### Game #22 Storylines

- Iowa is one of only two Big Ten teams (Penn State) with two players in the top ten in scoring.
- Iowa is in the middle of a stretch of playing 4-of-6 and 5-of-7 on the road.
- Four of UI's five Big Ten losses have come by margins of nine points or less, two by three points.
- Iowa is 13-3 when shooting 40 percent or better from the field.
- Aaron White is one of only three Big Ten players to average 14 ppg and six rpg or better. The other two being Cody Zeller of Indiana and Deshaun Thomas of Ohio State.
- The Hawkeyes are 8-1 when Aaron White scores 16 points or more.
- Iowa is 16-2 when scoring 80 points or more, the last three seasons. The Hawkeyes are 22-0 when holding opponents to fewer than 60 points, the last three years.
- Melsahn Basabe earned his first start of the season in Iowa's last game. In the last three outings, Basabe has led the team in rebounding, averaging 9.3 boards.
- For only the second time in the last two decades, the men's basketball team has nine players logging 15.5 minutes or more per game, and 10 players averaging 9.5 minutes or more. Iowa's 1998-99 team, that advanced to the Sweet 16 in the 1999 NCAA Tournament, had 10 players average 17 minutes or more.

## THE SETTING

Iowa (14-7, 3-5) travels to Minneapolis Sunday to play No. 23 Minnesota (16-5, 4-4). Tip-off is set for 12:06 p.m. (CT) inside Williams Arena. Sunday will be Iowa's third road contest in four games and its fourth Sunday road contest in the last five weeks.

## ON THE AIR

**Radio:** All Iowa games are broadcast on the Hawkeye Radio Network. Gary Dolphin handles the play-by-play, along with color commentator Bob Hansen. The network includes more than 40 stations that blanket the state of Iowa and include portions of Illinois, Nebraska, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin. The Hawkeye Radio Network coverage includes a 60-minute pregame show. Fans can also listen to the broadcast on satellite radio: Sirius (91) and XM (91).

**Television:** Sunday afternoon's game will be televised on BTN (BTN2GO). Brian Anderson and Eddie Johnson will call the action.

## HAWKEYES BEAT PENN STATE. 76-67

- Iowa led by as many as 15 points en route to a 76-67 win over Penn State on Thursday night in Iowa City. The win was Iowa's 10th straight over the Nittany Lions in Iowa City.
- Sophomore Aaron White netted a career-high 27 points. It was the fourth time he has scored 20 points or more this season, and the sixth time in his career.
- Melsahn Basabe started for the first time this season and first time since Jan. 26, 2012. In his 53rd career start, the junior recorded his first double-double of the season and the 10th of his career. He scored 10 points and pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds. Eight of his 10 points came at the free throw line, matching a career best.
- Iowa tied for season highs in free throws made (31) and attempted (39); Iowa also went 31-of-39 at the free throw line vs. Wichita State on Nov. 21, 2012 in Cancun.
- The Hawkeyes forced 18 Penn State turnovers, which is the most Iowa has forced against a Big Ten team this season.
- Iowa was credited with assists on 90 percent of its field goals (18-of-20).
- Zach McCabe collected a game-high four steals, which equaled a personal best.
- The Hawkeyes had 10 players play 10 minutes or more. Iowa's bench scored 27 points. For the season, Hawkeye reserves average 25.4 points per game.
- Iowa collected 11 steals, which ties for the most in Big Ten play (vs. Indiana). The Hawkeyes are 5-1 when recording double-digit thefts.
- The win improved Iowa's home record to 11-2 this season. Additionally, the Hawkeyes have won 16 of their last 19 home contests, dating back to last season.

## Head Coach Fran McCaffery

Fran McCaffery is in his third season as the head basketball coach at the University of Iowa and his 17th year overall as a college head coach. McCaffery spent five seasons (2005-10) as the head coach at Siena, six years at UNC-Greensboro (1999-2005) and three seasons at Lehigh (1985-88) before joining the Hawkeyes.



McCaffery has three decades of Division I coaching experience. He completed his 30th season as a collegiate coach in 2012, which includes 16 years as a head coach and 14 as an assistant.

McCaffery, 53, holds a career mark of 294-221 (.571) and guided his teams to seven postseason appearances (five NCAA, two NIT). He is 43-44 (.494) at Iowa.

McCaffery's five years at Siena were the best in its 70-year history. He led the Saints on an incredible run that ended with three straight Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances. In so doing, Siena became the only program in the country to win its regular season and postseason title the last three years.

McCaffery's Saints owned a 112-51 (.687) record in his five years with the program. He guided the Saints to four consecutive 20-win seasons, something that has never been accomplished before at the Siena.

