- Wednesday will be the seventh meeting between Iowa and Northern Illinois. Iowa leads the all-time series, 6-0.
- lowa has won 27 straight nonconference home games, a streak that dates back to November 2011 (Clemson). The active streak ties Wichita State and Oregon for 10th in the country.
- Iowa is scheduled to play three home games in six days this week.
- Junior Mike Gesell tallied season highs in points (15), steals (3), 3-pointers (3-of-3) and rebounds (4) in Monday's win over Pepperdine.
- Aaron White was named to the 2K Classic All-Tournament team after averaging a doubledouble against No. 10 Texas and No. 23 Syracuse in New York (19 points and 10 rebounds).
- Junior Jarrod Uthoff is averaging 14.3 points and 6.7 rebounds the last three games.
- Adam Woodbury averaged 11 points and 6.5 rebounds in lowa's two games in New York.
- Iowa is 36-6 when scoring 80 points or more, the last five seasons. The Hawkeyes are 42-1 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last five years.
- Aaron White scored 17 points vs. Pepperdine to raise his career scoring total to 1,385 points and surpass Ed Horton (1,372 points) for 15th place on Iowa's all-time scoring chart.

HAWKEYES TOP PEPPERDINE

- lowa used an 11-0 run in the second half to pull away and defeat Pepperdine, 72-61.
- Three Hawkeyes scored in double figures: Aaron White (17), Jarrod Uthoff (15), and Mike Gesell (15).
- Mike Gesell posted season highs in points (15), steals (3), rebounds (4), and 3-pointers (3-of-3).
- lowa's defense forced 19 turnovers and converted the miscues into 22 points. The Hawkeyes were credited with a season-best 12 steals. lowa ranks second in the Big Ten in steals per game (9.4).
- Mike Gesell and Anthony Clemmons were a combined 5-of-6 (.833) from 3-point range.

ATTACKING THE RIM

Iowa's 27.2 free-throw attempts average last season, ranked 15th nationally. The Hawkeyes ranked ninth in the country in made free throws (20.0). Through five games this season, lowa is averaging 25.4 free throw attempts and 18.4 makes. Iowa has made as many free throws (92) as its opponents have attempted (92).

Aaron White is on pace to shatter the school's free-throw makes record. White currently ranks fifth with 441 career makes. White (604) is also climbing lowa's free-throw attempts chart, ranking sixth. He has averaged 9.3 attempts the last three games.

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his fifth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 19th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.

McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 32nd season as a collegiate coach in 2014, which includes 18 years as a head coach and 14 as an



assistant. McCaffery became one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

McCaffery, 54, holds a career mark of 328-245 (.572) and guided his teams to nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, three NIT). He is 77-65 (.542) at lowa.

Since taking over the lowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have increased their win total by 15 games. McCaffery coached lowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided the Black and Gold to back-to-back NIT appearances, including a runner-up finish in 2013.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past two seasons at Iowa and 14-of-18 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more six of the last eight seasons, including the last two at Iowa (2013 and 2014).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced Mc-Caffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by 57 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes won a school-record 18 home games a year ago.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-toback 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

SCOUTING NORTHERN ILLINOIS

Northern Illinois enters Wednesday's game against lowa with a 2-0 mark, notching wins over Aurora (86-56) and Idaho (78-67). Returning Mid-American Conference All-Freshman Team honoree Aaric Armstead averages a team-best 16.5 points, netting 10 of his 11 free throw attempts (91 percent) this season. Senior Jordan Threloff averages 14 points, shooting 69 percent (9-of-13) from the field, and pulling down a team-leading 12.5 rebounds.

The Huskies are coached by Mark Montgomery, who is in his fourth season at the helm. He began his career as a student-athlete (1988-92) at Michigan State. Following his collegiate career, Montgomery played four years of professional basketball in Europe. He began his coaching career at Central Michigan in 1997 before returning to his alma mater as an assistant coach in 2001. After six seasons as an assistant with the Spartans, he was elevated to associate head coach in 2007. Montgomery was hired by Northern Illinois in 2011 where he holds a 27-68 record.

2014 INDIVIDUAL HIGHLIGHTS

- Devyn Marble (first) and Aaron White (third) were all-conference honorees. Marble is lowa's first all-conference first-team honoree since Adam Haluska in 2007.
- Aaron White was the only player in the country to shoot better than 55 percent from the field and 80 percent from the free throw line in 2013-14. White, who amassed 1,301 points, became just the fourth Hawkeye to accumulate 1,300+ points as a junior, joining Roy Marble (1,441), Ronnie Lester (1,423) and Jess Settles (1,303).
- Junior Gabriel Olaseni was one of only four players in the country (minimum 160 rebounds) with more offensive rebounds (82) than defensive (81).
- Peter Jok shot at a 34.8 percent clip from 3-point range, which is eighth best for an Iowa freshman.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

In recognition of Mike Gesell's outstanding academic record in the Tippie College of Business at The University of Iowa, the junior has been invited to become a member of Beta Gamma Sigma, the National Scholastic Honor Society for business students. This honor is reserved for students who have earned GPAs that place them in the top 10 percent of their class. The UI chapter, established in 1920, is one of the 10 oldest in the nation.

