO

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call all NCAA Tournament games for the Hawkeye Radio Network. The games can be heard on AM-800 KXIC, AM-600 WMT, AM-1040 WHO and also on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his sixth season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her fifth year providing analysis.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,034 games, since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 629-405 (.608). That includes a 318-158 (.668) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 297-87 (.773) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

HAWKEYE NCAA TOURNAMENT FACTS

- Iowa is 16-18 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Hawkeyes have advanced to the Sweet 16 five times, the Elite 8 three times and also played in the 1993 Final Four.
- Iowa is an eight seed for the second-straight season. In 2009, Iowa earned a No. 8 seed for the first time in school history, falling to No. 9 seed Georgia Tech, 62-76, in first round action in Iowa City.
- Iowa is 7-4 in NCAA Tournament first round games. Iowa's last first round win was in 2001 (89-82 in overtime vs. Oregon).
- The Hawkeyes have never played on the campus of Stanford University. Iowa does have previous NCAA Tournament experience in the state of California. The Hawkeyes played two NCAA Tournament games in Long Beach in 1988, defeating Southern Cal (76-67) in the Sweet 16 and losing to Long Beach State (78-98) in the Elite 8.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Iowa is 0-2 all-time vs. Rutgers. The Scarlet Knights won 57-51 on Dec. 4, 2005 in the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge in Iowa City. Rutgers followed the next year with a 70-53 win on Dec. 12, 2006 in New Jersey.

RUTGERS VS. IOWA NOTES

- The Scarlet Knights are coached by former Iowa Coach C. Vivian Stringer. Stringer was Iowa's head coach from 1983-95, posting a 269-84 overall record and a 169-45 Big Ten mark. Stringer led Iowa to two outright Big Ten titles and Iowa shared the Big Ten title on four occasions under her direction. She led Iowa to nine-straight NCAA Tournament appearances and a Final Four berth in 1993. She was the Big Ten Coach of the Year in 1991 and 1993. Stringer is a member of the UI Varsity Club Hall of Fame, the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder ranks second in all-time wins at Iowa, with 188 victories as a Hawkeye. Stringer is Iowa's all-time winningest coach, with 269 victories.
- Rutgers Director of Basketball Operations Michelle Edwards played at Iowa under Stringer (1984-88). She is third in career scoring at Iowa with 1,821 points. Edwards was a consensus all-American, and is the only player in Iowa women's basketball history to have her number retired.
- Iowa is 19-10 all-time against Big East opponents, having played 10 of the 16 teams.
- Iowa is 1-2 vs. the Big East in NCAA Tournament games, with a win over DePaul in 1996 (in Iowa City) and losses at Connecticut in 1997 and 2002.
- Iowa and Rutgers played two common opponents this season. Iowa lost to Boston College (67-72) in Iowa City and Rutgers defeated Boston College (59-53) at home. The Hawkeyes lost to West Virginia (66-69) in the Nugget Classic (Reno). Rutgers was swept by West Virginia, dropping a road contest (51-55) and a second round game of the Big East Tournament (49-56).
- Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder is 0-5 all time vs. Stringer, including an 0-3 mark when Stringer was at Iowa and Bluder was at Drake.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

This year marks the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in post-season play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa is guaranteed to finish with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

HOT AT THE RIGHT TIME

The Hawkeyes have won nine of their last 12 games, with two of those losses coming to Big Ten champion Ohio State by a combined six points (four-point loss in Columbus, two point loss in Big Ten Tournament championship game). Iowa jumped from last place in the Big Ten (1-6 entering game at Illinois Jan. 21), to a tie for third place.

KREI HITS STRIDE LATE IN THE SEASON

Sophomore Kelly Krei emerged as a scoring threat for Iowa in its last six games.

Krei, who averages 8.8 points per game, scored 13 or more points in four of Iowa's last six contests, including a career-high 20 points against Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals.

Over the six-game stretch, Krei is shooting a blistering .440 from the field (22-50), including an impressive .455 from three-point distance (15-33). Krei has only missed two free throws over the six-game stretch as well (13-15, .867).

In Iowa's last 12 games, Krei has made at least two three-pointers seven times, including five against Penn State and four against Ohio State in the Big Ten Tournament. She has also reached double figures in scoring five times in the last 12 games, with Iowa winning three of those five contests.

