THE SETTING:

The University of Iowa women's basketball team (5-1) stays on the road this week, facing USC, Boston College, and UNC Wilmington in the 2013 Cancun Challenge in Cancun, Mexico. Iowa faces USC on Thursday at 7:30 p.m. (CT), Boston College on Friday at 5 p.m., and concludes action against UNC-Wilmington on Saturday at 7:30 p.m.

The Hawkeyes are in the midst of a five-game road stretch. Iowa dropped a 90-87 decision at No. 16 Colorado on Nov. 20, before defeating Northern Iowa in Cedar Falls on Nov. 24, 67-60.

AUDIO COVERAGE:

Brent Balbinot and Shelley Till will call the action for the Hawkeye Radio Network. Hawkeye fans can listen to the contests on the Hawkeye All-Access page of hawkeyesports.com. Balbinot is in his 10th season as Iowa's play-by-play voice, while Till is in her ninth providing analysis.

FOLLOW THE ACTION:

Hawkeye fans can also follow the action via a live stream at CBSsports.com, ULive, and via live stats. The links can be accessed on the women's basketball schedule page. Follow @IowaWBB on Twitter for game updates.

IOWA HISTORY:

Iowa has played 1,138 games since beginning basketball in 1974. Iowa's overall record is 697-441 (.612). That includes a 348-178 (.662) mark in regular season Big Ten contests and a 339-97 (.776) mark in Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

NCAA STREAK LEADS THE BIG TEN:

Iowa is the only Big Ten team, and one of only 13 teams in the country, to have appeared in the last six NCAA Tournaments.

IOWA IN THE RANKINGS:

The Hawkeyes are the first team listed receiving votes in the AP Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Seven Iowa opponents are also ranked in the Associated Press/USA Today polls: Nebraska (11/10), Penn State (14/15), Colorado (16/20), Purdue (18/22), Michigan State (21/19), Iowa State (22/16) and Dayton (RV/24). In addition, Ohio State is receiving votes.

TOURNAMENT FIELD:

This year, the event features eight Division I teams representing five conferences: Arizona State (Pac-12), Arkansas State (Sun Belt), Boston College (ACC), Illinois (Big Ten), Iowa (Big Ten), North Carolina (ACC), UNC Wilmington (Colonial), and USC (Pac-12).

HAWKEYES RETURN TO CANCUN:

Both Arizona State (2007 and 2005) and Iowa (2010 and 2008) are making their third appearance in the event. The Hawkeyes are 3-1 all-time in Cancun Challenge action. Iowa last traveled to Cancun in 2010, downing James Madison and Virginia Tech.

The Big Ten Conference is 11-6 all-time at the Challenge, marking the most wins of any conference.

ALL-TIME SERIES:

The Hawkeyes are 3-1 all-time against USC. The two teams have split two neutral site games. Iowa dropped its only meeting against Boston College, 72-67, on Dec. 2, 2009, in Iowa City in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge. The Hawkeyes have never faced UNC Wilmington.

2013-14 Team Captains

Iowa captains are senior Theairra Taylor and junior Samantha Logic.

SCOUTING USC:

USC is 3-1 overall following an 82-51 loss at No. 20 Oklahoma State on Nov. 22. The Trojans face South Carolina on Monday night.

USC, led by first-year head coach Cynthia Cooper, finished 11-20 overall last season, with an 11-7 mark in Pac-12 play. The Trojans returned four starters from last year's squad.

SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE:

Boston College is 2-2, with wins against Hofstra and Florida International, and losses to Stanford and BYU.

Boston College is led by head coach Erik Johnson. Johnson led the team to a 12-19 overall record and 5-13 conference mark last year in his first season.

SCOUTING UNC-WILMINGTON:

The Seahawks are 1-4 overall. UNC-Wilmington, coached by Adell Harris (fifth season), finished 5-26 last season with a 3-15 conference mark.

BALANCED ATTACK

Three Hawkeyes are averaging double figures, and five players are averaging at least 9.7 points per contest: Samantha Logic (15.8 ppg), Bethany Doolittle (12.8), Ally Disterhoft (12.8), Theairra Taylor (9.8), and Melissa Dixon (9.7).

Six Hawkeyes scored in double figures in Iowa's overtime win against No. 14 Dayton, and Iowa has had three or more players score in double figures in each of the last four contests.

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS:

- Samantha Logic is sixth in career assists (392). She needs 21 more assists to move past Kristi Smith and Jaime Printy for fourth place.
- Melissa Dixon ranks 10th in career 3-pointers (120). She needs six more 3-pointers to move past Johanna Solverson for ninth place.
- Bethany Doolittle is seventh all-time with 98 career blocks. She needs 17 blocks to move past Jennie Lillis for fifth place.

CLIMBING TO THE TOP:

Lisa Bluder needs 14 wins to surpass Hall of Famer C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins) as Iowa's all-time winningest coach. Bluder is 255-158 all-time as the Hawkeye head coach.