The 2009 MAAC Coach of the Year and 2010 District I Coach of the Year is the third winningest coach, by percentage, in league history (68-22, .756). He is the only coach to guide a MAAC program to two NCAA Tournament wins. McCaffery led his 2008 and 2009 teams to first round NCAA Tournament victories over Vanderbilt and Ohio State, respectively.

In his final two seasons at Siena, he coached the Saints to back-to-back 27-win campaigns and boasted a combined 39-3 (.929) record against MAAC opponents, which included MAAC Tournament contests.

McCaffery began his coaching career as an assistant at Penn (1982-83) and Lehigh (1983-85). Then at age 26, he became the nation's youngest Division I head coach when hired by Lehigh in 1985. After three seasons as head coach at Lehigh, he spent 11 seasons as an assistant at Notre Dame (1988-99).

McCaffery played basketball at Wake Forest his freshman year (1977-78) and then concluded his collegiate playing career at Penn his final three seasons (1979-82).

He earned his B.S. degree in Economics from The Wharton School (Penn) in 1982. McCaffery also earned a Master of Education from Lehigh in 1985.

## 2012-13 Captains

Iowa captains are senior Eric May and junior Roy Devyn Marble

### ALL-TIME SERIES

Minnesota holds a 100-90 advantage in the series that began with a 47-10 Gopher win in 1902. The 190 meetings are the most Iowa has played against any opponent. The Gophers had won six straight in the series before the Hawkeyes swept Minnesota a season ago. It marked Iowa's first sweep over Minnesota since 2007.

The Gophers hold a 60-34 advantage in games played at Minnesota. Minnesota has won five of the last seven meetings in Williams Arena. Iowa snapped a three-game losing streak in the barn with last year's 64-62 thrilling win on Jan. 4, 2012.

The teams have met twice in the Big Ten Tournament. Along with a 2006 win in Indianapolis, Iowa defeated the Gophers 81-78 in the 2000 event at the United Center in Chicago. Iowa also defeated the Gophers at a neutral site (Los Angeles) early in the 1964-65 season.

### SCOUTING MINNESOTA

- Minnesota snapped a four-game losing skid with an 84-65 triumph over Nebraska on Tuesday night in Minneapolis. Senior forward Rodney Williams scored a season-high 23 points, while sophomore guard Andre Hollins added 14 points and junior guard Austin Hollins finished with 13 points.
- The Golden Gophers are 11-1 at home, with the lone setback coming to top-ranked Michigan (83-75) on Jan. 17.
- During Minnesota's four-game losing skid, three of the losses came on the road. Additionally, each of the four losses came by eight points or less, including one game by one point (at Wisconsin).
- Minnesota leads the Big Ten in blocks (6.1) and steals (6.1); ranks second in rebounding margin (+9.6) and assists (16.0); ranks third in scoring (73.7), and is fourth in field goal percentage (.463). Their +9.6 rebounding margin is fifth best in the country.
- Trevor Mbakwe ranks first in the conference in rebounding (8.6); second in blocks (1.8); and fifth in field goal percentage (.587). Andre Hollins ranks eighth in the league in scoring (14.1); fourth in 3-point accuracy (.420); fifth in free throw percentage (.793); ninth in 3-pointers (2.0); and 10th in assists (3.5). Austin Hollins ranks second in the Big Ten in steals (2.0).

### IOWA BEAT MINNESOTA IN LAST MEETING

Iowa used two second-half 9-0 runs, including one to end the game, to come from behind and edge Minnesota, 63-59, on Feb. 1, 2012, in Iowa City.

Roy Devyn Marble scored five of his 12 points in crunch time, and assisted on another crucial basket in the final seconds. Senior Matt Gatens led all scorers with 18 points, netting 14 in the second half. Zach McCabe posted personal bests in rebounding (10), steals (4) and assists (4).

Iowa scored in transition and had a high number of high percentage shots en route to victory. The Hawkeyes outscored Minnesota 15-0 in fast break points and 30-10 in paint points.

### IOWA VS. RANKED TEAMS

Sunday will be Iowa's fourth contest this year against a ranked opponent. The Hawkeyes fell 69-65 on Dec. 31 to fifth-ranked Indiana in Iowa City; No. 2 Michigan (95-67) on Jan. 6 in Ann Arbor; and No. 18 Michigan State (62-59) on Jan. 10 in Iowa City.

The Hawkeyes collected four wins over top-25 competition a year ago.

## BASABE... SPICY!

Melsahn Basabe's play has been so good the last few games, that he was moved to the starting lineup in Iowa's last outing vs. Penn State. The junior has averaged 9.4 points and 6.8 rebounds in his last five games. He led the team in rebounding the last three outings, averaging 9.3 boards. Basabe posted his first double-double of the season in Iowa's win over Penn State (10 points and 10 rebounds).

Overall, Basabe ranks fourth in team scoring (7.4), first in blocks (1.1) and third in rebounding (4.5).