KASH IN THE BANK

- As a 5-9 guard, junior Kachine Alexander ranks second in the Big Ten and 17th nationally with 10.7 rebounds per game.
- Alexander claimed the Big Ten rebounding title, averaging 11.1 boards per game in league games.
- Alexander is the top rebounding guard in the country under 5-10, and is one of only two guards in the entire country to average a double-double (15.5 points, 10.7 rebounds per game). She is also one of only three Big Ten players to average a double-double, with the other two being post players.
- Alexander has 15 double-doubles this season and 24 in her career.
- Alexander has scored double figures in 20 of 25 games played, including seven 20-plus point performances. She has 10 or more rebounds in 17 of those games, with an impressive 10 games with 12 or more boards.

BALANCE SCORING EQUALS SUCCESS

Iowa has had 13 games this season where four or more players scored double figures. In those 13 games, the Hawkeyes are a perfect 13-0.

Four or more Hawkeyes have scored 10 or more points in four of Iowa's last seven games.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 10th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 26th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 544-264 (.673), including a 188-122 (.606) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

GET TO 70 POINTS

If Iowa scores 70 or more points, chances are the Hawkeyes will walk away with a victory. Iowa is 15-2 when reaching the 70-point mark, including a 3-1 record when hitting 80 points. Iowa's only losses when scoring 70 more points both came on the road. The Hawkeyes dropped an overtime contest at Penn State (73-77) and a game at Big Ten champion Ohio State (82-86).

GOING DOWNTOWN

The Hawkeyes drained at least 10 three-pointers in five games this year, coming away with victories in three of those contests.

Iowa tied the school record for three's made in a single game against Columbia and Illinois, winning both games. The Hawkeyes also nailed 10 treys in a win over Minnesota. Iowa hit 11 three-pointers in losses at Penn State and Ohio State.

HAWKEYES BREAK NUMEROUS INDIVIDUAL RECORDS

Members of the Iowa women's basketball team have either set or tied many individual records this season.

- Morgan Johnson broke both the school and freshmen record for single-season blocks. Johnson currently has 77 blocks, breaking the previous records held by Tangela Smith (73, 1994-95).
- Jaime Printy shattered the freshmen scoring record at Iowa. Printy broke the previous record (Lisa Becker, 416 points, 1983-84) against Indiana Feb. 25. She currently has 477 points.
- Printy also set the freshmen record for three-pointers made Feb. 4 at Ohio State. She broke Lindsey Meder's record of 49, set during the 1998-99 season. Printy currently has 78 made treys.
- Printy holds the freshmen assists record as well. She set the record against Ohio State in the Big Ten Tournament championship game March 7. Printy has 95 assists, breaking Cara Consuegra's previous record of 94 (1997-98).
- Sophomore Kamille Wahlin now holds the record for three-pointers made by a sophomore. She broke Wendy Ausdemore's previous record of 62 made three's set during the 2006-07 season, Feb. 18 vs Minnesota. Wahlin has made 81 three-pointers this season.
- Junior Kachine Alexander broke the junior rebounding record, previously held by Shanda Berry (263, 1987-88). Alexander has 267 boards this season.
- Wahlin went 7-15 from three-point range against Penn State Dec. 28, which set a new school record for three-point attempts in a game and tied the school record for three-pointers made in a single game.
- Junior Kachine Alexander set two school records and a Big Ten mark from the free throw line Feb. 14 vs. Illinois. Alexander was 17-20 from the charity stripe, setting new school marks for makes and attempts. In addition, her 17 made free throws are the most by a single player in a Big Ten game.
- Freshman Morgan Johnson broke both the school and Carver-Hawkeye Arena record for blocks in a single game with eight against Minnesota Feb. 18. The previous record was seven, which she had already tied twice.

