Game #30 Opening Tip

- Tuesday will be the only regular season meeting between Iowa and Indiana. Iowa and Indiana State met only once last year, with that game also played in Bloomington (Indiana won, 93-86).
- According to ESPN, Iowa's strength of schedule ranks 28th strongest in the country, which ranks third among Big Ten teams (Wisconsin - 20; Michigan State - 23).
- Junior Mike Gesell was named third team Academic All-America (3.93 GPA) last week.
- Iowa is 18-1 this year when scoring 64+ points, with the lone loss coming to Iowa St. (90-75).
- Aaron White combined to score 50 points and 23 rebounds in Iowa's two wins last week (25 ppg and 11.5 rpg). White's performances garnered the senior BIG Player of the Week honors.
- Iowa is 6-3 in road games this season, with five of the wins coming in league play. The six overall road wins tie Michigan State for second best in the Big Ten (Wisconsin - eight). Iowa's six road victories are the most by a Hawkeye team since the 2002-03 campaign.
- In Iowa's two wins last week (Illinois and Penn State), Iowa's senior class combined for 88 points (Aaron White 50, Gabriel Olaseni 20, and Josh Oglesby 18).
- Iowa is averaging a double-double out of its center position of Adam Woodbury and Gabriel Olaseni. The duo combine to average 15 points and 10 rebounds.

Iowa (19-10, 10-6), winners of six of its eight games and four straight, travels to Bloomington, Indiana, Tuesday to face Indiana (19-10, 9-7). Tipoff is slated for 6:04 p.m. (CT) at Assembly Hall.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

TV: Tuesday night's game will be televised nationally on ESPN (WATCHESPN). Mike Tirico, Dan Dakich, and Quint Kessenich will call the action.

HAWKEYES WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT GAME, OUTLAST PENN STATE

- Iowa won its fourth straight game Saturday evening with an 81-77 triumph in overtime at Penn State. The win was the Hawkeyes' first ever overtime win in State College.
- The win improved Iowa's league record to 10-6. It marks the most conference wins during the Fran McCaffery era (2010-present).
- Five Hawkeyes posted double figures: Aaron White (21), Mike Gesell (14), Gabriel Olaseni (12), Josh Oglesby (12), and Jarrod Uthoff (11). Oglesby's 12 was a season high, bolstered by a season-high four 3-pointers.
- Aaron White became just the third Hawkeye to register 21+ points and 14+ rebounds in a Big Ten road game since 1996-97 (Jared Reiner at Indiana in 2003 and Greg Brunner at Indiana in 2004). White also grabbed a season-high 14 rebounds to go along with his 21 points. It is White's team-best third double-double of the year and 15th of his career.
- The Hawkeyes made their first 14 free throws of the contest and seven of eight in overtime. Iowa was 25-of-27 (.926) from the charity stripe for the game. Gabriel Olaseni was a perfect 8-of-8, while Aaron White was 6-of-6 the last 29 seconds in overtime.
- Guard Mike Gesell registered 14 points, seven assists, and a career-high five steals.
- Iowa (8-of-21, .381) improved to 8-1 this season when making at least eight triples.

NUMBER OF THE WEEK -- 4

- Iowa has won four straight contests, dating back to Feb. 19.
- Iowa's overtime victory over Penn State on Saturday was the Hawkeyes' fourth consecutive over the Nittany Lions.

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery, who is signed through the 2020 season, is in his fifth season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 19th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 32nd season as a collegiate coach in 2014, which includes 18 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant. McCaffery became one of 12 coaches to lead four different Division I teams to the NCAA Tournament in 2014.

McCaffery, 55, holds a career mark of 344-250 (.579) and guided his teams to nine postseason appearances (six NCAA, three NIT). He is 93-73 (.560) at Iowa.

Since taking over the Iowa program in 2010, the Hawkeyes have increased their win total by 15 games. McCaffery coached Iowa to 25 victories in 2013, equaling the second-most win total in program history. McCaffery has guided the Black and Gold to back-to-back NIT appearances, including a runner-up finish in 2013.

