SCOUTING IOWA STATE

The Iowa State Cyclones are 4-2 with wins over Houston Baptist (73-33), Drake (71-64), Northern Arizona (65-41) and Butler (64-44). Both of Iowa State's Iosses came to Big Ten opponents (Penn State, 66-59, and Michigan, 56-49).

In their last game, the Cyclones were defeated by Michigan in Ann Arbor. The Wolverines limited lowa State to a .339 (19-56) field goal percentage. Hallie Christofferson led lowa State with 13 points and 10 rebounds. Jessica Schroll had 12 points and Chelsea Poppens had nine points and 11 boards.

Poppens leads lowa State with 14.2 points and 11.7 rebounds per game. Christofferson is next at 10.2 points and 7.5 rebounds.

As a team, lowa State is shooting .392 (130-332) from the field, including .263 (44-167) from three-point distance.

IOWA VS. IOWA STATE NOTES

- lowa leads the all-time series, 22-19. The Hawkeyes are 5-10 against the Cyclones in Ames. lowa's last win in Ames came in 1989.
- Two experienced coaches will face off Wednesday night. Lisa Bluder is the dean of Big Ten coaches, and is in her 12th season at Iowa. Bill Fennelly is the dean of Big 12 coaches, and is in his 17th year at Iowa State.
- Both teams have five players from the state of Iowa on the roster. Iowa's include Trisha Nesbitt (Ames), Kelly Krei and Virginia Johnson (Iowa City), Kalli Hansen (Olin) and Jaime Printy (Marion). Iowa State's players are Elly Arganbright (Panora), Hallie Christofferson (Hamlin), Chelsea Poppens (Aplington), Melissa Youngblut (Davenport) and Amanda Zimmerman (Ballard).

IOWA CORN CY-HAWK SERIES

lowa State leads the eighth annual lowa Corn Cy-Hawk Series, 9-4, after six events. Iowa State gained two points in volleyball, and men's and women's cross country, along with three points in football. Iowa's points came in women's soccer and wrestling.

IN THE RANKINGS

Iowa is receiving votes in the latest ESPN/USA Today poll.

Four lowa opponents are ranked in the AP and ESPN/USA Today polls: Texas A&M (4/4), Purdue (13/16), Penn State (16/15) and Ohio State (17/18).

In addition, Nebraska, Michigan, Northwestern, Iowa State and UNLV are receiving votes.

HAWKEYES FALL AT KANSAS STATE IN OVERTIME

lowa fought back from a large second half deficit, but couldn't complete the comeback, falling at Kansas State, 81-78, in overtime Saturday night in Manhattan.

The game was tied at 32 at half, but a 13-2 run to start the second half gave Kansas State a 47-34 lead. Iowa battled back and eventually gained a 68-67 lead with 5:12 remaining. Kalli Hansen's three-pointer with 3:45 left made the score 73-69 in favor of Iowa, but Kansas State forced overtime with a bucket at the 1:06 mark.

Kansas State made just one basket in overtime, but five free throws led the Wildcats to the win.

Four Hawkeyes scored double figures, led by Jaime Printy (21). Morgan Johnson netted 17, Kamille Wahlin had 13 and Kalli Hansen chipped in a career-high 11. Johnson, Samantha Logic and Hansen each grabbed six boards.

HANSEN NETS CAREER NUMBERS AT KANSAS STATE

Senior Kalli Hansen recorded career-highs in points (11), field goals made and attempted (4-6), three-pointers made and attempted (2-3) and assists (2) in Iowa's game at Kansas State (Dec. 3).

Hansen's jumper with 4:31 remaining gave lowa a 70-69 lead and her three-pointer on the next possession made the score 73-69. The Hawkeyes could not hold on to the lead, falling in overtime.

REACHING DOUBLE FIGURES

lowa's game at Kansas State marked the fourth time this season that at least three players have scored 10 or more points.

The Hawkeyes had four players in double figures against Northern lowa and Kansas State. Three players reached double digits against Harvard and Albany.

NO DOUBLE FIGURES. NO PROBLEM

lowa had just one player (Morgan Johnson) score double figures in a win over Virginia Tech (Nov. 30).

The last time an lowa team won a game with just one player in double figures was Dec. 2, 2007 vs. Detroit when Kristi Smith netted 10 points.

Since the game vs. Detroit in 2007, lowa teams have only had one player score 10 or more points just seven times. The Hawkeyes lost all seven of those contests.