ROSTER CHANGES FOR 2014-15

Roy Devyn Marble, Melsahn Basabe, and Zach McCabe exhausted their eligibility after last season, while forwards Kyle Meyer and Darius Stokes transferred.

lowa welcomes five newcomers: Brady Ellingson, Trey Dickerson, Dom Uhl, and walkons Nicholas Baer and Charlie Rose.

After spending the last three seasons as a walk-on, guard Kyle Denning has been rewarded with a scholarship for his senior season by head coach Fran McCaffery.

UTHOFF PRODUCING ON THE WING

Jarrod Uthoff ranks second in team scoring (13.6 ppg) and first in steals (1.8) through five games. The redshirt junior averaged 14 points, six rebounds, and three steals in lowa's two games in New York. He has drained two 3-pointers or more in 4-of-5 games. Uthoff is shooting at a 47 percent clip (25-of-53) from the field, including 48 percent (11-of-23) from 3-point territory. He drained a personal-best four triples in lowa's victory over Hampton (Nov. 14). Uthoff has reached double figures in four of lowa's first five contests. The native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, tallied 15 points, grabbed eight rebounds and had three assists in Iowa's win over Pepperdine.

STRONG START FOR WOODBURY

Center Adam Woodbury averaged 5.7 points and 3.9 rebounds last year as a sophomore. So far through five games as a junior, Woodbury is averaging 9.2 points and 6.6 rebounds. He is shooting 56 percent (20-of-36) from the field this year.

GESELL JOINS ELITE GROUP

Through two seasons, Mike Gesell became just the third Hawkeye to ever amass 550+ points, 200+ assists, 150+ rebounds and 75+ steals. Gesell has 553 points, 217 assists, 155 rebounds and 83 steals. Gesell joins Jeff Horner (632 points, 204 assists, 292 rebounds and 78 steals) and Dean Oliver (631 points, 267 assists, 184 rebounds and 93 steals).

Point guard Mike Gesell scored in double figures in seven of the last 11 games in 2014, which included a stretch of five straight games -- the longest stretch of his career.

In 33 games, Gesell ranked first in the Big Ten and 12th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.0).

Gesell leads the team in assists (4.0) through five games this year.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,646 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,553-1,093 (.587). That includes a 992-349 (.740) record in home games, a 557-741 (.429) record in contests away from lowa City, a 729-746 (.494) mark in Big Ten games and a 396-123 (.763) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.







WHITE HOT

Aaron White ranks first among active Big Ten players in rebounding (697) and is fourth in scoring (1,385).

White ranks first on the team in rebounding (8.8) and scoring (16.8), and second in assists (3.0) through five games in 2014-15. White is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to lead the team in scoring and rebounding since Greg Brunner in 2006 (14.1 points and 9.2 rebounds per game).

White was the only Big Ten player to average 13+ points and 7+ rebounds during league play in 2014. White became the first Hawkeye ever to register 1,300+ points, 650+ rebounds, 100+ steals and 100+ assists by his junior season.

White was the only player in the country to shoot better than 55 percent from the field and 80 percent from the foul line in 2014. He shot 58 percent from the field and 81 percent from the charity stripe.

White became the fifth player, since 1960, to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding three consecutive seasons. White joins Don Nelson (1960-62); Kevin Kunnert (1971-73); Bruce King (1975-77); and Greg Brunner (2004-06). He is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to ever lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding all four seasons.

White became the 41st Hawkeye to surpass 1,000 career points with his 19th point scored with one second remaining at the free throw line versus Notre Dame (Dec. 3). He reached the 1,000-point milestone in his 82nd career game. He currently ranks 15th in Iowa scoring.

BLOCK PARTY

Junior Gabriel Olaseni blocked at least three shots five times last season. His 43 blocks ranked 10th in the Big Ten (1.3 average). Sophomore Jarrod Uthoff denied 34 shots (1.1 average), a total that ranked 11th in the league. Olaseni denied a game-high four shots in lowa's season-opening triumph over Hampton. He leads the Hawkeyes averaging 2.2 rejections per game. Uthoff ranks second in blocks (1.2), rejecting at least one shot in 4-of-5 games.

As a team, lowa ranked second in the Big Ten, and 40th nationally, in rejections (5.0) in 2013-14.


