Quick Hits

- The Hawkeyes are 8-0 at home this season, and 83-19 in their last 102 games inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.
- The Hawkeyes have won 8-of-10 overall. lowa entered the week as one of 14 teams nationally with 12 or more wins, and tied for the second-highest win total in the country this season.
- Penn State (9-3) is the defending Big Ten Conference champion. They are 1-1 in true road games this season.
- lowa is averaging 82.7 points and 19.3 assists per contest, leading the Big Ten in both categories. In addition, the Hawkeyes are 10th nationally in assists per game.
- lowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last 13 contests, including four in the loss at Indiana on Thursday (Logic 25, Doolittle 20, Disterhoft 13, Peschel 10).
- Four Hawkeyes are averaging double figures (Dixon, Logic, Doolittle, Disterhoft).
- Junior guard Samantha Logic -- the Big Ten leader in assists -- is averaging 19.3 points, 12 rebounds, and seven assists over the last three contests.
- After converting seven 3-pointers total during the first six games of the season (7-of-46), junior guard Melissa Dixon has made 38 over the last nine games (38-of-87).
- Lisa Bluder needs seven wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as lowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

The 22nd-ranked University of Iowa women's basketball team (12-3, 0-1) hosts No. 15/17 Penn State (9-3, 0-0) in its Big Ten home opener on Sunday. Tip is set for 2 p.m. (CT) on Mediacom Court at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

The Hawkeyes, 8-0 at home this season, have won 8-of-10 overall. lowa entered the week as one of 14 teams nationally with 12 or more wins, and tied for the second-highest win total in the country this season.

Tickets are \$10 for adults. Youth -- high school-aged and younger --- are admitted free to all weekday games, while weekend games are \$6. Youth -- five years old and younger -- are admitted free to all games, and UI students are admitted free. Tickets can be purchased online at hawkeyesports.com, over the phone at 1-800 IA-HAWKS, and at the UI Athletics Ticket Office in Carver-Hawkeye Arena

BE BOLD. WEAR GOLD:

Sunday's game has been designated as the 'Be Bold Wear Gold!' game. Fans are encouraged to wear gold, and the first 1,000 fans in attendance will be given gold poms poms. In addition, lowa women's basketball trading cards will be available for the first 500 fans.

Sunday's game can be seen locally in the state of lowa on Mediacom Connections (MC22) and online via <u>video.BTN.com</u> (Big Ten Digital Network). Rob Brooks and Shelley Till will call the action.

AUDIO COVERAGE:

Brent Balbinot and former Hawkeye Kristi Faulkner will call the action for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contest on AM-800 KXIC in Iowa City, AM-1360 KMJM in Cedar Rapids, AM-1040 WHO in Des Moines or on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his 10th season as Iowa's play-by-play voice.

IOWA HISTORY:

lowa has played 1,147 games since beginning basketball in 1974. lowa's overall record is 704-443 (.613). That includes a 348-179 (.662) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 343-97 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

SCOUTING PENN STATE:

- No. 15/17 Penn State is 9-3 overall, with losses to the two teams currently ranked the highest in the national polls (Connecticut, Notre Dame), and at South Dakota State.
- The Nittany Lions, the defending Big Ten champions, are the top rebounding team in the conference this season (45.4/game).
- Penn State is coached by Coguese Washington. In her seventh season at the helm of the program, she is 127-76 overall.
- Maggie Lucas, the 2012-13 Big Ten Player of the Year, leads Penn State and ranks second in the Big Ten in points per game (21.1). She is 13th in Big Ten history in scoring with 2,091 career points.
- The Nittany Lions are projected to start four seniors and a junior. Three of the five starters are 6-foot-3 or taller.

lowa captains are senior Theairra Taylor and junior Samantha Logic.

IOWA-PENN STATE NOTES:

- Penn State leads the all-time series, 25-17.
- The Nittany Lions claimed the only meeting last season, winning 81-69 on Feb. 14, 2013, in lowa City.
- lowa and Penn State have split the last six meetings in lowa City. The Nittany Lions have won the last three.
- Penn State has claimed the last four games overall in the series.

THE LAST MEETING:

A ninth double-double of the season by senior center Morgan Johnson and some sharp-shooting from long range by guard Melissa Dixon (4-of-9 from 3-point range) wasn't enough for lowa to overcome No. 8 Penn State last season in Iowa City.

The Nittany Lions led 37-34 at halftime, before using a 17-6 run during the second half on their way to an 81-69 victory inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

IOWA DROPS BIG TEN OPENER AT UNDEFEATED INDIANA:

Indiana made 11 3-point field goals and held on to defeat lowa, 86-84, on Wednesday in Assembly Hall in a Big Ten Conference opener for both teams. The Hoosiers snapped a seven-game losing streak in the series to improve to 14-0 on the season. While Indiana shot 47.8-percent from 3-point land, the Hawkeyes were 3-of-17 from long range (17.6 percent).