IOWA RETURNS TO WIN COLUMN AT NORTHERN IOWA:

Riding a double-double by point guard Samantha Logic, Iowa returned to the win column with a 67-60 road victory at Northern Iowa on Nov. 24 in Cedar Falls, Iowa. Logic scored 17 points with 10 rebounds to pace the Hawkeyes (5-1 overall), who bounced back from their first road loss of the season Nov. 20 at No. 16 Colorado.

The contest is the first for the mythical Iowa state championship. Iowa plays at Iowa State on Dec. 12 and hosts Drake on Dec. 21.

Ally Disterhoft scored 14 points with seven rebounds for the Hawkeyes and Bethany Doolittle added 11 points, eight rebounds, and three steals.

HAWKEYES RALLY. FALL SHORT AT NO. 16 COLORADO:

Iowa scored a season-high 52 points in the second half, but late woes at the free throw line doomed the Hawkeye comeback during a 90-87 loss to No. 16 Colorado on Nov. 20 at the Coors Events Center in Boulder, Colo. Iowa's point total ended a 34-game stretch where Colorado held its opponents to 70 points or less. The Buffaloes (3-0) have now won 27-straight nonconference regular season games.

Hawkeye junior Samantha Logic shared a game-high scoring honors with 26 points on 9-of-19 shooting from the field and 7-of-9 from the line. She had six assists and five rebounds. Four Iowa players scored in double figures: Logic, Kali Peschel and Theairra Taylor (12 apiece), and Bethany Doolittle (10). Doolittle had a team-high seven rebounds.

HAWKEYES LIMIT STONY BROOK:

Iowa improved to 4-0 by limiting Stony Brook to 18.6-percent shooting from the field and 6.7-percent from 3-point range during a 78-40 victory on Mediacom Court inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena on Nov. 17. Four days after holding Arkansas-Pine Bluff to 38 points, the Hawkeyes held Stony Brook to 21 points in the first half and 19 in the second.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 14th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 30th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder has a career record of 612-300 (.671), including a 256-158 (.619) record at Iowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.

Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer (269 wins). She has guided the Hawkeyes to 12 postseason tournaments (10 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and nine upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and taking home the conference tournament title in 2001.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball News Service and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, Iowa, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

Iowa shot 43.8-percent for the game (28-of-64) with five 3-pointers in 28 attempts. The Hawkeyes maintained huge advantages in bench points (33-11), paint points (38-18), and points off turnovers (22-8). Iowa outscored Stony Brook by 23 points in the second half (42-19).

Ten Hawkeyes saw action and 10 Hawkeyes found the scoring column. Iowa's leading scorer and rebounder came off the bench in freshman Ally Disterhoft. She scored 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting from the field (2-of-3 from 3-point), with nine rebounds, two steals and two blocks in 28 minutes.

FEWEST POINTS ALLOWED IN 19 YEARS:

The Hawkeyes sprinted to an 11-0 lead, outscored Arkansas-Pine Bluff 20-0 in fast break points, and cruised to a 76-38 win on Wednesday night inside Carver-Hawkeye Arena. It marked the fewest points allowed by Iowa since it defeated Michigan 53-36 on Dec. 30, 1994.

Three Hawkeyes scored in double figures with juniors Bethany Doolittle and Melissa Dixon sharing game high honors with 17. Freshman Ally Disterhoft played 23 minutes and scored 12 points with nine rebounds and four assists.

Three other Hawkeyes logged career highs in minutes played: sophomore Claire Till (25), and freshmen Alexa Kastanek (21) and Hailey Schneden (six). Eight of the 10 Iowa players saw 20 or more minutes of action.

HAWKEYES TOP DAYTON IN OVERTIME:

The Hawkeyes defeated No. 14 Dayton on Nov. 10 in overtime, 97-93, to win the Hawkeye Challenge. Iowa equaled its high point total from a year ago, when it defeated Missouri State, 97-43, on Dec. 19 -- 97 points equals the seventh-highest total in a game in school history (106 is most).

Iowa led by double digits in both halves, then overcame a five-point deficit with 32 seconds to play, before winning in overtime.

Samantha Logic (tournament MVP), Bethany Doolittle, and Kali Peschel were named to the all-tournament team, as six Hawkeyes scored in double figures.

Logic recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists).

Doolittle notched a career-best six blocks, moving into a tie for seventh all-time in program history with 86 career blocks. The center also netted a team high and career best 22 points.

Peschel recorded her first career double-double, posting career highs in points (12) and rebounds (14). She has grabbed double-digit rebounds in Iowa's first two contests (11 vs. UC Riverside).

Freshman Ally Disterhoft netted 19 points off the bench. Melissa Dixon (13 points) and Thea-irra Taylor (10) also scored in double figures.

