Cancun Challenge Quick Hits

- The Iowa men's basketball team travels to Cancun for the first time in its program history.
- The Hawkeyes have started the year 4-0 for the first time since 2008. Iowa's 2008 squad started its season 5-0.
- Iowa has won nine of its last 10 home games, dating back to Feb. 1.
- Iowa won its first three games by an average of 20.5 points.
- Roy Devyn Marble and Aaron White have scored in double figures in all four games.
- Aaron White leads the team in rebounding (8.0), steals (1.8) and free throws made (27) and attempted (39), and is second in scoring (14.8).
- The Hawkeyes have attempted 23 or more free throws in each of their first four games.
- This marks the second time in three years under Fran McCaffery that the Hawkeye head coach has started two freshmen in the season opener (Basabe and McCabe in 2010).
- Iowa is 10-2 when scoring 80 points or more, the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes are 17-0 when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points, the last two years.
- Iowa's average starting lineup height is 6-foot-6. The Hawkeye starting lineup consists of two freshmen, one sophomore, and two juniors.

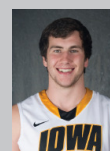

THE SETTING

Iowa (4-0) travels to Cancun, Mexico to compete in the 2012 Cancun Challenge. The Hawkeyes will play Western Kentucky (2-1) from the Sun Belt Conference on Tuesday at 8:30 p.m. Iowa will then face either DePaul or Wichita State on Wednesday (6 or 8:30 p.m.) depending on the result of Tuesday's action.

This marks the first time the Iowa men's basketball will compete in the Cancun Challenge. The Hawkeye women's basketball team has traveled to Cancun twice during Lisa Bluder's tenure.

ON THE AIR

Radio: Iowa games at the Cancun Challenge are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show.

Television: Cancun Challenge games on Tuesday and Wednesday will be televised on the CBS Sports Network. The channel is available on satellite providers and many cable digital sports packages.

HAWKEYES RALLY FOR WIN OVER GARDNER-WEBB

- Iowa trailed by as many as 23 points late in the first half, but rallied to register an impressive 65-56 win over Gardner-Webb on Saturday night in Iowa City.
- Fueled by a 24-4 run spanning halves, the Hawkeyes tied the game (42-42) with 10 minutes left in the second half. Iowa would outscore the Runnin' Bulldogs 23-14 the remainder of the half to post the nine-point victory.
- Iowa was held to 18 first-half points, while Gardner-Webb was limited to 18 second-half points. The Hawkeye offense scored 47 points the final 20 minutes, which proved to be the difference.
- Iowa had four players score in double figures: Josh Oglesby (13), Aaron White (13), Adam Woodbury (12) and Roy Devyn Marble (11). Marble scored all 11 of his points in the second stanza, while Oglesby netted 12 of his 13 the final 20:01 of the contest.
- Aaron White posted Iowa's first double-double of the season (13 points, 10 rebounds).
- After shooting only 20 percent (5-25) in the first half, the Hawkeyes shot 50 percent (14-28) in the second stanza. Iowa held Gardner-Webb to 19 percent (5-26) shooting from the floor the final 20 minutes.
- Iowa made a season-high 21 free throws (32 attempted).

Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery is in his third season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 17th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 30th season as a collegiate coach in 2012, which includes 16 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 53, holds a career mark of 284-214 (.570) and guided his teams to seven postseason appearances (five NCAA, two NIT). He is 33-37 (.471) at Iowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- Fran McCaffery has coached in 498 career games (284-214, .570). Wednesday's game against DePaul or Wichita State will be his 500th game as a head coach.
- The Hawkeyes have played 10 players or more in each of the first four games.
- Iowa (62) doubled the amount of assists than its opponents (31).
- Aaron White is attacking the rim averaging a team-best 9.75 free-throw attempts per game. He is averaging 6.75 free-throw makes per outing.
- The Hawkeyes have attempted 23 or more free throws in each of their first four games. Iowa has attempted 23 free throws twice (Central Michigan and Howard) and 25 twice (Gardner-Webb and UTPA).
- Iowa has made (70) more free throws than its opponents have attempted (56), which is a staple of Fran McCaffery-coached teams.
- Roy Devyn Marble scored 15 of his season-high 22 points in the first half against Howard. It marked the third time in his career the junior reached the 20-point plateau.
- Freshman center Adam Woodbury has missed only five field goal attempts (12-of-17, .706). He is also averaging 5.5 boards per contest.
- The Hawkeyes boast a +7.0 rebounding margin over their opponents.
- Iowa blocked 10 shots vs. UT-Pan American in its season opener, the most by an Iowa team since Nov. 14, 2005 (Md.-Eastern Shore).

NUMBER OF THE WEEK -- 3

Three of Iowa's starters are from the Sioux City area. Junior Zach McCabe and freshman Adam Woodbury hail from Sioux City, Iowa, while freshman Mike Gesell is a native of South Sioux City, Neb. Gesell celebrated his 19th birthday on Nov. 9, the season opener.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Tuesday will be the first meeting between Iowa and Western Kentucky. The Hawkeyes are 9-2 all-time against current teams in the Sun Belt. Iowa is 2-1 all-time against DePaul and 4-4 vs. Wichita State.

The Hawkeyes last played the Blue Demons on March 15, 1995, winning 87-86 in the postseason NIT in Moline, Ill. Iowa last played Wichita State on Nov. 24, 2009, falling to the Shockers 74-57 in the CBE Classic in Kansas City, Mo.

SCOUTING WESTERN KENTUCKY

- Western Kentucky is 2-1 having lost its opener in overtime at Southern Miss, then winning their two home games against Austin Peay (74-54) and Western Carolina (92-81).
- The Hilltoppers have three players average double figures in scoring: Jamal Crook (19.7), T.J. Price (13.0), and George Fant (12.3). Crook also leads the team in assists (5.0), steals (2.0), and free throws made (19) and attempted (23).
- Western Kentucky has two players average 8.3 boards per contest: T.J. Price (8.3) and George Fant (8.3).
- The Hilltoppers pull down 5.3 more rebounds than their opposition.
- Jamal Crook, T.J. Price, and George Fant average 31 minutes or more per contest.
- Western Kentucky beat Western Carolina, 92-81, on Saturday. Jamal Crook and T.J. Price share game high scoring honors with each netting 26 points.
- The Western Kentucky-Western Carolina game featured 52 fouls and 74 free throw attempts. The Hilltoppers made 30 of their 43 foul attempts.

MARKED IMPROVEMENT IN YEAR TWO

Fran McCaffery guided Iowa to 18 wins (18-17) in his second season as head coach of the Hawkeyes, with four of the 18 victories coming against top 20 opponents. McCaffery was one of only four Big Ten coaches to record four or more wins over ranked opponents, and the only coach to do so with an unranked team.

McCaffery's seven-win improvement in his second season, ties Pops Harrison (1943-44) for the fourth best improvement following his second year as Iowa head coach. Steve Alford (2000-01) and Lute Olsen (1975-76) rank first (+9), while George Raveling (1984-85) is third (+8). Furthermore, the seven-win improvement ranked third-best in the Big Ten in 2012 behind Indiana (+12) and Michigan State (+10).

Iowa improved by four wins in conference play from 2011 (four) to 2012 (eight), its best improvement since 1994-95. Tom Davis' 1994 team won five, while his 1995 squad collected nine victories.

Last year, Iowa allowed opponents 72.5 points per contest. Through four games in 2012, Iowa is yielding just 52.0 points. Iowa held Howard to 36 points on Nov. 15, which were the fewest points a Hawkeye team allowed since a 61-36 win over Bryant on Dec. 5, 2008.

IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,663 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,599-1,064 (.600).