TEAM RECORDS FALLING, TOO

- The 2009-10 Hawkeyes have also put their name in the team records book as well.
- Iowa shattered the single season record for three-pointers made and attempted. Iowa has made 252 treys and attempted 683. The previous mark for made three-pointers was 199 and attempts was 554, both set during the 2001-02 season.
 - The Hawkeyes broke the school record for team blocks in a single game with 13 against Minnesota Feb. 18. The old mark was 12, set at Drake in 2009.
 - Iowa tied the school record for three-pointers made in a game twice, by draining 12 triples Nov. 28 vs. Columbia and vs. Illinois Feb. 14. Iowa's 34 three-point attempts at Penn State Dec. 28 also tied a school record.
 - Iowa went a perfect 16-16 from the free throw line against Columbia Nov. 28, which tied the school record for team free throw percentage (1.000). In addition, Iowa set a new mark for free throw percentage (minimum 20 attempts) vs. Penn State in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament (21-22, .955).

CLIMBING THE RECORDS LADDER

- Johnson's 209 rebounds are third among freshman. She trails Cindy Haugejorde (237) for second place.
- Kamille Wahlin currently ranks sixth in sophomore scoring with 450 points. She trails Toni Foster (475) for eighth place.

LEADING THE LEAGUE

Several Hawkeyes finished the Big Ten schedule a top of statistical categories, and are currently leading in overall stats.

- Junior Kachine Alexander claimed the Big Ten rebounding crown, averaging 11.1 boards per contest in league games. She also finished first in defensive rebounds (8.12 per game).
- Sophomore Kamille Wahlin topped the conference with 2.59 made three-pointers per game.
- Freshman Morgan Johnson led the entire conference in field goal percentage, shooting .508 from the field.
- As a team, the Hawkeyes made more treys per game (7.72) than any other league opponent during the conference season.
- In all games, Alexander ranks first in offensive rebounds (3.32).
- Jaime Printy currently leads the conference in free throw percentage (.878).
- Wahlin tops the conference in three-pointers made per game (2.61).
- Iowa tops the conference in free throw percentage (.772) and three's made per game (7.88).

ONE, TWO FROM THREE

Kamille Wahlin and Jaime Printy are proving to be a potent one-two punch from behind the three-point arc.

The duo ranks first and second, respectively, in the Big Ten in three pointers made per game. Wahlin leads the league with 2.61 per game, while Printy is second at 2.44.

ROOKIES ON TOP

Freshmen Jaime Printy and Morgan Johnson wrapped up the conference season with some pretty impressive figures compared to their young counterparts.

Printy led all freshmen in scoring (15.8) and free throw percentage (.836), while Johnson led the way in rebounds (6.6), field goal percentage (.508) and blocks (2.61).

HAWKEYES PUT NAME IN BIG TEN TOURNAMENT RECORDS BOOK

Iowa shattered one Big Ten Tournament record and tied two more in its impressive run to the championship game.

- The Hawkeyes set a new Big Ten Tournament record by attempted 70 three-pointers. The previous record was 60, held by Purdue in the 1996 tournament.
- Iowa's 11 made three-pointers against Penn State in the quarterfinals tied a tournament record for three's made in a single game.
- Kachine Alexander was a perfect 15-15 from the free throw line in the Big Ten Tournament, tying the record for individual free throw percentage. Alexander is the fifth player in Big Ten Tournament history to shoot 1.000 from the free throw line while attempting at least 10 free throws.

TAKING ADVANTAGE OF FREE THROWS

Iowa, under Head Coach Lisa Bluder, is proving to be one of the best free throw shooting teams in the country.

The Hawkeyes have ranked in the top 10 in the nation three of the past four seasons. Iowa finished the 2005-06 season ranked 10th (.760), 2006-07 ranked fifth (.788) and also ranked fifth (.792) last season.

The 2009-10 campaign is no different. Iowa ranks seventh in free throw percentage across the NCAA (.772).

UNDERCLASSMEN CONTRIBUTING

Iowa's freshman and sophomore classes are putting up big numbers for the Hawkeyes this season.

Hawkeye underclassmen are responsible for 80 percent of the teams' points and minutes played.

In addition, Iowa fields the youngest starting lineup in the Big Ten, with two freshmen, two sophomores and one junior.

OH, SO CLOSE

Nine of Iowa's 13 losses have been by six points or less, with three of those being by three points. Iowa has also lost two overtime games by a combined seven points.

- The Hawkeyes had a three-point attempt at the buzzer against West Virginia fall short, that would have sent the game to overtime.
- Against Boston College (Dec. 2), Iowa missed a three-pointer with seven seconds left which would have tied the game.