McCaffery has posted upper division finishes in each of the past two seasons at Iowa and 14-of-18 seasons as a head coach. He has posted 20 wins or more six of the last eight seasons, including the last two at Iowa (2013 and 2014).

McCaffery and the Hawkeyes have made Carver-Hawkeye Arena one of the most feared arenas to play nationally. Fans have embraced McCaffery and his team's style of play with attendance increasing by 57 percent since 2010. The Hawkeyes won a school-record 18 home games a year ago.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title 2008-10.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

ALL-TIME SERIES RECORDS

Indiana holds a 98-74 advantage in the series that began with an 18-12 Hoosier win in 1909. Iowa won five of six between 2010-12 before Indiana won the last three meetings.

Indiana holds a 58-28 advantage in games played at Bloomington. The Hoosiers have won the last three games played at Assembly Hall. Last year's game was originally scheduled for Feb. 18, but due to Assembly Hall roof damage, the Hawkeyes and Hoosiers rescheduled the contest for Feb. 27, which Indiana won 93-86.

SCOUTING INDIANA

- Indiana has alternated wins and losses its last nine games, dating back to Jan. 28. The Hoosiers lost their last contest at Northwestern (72-65) on Feb. 25.
- The Hoosiers are 15-2 at home this season, including a 6-1 mark at Assembly Hall during league play. Indiana's two defeats at home this season came to Eastern Washington (88-86 on Nov. 24) and Purdue (67-63 on Feb. 19).
- Indiana is 6-3 in Big Ten games decided by eight points or fewer. After winning their first six by eight points or less, the Hoosiers have dropped their last three.
- Indiana has had a week to prepare for the Hawkeyes, losing its last game (72-65) to Northwestern on Feb. 25 in Evanston, Illinois. Indiana drained 12 triples, but were 7-of-16 (.438) from the free throw line. Northwestern shot 51 percent from the field (25-of-49). Indiana's Troy Williams posted a double-double (21 points and 14 rebounds).
- The Hoosiers have three players average double figures: Yogi Ferrell (16.0 ppg), James Blackmon (15.8 ppg), and Troy Williams (13.7 ppg). Ferrell also leads the squad in assists (146). Williams leads the team in rebounding (7.0) and steals (30).
- Three Hoosiers have made 50+ 3-pointers: Yogi Ferrell (70), James Blackmon (65), and Nick Zeisloft (51). Indiana's 9.3 triples made per game ranks ninth in the country, while its 41 percent (271-of-659) shooting behind the arc ranks fourth best in the nation.
- Yogi Ferrell's free throw percentage (.870, 87-of-100) ranks 45th in the country, while Troy Williams's field goal percentage (.577, 146-of-253) ranks 19th nationally.
- Indiana concludes its regular season with two games at home, beginning Tuesday with Iowa. The Hoosiers will play their home finale Saturday against Michigan State.
- The Hoosiers average 16,149 in their 17 previous home games.

LAST MEETING AGAINST INDIANA

Indiana beat the Hawkeyes, 93-86, in a rescheduled game due to Assembly Hall roof damage on Feb. 27, in Bloomington, Indiana. Iowa had three players score in double figures: Roy Devyn Marble (20), Aaron White (19) and Melsahn Basabe (14). Aaron White controlled a game-high 10 rebounds to go along with his 19 points. Iowa outrebounded Indiana by seven (40-33). The Hawkeyes netted 52 points in the paint in defeat.

UTHOFF, GESELL EARN ACADEMIC DISTINCTION

Juniors Mike Gesell and Jarrod Uthoff were named Capital One Academic All-District first team honorees for their combined performance athletically and in the classroom. Gesell was also tabbed third team Academic All-America last week becoming the first Hawkeye to accomplish the national distinction since Adam Haluska (first team) in 2007.