JOHNSON FROM THE FIELD

Junior Morgan Johnson has atttempted at least 10 shots in four games this season. In three of those games, Johnson has shot .500 or better.

Johnson was 5-10 (.500) vs. Harvard, 9-13 (.692) at Northern Iowa and 6-11 (.545) at Kansas State.

The only game Johnson failed to shoot .500 with 10 or more shots was vs. Virginia Tech (8-21, .381).

CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS

The Hawkeyes have cashed in from the free throw line so far this season.

lowa is 126-155 from the charity stripe and their .813 free throw percentage ranks first in the Big Ten and fourth in the NCAA.

Individually, Jaime Printy's .885 free throw percentage is fifth-best in the Big Ten and 45th-best in the NCAA.

Head Coach Lisa Bluder

Lisa Bluder (pronounced BLUE-dir) is in her 12th season as head coach at the University of Iowa and her 28th season as a college head coach. She is a three-time Big Ten and two-time WBCA Regional Coach of the Year.

Bluder, 48, has a career record of 572-277 (.674), including a 216-135 (.615) record at lowa, a 187-106 (.638) record in 10 seasons (1990-2000) at Drake and a six-year mark (1984-90) of 169-36 (.824) at St. Ambrose.



Bluder is Iowa's second all-time winningest coach and trails only C. Vivian Stringer. She has guided the Hawkeyes to 10 post-season tournaments (8 NCAA, 2 WNIT) and eight upper-division finishes in the Big Ten Conference, including winning a share of the league championship in 2008 and tying for second place in 2009.

In her first season with the Hawkeyes, Bluder transformed a struggling program into a 21-game winner. Iowa finished second in the Big Ten, won the conference tournament and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Bluder became Iowa's third coach to be named Big Ten Coach of the Year. She was also honored as the College Coach of the Year by the *Women's Basketball News Service* and was named the WBCA District 6 Coach of the Year. Iowa's 2001-02 squad finished fourth in the Big Ten and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year. In 2003, Bluder guided the Hawkeyes to their first-ever WNIT appearance. Iowa, which had nine underclassmen on its roster, advanced to the quarterfinals before falling to Creighton. In 2004-05, Iowa finished 23-10, starting the year 13-0 and was the last Division I undefeated team standing. In 2005-06, Bluder mentored a team plagued by injuries to a fifth-place Big Ten finish and an NCAA Tournament berth.

In her 10 years at Drake, Bluder brought great success and tradition to the Bulldog program and established herself as one of the top coaches in the country. She led Drake to five 20-plus win seasons in her last six years, including five post-season appearances. She guided the Bulldogs to eight Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearances, reaching the semifinals six times and winning the tournament four times. Bluder was also named the Conference Coach of the Year three times at Drake.

Bluder began her coaching career at St. Ambrose, where she coached six successful seasons, building the Bees into a NAIA powerhouse. During her tenure at St. Ambrose, Bluder guided the Bees to four straight national tournaments, including two consecutive Final Four appearances. The 1990 St. Ambrose team was ranked No. 1 and Bluder was named the NAIA Converse Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Linn-Mar High School in Marion, IA, Bluder was a three-year starter at Northern Iowa. She graduated from UNI in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in marketing.

HITTING FROM OUTSIDE

Kelly Krei has emerged as lowa's top three-point shooter.

Krei is 15-31 from beyond the arc and leads the team with a .484 three-point percentage. Her three-point percentage ranks second in the Big Ten.

CONSISTENT STARTS

Three Hawkeyes have recorded consistent starts in certain statistical categories through seven games this season.

- Junior Jaime Printy has scored at least 15 points in all but two games, including three 20 point performances.
- Freshman Samantha Logic has grabbed at least five rebounds and dished out at least four assists in five of lowa's eight games.
- Junior Morgan Johnson has recorded three blocks in four of lowa's first eight contests.

PRINTY STREAK SNAPPED

Junior Jaime Printy had converted 30-straight free throws, dating back to lowa's game vs. UNLV (Nov. 13), before a miss from the charity stripe against Texas A&M (Nov. 26).

Printy went 8-8 against UNLV (Nov. 13), 9-9 against Albany (Nov. 16), 4-4 vs. Northern lowa (Nov. 19) and 8-8 vs. St. John's (Nov. 25). She made her first attempt against Texas A&M, before missing the first of two free throws in the second half.