IOWA CONTINUES TREND AGAINST RANKED FOES:

The Hawkeyes have recorded at least one win against a top-25 team in all but two seasons under Bluder. In 10 of those seasons, Iowa has knocked off at least one top-15 opponent. Iowa defeated No. 11 Purdue and No. 12 West Virginia last year, when it tied a single-season record with seven victories over ranked foes.

LOGIC NAMED BIG PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Junior guard Samantha Logic was named Big Ten Player of Week on Nov. 12 for her efforts in Iowa's wins against UC Riverside and No. 14 Dayton last week.

Logic (5-foot-9) was named tournament MVP of the Hawkeye Challenge after averaging 22 points, 9.5 assists, 6.0 rebounds, and 3.0 steals, leading Iowa to the team title. She went 4-of-5 from 3-point range and made 10-of-12 free throws.

In the season-opening victory against UC Riverside on Nov. 8, Logic netted a career-best and game-high 28 points. She added seven rebounds, five assists and three steals.

The Racine, Wis., native recorded her 13th career double-double (16 points, 14 assists) on Nov. 10, leading the Hawkeyes to a 97-93 overtime victory against the Flyers. Logic hit the game-tying 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime. The 14 assists equaled a personal best and Iowa school record, and are the most in Carver-Hawkeye Arena history. The previous high was 12 (three times).

Logic, 1-of-2 conference juniors named preseason All-Big Ten, has seven career games with double-digit assists, the second most in Iowa history. Cara Consuegra had nine games in her career with 10 or more assists. Logic moved into eighth place on Iowa's all-time assists list, passing Steph Schueler (367). Logic has 372 career assists. The award marked Logic's third career Player of the Week honor. Jaime Printy was the last Hawkeye to garner the weekly honor (Jan. 29, 2013).

LOGIC NAMED PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN:

Junior Samantha Logic was named Preseason All-Big Ten by league media, the conference office announced Thursday. Logic, a junior from Racine, Wis., started all 34 games last season and was a third team All-Big Ten selection. The 5-foot-9 guard set school records for single-season

assists (217) and single-game assists (14 vs. Texas, Dec. 28). Logic tallied five double-doubles, and led the Big Ten and ranked 15th in the NCAA in assists per game (6.4).

SUCCESS UNDER BLUDER:

Last season marked the 10th time in 13 seasons under head coach Lisa Bluder -- one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins -- that Iowa has been selected for the NCAA Tournament, including each of the last six seasons. The Hawkeyes have participated in postseason play in all but one season under Bluder (two WNIT appearances).

It also marked the seventh time in Bluder's 13 seasons that the Hawkeyes reached 20 wins. Iowa has collected 20 or more wins in five of the last six years. In addition, Iowa finished with a winning record for the 12th time in 13 seasons under Bluder.

IOWA SELECTED TO HOST NCAA 1ST AND 2ND ROUNDS:

The University of Iowa and Carver-Hawkeye Arena have been selected by the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee to serve as one of 16 hosts for the first and second rounds of the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. Iowa is 1-of-8 schools chosen to host first/second round games for the second-straight year.

The 2014 NCAA Championship will mark the 13th time the University of Iowa has served as a host. Iowa hosted its first NCAA action in 1986 when it was one of four regional final sites. Carver-Hawkeye Arena also hosted from 1986-90, 1992-94, 1996-98 and in 2009 and 2013. Carver-Hawkeye Arena has hosted the regional finals four times and first and/or second round games 11 times.

Iowa hosted first and second round games in 2009. Despite having late afternoon and evening games on a Sunday in March of 2009, Iowa's site recorded the fourth-highest first round attendance (5,615).

In 2013, the first round of the Iowa City Regional drew 6,836 fans, which was the third-best attended site among the 16 host sites. In addition, Iowa City had the sixth-best figure for second round games (4,942) and the fifth-highest total attendance (11,778).

BLUDER GETS WIN NO. 600:

Head coach Lisa Bluder became the 42nd coach in NCAA women's basketball history (all divisions) and only the 25th Division I head coach (minimum 10 years at a DI school) to collect 600 wins Jan. 20 vs. Purdue.

Bluder is one of 13 active Division I coaches with 600 or more wins.

HAWKEYES LIKE TO SHARE:

- The Hawkeyes are third in the Big Ten in assists, averaging 17.3 per contest.
- Samantha Logic leads the league in assists, averaging 6.5 a game.
- As a team, Iowa registered 30 assists, one shy of the school record, in the win against No. 14 Dayton on Nov. 10.
- Iowa broke the school record for single-season assists last year in the win over Miami (March 24). The previous record of 514 was set in 2011-12. Iowa finished with 531 assists. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten and 26th in the NCAA with 15.7 assists per game. Iowa recorded at least 17 assists in 15 games, including five games with 20 or more.