Gesell, a native of South Sioux City, Nebraska, is a finance major maintaining a 3.93 grade point average. He leads the team in assists (109) and ranks seventh in the Big Ten in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.0). Gesell averages 7.4 points per game. Earlier this fall, Gesell earned invitation to Beta Gamma Sigma, the National Scholastic Honor Society for business students at the University of Iowa who have garnered GPA's that place them in the top 10 percent of their class.

Uthoff, a native of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, is an economics major with a 3.34 GPA. Uthoff ranks second in team scoring (12.0), rebounding (6.2), assists (56), and steals (31). He is the only Division I player with 45+ 3-pointers, 45+ blocks, and 30+ steals. He was named the Big Ten Player of the Week on Jan. 6, following his performances in Iowa wins over No. 18 Ohio State and Nebraska.

The Iowa women's basketball team also had two players recognized (Sam Logic and Ally Disterhoft). The University of Iowa is one of only two schools to have two men and two women's basketball student-athletes earn Academic All-District laurels.

SUCSESSEFUL FEBRUARY

Iowa was 6-2 in the month of February, marking the first time since 1989 that the Hawkeyes posted six wins during the shortest month of the year.

Iowa boasted a +12.3 scoring margin during the month of February, averaging 70.9 points per game, while allowing 58.6 points. The Hawkeyes shot 47 percent from the field and 39 percent from 3-point range in February. Jarrod Uthoff was 16-of-36 (.444) from 3-point territory, while Aaron White shot at an 84 percent clip (43-of-51) from the foul line in February.

FINDING WAYS TO SCORE

Aaron White ranks first in the country in highest percentage of points scored from free throws (minimum 425 total points). The Hawkeye senior has scored 168 of his 446 points (37.7 percent) from the charity stripe.

On Jan. 5 against Nebraska, White surpassed Roy Marble as Iowa's all-time leader in free throws. He currently ranks fourth in Big Ten annals and is 24 makes from equalling Kiwane Garrus of Illinois (615) for third in conference history.

White has attempted 10+ free throws in nine games this year, including the last two contests, and 15 times in his career. Only two active players in the nation have accomplished that feat more than White.

WHITE HOT

Aaron averaged 25 points and 11.5 rebounds in Iowa's two wins last week, which garnered the Hawkeye senior his first ever Big Ten Player of the Week honor.

White, who is fourth in Iowa history with 1,747 points, 868 rebounds, and 135 games played, ranks first among active conference players in rebounding (868) and is fourth in scoring (1,747). He is the only Hawkeye ever to amass 1,700+ points and 850+ rebounds.

White is one of 16 players named to the first-ever Karl Malone Award watch list. He ranks first on the team in rebounding (7.4), steals (1.3), and scoring (15.4), and is fifth in assists (1.5) this season. White is one of only two Big Ten players to average 15+ points and 7+ rebounds (Wisconsin's Frank Kaminsky). His rebounding and scoring averages rank third and eighth, respectively, in the Big Ten this year. White is seeking to become the first Hawkeye to lead the team in scoring and rebounding since Greg Brunner in 2006 (14.1 points and 9.2 rebounds per game).

White was the only Big Ten player to average 13+ points and 7+ rebounds during league play in 2014. White became the first Hawkeye ever to register 1,300+ points, 650+ rebounds, 100+ steals, and 100+ assists by his junior season.

White was the only player in the nation to shoot better than 55 percent from the field and 80 percent from the foul line in 2014. He shot 58 percent from the field and 81 percent from the charity stripe. Again this season, White is the only player in the nation to shoot better than 50 percent from the field (51.4 percent) and 80 percent from the charity stripe (81.6 percent).

White became the fifth player, since 1960, to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding three consecutive seasons. White joins Don Nelson (1960-62); Kevin Kunnert (1971-73); Bruce King (1975-77); and Greg Brunner (2004-06). He is seeking to become the first player all-time to lead the Hawkeyes in rebounding all four seasons.

In Iowa's 10 conference wins, White is averaging 18.7 points per game, compared to 8.8 in the six defeats (White saw limited action in loss at Purdue due to injury).

