IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 1,056 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 645-411 (.611). That includes a 322-162 (.665) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 306-88 (.777) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

WIN NO. 300 AT HOME

The UI women's basketball program picked up victory No. 300 inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena with a 90-79 win over Central Michigan Nov. 21. The Hawkeyes have compiled a 306-88 (.777) record inside their home venue since it opened in 1983.

SCOUTING ILLINOIS

The Illinois Fighting Illini are 7-14 overall and 2-6 in Big Ten play.

In their last game, the Fighting Illini took Penn State to the wire, but couldn't come away with the win, falling 67-65 in Champaign. Karisma Penn led the way with 21 points, 13 rebounds and five blocks. Amber Moore had 17 points. Illinois converted 24 Penn State turnovers into 23 points.

Penn is the team's leading scorer, and the only player to average double figures, at 17.3 points per game. She also leads the team with 10.6 rebounds per contest. Amber Moore is next at 8.7 points per game.

As a team, the Fighting Illini are shooting .403 (511-1,267) from the field, including .321 (103-321) from three-point distance.

ILLINOIS VS. IOWA NOTES

- Sunday is the 63rd meeting between Iowa and Illinois, with the Hawkeyes holding a 46-16 advantage in the all-time series. The 46 victories are the most the Hawkeyes have against any other Big Ten opponent. Iowa has won 43 of the last 50 meetings, including 11 of the last 12. Iowa won 21-straight games in the series between 1986 and 1996. The Hawkeyes are 19-10 in games played in Champaign, and have won the last six matchups at Assembly Hall.
- Illinois third-year Head Coach Jolette Law is a 1990 graduate of the University of Iowa. Law, who was an all-American in 1990 and played four years (1986-90) for former Iowa Hall of Fame Coach C. Vivian Stringer. Law currently ranks 20th in Iowa career scoring (1,137), sixth in steals (205) and eighth in assists (353). The Hawkeyes won or shared four Big Ten championships, reached the Elite Eight twice and won 46-straight home games during her career.

LAST MEETING

Iowa defeated Illinois in Iowa City, 77-67, to sweep the season series against the Fighting Illini last season.

The Hawkeyes led by as many as 30 in the second half, but Illinois trimmed the deficit to just four points with 3:30 remaining. Clutch free throw shooting by Kachine Alexander down the stretch helped Iowa hold onto its lead and seal the win.

Iowa sprinted out to a 25-6 lead in the first half, and took a 47-20 lead into halftime.

Three Hawkeyes scored double figures, including a game-high 24 points by Alexander. Jaime Printy added 17 points, four rebounds, two assists and a career-high three steals, while Kamille Wahlin had 17 points.

ALEXANDER SET FREE THROW RECORDS VS. ILLINOIS LAST YEAR

Kachine Alexander set two school records and a Big Ten record against Illinois last season.

Alexander's 17 made free throws and 20 free throw attempts were both school records. In addition, the two marks are Carver-Hawkeye records for an Iowa player.

Alexander's 17 made free throws are also the most by a single player in a Big Ten game. The 20 attempts are the third-most by a Big Ten player in conference history.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS

The Hawkeyes are ranked No. 18 in the AP poll and No. 21 in the ESPN/USA Today poll.

Four Iowa opponents are also ranked in the AP and the ESPN/USA Today polls: Michigan State (10/11), North Carolina (15th/14th), Iowa State (23rd/20th) and Ohio State (24th/23rd).

Northwestern is receiving votes.

HAWKEYES KNOCK OFF SPARTANS

Iowa held on for an exciting, 66-64 victory over No. 10 Michigan State in Iowa City (Jan. 27).

Iowa held on to a two-point lead with just over five seconds remaining. Michigan State's Kalisha Keane missed a three-pointer that would have won the game, and Lykendra Johnson missed two-straight layups that would have sent the game to overtime.

Iowa was lights out from the field, shooting .500 (24-48) from the field, including .462 (6-13) from beyond the arc. The Hawkeyes out-scored Michigan State, 32-26, in the paint.

Kachine Alexander led the way with 23 points, 11 rebounds and three steals while playing all 40 minutes. Kelly Krei and Jaime Printy each added 11 points, while Kamille Wahlin chipped in eight points, four rebounds and six assists with zero turnovers.

SEEING DOUBLE

Kachine Alexander recorded her sixth double-double of the season against Michigan State (Jan. 27), finishing with 23 points and 11 rebounds.