## HAWKEYE FASTBREAKS

- In Iowa's two win against Minnesota a year ago, Zach McCabe averaged 10 points and 8.5 rebounds. Aaron White averaged 9.5 points and 6.5 boards, while Roy Devyn Marble averaged 10.5 points and 4.5 rebounds.

- Iowa's strength of schedule ranks 43rd in the country.
- Junior Zach McCabe has averaged three steals the last two games.
- The Hawkeyes have played 10 players or more in 20 of their 21 games. The only contest in which they did not play 10 players was Iowa State (nine players). Iowa has nine players who average nearly 15.5 minutes or more of action.
- Co-captain Eric May has posted his best offensive rebound average, assist rate, turnover rate and free throw percentage of his career this season.
- Iowa shot 40 percent from the field in its win over Penn State, marking the first game since Wisconsin on Jan. 19 in which it shot at least 40 percent from the field. The Hawkeyes are 13-3 this season when shooting at a 40 percent clip or better.
- Seven of the 12 Big Ten teams enter this weekend with four losses or more in league play. The Big Ten is the No. 1 rated conference by the RPI.
- Adam Woodbury has almost the same number points (112) and rebounds (111).
- Last season, Iowa had eight different players post double digits in one game or more. This year, 11 different players have scored double figures for the Hawkeyes.
- Three of Iowa's first six Big Ten games were one-plays. The Hawkeyes only play Michigan, Michigan State and Ohio State once. Iowa's other one-play this season is Illinois (March 5 in Iowa City).
- Aaron White ranks 41st in the nation in free throw attempts per game (6.67).
- Iowa has made 44-of-127 (.346) 3-pointers in six games away from home, while the Hawkeyes are 64-of-236 (.271) from long range in 13 home contests.
- Iowa ranks fourth in the country in free throws made (17.8) and seventh in attempts (25.1).
- Iowa has made (374) more free throws than its opponents have attempted (357), which is a staple of Fran McCaffery-coached teams.
- Iowa has had an attendance figure of 10,500 fans or greater in all 13 home contests, including sellouts of 15,400 against Indiana on Dec. 31 and Wisconsin on Jan. 19.
- Iowa's 12 triples vs. UNI are the second most by a Fran McCaffery-coached Iowa team. Roy Devyn Marble's 30 points and 14 free throws made rank third and first, respectively, the last three seasons under Fran McCaffery.
- Iowa has won 16 of its last 19 home games, including 11-of-13 this season, dating back to Feb. 1, 2012. The Hawkeyes' two losses this season have come to nationally ranked teams (Indiana and Michigan State).

## Peter Jok Signs With Hawkeyes

University of Iowa Men's Basketball Coach Fran McCaffery announced today that Peter Jok has signed a National Letter of Intent to attend the University of Iowa.

"We are thrilled that Peter Jok is going to become part of the Hawkeye family," said McCaffery. "He has a complete skillset that will be a great asset to our team. He's an excellent athlete who can play four different positions, and is a terrific 3-point shooter. Peter is exactly what we are looking for in this class."

Jok is a 6-foot-6, 200-pound guard born in Sudan, who played his first two years as a prep at Des Moines Roosevelt, and his last two at West Des Moines Valley. Last season at Valley, Jok earned second team all-conference honors after averaging 10.2 points. He hit 86 percent of his free throws, grabbed 4.3 rebounds and made 37 percent of his 3-point attempts. Jok's high school coach at Valley is Jeff Horner, Iowa's all-time assist leader.

As a sophomore at Roosevelt, Jok averaged 18.5 points and seven rebounds and was a second team all-state and first team all-conference honoree. He was also one of 30 high school freshmen invited to the Nike Top 100 Camp in St. Louis in 2010, and participated in the 2012 NBA Players Association Top 100 Camp.

Jok played AAU basketball on the All-Iowa Attack.

Jok will join Jarrod Uthoff, who transferred to Iowa from the University of Wisconsin this year, on the 2013-14 active Iowa roster.

### DISHING THE ROCK

Iowa has done an outstanding job sharing the basketball this season. The Hawkeyes have assisted on 66.8 percent of their field goal makes (338 assists on 522 field goals), a rate that is 12th best in the country.

### IN NATIONAL STATISTICS...

Iowa ranks 20th in the country in assists (16.1) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (.290); 39th in field goal percentage defense (.390).

### WHITE HOT!

Aaron White has averaged 17.3 points per game and 5.3 rebounds the last three games. The sophomore is one of just three Big Ten players to average 14 points and six rebounds this season, with the other two being Cody Zellar of Indiana and Ohio State's DeShaun Thomas.

The Hawkeyes are 8-1 this season when White scores 16 points or more.