White currently ranks fourth in Iowa scoring; he is 22 points from surpassing Greg Stokes (1,768) for third all-time.

HAWKEYE FAST BREAKS

- Iowa is 15-1 this season when scoring 70+ points and 16-2 when shooting at a higher percentage than its opponents.
- The Hawkeyes have won six true road games this season. The last time Iowa won seven true road games was during the 1990-91 campaign.
- The Hawkeyes are 9-2 when Gabriel Olaseni scores in double figures this season.
- Iowa is 8-1 this season when sinking eight or more 3-pointers.
- Iowa is the only team post a win at Ohio State this year (18-1).
- Josh Oglesby is 6-of-10 (.600) from 3-point range the last two games combined.
- In conference statistics rankings, Iowa ranks fourth in field goal percentage (.454) and 3-point accuracy (.367).
- Junior guard Anthony Clemmons has amassed 19 assists and only five turnovers off the bench the last five games.
- Iowa has had fewer than 10 turnovers in nine games this year. Iowa had a season-low four turnovers at Northwestern (Feb. 15).
- Iowa has beaten Ohio State and Michigan both on the road in the same season for the first time since 1998-99.
- Iowa was the first team in the country to post road wins over two ranked opponents: No. 12 North Carolina (60-55) on Dec. 3 and No. 18 Ohio State (71-65) on Dec. 30.
- Iowa has nearly made (465) more free throws than its opponents have attempted (473).
- Iowa has reached sell out status in four games this season. The Hawkeyes average 14,025 fans through 17 home games.
- Aaron White's 29 points on Feb. 25, are the most by an Iowa player vs. Illinois since James Moses had 30 in 1991. Also, White became just the second player since 1997 to register 29+ points and 9+ rebounds against Illinois (Ohio State's Evan Turner in 2010).
- Iowa's 34-point win over Rutgers is the largest by a Big Ten team in league play this year and the biggest by an Iowa team in conference play since a 91-57 win over Northwestern in 1998.
- Iowa's 18-point win against Michigan in Ann Arbor is its largest since winning by 18 on Feb. 8, 1954.
- All five starters reached double figures at Michigan for the first time in a conference game since Feb. 7, 2004 (vs. Indiana).
- Adam Woodbury collected six assists to go along with his 11 points at Michigan. Woodbury became just the third Big Ten 7-footer to post 10+ points and 6+ assists in a game since 1996-97.

- Gabriel Olaseni scored 18 points in consecutive games against Nebraska (Jan. 5) and Michigan State (Jan. 8). The London native became just the fifth Big Ten player since 2006 to record back-to-back 18-point games off the bench (Indiana's Will Sheehey in 2012; Michigan's DeShawn Sims in 2008; Minnesota's Lawrence McKenzie in 2007; and Ohio State's Deaquan Cook in 2006).
- Iowa has had four players post two or more double-doubles this year (Adam Woodbury, Jarrod Uthoff, Gabriel Olaseni, and Aaron White). Iowa and Michigan State are the only Big Ten schools to have four players with multiple double-doubles this season.
- Iowa is 38-6 when scoring 80 points or more, the last five seasons. The Hawkeyes are 53-2 when holding opponents to fewer than 61 points, the last five years.

IMPROVED DEFENSE

After allowing 70.3 points a year ago, the Iowa defense has improved this season, allowing 8.3 fewer points per game (62.0). Also, opponents shot .415 from the field last season compared to .393 in 2014-15.

In Iowa's 18 wins, the Hawkeyes average 7.8 steals per game compared to 4.2 in their 10 defeats. The +3.6 steals per game difference in wins versus losses is second in the Big Ten behind Minnesota (+5.8). The +3.6 differential also is the eighth largest in the country.

Aaron White is the only active Division I player to have 1,700+ points, 850+ rebounds, 175+ assists, and 125+ steals. He is the only Hawkeye ever to post those numbers in the program's history.

Also, his 15 career double-doubles ranks second among active Big Ten players; Michigan State's Branden Dawson ranks first (18).