Printy's latest streak is the second time she has made at least 30-straight free throws. She made 32-straight free throws last year, one shy of lowa's record for consecutive free throws (33 by Lindsey Meder).

LOGIC COLLECTS DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Freshman Samantha Logic scored 10 points and grabbed 11 rebounds at Northern Iowa (Nov. 19) for her first career double-double.

Logic's double-double was the first for an Iowa freshman since the 2009-10 season. Morgan Johnson had 16 points and 11 rebounds vs. Purdue (Jan. 31, 2010).

KREI HITTING THE GLASS

Kelly Krei recorded her third career double-double vs. Albany (Nov. 16) with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

Krei's first double-double came at home vs. Indiana as a sophomore (14 points and 13 rebounds). Her second was in the season opener vs. Southern in the Islander Tip-Off Classic, hosted by Texas A&M Corpus Christi, as a junior (20 points and 10 rebounds).

MAJOR BENCH POINTS

Iowa's 26 points off the bench vs. Albany were the most for a Hawkeye team in 26 games. The Hawkeyes scored 26 bench points against Virginia Tech last year in Cancun. Before the Virginia Tech game a year ago, the last time an Iowa team scored 26 or more bench points was against Texas State in 2008 (27 off the bench).

MOVING UP CAREER CHARTS

Four Hawkeyes are currently working their way up the career records lists at Iowa.

- Kamille Wahlin ranks fourth in career three-pointers made (180), 10th in career assists (331) and 21st in career scoring (1,152). She needs six more three-pointers to move past Kristi Smith into third place, nine more assists to move past Kachine Alexander for ninth place and nine more points to past Tia Jackson for 20th place.
- · Morgan Johnson ranks second in career blocks (174) and needs 62 more to move past Tangela Smith for first place.
- Jaime Printy ranks fifth in career three-pointers made (166) and 19th in career scoring (1,165). She needs 15 more three-pointers to move past Wahlin for fourth place and 29 more points to move past Crystal Smith for 18th place.
- Kelly Krei ranks eighth in career three-pointers made (131) and needs eight more to move past Kristi Faulkner into seventh place.

NESBITT SIDELINED WITH KNEE SURGERY

Junior Trisha Nesbitt will be sidelined after having minor knee surgery Nov. 15. She is expected to miss 3-6 weeks of action.

HAWKEYES ON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAMS

Junior Jaime Printy was named to both the Hawkeye Challenge and Junkanoo Jam all-tournament teams. Senior Kamille Wahlin was chosen for the Hawkeye Challenge all-tournament team and freshman Samantha Logic was picked for the Junkanoo Jam all-tournament team.

Printy led Iowa in scoring vs. both Harvard (24 points) and UNLV (25 points) in the Hawkeye Challenge. She added six rebounds and four assists vs. Harvard, along with five rebounds and four assists vs. UNLV.

Printy was also named **CollegeSportsMadness.com**'s Big Ten Player of the Week.

Wahlin netted nine points against Harvard and scored 15 vs. UNLV. She also had two rebounds and three assists against the Rebels.

Logic averaged 14.5 points and six rebounds while shooting .500 (12-24) from the field against two tough opponents in the Junkanoo Jam.

Logic started the week with 13 points, three rebounds and three steals in lowa's win over St. John's. Logic was 5-9 from the field in 22 minutes of action.

Against the No. 4 ranked and defending NCAA champion Texas A&M Aggies, Logic was one rebound shy of a double-double. She scored 16 points, grabbed nine rebounds and added three assists

Printy started the Junkanoo Jam with a team-best 17 points (8-8 FTs), five rebounds, three assists and three steals against St. John's.

Printy added 14 points, three rebounds and three steals against Texas A&M.

HAWKEYES PICKED TO FINISH THIRD

The lowa women's basketball team was picked to finish third by both the league coaches and media. Penn State was chosen as the favorite in both polls.

Junior Jaime Printy was a preseason all-Big Ten selection by both the league media and coaches.

PRINTY NAMED TO WATCH LISTS

Junior Jaime Printy has been named to the "Wade Watch," Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy Watch Lists. The "Wade Watch" List is made up of the top 25 preseason women's basketball players, the Wooden Award includes 30 student-athletes and the Naismith Trophy list has 51 players.

The three awards are considered the most prestigious awards in NCAA women's college basketball.