Samantha Logic led all players with 25 points, making 9-of-15 field goals and 6-of-7 free throws. She added 12 rebounds. Bethany Doolittle made 10-of-15 field goals for 20 points and six blocked shots before fouling out with 4:41 remaining. Ally Disterhoft (13) and Kali Peschel (10) also scored in double figures for the Hawkeyes.

IN THE RANKINGS:

lowa is ranked 22nd in The Associated Press Top 25 poll this week, and sits 23rd in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Six Iowa opponents are also ranked in the Associated Press/USA Today polls: Colorado (12/14), Iowa State (14/10), Penn State (15/17), Purdue (17/19), Nebraska (18/15), and Syracuse (20/24), In addition, Dayton and Indiana are receiving votes.

HAWKEYES IN BIG TEN PLAY:

lowa head coach Lisa Bluder, the dean of Big Ten coaches, is a three-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2001, 2008 and 2010). She has guided lowa to nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten in 13 seasons. Iowa won a share of the Big Ten regular season championship in 2008 and finished in a three-way tie for second in 2009.

NONCONFERENCE RECAP:

lowa's 12 wins prior to the start of conference play equaled the most in a season under head coach Lisa Bluder. Iowa finished 12-1 in its pre-conference slate during the 2010-11 campaign. The Hawkeyes were 11-3 prior to the start of league play last season, and 11-0 in 2004-05.

BALANCED ATTACK:

Five Hawkeyes are averaging at least 9.9 points per game: Samantha Logic (14.9), Melissa Dixon (14.8), Bethany Doolittle (13.9), Ally Disterhoft (11.9), and Theairra Taylor (9.9).

lowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last 13 contests, including four in the loss at Indiana (Logic 25, Doolittle 20, Disterhoft 13, Peschel 10).

CLIMBING TO THE TOP:

Lisa Bluder needs seven wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269) as lowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder -- one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins -- is 263-160 all-time as the Hawkeye head coach.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS:

- Samantha Logic is second in career assists (452). Cara Consuegra (1997-2001) is lowa's all-time assists leader (576).
- Melissa Dixon has 158 career 3-pointers, and ranks seventh in program history. Kelli Krei is sixth with 162.
- Bethany Doolittle is fifth all-time with 127 career blocks. Toni Foster is fourth with 145.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 14th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 30th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder has a career record of 619-302 (.673), including a 263-160 (.623) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is lowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins). She has guided the Hawkeyes to 12 postseason tournaments (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and taking home the conference tournament title in 2001.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became lowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball News Service and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, lowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

HAWKEYES CONTINUE TREND AGAINST RANKED FOES:

- lowa is 2-2 this season against ranked opponents:
 - W vs. No. 14 Dayton (97-93 in overtime) Nov. 10
 - L at No. 16 Colorado (90-87) Nov. 20
 - W vs. No. 22 Syracuse (97-91) Dec. 5
 - L at No. 11 Iowa State (83-70) Dec. 12
- The Hawkeyes have defeated nine top-25 opponents since the start of last season (9-6 record).
- lowa is averaging 87.8 points per game during its four contests against ranked teams this season.
- The Hawkeyes have recorded at least one win against a top-25 team in all but two seasons under Bluder. In nine of those seasons, lowa has knocked off at least one top-15 opponent.
- This year marked the seventh time in school history that lowa played at least three ranked teams prior to conference action. lowa faced five ranked opponents in 1990 (2-3 record) and three in 2012 (last year) (3-0), 1999 (0-3), 1995 (2-1), 1993 (3-0), and 1989 (1-2).
- Last season marked just the second time in school history that lowa defeated three ranked teams prior to Big Ten play (No. 12
 West Virginia, No. 22 lowa State, No. 20 Texas). The only other time lowa defeated three ranked opponents was in 1993 (No. 4
 Louisiana Tech, No. 20 Missouri State, No. 9 Southern California).
- lowa tied the school record for number of wins over ranked teams in a season last year with seven. The Hawkeyes have accomplished the feat three other times (1995-96, 1993-94, 1992-93). lowa faced 11 ranked teams last season, which tied for the most games against ranked opponents in a season. The only other time lowa played 11 ranked teams in a season was in 1992-93 (7-4 record).

B1G HONOR ROLL:

- Two Hawkeyes -- Samantha Logic and Melissa Dixon -- have been named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll in the last six weeks. Iowa has had a player named to the Honor Roll or be named Player of the Week in five of the last six weeks.
- Logic was named to the Honor Roll on Nov. 25 after averaging 21.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals as lowa split
 a pair of road contests at No. 16 Colorado and UNI.
- Dixon was honored Dec. 2 after being named MVP of the Cancun Challenge Mayan Division, where she averaged 22.3 points per game, including a career-high 32 against UNC-Wilmington.
- Dixon was honored again on Dec. 9, after helping lowa to wins over No. 22 Syracuse and Idaho State last week, averaging 25.5 points per game, while converting 13-of-21 three-point attempts.
- Logic was to the Honor Roll on Dec. 31. She finished with 21 points, eight assists, seven rebounds and two steals while shooting 60 percent from the floor in a win over North Dakota
- Logic was named Big Ten Player of Week on Nov. 12 for her efforts in lowa's wins against UC Riverside and No. 14 Dayton, and
 on Dec. 23 following her triple-double against Drake.