- Against Michigan (Dec. 6), Iowa missed the front-end of a one-and-one from the free throw line with both 27 and 11 seconds left, each time trailing by only one point.
- Iowa's two overtime losses came at Penn State (Dec. 28, four point loss) and at Minnesota (Jan. 3, three point loss). In each of those games, the Hawkeyes had the potential game winning shot in regulation bounce off the iron as time expired.
- Iowa led by nine points with 9:48 remaining against Penn State (Jan. 14), but an 11-0 Lady Lion run gave them a 51-49 advantage with 7:13 left. Penn State took the lead for good with 5:36 left, as Iowa could only come within four points with 44 seconds left.
- The Hawkeyes had a 72-71 lead with 4:58 left at then-No. 8 ranked Ohio State, but couldn't hold on to the win, losing by four points.
- Iowa dropped a six-point decision at Northwestern. The Hawkeyes trailed by only two with 13 seconds remaining, but clutch free throw shooting by Northwestern dealt Iowa the loss.
- Iowa lost a two-point game against then-No. 10 ranked Ohio State in the Big Ten Tournament championship.
- In addition, Iowa led No. 19 Kansas by three points (54-51) with 6:41 remaining in the game, but the Jayhawks closed the contest with a 15-1 run.

FOUR HAWKEYES EARN ALL-BIG TEN HONORS

The 2009-10 all-Big Ten awards were announced March 1, with Head Coach Lisa Bluder, freshman Jaime Printy, junior Kachine Alexander and sophomore Kamille Wahlin taking home honors.

Bluder was named Big Ten Coach of the Year by the media, while Printy was tabbed Big Ten Freshman of the Year by both the league coaches and media. Printy was also a media second team all-Big Ten pick, a third team coaches all-Big Ten selection, and was a unanimous selection on the coaches all-Freshmen team.

Alexander was a first team all-Big Ten pick by the coaches and a second team all-Big Ten honoree by the league media. Alexander was also selected to the coaches' all-Defensive team. Wahlin was a third team all-Big Ten selection by both the coaches and media.

THREE HAWKEYES OUT FOR SEASON

Senior JoAnn Hamlin, sophomore Hannah Draxten and freshman Theairra Taylor will all miss the season with injuries.

Hamlin has missed the entire season after having a blood clot removed in her right leg. Taylor suffered a torn ACL in Iowa's win over South Dakota State (Dec. 22). Draxten has played four games this season, despite suffering from a herniated disc. It was announced after Iowa's loss at Penn State that Draxten would be forced to miss the rest of the season due to the back injury.

ALEXANDER NAMED BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Kachine Alexander was named Big Ten Player of the Week for the second time this season Feb. 15.

The Minneapolis, MN, native averaged 22.5 points and 11 rebounds in wins at Indiana and at home against Illinois. She shot .579 from the field and .875 from the free throw line. She scored 21 points and grabbed 16 rebounds at Indiana, and followed with 24 points, six rebounds and six assists against Illinois.

Alexander first received the award Nov. 16, after earning MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge. She tied a Hawkeye Challenge tournament record by grabbing 18 rebounds (nine offensive, nine defensive), along with netting 19 points in Iowa's season-opening win over Santa Clara. Both her 19 points and 18 rebounds were game highs.

Alexander followed on Sunday with a 21 point, 12 rebound (nine offensive, three defensive) performance in the championship game against Illinois State. Alexander was clutch down the stretch at the free-throw line, making 13-16 attempts from the charity stripe.

Hawkeyes Ink Talented Recruit

Jade Rogers has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa next fall.

"We are eager to have Jade Rogers join our team," Bluder said. "Jade is a tremendous kid that loves the game, and has grown up as a Hawkeye fan. Jade will be a versatile player that can play a number of positions. She can post up or she can shoot the long ball. She is also a good rebounder. Jade has had a great career at Cedar Rapids Kennedy, and is looking forward to continuing her career as a Hawkeye."

Rogers, a 5-11 forward, is from nearby Hiawatha, IA, and attends Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School. She led the state in scoring (22.3) and rebounding (13.4) as a sophomore, and was named the Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year. She also earned first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference honors.