### HEATING UP

Roy Devyn Marble's game has soared as of late before injuring his ankle, rising to ninth in Big Ten scoring (14.0 ppg). He has scored in double digits in all but three games played this season (Iowa State, Penn State and Northwestern).

In his last 10 games played, the junior averaged 14.5 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 2.5 assists. During that 10-game stretch, Marble is shooting 78 percent from the free throw line (53-of-68). The native of Southfield, Mich., did not play vs. Michigan State due to an injured ankle.

Last year, Iowa allowed opponents 72.5 points per contest. Through 21 games in 2012-13, Iowa is yielding 63.9 points. Iowa held Howard to 36 points on Nov. 15, which were the fewest points a Hawkeye team allowed since a 61-36 win over Bryant on Dec. 5, 2008. Also, the Black and Gold limited Northwestern (Jan. 13) to 50 points, its fewest output against Iowa since scoring 48 in Iowa's 65-48 victory on Feb. 23, 1999 in Iowa City.

Also, Iowa is holding its opponents to a much lower field goal percentage this season, compared to a year ago. Hawkeye opponents are shooting at a 39 percent clip this season, compared to 46 percent last season.

### DEFENSE IMPROVEMENT, PART 2

Iowa has improved its 3-point field goal percentage defense by 5.5 percent this season compared to last. That improvement is tops in the Big Ten.

### IOWA HISTORY

Iowa has played 2,680 games since beginning basketball in 1902. Iowa's overall record is 1,609-1,071 (.600). That includes a 967-355 (.731) record in home games, a 552-726 (.432) record in contests away from Iowa City, a 714-733 (.493) mark in Big Ten games and a 373-118 (.760) record in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

### DYNAMIC DUO

Sophomore Aaron White and junior Roy Devyn Marble are one of only two Big Ten duos to rank in the top ten in overall scoring. Marble ranks ninth (14.1), while White ranks 10th (14.0). Penn State's D.J. Newbill ranks fifth (15.7), while Jermaine Marshall ranks seventh (15.0).

### FREEBIES

Iowa made 31-of-39 free throws Thursday night vs. Penn State. The last time the Hawkeyes made at least 31 foul shots in a Big Ten game was Jan. 16, 2007 against Indiana (32). The last time Iowa attempted at least 39 free throws in a league game was Feb. 5, 2005 vs. Michigan State (45).

Aaron White, who ranks 41st in the country in free throw attempts, has attempted double-digit foul shots in four games this season, including two of the last four contests.

### HAWKEYES ARE TOUGH AT HOME

Iowa has won 97 of its 135 games (.718) in Carver-Hawkeye Arena (15,400) over the last nine seasons, including win streaks of 21 straight overall and 12 straight Big Ten Conference wins. Iowa has won 10 of its last 20 home games against ranked opponents. Iowa was a perfect 17-0 at home in 2006, 14-2 in 2007, 10-8 in 2008, 13-4 in 2009, 9-9 in 2010, 8-8 in 2011 and 13-6 in 2012.

### COACHING EXPERIENCE

Fran McCaffery has assembled one of the most experienced coaching staffs in the country. Assistant coaches Kirk Speraw, Sherman Dillard and Andrew Francis have over six decades of combined coaching experience. Furthermore, the entire coaching staff combines for 48 years of head coaching experience.

Director of basketball operations Jerry Strom is in his 32nd season as a member of the Iowa basketball staff. Additionally, Iowa's video coordinator, Al Seibert, has 18 years of collegiate coaching experience.

### **IOWA POSTS LARGEST COMEBACK IN SCHOOL HISTORY**

Iowa trailed Gardner-Webb by 23 points (38-15) with 13 seconds left in the first half on Nov. 17 in Iowa City. Sophomore Josh Oglesby drained three free throws after being fouled on a 3-point attempt with one second remaining in the half to cut the deficit to 20 (38-18) at halftime. The Hawkeyes rallied in the second half and ultimately won by nine points (65-56), which is a 32-point swing. The comeback is believed to be the largest in school history.

The last team in the country to overcome a 20+ halftime deficit was Harvard, which trailed Brown by 22 points (53-31) and won 85-78 on Feb. 12, 2011.

The last Big Ten team to overcome a 20+ halftime deficit was Illinois, which trailed at Clemson by 20 points (47-27) and won 76-74 on Dec. 2, 2009.

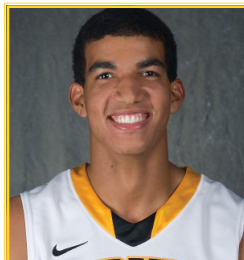

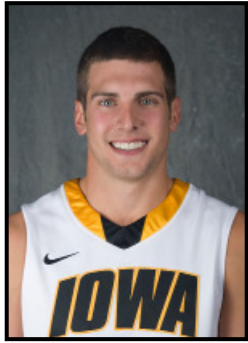