DIXON CATCHING FIRE:

- Junior guard Melissa Dixon finished with six 3-point field goals in lowa's win over Idaho State on Dec. 7 one shy of her personal record and the school record (seven accomplished five times, twice by Dixon).
- After converting seven 3-pointers total during the first six games of the season (7-of-46), Dixon has made 38 over the last nine
 games (38-of-87).
- Prior to the Cancun Challenge, Dixon was averaging 9.7 points per game. She is now averaging 14.8 points per outing.

LOGIC NAMED B1G PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

lowa junior guard Samantha Logic was named Big Ten Player of Week on Monday following her second career triple-double in lowa's 73-51 win over Drake on Dec. 21.

Logic (5-foot-9) -- the Big Ten leader in assists -- tallied 12 points, 10 assists and 17 rebounds, while shooting 85.7 percent from the field on 6-of-7 shooting and added two steals. She last accomplished the feat on Feb. 26, 2012, against Michigan (13 points, 11 rebounds, 11 assists).

Logic, the only current Big Ten player with two career triple-doubles, has two of the five triple-doubles in program history -- Cara Consuegra, Kachine Alexander (twice).

The Racine, Wis., native, who has 15 career double-doubles, is second in career assists (441). She surpassed Michelle Edwards (431) during lowa's win over the Bulldogs. Logic, 1-of-2 conference juniors named preseason All-Big Ten, has nine career games with double-digit assists, equaling Cara Consuegra for the most in program history.

The award marks Logic's fourth career Player of the Week honor, and second this season (Nov. 12).

IOWA SETS NEW SINGLE-GAME 3-POINT RECORD:

The Hawkeyes won their sixth game in a row, thanks to a school-record 17 made 3-point field goals, 95-47, on Dec. 7 against Idaho State inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

lowa shot 56.4-percent from the field for the game and held the Bengals to 21.5-percent (11.8-percent in the second half). While the Hawkeyes made 75-percent of their two-point field goals (14-of-21), the real story was their success from long range.

Junior Melissa Dixon converted six 3-pointers, giving her 20 in the last three games. She had a school-record seven against UNC-Wilmington and Syracuse. Senior Theairra Taylor made four 3-pointers against Idaho State, freshman Ally Disterhoft had three, sophomore Kathryn Reynolds added two, and junior Samantha Logic and freshman Alexa Kastanek made one apiece.

The previous record was 14, last accomplished on Dec. 22, 2011, against Mississippi Valley State.

BLUDER GETS WIN NO. 600:

Head coach Lisa Bluder became the 42nd coach in NCAA women's basketball history (all divisions) and only the 25th Division I head coach (minimum 10 years at a DI school) to collect 600 wins Jan. 20 vs. Purdue. Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

HAWKEYES LIKE TO SHARE:

- The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in assists, averaging 19.3 per contest. lowa also leads the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.3).
- Samantha Logic leads the league in assists, averaging 6.6 a game.
- lowa tallied 28 assists on 31 made field goals on Dec. 7 in its win over Idaho State. The Hawkeyes have tallied 28 or more assists
 four times this season. The school record for assists in a game is 31.
- lowa broke the school record for single-season assists last year in the win over Miami (March 24). The previous record of 514 was set in 2011-12. Iowa finished with 531 assists. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten and 26th in the NCAA with 15.7 assists per game. Iowa recorded at least 17 assists in 15 games, including five games with 20 or more.

NCAA STREAK LEADS THE BIG TEN:

lowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA Tournaments.

LOGIC BREAKS ASSIST RECORD:

- Last season, Logic led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA with 6.4 assists per game. She leads the Big Ten in the category
 this season, and is 13th nationally.
- Logic's nine games with double digit assists equal Cara Consuegra for the most games with 10 or more assists. The next closest
 Hawkeyes on the list are Kachine Alexander, Jolette Law and Michelle Edwards, with two career games.
- Logic recorded seven or more assists in 15 games, including four games with 10 or more. She had at least five assists in 24 games.
- Samantha Logic recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists) on Nov. 10, leading the Hawkeyes to a 97-93 overtime victory against No. 14 Dayton. Logic hit the game-tying 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime. The 14 assists equaled a personal best and lowa school record, and are the most in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history. The previous high was 12 (three times).
- Logic -- who now has 16 career double-doubles -- became lowa's single-season assist record holder a year ago, breaking the
 mark in lowa's win at Northwestern (March 3). Logic entered the game tied with Cara Consuegra (2000-01) at 191 assists. Logic
 collected seven assists at Northwestern and finished with 217.