UTHOFF PRODUCING ON THE WING

Jarrod Uthoff ranks second in team scoring (12 ppg) and steals (1.1), and first in 3-point shooting (49-of-125, .392). He is the only Division I player to have 45+ 3-pointers, 45+ blocks and 30+ steals.

Uthoff has made 34 of his team-leading 49 3-pointers in Iowa's 19 victories. He is averaging a team-best 15.1 points per game, shooting 46 percent (43-of-93) from the field and 100 percent (16-of-16) from the foul line, in Iowa's eight conference road games, while averaging 11 points, shooting 40 percent (32-of-79) from the field, in its eight league home contests.

The redshirt junior, who has led the team in scoring in four of the last eight games, poured in a game and career-high 25 points in Iowa's loss at Northwestern (Feb. 15). His career-high fifth 3-pointer came with four seconds remaining in regulation to even the score and send the game to overtime.

The Cedar Rapids, Iowa, native was named Big Ten Player of the Week on Jan. 6 by the Big Ten Conference after his performance in Iowa's win at No. 18 Ohio State (Dec. 30) and vs. Nebraska (Jan. 5). Uthoff averaged 16.5 points, seven rebounds, and 3.5 blocks in those two games.

Iowa Signs 4 Prep Standouts

Brandon Hutton, Andrew Fleming, Isaiah Moss, and Ahmad Wagner have all signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa in 2014.

Hutton is a 6-foot-6, 210-pound forward from De La Salle High School in Chicago. He averaged 12 points, eight rebounds, four assists and two blocks while earning Chicago Catholic League All-Conference accolades last season. Hutton was also recognized on the 2014 Illinois Basketball Coaches Association third team all-state squad. He will be a two-time team captain and three-year varsity player once he begins his senior season. Hutton, a 2015 McDonald's All-American nominee, is also a leader off the court, being recognized on the honor roll and participating in a number of student groups.

Fleming helped lead Ensworth High School in Nashville, Tennessee, to three-straight state titles, earning all-tournament laurels on each championship team. He is a two-time All-State honoree, earning first team recognition as a junior and third team distinction his sophomore campaign. As a junior, Fleming was named Tennessee's Division II-AA Mr. Basketball and was tabbed the state championship Most Valuable Player. Fleming led the Region in scoring his sophomore (20.5 ppg) and junior (19.3 ppg) seasons. He scored 1,117 points in three seasons at Ensworth before playing his senior year of prep basketball at Oak Hill Academy (Virginia) for coach Steve Smith. Fleming is the Ensworth record holder for points (49) and 3-pointers (9) in a single-game.

Wagner, a native of Yellow Springs, Ohio, accumulated 686 points (shooting 61 percent from the field), 526 rebounds and 138 blocks his first three seasons at Wayne High School. As a junior, he averaged 15 points, 11 rebounds and four blocks, earning conference Player of the Year and honorable mention all-state laurels, as well as being recognized on the first team all-conference and all-division teams. The 6-foot-7, 215-pound forward was also his team's co-Most Valuable Player in 2014. A three-time team captain, he has also excelled in the classroom by maintaining a GPA above 3.5. Wagner also played on the All-Ohio Red AAU squad, who finished first in the division in the EYBL.

Moss averaged 10 points, two rebounds, two assists and one steal his junior year at Simeon High School in Chicago. The 6-foot-5, 175-pound wing averaged 16 points, six rebounds, three assists and two steals for the Mac Irvin Fire AAU team. Moss was instrumental in leading Mac Irvin Fire to the 2014 Big Foot Classic championship in Las Vegas. He also played for the Playground Elite AAU squad last July, averaging 17 points, six rebounds, three assists and three steals.

Uthoff drained four triples in Iowa's victory over Hampton (Nov. 14) and at No. 18 Ohio State (Dec. 30). He has reached double figures 19 times this season. He averages 14 points per contest over the last six games.