Alexander now has 30 career double-doubles, which is five shy of Lisa Long's school record for double-doubles (35, set from 1983-87).

Last season, Alexander finished with 15 double-doubles, which was one shy of tying Amy Herrig's record for single-season double-doubles.

Alexander tallied nine double-doubles as a sophomore.

MORE MILESTONES FOR ALEXANDER

- If Kachine Alexander records six more assists, she would be the first player in Iowa history and just the fifth in Big Ten history, to have 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds and 300 career assists. The other Big Ten players to hit the milestone were Wisconsin guard Jolene Anderson, Minnesota center Janel McCarville, and Illinois forwards Lacey Simpson and Tajua Catchings.
- With 11 rebounds at Ohio State (Jan. 24), Alexander became just the sixth player in school history, and the first-ever guard, to collect 800 career rebounds.
- Alexander is the sixth player in school history to have 1,000 career points and 800 career rebounds.

PRINTY AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Iowa has played in six games against opponents ranked in the top 25 this year, and Jaime Printy's numbers in those games have been impressive.

Printy is averaging 15.5 points, 4.7 rebounds and 4.2 assists in Iowa's games against ranked opponents (North Carolina, Iowa State, Ohio State twice and Michigan State twice). Printy is shooting .448 (30-67) from the field, including .458 (11-24) from three-point distance and .917 (22-24) from the free throw line against ranked foes.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 11th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 27th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 47, has a career record of 561-270 (.675), including a 205-128 (.616) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to nine post-season tournaments (7 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and seven upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

PRINTY HAS A BIG WEEK

Jaime Printy averaged 20.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in Iowa's two games at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and at home vs. Indiana (Jan. 16).

Printy shot a combined .571 (12-21) from the field, including .700 (7-10) from three-point distance, while only missing one free throw (10-11, .909).

Printy started the week with 23 points, seven rebounds, two assists and three steals in Iowa's buzzer-beater loss at Michigan State, scoring 18 of Iowa's 28 first half points.

She followed with a game-high 18 points on 5-10 shooting, including 3-6 from beyond the arc, and eight rebounds in Iowa's 20-point victory over Indiana.

NINE IN A ROW FROM DOWNTOWN

Jaime Printy buried nine-straight three-pointers, starting with Iowa's game at Minnesota (Jan. 5). Printy made her last three-point attempt at Minnesota, was a perfect 2-2 against Ohio State (Jan. 8), a perfect 4-4 at Michigan State (Jan. 13) and made her first two attempts vs. Indiana (Jan. 16) before missing a long-distance shot.

KASH GETS A GRAND

With a layup at the 11:54 mark in the first half against Minnesota (Jan. 5), senior Kachine Alexander became the 27th player in school history to record 1,000 career points.

Alexander currently ranks 24th in career scoring at Iowa with 1,084 points.

JOHNSON BRINGING THE WINDEX

Morgan Johnson tallied 10 or more rebounds for the fourth time this season against Indiana (Jan. 16). Johnson finished the game one-point shy of a double-double, scoring nine points and grabbing 10 boards.

Johnson has recorded double digit rebounds in 10 career games.

JOHNSON AT .500 OR BETTER

When Morgan Johnson takes eight or more shots in a game, chances are she will make at least half of them.

Johnson has attempted eight or more shots in 15 of Iowa's 20 games this year. In those 15 games, Johnson has shot .500 or better 10 times, including two 6-9 (.667) shooting performances against North Carolina and Kansas State.

Johnson has attempted 10 or more shots eight times, shooting .500 or better in all but two games. Johnson was 8-13 (.615) against Northeastern, 10-16 (.625) against Central Michigan, 8-11 (.727) vs. Iowa State, 9-12 (.750) vs. South Dakota State, 5-10 (.500) vs. Michigan and vs. Ohio State and 7-12 (.583) at Ohio State.

She was 2-12 (.167) vs. James Madison and 4-12 (.333) at Minnesota.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Morgan Johnson recorded her fifth double-double of the season and the eighth double-double of her career against Minnesota (Jan. 5). Johnson finished the game with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

JOHNSON FILLING UP THE STAT SHEET

Morgan Johnson scored double figures over a tough four game-stretch, including double-doubles in two of those four contests.

Johnson tallied a double-double with 16 points and 13 rebounds at No. 14 North Carolina Dec. 2. She followed with 13 points and six rebounds against Kansas State and recorded another double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds against No. 15 Iowa State. Johnson had a career-high 26 points at South Dakota State, including the first 11 points of the contest.