Rogers suffered an ACL injury during the summer of 2008, but returned to the court and helped lead Kennedy to the semifinal round of the state tournament. Rogers played in 17 games as a junior and averaged 17.9 points and 10.6 rebounds. She was named first team all-state, all-district, all-metro and all-conference, along with being named to the state tournament all-tournament team.

As a freshman, Rogers earned second team all-state honors, along with first team all-district, all-metro and all-conference recognition.

Rogers currently has 1,089 points (18.5 per game average), which is fourth on the all-time scoring list at Kennedy. She also holds school records for single-game rebounds (20), single-season rebounds per game (12.6) and is on pace to become Kennedy's career rebounding leader. Rogers is also a three-time team captain.

Rogers has also lettered in volleyball. She helped lead the Kennedy volleyball team to a state tournament appearance this year.

PRINTY EARN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

Jaime Printy was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week for the fourth time this season, Feb. 15.

Printy averaged 22.5 points along with 4.5 rebounds in Iowa's wins at Indiana and over Illinois. She scored a career-high 28 points at Indiana, and netted 17 points vs. Illinois.

Printy led the Hawkeyes to back-to-back conference wins, as Iowa defeated Illinois in Champaign, and knocked off Northwestern in Iowa City. The Marion, IA, native averaged 22.5 points on the week, and shot a blistering .522 (12-23) from the field, including .400 (4-10) from three-point range and .850 (17-20) from the charity stripe. Printy led Iowa with 22 points at Illinois, including 8-8 from the free throw line, which set career highs in both makes and attempts. She also added four rebounds, four assists and two steals. Against Northwestern, Printy led the Hawkeyes with 23 points on 6-10 shooting, and played 38 minutes in the win.

Printy first earned the award Nov. 30, after a stellar performance against William & Mary, and an impressive two-game stretch at the Nugget Classic in Reno, NV. Her second accolade came Jan. 4, after the Hawkeyes defeated Wisconsin and dropped a tough overtime game at Minnesota. Her third honor came Jan. 25 after wins over Illinois and Northwestern.

JOHNSON EARN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

Morgan Johnson was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week (Feb. 1) for her efforts in Iowa's win against Purdue.

Johnson led Iowa against the Boilermakers with her third career double-double. The Platte City, MO, native netted 16 points and 11 rebounds, and finished 7-8 from the field. She made her first seven shots of the game before missing her final attempt at the 2:10 mark in the second half. Johnson added two blocks in 24 minutes of action.

ALEXANDER NAMED TO ALL-REGION TEAM

IOWA CITY – Junior Kachine Alexander has been named to the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) all-Region team. Alexander is one of only five players selected to the Region 6 team, and one of only 52 Division I women's basketball players to earn the award.

Alexander is now eligible for the State Farm Coaches' all-America team. The all-America committee will trim the list to 40 finalists Tuesday, March 23. Those 40 finalists will all be in the running for selection to the 10-member State Farm Coaches' all-America team.

Alexander was a first team all-Big Ten selection and was also one of five players named to the Big Ten all-Defensive team. She leads the Hawkeyes with 15.5 points and 10.7 rebounds per contest. The Minneapolis, MN, native claimed the Big Ten rebounding title, averaging 11.1 boards per game in league games. She is one of only two guards in the country to average a double-double, and ranks 17th nationally in rebounding.

Alexander has 15 double-doubles this season, which is one shy of tying the school record for single-season double-doubles held by Amy Herrig. She became Iowa's all-time leading rebounder among juniors this season, and currently has 267 boards.

Four players from the Big Ten were chosen to the Region 6 squad. Alexander was joined by Ohio State's Samantha Prahalis and Jantel Lavender along with Illinois' Jenna Smith. Missouri State's Casey Garrison was also included on the team.

Alexander is the 13th Hawkeye in school history to earn all-region honors. She is also the fifth player to earn the award under Head Coach Lisa Bluder, joining Cara Consuegra (2001), Jennie Lillis (2003), Crystal Smith (2006) and Kristi Smith (2008).

Alexander and the Hawkeyes are a No. 8 seed in the NCAA Tournament, and will take on No. 9 seed Rutgers Saturday at 7:16 p.m. (CT) regionally on ESPN2 and espn360.com in Stanford, CA.