Uthoff tallied eight points and equaled career bests in rebounding (11) and blocked shots (five) in Iowa's win at No. 12 North Carolina. He had 22 points, five rebounds, four assists, and four blocks at Minnesota on Jan. 13. Uthoff became the first player to amass 22+ points, 5+ rebounds, 4+ assists, and 4+ blocks in a Big Ten contest since Minnesota's Joel Przybilla versus Iowa on Jan. 12, 2000.

Uthoff has two double-doubles this season (North Florida and Michigan State). He had 10 points and a personal-best 12 boards against North Florida (Dec. 22), and 12 points and a team-best 10 rebounds versus Michigan State (Jan. 8).

FRESH START

Sophomore Peter Jok made his first start of his career on Dec. 22 vs. North Florida. The native of West Des Moines, Iowa, has started the last 17 games, beginning with that North Florida contest.

Jok is averaging 7.3 points per game for the season and 8.7 points since being inserted into the starting lineup, which ranks third during the 17-game stretch. He has made at least one triple in 15 of the last 21 games, including multiple 3-pointers in five of the last eight contests.

Jok netted a career-high 16 points vs. Minnesota (Feb. 12) and 14 points against Nebraska (Feb. 22) in Lincoln.

IOWA VS. RANKED TEAMS

The Hawkeyes are 4-5 against opponents ranked in either the Associated Press or USA Today Coaches polls this season.

Iowa won at No. 12 North Carolina (60-55) on Dec. 3, at No. 18 Ohio State (71-65) on Dec. 30 and completing the season sweep against the 25th-ranked Buckeyes (76-67) in Iowa City on Jan. 17, and beat No. 16 Maryland (72-55) in Iowa City on Feb. 8. The Hawkeyes fell to No. 10 Texas (71-57) and No. 23 Syracuse (66-63) in New York City, at home to No. 13 Iowa State (90-75) and twice to No. 5 Wisconsin (82-50 on Jan. 20 and 74-63 on Jan. 31).

OLASENI: BIG SIXTH MAN OF THE YEAR CANDIDATE

Senior Gabriel Olaseni is a strong candidate for the conference's Sixth Man of the Year. Olaseni ranks third on the Hawkeyes in scoring (8.3), second in blocked shots (46) and free throw shooting (82-of-106), fourth in rebounding (4.8).

Olaseni denied a game-high four shots three times this season. He denied a career-high five shots in Iowa's win over Northern Illinois. His 42 blocks are the fifth most by a Hawkeye senior in program history.

WHITE NAMED TO KARL MALONE AWARD WATCH LIST

Iowa senior Aaron White is one of 16 players named to the first-ever Karl Malone Award watch list. Named after Hall of Famer and two-time NBA Most Valuable Player Karl Malone, the annual honor in its inaugural year recognizes the top power forwards in Division I men's college basketball.

White ranks third in the Big Ten in rebounding (7.4 rpg) and ninth in scoring (15.4 ppg). He is seeking to become the first Hawkeye in nine years to finish the season leading the team in scoring and rebounding (Greg Brunner in 2006). White is the only active Division I player, and the only Hawkeye ever, with 1,700+ points, 850+ rebounds, 175+ assists, and 125+ steals. The native of Strongsville, Ohio, is also the only Division I player to shoot better than 50 percent from the field and 80 percent from the free throw line the last two seasons. White ranks fourth in Iowa career rebounding (868) and scoring (1,747), 14th in double-doubles (15), and first in free throws made (591) and attempted (768).

Malone attended La. Tech due to its close proximity to his hometown of Summerfield, Louisiana. He led the Bulldogs to a Sweet 16 appearance and earned All-Southland honors in his three seasons while averaging 18.7 points and 9.3 rebounds per game. Malone

achieved great success during his 19 seasons in the NBA as a 14-time NBA All-Star (1988-98, 2000-02), 11-time All-NBA First Team player (1989-99) and a member of the NBA's 50th Anniversary All-Time Team. He also won two Olympic gold medals (1992, 1996).

White is one of three from the state of Iowa (UNI's Seth Tuttle and Georges Niang of Iowa State).