Over the four-game stretch, Johnson averaged 17 points, nine rebounds, shot .707 (29-41) from the field and blocked 13 shots.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Iowa is one of only four teams in the Big Ten to have four players ranked among the top 30 scorers in the conference.

Iowa, Ohio State, Northwestern and Penn State each have four players ranked. Wisconsin, has three ranked, while the remaining six schools have either one or two players ranked.

The Hawkeyes have had at least three players reach double figures in scoring in 18 of the 21 games this year. Five players scored 10 or more points against Bradley. Four players hit double digits against Northeastern, Central Michigan, Kansas State, Minnesota and in both games vs. Ohio State.

HAWKEYES HITTING THE BOARDS

Iowa's rebounding numbers are impressive. The Hawkeyes lead the Big Ten in total rebounding (42.3 per game) and rank second in rebounding margin (+5.1) and defensive rebounds (27.9 per game) and third in offensive rebounds (14.0 per game).

Kachine Alexander ranks second in offensive rebounding (3.4 per game) and third in overall rebounding (9.5 per game). Morgan Johnson ranks third in offensive rebounding (3.3 per game). Alexander's 18 rebounds against Central Michigan, Nov. 21, are the third most for any Big Ten player this season.

REBOUNDING NUMBERS IMPROVED FROM A YEAR AGO

Iowa's rebounding has improved greatly from a year ago.

Through 21 games last year, Iowa had a +0.5 rebound margin. The Hawkeyes were being outrebounded, 805-794, including a 258-260 deficit on the offensive glass.

This year through 20 games, Iowa holds a +5.1 rebounding margin and is outrebounding opponents 881-774. That includes a 295-263 advantage on the offensive glass.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kachine Alexander ranks second in career double-doubles (30), sixth in career rebounding (814), 11th in career assists (294) and 24th in career scoring (1,084). She needs 14 more rebounds to move past Jennie Lillis for fifth place on the rebounding list and three assists to move past Lillis for 10th on the assists list. She needs six more double-doubles to take over first place (Lisa Long, 35).
- Morgan Johnson ranks fourth in career blocks (129) and needs 17 more to move past Toni Foster into third place.
- Kamille Wahlin ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (146) and 27th in career scoring (964). She needs 11 more three-pointers to move past Leah Magner into fourth place.
- Jaime Printy ranks seventh in career three-pointers made (130) and needs nine more to move past Kristi Faulkner for sixth place.

BLUDER REACHES MILESTONE

With a 75-71 win at Drake Dec. 20, Iowa Head Coach Lisa Bluder became only the second coach in school history to reach the 200-win milestone.

Bluder currently has 204 wins in her 11 years at Iowa. C. Vivian Stringer is the only other Hawkeye head coach to reach the 200-win plateau at Iowa, finishing her time in Iowa City with 269 wins.

Ohio State Head Coach Jim Foster is the only other active Big Ten coach to have reached 200 wins at his/her current school.

ALEXANDER NAMED CO-BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kachine Alexander was named co-Big Ten Player of the Week, Nov. 22, for her efforts against Bradley, Northeastern and Central Michigan. Alexander shared the weekly honor with Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke.

Alexander collected double-doubles in each of Iowa's three games and earned MVP honors at the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge.

Alexander's first double-double of the season came against Bradley, recording 14 points and 10 rebounds. Alexander was 8-10 from the free throw line and also had five assists and three steals.

Alexander started the KCRG-TV9 Hawkeye Challenge with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Northeastern, adding six assists, two steals and a block.

She wrapped up the tournament MVP award with 20 points and 18 rebounds against Central Michigan in the championship.

Alexander has now been named Big Ten Player of the Week five times in her career. She was a two-time award winner as both a sophomore and junior.

ALEXANDER MAKES FIRST CUT FOR WOODEN AWARD - ON WATCH LISTS FOR OTHERS

Senior Kachine Alexander was one of 20 players to be named to the Wooden Award Top 20 Midseason List Jan 11. She is also on watch lists for the Wade Trophy and the Naismith Trophy. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players and the Naismith Trophy watch list is made up of 50 players.

The Wade Trophy, Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy are considered the three most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER

Last year marked the seventh time in 10 seasons under Head Coach Lisa Bluder that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the ninth time in 10 seasons under Bluder. Iowa's third place finish in the Big Ten is also the seventh time under Bluder the Hawkeyes recorded an upper-division finish in the conference.

Iowa also tallied its fifth 20-win season under Bluder, including each of the last three seasons.
